7. The quoted rates shall remain fixed throughout the tenure of the contract and no revision is permissible for any reason.

SECTION-I

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS, TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. COMPANY PROFILE

The Food Corporation of India was setup under the Food Corporation's Act 1964 in order to fulfill following objectives of the Food Policy:

- (i) Effective price support operations for safeguarding the interests of the farmers.

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- (ii) Distribution of food-grains throughout the country for public distribution system &
- (iii) Maintaining satisfactory level of operational and buffer stocks of food-grains to ensure National Food Security.

2. OBJECTIVE OF CONTRACT

To ensure uninterrupted, effective, clear and proper capturing of video images of identified locations for the designated depot premises, so as to have continuous display/storage of such image/data and its retrieval as and when required for effective security surveillance.

3. SCOPE OF WORK

Onsite Comprehensive Annual Maintenance Contract of CCTV Cameras installed at various depots of FCI DO Hisar mentioned in Annexure-C. It is time bound work; bidders have to take over the AMC work within 07 days after the issue of Work order. If bidder fails to start the work in stipulated time, he is liable for compensation @ 1.5% per month of contract value for delay of work to be computed on per day basis. The contractor shall deploy only well experienced and qualified personnel for execution of the work.

4. VOLUME OF WORK:

Subject as hereinafter mentioned the Corporation do not guarantee any definite volume of work or and particular pattern of service at any time or through-out the period of Contract. The mere mention of any item of work in this Contract is not by itself confirm right on the Tenderer to demand that the work relating to all or any item thereof should necessarily or exclusively be entrusted to them. The Corporation will also have the right to appoint one or more Tenderer at any time viz. at the time of award of Contract and/or during the tenure of Contract for all or any or all the services mentioned hereunder and to divide the work as between such Tenderer in any manner that the Corporation may decide and no claim shall be made against the Corporation by the Tenderer by reason of such division of work.

6. DUE DILIGENCE

The Bidder is expected to examine all instructions, forms, terms, conditions and specifications in this Bid document. Bid shall be deemed to have been made after inspection of various sites and careful study and examination of this document with **full** understanding of its implications. The Bid should be precise, complete and strictly in the prescribed format as per the requirement of this tender. Failure to furnish all information required by this bid document or submission of a Bid not as per this document will be at the bidder's risk and shall result in rejection of the Bid and the decision of the Corporation in this regard will be final, conclusive and binding.

7. DISQUALIFICATION CONDITTONS.

- (I) Tenderer who have been blacklisted or otherwise debarred by FCI or any Department of Central or State Government or any other Public Sector Undertaking will be ineligible during the period of such blacklisting or for a period of 5 years from the date of **blacklisting/debarment**, whichever is earlier.

- (II) Any Tenderer whose contract with the Food Corporation of India, or any Department of Central or State Government or any other Public Sector Undertaking has been terminated before the expiry of the contract period at any point of time during last five years, will be ineligible.

- (III) Tenderer who's **Earnest Money Deposit and/or Security Deposit** has been forfeited by Food Corporation of India or any Department of Central or State Government or any other Public Sector Undertaking, during the last five years, will be ineligible.

- (IV) If the proprietor /any of the partners of the Tenderer Firm/any of the Director of the Tenderer Contractor have been, at any time, convicted by a court for an offence and sentenced to imprisonment for a period of three years or more, such Tenderer will be ineligible.

- (V) While considering ineligibility arising out of any of the above clauses, incurring of any such disqualification in any capacity whatsoever (even as a Proprietor, Partner in another Firm, or as Director of a Company etc.) will render the Tender disqualified.

- (VI) A Hindu Undivided Family (either as a Proprietor or partner of a firm) shall not be entitled to apply for Tender. Any Tender submitted in the capacity of Hindu Undivided

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Family (either as a Proprietor or partner of a firm) shall be summarily rejected.

8. AUTHORIZED SIGNATORY

The bidder shall authorize a person(s) who will be responsible for the management and control of the work relating to the contract during the tenure of the contract. The person so authorized shall be deemed to have power of attorney from the bidders in respect of the contract and whose act shall be binding on the bidders.

Signing of Tender:

- (i) Person or persons signing the Tender shall state in what capacity he is or they are signing the Tender e.g. as sole proprietor of a firm or a Secretary/Manager/Director, etc. of a limited company. In the case of registered partnership firm, the names of all the partners should be disclosed and Tender shall be signed by all the partners. The original or an attested copy of registered Partnership Deed should be furnished along with the Tender. In case of limited Company, the names of all the Directors shall be mentioned and a copy of the Resolution passed by the Company authorizing the person signing the tender to do so on behalf of the Company shall be attached to the tender along with a copy of the Memorandum and Articles of Association of the Company.
- (ii) **"The person signing the Tender, or any documents forming part of the Tender, on behalf of another or on behalf of registered firm shall be responsible to produce a proper power of attorney duly executed in his favor, stating that he has authority to bind such other person or the registered Firm as the case may be, in all matters pertaining to the contract. If the person so signing the Tender fails to produce the said power of attorney his tender shall be liable to summarily rejection without prejudice to any other right of the Corporation under the contract and law."**
- (iii) **"The Power of Attorney should be signed by all the Partners in the case of a registered partnership concern, by the Proprietor in the case of proprietary concern, and by the person who by his signature can bind the Company in the case of Company. The each page of the entire tender documents must also be signed by the Tenderer/ authorized person."**
- (iv) **"The person signing the tender or any other document(s) forming part of the tender, on behalf of any other person or a registered firm shall be deemed to warrant that he has authority to bind such other person or the Registered firm, as the case maybe, in all matters pertaining to the contract. If, at any stage, it is found that the person concerned had no such authority, the FCI may, without prejudice to other civil/ criminal remedies, terminate the contract and hold the signatory liable for all costs and consequences/damages."**

a. BIDDING PROCESS

- i. Bidders are advised to study the Bid Document carefully. Submission of the Bid will be deemed to have been done after careful study and examination of all instructions, terms and required specifications in the bid document with full understanding of its implications.

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- ii. The bidders may contact GeM portal helpline, with regard to technical issues relating to functioning of their platform or any doubts regarding on line submission of bid.
- iii. Bid(s) not having mandatory document(s) uploaded shall not be accepted.
- iv. Food Corporation of India reserves the right to reject any or all the bids and/ or cancel the bid enquiry at any stage without assigning any reason.
- v. No negotiation will be entertained with any of the bidder(s).

9. BID OPENING AND EVALUATION

- (i) The Corporation will open online Bid at specified date and time. In the event of the specified date for the opening of bids being declared holiday for the FCI, the bids will be opened on the appointed time on the next working day.
- (ii) Prior to the detailed evaluation, the Corporation will determine whether each Bid is prima facie complete and is substantially responsive to the bidding documents. For purposes of this determination, a substantially responsive Bid is one that conforms to all the terms, conditions and specifications of the bidding documents.
- (iii) Bids with any deviations, objections to or reservations on provision of terms and conditions of bid will be treated as non-responsive.

ACCEPTANCE OF BIDS

Divisional Manager Hisar Haryana for and on behalf of the Corporation reserves the right to reject any or all the bids, without assigning any reasons thereof and does not bind himself to accept the lowest or any other bid.

10. VALIDITY OF THE BID

- a. The Bid should be kept valid for a period specified in GeM Portal.
- b. In exceptional circumstances, prior to expiry of the original Bid validity period, the Corporation, at its discretion, may extend the validity period as per GeM provisions.

11. EARNEST MONEY

- a. Each Tender must be accompanied by an Earnest Money Deposit (EMO) @2% (5000/-) of the tender value.
- b. The Tenderers shall deposit Earnest Money in the stipulated FCI account on or before bid submission closing date & time and the scanned copy/ soft copy of RTGS / NEFT/Fund transfer (internet banking) acknowledgment of such deposit shall be uploaded along with the Technical Bid.
- c. Any Tender not in accordance with the following Terms and Conditions will be rejected by FCI as non-responsive
- i. The Tenders not accompanied by the prescribed EMO, and not in the prescribed form shall be rejected summarily unless otherwise specifically exempted as per the policy of Government of India issued from time to time.

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- ii. T h e Earnest Money will be returned to all unsuccessful Tenderers within a period of 15 days from the date of disqualification in the case of all Tenderers whose Technical Bids are disqualified, and within a period of 30 days from the date of issue of the Acceptance Letter in the case of all other Tenderers and to a successful Tenderer, after he has furnished the Security Deposit, if he does not desire the same to be adjusted towards the Security Deposit. No interest shall be payable on Earnest Money, in any case.
- iii. E M D shall be liable for forfeiture if the Tenderer resides from his offer or modifies his offer and/or the Terms and Conditions thereof in any manner, after the last date and time fixed for submitting the Tender, it being understood that the Tender documents have been made available to him and he is being permitted to Tender in consideration of his agreement to this stipulation. The Tenderer is free to modify his offer before the last date and time fixed for submitting the Tender but if he does not re-submit his offer before the said date and time thereby completely withdrawing the offer, his EMO is liable to be forfeited.
- iv. T h e Earnest Money is also liable to be forfeited in the event of the Tenderer's failure after the acceptance of his Tender to furnish the requisite Security Deposit by the due date including extension period if any, as per terms of the Tender, without prejudice to any other rights or remedy available to the corporation under the contract and law.
- d. If any of the attached/uploaded documents are found to be forged/fabricated at any stage, before or after the award of the contract and/or expiry of the contract the Security Deposit /Earnest Money Deposit of the Tenderer will be forfeited without prejudice to any other rights and remedies of the corporation under the Contract and Law.
- e. Tenderers must quote their Income Tax Permanent Account Number (PAN).
- f. Once the bids are submitted, withdrawal of bid is not permissible. In case of withdrawal. EMO shall be forfeited.
- g. Tenderer shall submit EMO in the form of online transaction in favor of "Food Corporation of India" payable at FCI **"Food Corporation of India", DO Hisar, Haryana [State Bank of India, Hisar (Account No. 10311539445 IFSC Code: SBIN0000652)]**. The said Transaction should be done from the bidders own account only otherwise the tender will be summarily rejected.
- h. According to Rule 170 of GFR, there is an EMD exemption on tenders for MSME business.

12. SECURITY DEPOSIT

- (i) Successful bidder on award of work has to deposit additional 3% of bid Value as Security Deposit (12500/-) [Total = 3% SD and 2% EMD (Bid Value = Total value quoted for entire contract period) in the form of online transaction in favor of Food Corporation of India payable at FCI **"Food Corporation of India", DO Hisar, Haryana [State Bank of India, Hisar (Account No. 10311539445 IFSC Code: SBIN0000652)]**. This amount will be released/ refunded after successful completion of contract period.
- (ii) EMO remitted by the successful bidder will be adjusted against security deposit.
- (iii) Successful MSME tenderers shall deposit 5% of bid Value as Security Deposit (Bid Value= Total value quoted for entire contract period) at above FCI account number.

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- (iv) In case the firm failed to join/execute the work satisfactorily or withdraws the work at any of the various locations during the contract period, then the security deposit shall be forfeited besides taking action.
- (v) The Corporation shall not be liable for payment of any interest on the Security Deposit or any depreciation thereof for the time it is held by the Corporation

SECTION-II

TERMS AND CONDITIONS GOVERNING THE CONTRACT

1. DEFINITIONS

- (i) Annual Maintenance Contract shall include repair/replacement of defective parts with the parts of equivalent or higher specification and details of replacement should be provided to the competent authority. A standby arrangement is also mandatory in such cases. The annual maintenance, Repairing, Installation, Testing and commissioning of CCTV Cameras as per the Corporation requirement and complete in all respects.
- (ii) The term 'CONTRACT' shall mean and include the invitation to Bid, incorporating also the instructions to bidders, the Bid, its Annexure, appendices and schedules, acceptance of Bid and such general and special conditions as may be added to it.
- (iii) Contractor/Supplier/Bidder/Vendor/Service Provider shall mean the Bidder whose Bid will be accepted by the Corporation for the award of the Works and shall include such successful Bidder's legal representatives, successors and permitted assigns.
- (iv) The term 'CORPORATION' or 'FOOD CORPORATION OF INDIA' wherever occurs shall mean the FOOD CORPORATION OF INDIA established under FOOD CORPORATION ACT 1964 and shall include its administrators, successors and assigns. It will also be called FCI.
- (v) 'SERVICES' shall mean the performance of any of the items of work enumerated in schedule of services including such auxiliary, additional and incidental duties, services and operations as may be indicated by the Divisional Manager DO Hisar or any person authorized by him on his/Corporation's behalf.
- (vi) Depot Manager or Manager (Depot)' shall mean the officer-in-charge of the Depot.
- (vii) GM(R) shall mean The General Manager, FCI, Regional Office, Panchkula.

2. NON-PERFORMANCE

The non-performing and defaulting Bidder shall be DEBARRED and shall be suspended/ banned from participating in all the Corporation Bid inquiries for a period of three years. The decision of the Divisional Manager DO Hisar shall be final and binding in this regard.

3. LAWS GOVERNING THE CONTRACT

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The contract will be governed by the laws of the country in force from time to time. The Contract shall be interpreted in accordance with the law of the land & will be under the jurisdiction of courts in Panchkula.

4. AGREEMENT

The successful Bidder shall execute a formal agreement with the Divisional Manager DO Hisar within **Seven (07) days** of award of contract **(Annexure-B)**.

5. SUBLETTING

The tenderer shall not sublet, transfer or assign the contract or any part thereof. In the event of the tenderer contravening this condition the Corporation is entitled to terminate the contract and

to get the balance terms under the contract executed at the risk and cost of the tenderer and the tenderer shall be liable for all the loss and damage which the corporation may sustain in consequence or arising out of such replacing of the contract without prejudice to any other right the corporation may have under the contract and law.

6. PARTIES TO THE CONTRACT

- a) The parties to the Contract are tenderer and the Food Corporation of India represented by the Divisional Manager DO DO Hisar, Behind New Grain Market, Hisar, Haryana 125001 and / or any other person authorized and acting on his behalf.
- b) Notice or any other action to be taken on behalf of Food Corporation of India may be issued/ accepted by the Divisional Manager DO Hisar Haryana or any other officer so authorized and acting on his behalf.
- c) The tenderer shall not during the currency of the contract, make, without the prior approval of the Corporation any change in the constitution of the firm. The tenderer shall notify, to the Corporation the death/resignation of any of the partner(s)/ Director(s) immediately on the occurrence of such an event. On receipt of such notice the Corporation shall have the right to terminate the contract at its discretion.

7. PERIOD OF CONTRACT:

- a) The contract shall remain in force for a **period of one year's, further extendable up to one year {if required) on the same prevailing terms and conditions at the discretion of Corporation.**
- b) The Divisional Manager DO Hisar reserves right to terminate the contract at any time during its currency without assigning any reason thereof by giving thirty days' notice in writing to the Tenderer at their last known place of residence/ business and the Tenderer shall not be entitled to any compensation by reason of such termination. The action of the Divisional Manager DO Hisar Haryana under this clause shall be final, conclusive and binding on the Tenderer and shall not be called in question.
- c) **In case, the Tenderer suppress or conceal any material relevant information, FCI**

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shall have the right to disqualify/summarily terminate the Contract without prejudice to any other rights or remedies the Corporation may have under the Contract and Law."

8. TERMINATION:

- (i) Divisional Manager DO Hisar may terminate the contract at any point of time without assigning any reasons by giving one-month prior notice.
- (ii) Corporation may terminate this agreement at any point of time in the event of material breach of the agreement by the other party. Corporation may also terminate the contract in the event of the tenderer having been adjudged insolvent or going into liquidation or winding up their business or making arrangements with their creditors or failing to observe any of the provisions of this contract or any of the terms and conditions governing the contract.
- (iii) Any Tenderer unwilling to work after the award of the tender/contract will be blacklisted by FCI.
- (iv) Corporation without prejudice to any other rights or remedies under the contract shall have the right to get balance work at the risk and cost of the tenderer and to claim from the tenderer any resultant loss sustained or costs incurred besides forfeiting Performance Bank Guarantee for the balance work.
- (v) In the event the Corporation terminates the contract in whole or in part, pursuant corporation may procure, upon such terms and in such manner, as it deems appropriate Goods or Services similar to those undelivered, and the Tenderer shall be liable to corporation for any excess costs for such similar goods or services. However, the tenderer shall continue the performance of the contract to the extent not terminated.
- (vi) The tender for installing new cameras at the Divisional Office Hisar has already been finalized at the headquarters level. As soon as the installation work of the new cameras begins, your tender will be terminated.**

9. CORRUPT PRACTICES:

Any bribe, commission or advantage offered or promised by or on behalf of the Tenderer to any officer or official of the Corporation shall (in addition to any criminal liability which the Tenderer may incur) debar his tender from being considered. Canvassing on the part of or on behalf of the Tenderer will also make his Tender liable to rejection.

- 1. Food Corporation of India reserves the right to reject any or all the Tenders without assigning any reason. The successful Tenderer will be intimated of the acceptance of his Tender by a letter/telegram/fax/e-mail.
- 2. In case of any clear indication of cartelization, the Corporation shall reject the tender(s) and forfeit the CPG/Bank Guarantee.

- 3. FCI will not enter into any negotiation even with the Lowest Tenderer.
- 4. If the information given by the Tenderer in the Tender Documents and its Annexures and Appendices is found to be false/ incorrect at any stage, Food Corporation of India shall have the right to disqualify/summarily terminate the Contract, without prejudice to any other rights that the Corporation may have under the Contract & Law.
- 5. The Divisional Manager DO Hisar, Behind New Grain Market, Hisar, Haryana 125001 for and on behalf of Food Corporation of India reserves the right to reject any or all the tenders without assigning any reason and does not bind himself to accept the lowest or any tender.

10. NO WAIVER OF RIGHTS:

Neither the inspection by FCI or any of their agents, nor any order by FCI for payment of money or acceptance of, the whole or any part of the Works by FCI, nor any possession taken by FCI shall operate as a waiver of any provision of the Contract, or of any power reserved to FCI, or any right to damages here in provided, nor shall any waiver of any breach in the Contract be held to be a waiver of any other or subsequent breach.

11. BRIBE, COMMISSION, GIFT ETC.:

An Act of bribe, gift or advantage, given, promised or offered, by or on behalf of the Tenderer, or any one of their partners/Directors/Agents or officials, or any person on his or her behalf to any officer, officials, representative or Agent of the Corporation, or any person on his or their behalf, for showing any favor or forbearing to show any disfavor to any person in relation to the Contract, shall make the tenderer liable for termination/debar, as the case may be, of this Contract or any other Contract with the Corporation and the tenderer shall be liable to reimburse the Corporation of any loss or damage resulting from such cancellation. Canvassing on the part or on behalf of the tenderer will also make his tender liable for rejection.

12. TAXES AND DUTIES

The Bidder shall quote Consolidated Rate [inclusive of all taxes/ GST] on per year basis for entire CCTV system installed at all locations.

13. AVAILABILITY OF REQUISITE PERMISSIONS AND LICENSES AND COMPLIANCE WITH THE STATUTORY PROVISIONS

The bidder is required to follow all the statutory acts as may be applicable for such type of work which may also involve manpower/links/ services provided/ intellectual property right and other IT Acts, Labor Acts, PF Acts. The bidder merely by filling the bid confirms that the bidder has all the requisite permissions and licenses to carry out all the works as stipulated by this tender. Further, merely by filling the bids, the bidder reconfirms that the bidder has complied with all the statutory provisions of the

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central, state, local and municipal laws enforce. The bidder also confirms merely by filling the bids, to comply with any future laws that may be enforced upon by the statute. Agencies which do not have requisite permissions/ licenses or who do not comply with the statutory provisions are requested to fill in the bids only if they are eligible in this respect. Valid registrations viz. GST as per requirement should be available with the bidder and a copy shall be uploaded with the bid. The bidder shall obtain such permits and licenses as may be required under any law in force for the time being for his business.

NOTE: - Parts replaced should be of same or higher configuration and specifications as applicable for the system.

14. OPERATIONAL ACCEPTANCE AND FINAL ACCEPTANCE

Upon successful completion of entire work in each Warehouse/Depot including testing by the bidder, the concerned Depot Manager shall issue a Certificate to the bidder as a proof of the final acceptance. Such certificate shall not relieve the bidder of any of his obligations which otherwise survive, by the terms and conditions of the Contract after issuance of such certificate.

15. LIMITATION OF LIABILITY:

- (i) The Contractor shall arrange all safety precautions for his representatives and workmen during the contract period and FCI shall not be responsible for any consequences due to his failure to do so. The contractor shall ensure that no electric hazards/fire is caused due to his negligence or improper usage of materials etc.
- (ii) Bidder's aggregate liability for actual damages shall be capped at 100% of the total value of the contract. However, in the following cases, the liability of the Bidder's shall be as per actual damages: 1) the bodily injury (including death) and damage to real property and tangible personal property caused by Bidder's negligence and/or 2) the intellectual property infringement claims.
- (iii) Bidder shall not in any event be liable for any indirect or consequential damages, or for Joss of profit, business, revenue, goodwill, anticipated savings or Data, or third party c]aims except with respect to bodily injury (including death) and damage to real and tangible personal property.
- (iv) Neither this Contract nor the Services delivered by Bidder under this Contract grants or creates any rights, benefits, claims, obligations or causes of action in, to or on behalf of any person or entity (including any third party) other than between the respective Parties to this Contract, as the case may be.
- (v) Title and Risk of Loss: Bidder shall bear the risk of loss on Project Assets; up to the time they are transferred and handed over to the FCI - after which it shall stand transferred to the FCI. Bidder shall arrange and pay for insurance to cover such item until it is transferred.

16. SCOPE FOR ONSITE COMPREHENSIVE WARRANTY AND AMC:

- (i) AMC shall include the repair/replacement of defective parts with the parts of equivalent or higher specification and details of replacement should be provided

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to the competent authority. A standby arrangement is also compulsory in such cases.

- (ii) By arrangement is also mandatory in such cases.
- (iii) Annual Maintenance Charges will commence from the date of joining of the Contractor.
- (iv) Barring force majeure any damages should be covered under this comprehensive annual maintenance contract.
- (v) The firm has to ensure uninterrupted recording of CCTV surveillance system at all location in FCI. It includes relocation of CCTV cameras and time to time to check proper connectivity of surveillance system.
- (vi) **The qualified firm is supposed to response within 24 hours in the case of any break down or complaint lodged from FCI. The same complaint must be resolved in 48 hours otherwise penalty of Rs.200/- (Rupees two Hundred) per day per camera per location shall liable to be imposed.**
- (vii) Only genuine spare parts will be used.
- (viii) The firm shall also be responsible for deployment of necessary staff for regular visit at least once in a fortnight for cleaning of all hardware using suitable cleaning material and supportive equipment. Preventive maintenance includes proper network cabling and to resolve the issues with respect to loose connections. A separate log book shall be maintained for preventive maintenance record. No charges (TA, DA, etc) will be paid by FCI to the engineers for these visits.
- (ix) The equipment's are normally required to be repaired in FCI premises only except in exceptional cases when the equipment's cannot be repaired in the office premises and required to be taken to the workshop. The FCI will not make any payment towards cartage and the expense for the to and fro transportation of the machines will be borne by the firm concerned.
- (x) The equipment being taken to the workshop for repair would be at contractor's own risk and expenses. Any damage or loss caused to the equipment or their part due to negligence, mishandling shall be made good by the contractor.
- (xi) All material and equipment's etc required by the contractor for work during onsite comprehensive AMC will be arranged by him without any extra cost to FCI.
- (xii) All tools and testing instruments required for checking testing and attending to routine maintenance and breakdowns shall be arranged by the Contractor.
- (xiii) The contractor shall ensure the proper working of recording of the video obtained from the CCTV cameras and necessary backup has to be taken in the form of DVD/CDI HDD in the regular interval as instructed.
- (xiv) It shall be the responsibility of the firm to make all the CCTV surveillance system and equipment work satisfactorily throughout the contract period and to hand over the systems in working conditions to the FCI after expiry of the contract.
- (xv) All materials and Reports generated by contractor under this agreement shall be deemed to be "work made for hire" and own exclusively by FCI.
- (xvi) The Contractor recognizes that in the course of the transactions, it may be privy to certain information ("Confidential Information"), relating to FCI work including legal, financial, technical, commercial, marketing and business-related records, data, documents, reports, (whether or not the information is marked or designated as "Confidential" or "Proprietary").
- (xvii) The contractor agrees that it shall:
 - Keep all confidential information strictly confidential and shall not divulge such confidential information to any person.
 - Take all steps to protect the integrity of the Confidential Information and to ensure

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against any unauthorized disclosure thereof;

- Promptly inform FCI of any potential or accidental disclosure of the Confidential Information and take all steps, together with FCI, to retrieve and protect the said Confidential Information.
- The contractor must ensure confidentiality regarding handling of all information obtained within the Control Room, whether videotapes, snapshots, written, verbal and other sensitive materials held within the Control Room and in FCI premise.
- Engineer not engages in any private work /act/practice in FCI premise.
- Renting, lending and copying of any software and hardware products are completely prohibited.
- Ensure all storage and apparatus should be virus free.

(ii) Any breach of this clause may cause FCI substantial and irreparable damages, and in any event of such a breach, in addition to other remedies, which may be available, the FCI shall have the right to seek specific performance and injunctive and equitable relief.

(iii) It shall be the responsibility of the bidder to ensure uninterrupted and proper functioning of the CCTV Setup during the currency of the contract period including AMC. In case of continued failure of the CCTV system or bidder failing to provide satisfactory / uninterrupted functioning of CCTV System during the contract period Divisional Manager DO Hisar Haryana will be at liberty to terminate the contract at any time and appoint new agency at his risk and cost without prejudice to other right and remedies as per contract and law. The Divisional Manager DO Hisar Haryana shall have the sole authority to judge the performance of the bidder in such cases and his decision shall be binding on the Bidder.

- a. The contractor shall be responsible for any acts of commission or omission on the part of their work men in respect of any damage or loss to FCI property.
- b. Any liability arising out of accident or death of any personnel during the execution of work shall be upon the contractor.
- c. The contractor shall be responsible to comply with all the statutory obligations including Labor/taxation/Octroi etc.
- d. The contractor shall deploy only well experienced and qualified workmen for execution of the work.
- e. All persons employed by the contractor shall be engaged by him as own employees in all respects, and all rights & liabilities under the workmen's compensation act, or EPP act and other applicable enactments, in respect of all such personnel shall exclusively be that of the contractor. Contractor shall also comply with all rules and regulations/ enactments made by the State Government/ Centre Government from time to time pertaining to the contract including all labor laws.
- f. The contractor should ensure to take all necessary precautions for the safety of the workmen during the work.
- g. **FIRST AID FACILITIES:** The tenderer is liable to provide First Aid Facilities as provided in the Contract Labor (Regulation and Abolition) Act and the Rules framed there under or under any other applicable law.

11. SCHEDULE OF PAYMENT:-

- a) No advance payment will be made, in any case.
- b) **The payment will be released on monthly basis. On expiry of relevant month, the bill shall be raised by the firm/contractor with respective FCI Divisional office(s)**

on pro-rata basis and the payment will be released by respective FCI Divisional office(s) after adjusting applicable deductions, if any.

- c) The payment will be made after deduction of IDS, as per prevailing rules/rates.
- d) Any payment, made in excess, will have to be refunded by the contractor to FCI in the event of termination of contract.
- e) The tenderer shall abide by all statutory provisions applicable to the contract and make all necessary statutory payments. All Statutory Payments will be made as per applicable rates and the tenderer shall claim the same separately.
- f) The Payment will be made by the Divisional Manager of Divisional Offices Hisar of Haryana Region to the tenderer on submission of bills in **triplicate, duly supported** by certificate bearing satisfactory monthly maintenance report along with remarks, if any, by the depot security officer/ Manager (D), copy of fortnightly CCTV maintenance log book maintained at depot jointly signed by depot security officer/ Manager (D) and tenderer service executive must be attached with the bill, while claiming comprehensive AMC bill
- g) The FCI shall not be liable for payment of any interest on any bill outstanding for payment.
- h) The tenderer/bidder, registered under GST shall ensure that the invoice to be raised with FCI is compliant with the provisions of the GST Law and contains the requisite details in an accurate manner for claiming of tax credits by FCI. FCI reserves the right to release payment of GST amount (if applicable) only posts matching of the invoices in the GSTN System.
- i) This shall further be ensured by the tenderer/bidder, registered under GST (if applicable), that the invoice raised by him during a month is appropriately reported in the GST Returns of the said month.
- j) Payment for any inclusion/deletion of CCTV Cameras and Peripherals (other than the scheduled items) will be calculated on a pro-rata basis.
- k) The payment for last month of the contract period will be released after satisfactory take over by the next incoming AMC provider. The cost of all defective parts/components of the Systems found defective/non-functional by the next incoming AMC provider shall be borne by tenderer, which may be adjusted from the payment of the last quarter of the contract period and security deposit, if required.
- l) The payment shall be made through e-Payment system only.

17. INDEMNITY:

- a. The Tenderer shall defend, indemnify and hold FCI during and after the terms of the contract harmless from and against any and all liabilities, damages, claims, fines, penalties, actions, procedures and expenses of any nature arising or resulting from violation of any laws by the Tenderer or its personnel or in any way connected with the acts, amenities, negligence, breach of this agreement and failure to perform obligations under this contract.
- b) The Tenderer shall strictly abide by the Rules, Regulations and Laws of India.
- c) The Food Corporation of India shall have no liability/obligation to employ directly or indirectly any personnel deployed by the tenderer, in the services of the Corporation.
- d) In case of any negligence, connivance or direct/ indirect involvement of any personnel deployed by Tenderer for any theft, pilferage, misappropriation, bungling of CCTV instrument or any other loss to Food Corporation of India's property for whatsoever

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reason the Tenderer will be responsible and liable to compensate the losses as evaluated by the Divisional Manager DO Hisar Haryana or any officer acting on his behalf of Food Corporation of India or any other authorized officer of the Corporation. The decision of the Divisional Manager DO Hisar, Food Corporation of India, Haryana Region or any other authorized officer of the Food Corporation of India shall be final and binding on Tenderer.

- e) The FCI will not be responsible in any respect with regard to service conditions, salaries and conduct of the personnel deployed by the tenderer. The Tenderer will be the employer of the service executive and the FCI will have no concern/liability whatsoever in respect of their service.
- f) The service executive(s) deployed by the tenderer shall have no lien or claim in any manner on FCI during or after cessation of this contract. In case, the guard's resort to litigation in any court for any reason, the tenderer will be solely responsible towards the verdict of the court at its own cost. The tenderer will be liable for the expenses, losses and damages if any, due to filing of any claim or suit or any such proceedings by the tenderer employees against FCI and FCI is entitled to deduct the sum from the pending or future bills of the tenderer.
- g) Only trained and experienced service executive(s) will be deployed in FCI. The tenderer shall also provide the nominal roll of the service executive(s) along with their photographs to the FCI. Each service executive(s) will be provided with an identity card by the tenderer, which will have to be shown by them on demand by any of the officer/staff of the FCI. The tenderer personnel should not be drug addict/or use liquor in the FCI's premises.
- h) The Agreement shall be subject to jurisdiction of the courts at Chandigarh UT/ Haryana.

18. SUBMISSION OF HARD COPY OF TENDER DOCUMENT

Tenders should be uploaded/ submitted through <https://gem.gov.in>. Manual bids/Hard copy of the tender documents will not be accepted. However the successful tenderer will have to submit the original hard copy of MTF duly signed on each page of MTF along with annexures/appendices duly attested on or before the date & time stipulated by FCI, failing which the EMO furnished by the Bidder is liable to be forfeited and further that the award of contract through the letter of acceptance will be issued to the successful tenderer only after he fulfills this requirement.

19. FORCE MAJEURE.

The tenderer will not be responsible for delays which may arise on account of reasons beyond their control of which the Divisional Manager DO Hisar shall be the final Authority. Notices by persons deployed by the tenderer on account of any dispute between them as to wages or otherwise will not be deemed to be a reason beyond the tenderer control and tenderer shall be responsible for any loss or damage which the Corporation may suffer on this account.

20. SET-OFF:

- a) Any sum of money due and payable to the tenderer under this contract may be appropriated by the Corporation and set off against any claim of the Corporation under this contract or any other contract made by the tenderer with the Corporation.
- b) FCI reserves the right to claim from the tenderer/bidder any amount of tax, interest,

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penalty and litigation cost, if any, that may be incurred in future due to GST reporting/compliance mistake(s) on part of the service provider.

23. RECOVERY OF LOSSES SUFFERED BY THE CORPORATION:

- a) The Corporation shall be at liberty to reimburse itself for any damages, losses, charges, costs, or expenses suffered or incurred by him due to tenderer negligence and un-workman like performance of services under the contract or breach of any terms thereof. The total sum claimed shall be deducted from any sum then due or which at any time hereinafter may become due, to the Tenderer under this or any other contract with the Corporation. In the event of the sum which may be due from the Tenderer, as aforesaid being insufficient, the balance of the total sum claimed and recoverable from the Tenderer as aforesaid, shall be deducted from the security deposit furnished by the Tenderer. If this sum also be not sufficient to recover the full amount claimed by the Corporation, the Tenderer shall pay to the Corporation on demand the remaining balance of the aforesaid sum claimed.
- b) The Divisional Manager DO Hisar will be the sole judge for determining after taking into consideration all the relevant circumstances, the quantum of value of loss and also in regard to the liability of Tenderer for such loss of the amount, to be recovered from them. The decision of the Divisional Manager DO Hisar in this regard shall be final and binding on the Tenderer.
- c) In the event of the default on the part of the Tenderer for their failure to perform any of the services mentioned in this tender efficiently and to the entire satisfaction of the Divisional Manager DO Hisar or any officer acting on his behalf, the Divisional Manager shall without prejudice to other rights and remedies, under this tender have the right to recover by way of Liquidated damages from the Tenderer a sum of Rs.200/- (Rupees Two hundred) per day per camera per location. The parties to the Contract having read that the amount of Liquidated damages specified above represents a genuine estimate of the loss likely to be caused to the Corporation. The decision of the Divisional Manager on the question whether the Tenderer have committed such default or have failed to perform any such service efficiently and are liable to pay Liquidated damages and as to the quantum of such Liquidated damages shall be final and binding on the tenderer.

1. 2. In consideration of the due provision, execution and completion of the said works the Corporation does hereby agree with the contractor that the Corporation will pay the contractor respective amount for the work actually done by him at the "Schedule of Rates".
3. Successful bidder on award of work has to deposit 3% of bid Value as Security Deposit (Bid Value = Total value quoted for entire contract period) [Security Deposit shall be 5% in case of MSMEs]. That will be released/ refunded after successful completion of contract period.
