Contractors enlisted with other Departments of Government of Rajasthan and enlisted with CPWD/Postal, Telecom, Railway, MES, other state Govt./Central Govt. undertaking/organizations equivalent to appropriate class of Rajasthan shall also be eligible. The duly notarized copy of Registration Certificate is to be enclosed. Unregistered contractors shall not be allowed. The tenderers meeting eligibility criteria may apply after giving prescribed Earnest Money. II ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

The tenderer should be registered / enlisted in in PHED Rajasthan in appropriate Class as per PWF&AR Part II Appendix 16 dated 01.07.1999 and amendment issued by concerned department up to date. Contractors enlisted with other Departments of Government of Rajasthan and enlisted with CPWD/Postal, Telecom, Railway, MES, other state Govt./Central Govt. undertaking/organizations equivalent to appropriate class of Rajasthan shall also be eligible. The duly attested copy of Registration Certificate is to be enclosed. Unregistered contractors shall not be allowed.

III GENERAL DETAIL OF WORK

- 1 Tender document consists of the detailed plan, complete specifications, the schedule of quantities of the work to be done and the set of conditions of contract to be complied with by the persons whose tender may be accepted.

- 2 The bidders will have to register themselves on website <http://www.eproc.rajasthan.gov.in> for participation in this tender. For this purpose Digital Signature Certificates (DSC) have to be obtained from any agency approved by CCA. This DSC will be used to sign the bids submitted online by the bidder. Unsigned tenders will not be entertained and will be rejected out rightly.
- 3 The cost of tender document of **Rs. 1000/-** To be deposited in Revenue head 0075-00-800-52-01 through e-GRAS portal in favour of DDO CODE 32114-EX.ENG. DIV PHED Malpura.
- 4 The Processing fee of **Rs. 500/-** per bidder per tender to be deposited in Budget head 8658-00-102-(16)-[02] through e-GRAS portal in favour of DDO CODE 32114-EX.ENG. DIV PHED Malpura.
- 5 Earnest Money of **Rs. 14701/- (@ 2%)** for contractors not enlisted in PHED. (As per FD circular No. F.2(1)/FD/GT-SPFC/2017 Dt. 13.08.2020) and **Rs. 3675/- (@0.5%)** for contractors enlisted in PHED in B class and above. Tenders received without Earnest Money or with part Earnest Money, shall be rejected out-rightly.
- 6 The Bidder should upload scanned copy of E-Gras Challan on e-procurement website along with documentary proof of depositing the tender cost, e-procurement processing fee and Earnest Money in the office of Executive Engineer, PHED, Division Malpura
- Note: - Appropriate action as per RTPPP act/Rules shall be taken against the bidders who will not deposit the draft of EMD /tender fee/RISL charges after uploading the bid on e-proc Portal.)
- Rule-82 Breach of code of Integrity by the bidder of RTPPPRules-2013 states that without prejudice to the provisions of chapter IV of the Act in case of breach of any provision of code of integrity by a bidder: or prospective bidder, as the case may, the procuring entity may take appropriate action in accordance with the provisions of sub section (3) of section-11 and section-46 i.e,If a procuring entity finds that a bidder has breached the code of integrity it may debar the bidder for a period not exceeding three years.
- 7 The work is to be completely finished to the satisfaction of Engineer-in-charge within 12 months from the 10th day after the date of written/ e-mailed order to commence the work.
- 8 Security Deposit @ 10% (As per FD circular No. F.2(1)/FD/GT-SPFC/2017 Dt. 12.01.2022) of the gross amount of the running bill shall be deducted from each running bill of individual work order and shall be refunded as per rules on completion of the contract as per terms and conditions. The earnest money deposited shall however be adjusted while deducting security deposit from running bills of the contractor. There will be no maximum limit of security deposit.
- 9 A contractor may, however, elect to furnish Bank Guarantee or any acceptable form of security for an amount equal to the full amount of security deposit @ 10% of work order before or at the time of executing agreement. In that case earnest money may be refunded only after furnishing of Bank Guarantee as above. During execution of work or after completion of the work also a contractor may replace the security deposit by furnishing bank guarantee for an equal amount. However, during execution of the work if cost of work exceeds as shown at the time of furnishing bank guarantee, balance security deposit shall be deducted from the Running Account Bills.

- 10 All compensation or other sums of money payable by the contractor to the Government under the terms of his contract may be deducted from or paid by the sale of a sufficient part of his Security Deposit, or from interest arising there from, or from any sums, which may be due or may become due to the Contractor by the Government on any account whatsoever, and in the event of his Security Deposit being reduced by reason of any such deduction or sale as aforesaid, the contractor shall within ten days thereafter, make good in cash or bank guarantee or Nationalized/Scheduled bank as aforesaid, any sum of sums which may have been deducted from or raised by sale or his Security Deposit or any part thereof.
- 11 The tender should be accompanied with latest Tax Clearance Certificate from the concerned department authorities, without which the tenders may not be entertained. Valid **GST Registration Certificate along with latest GST return** shall be submitted without which Tender shall be disqualified.
- 12 The tenders for the works shall remain open for acceptance for the period of **90 days** from the date of opening of the tender or mutually extended period.
If any tenderer withdraws his tender prior to expiry of validity period or mutually extended period or makes modifications in the rates, terms and conditions of the tender within the said validity period, which are not acceptable to the department, or fails to commence the work in the specified period/fails to execute the agreement, the department shall without prejudice to any other right or remedy be at liberty of forfeit the amount of earnest money given in any form absolutely. If any contractor, who having submitted a tender does not execute the agreement or start the work or does not complete the work and the work has to be put to re-tendering, he shall stand debarred from participating in such re-tendering in addition to forfeiture of earnest money/security deposit and other action under agreement. If there is strong justification of believing that the tenderer or his authorized has been guilty of mal-practices such as submission of forged documents, influencing individually or politically, his offer will be liable to rejection and in such case his earnest money shall be forfeited.
- 13 All tenders, in which any of the prescribed conditions are not fulfilled or which have been vitiated by errors in calculations, totalling or discrepancies in figures or words or other discrepancies, will be liable to rejection.
- 14 Enlisted contractors, as per rules will be required to pay earnest money @ 0.5% of the estimated cost of work put to tender, in case of work for which they are authorized to tender under Rules for Enlistment of Contractors, but the amount to the extent of full earnest money shall be liable to be forfeited in the event of circumstances explained at S. No. 13 above.
- 15 No conditional tenders shall be accepted and will be rejected summarily forthwith.
- 16 The department will not be responsible for any delay on account of late submission of tender due to online submission.
- 17 Physical submission of bids is not allowed.
- 18 The bidder shall ensure that scanned copy of all the schedules as asked in tender document have been filled up and attached with the bid submitted in electronic format.
- 19 The acceptance of the tender will rest with the competent authority who does not bind itself to accept the lowest tender, and reserves to itself the authority to reject any or all the tenders received without assigning any reason.
- 20 No refund of tender fee is claimable for tenders not accepted or forms not submitted.
- 21 The work may be split up between two or more contractors or accepted in part and not in entirety if considered expedient.

22 All other conditions shall be prevailing as detailed out in the departmental tender document (in the respective sections/ volumes).

23 Contractor shall make arrangements and provide photographs to division office at the time of payments, as per finance department (G&T) division Circular F1(3)FD/GF&AR/2014 Jaipur, dated 18-3-2016 item no 9 Physical progress of work – Photographs of the site before the work/Job started and photograph of work at the time of release of payment. (GPS link photo with date and time stamp). Inspecting authority photograph at the site of inspection.

The contractor should have necessary tool & equipment including barricades / signboard dewatering pump set and necessary lighting arrangements for night etc. The contractor shall submit a certificate that he has dewatering pump(s) in working condition. Contractors shall submit daily leakages report to assistant engineer in prescribed format along with material consumptions and location of leakages, types of leakage and quantity of water wasted during the leakage also contractor shall submit detail of leakages on map having scale 1:500 duly verified by AEN/JEN. Along with the bills. Assistant engineer will relate the data provided by the contractor with NRW so that NRW could be controlled. Assistant Engineer correlates the leakage data with initial NRW calculation (commencement of work) to final NRW calculation at the end of each month for each zone.

24 The contractor should have necessary tool and equipment including barricades/ signboards dewatering pump set and necessary lightening arrangements for night etc. The contractor shall submit a certificate that he has dewatering pump in working condition.

If necessary material procured by contractor for work, Its payment will be made on sanctioned rates/prevailing market rate/BSR rates duly approved by competent authority.

25 The Contract shall be Parallel Contract and work order may be awarded more than one contractor as per requirement.

26 For the payment Assistant engineer will issue a satisfactory work certificate monthly, in absence of this certificate no payment shall be made.

27 Payment shall be done as per nomenclature defined in "G-Schedule", Any negligence in work worth for a penalty, as defined in Special condition of Contract.

In case of any discrepancies, RTPP shall prevail.

28 "75A" Additional Performance Security on abnormally low bids.

As per circular no. D&S/circular/2021-22/2943-3067 dated 29.10.2021

"75A" Additional Performance Security – (1) In addition to Performance Security as specified in rule 75. An Additional Performance Security shall also be taken from the successful bidder in case of unbalanced bid. The Additional Performance Security shall be equal to **(50%) fifty percent** of Unbalanced Bid Amount. The Additional Performance Security shall be deposited in lump sum by the successful bidder before execution of Agreement. The Additional Performance Security shall be deposited through e-Grass, Demand Draft, Banker's Cheque, Government Securities or Bank Guarantee.

Explanation : For the purpose of this rule –

- (i) Unbalanced Bid means any bid below more than fifteen percent of Estimated Bid Value.

- (ii) Estimated Bid Value means value of subject matter of procurement mention in bidding documents by the Procuring Entity.
- (iii) Unbalanced Bid Amount means positive difference of eighty five percent of Estimated Bid Value minus Bid Amount Quoted by the bidder.

The Additional Performance Security shall be refunded to the contractor after satisfactory completion of the entire work. The Additional Performance Security shall be forfeited by the Procuring Entity when work is not completed within stipulated period by the contractor.

5. Instructions and Guidance to Tenderers with their annexes
6. Work description
7. Bills of Quantities with Prices

2 TYPE OF CONTRACT

The present Contract is **Annual Rate Contract of Maintenance of Rising pipeline and All Distribution Pipe line of Rural Water Supply Schemes Malpura Sub Div Malpura**

3 AUTHORITIES

EXECUTIVE ENGINEER, ENGINEER IN CHARGE, REPRESENTATIVES

The work shall be supervised by the EXECUTIVE ENGINEER, PHED DIVISION Malpura; he shall carry out the duties specified in the Contract.

4 INSTRUCTIONS BY THE ENGINEER-IN-CHARGE

Instructions if any to the Contractor shall be given in writing. Oral instructions given have to be confirmed in writing by the Executive Engineer or his Representative.

These provisions shall also apply to the Engineer-in-Charge and to any of his assistants.

5 COMMUNICATION BETWEEN THE DEPARTMENT AND THE CONTRACTOR

ADDRESSES FOR NOTICES

Notices with legal, contractual issues or technical issues shall be addressed to the Executive Engineer, PHED Division Malpura office. Any notice given by the Contractor to the Executive Engineer, PHED Division Malpura under the terms of the Contract shall be sent by post, courier, or fax, official email or submitted in person to the receipt clerk and having obtained a receipt thereof in the office of the Executive Engineer, PHED Division Malpura the addresses as he shall indicate for this purpose only. All certificates, notices or instructions to be given to the Contractor by the Executive Engineer, PHED Division Malpura or the Engineer in Charge under the terms of the Contract shall be sent by post, courier, or fax, official email left at the Contractor's principal address or the address as the Contractor shall indicate for this purpose only.

6 CONTRACTOR'S STAFF

The Contractor shall employ for the execution of the Work only such persons who are skilled and experienced in all activities required for the completion of the work as per the terms and conditions of the tender document.

The Engineer in Charge shall be at liberty to object and require the Contractor to remove from the Work any person who in the opinion of the Engineer in Charge misconduct himself or is incompetent or negligent in the proper performance of his duties. Such person shall not be again employed without permission of the Engineer in Charge.

The Contractor shall always during progress of the work take all requisite precautions and use his best endeavors to prevent any riotous or unlawful behavior by or amongst the workers and other persons employed on the Works and for the preservation of peace and protection of the inhabitants and the security of property in the neighborhood of the work.

The Contractor shall, if required by the Engineer in Charge deliver to him a return in detail in such form and at such intervals as the Engineer in Charge may prescribe, showing the supervisors and labor employed by the Contractor for work. The Contractor shall make his own suitable arrangements for lodging and boarding of his, labor and supervisors. Police verification of the staff engaged shall be produced by the contractor from local police station within 15 days of the issue of work order.

7 CONTRACTOR'S SUPERVISION

The Contractor shall himself supervise the Work or shall appoint a competent agent approved by the Engineer in Charge to act on his behalf.

8 PRICE VARIATION

No price variation on any account will be applicable.

9 ACCIDENT OR INJURY TO CONTRACTOR EMPLOYEES

The department shall not be liable for, or in respect of any damages or compensation payable by law in respect of or in consequence of any accident or injury to any person in the employment of the contractor and the contractor shall indemnify and save harmless the department against all such damages and compensation and against all action, suits, claim, costs or expenses arising therefore. The contractor shall insure against such liabilities and shall continue such insurance during the whole of the time that any persons are employed by him on works.

10 RULES AND REGULATIONS APPLICABLE ON STAFF ENGAGED BY CONTRACTOR:

Staff engaged for entire operation/maintenance etc. shall have to be in accordance with the rules and regulations laid down by the ministry of Labor Welfare Govt. of India. The wages and other essential amenities, group insurance, compensation etc. shall be paid/allowed as per Govt. rules and expenditure on this account shall be contractor's responsibility. The necessary registration under labor rules shall be mandatory. Any sort of compensation due to loss of life/retrenchment, accident etc. shall be borne by the contractor. The department shall not bear any liability of labor, as it is the entire responsibility of contractor. He will be employer under labor/factory act 1948 etc. and department is only concerned with maintenance of pipelines and valve operation through this contract. The contractor is liable for engaging sufficient skilled staff for proper maintenance of all plant and machinery as directed by Engineer-in-Charge.

11 SAFETY PRECAUTION TOWARDS MAN POWER AND WATER SUPPLY INFRASTRUCTURES.

Adequate safety precautions against fire, flooding, lightening, electrical mishaps, the contractor at his own risk & cost shall strictly observe accidents due to moving/ non-moving equipments. Suitable safety measures like boots, gloves,

Insulated tools, alarms, checkered rubber sheets etc. Shall be provided/arranged by the contractor at his own cost. A fully equipped medical first aid kit should be available at each pump house at all the times. In absence of observance of above safety precautions or otherwise the contractor shall be responsible for any unforeseen loss on the equipment or person(s) dealing with these equipments.

In the event of any damage/loss of life and property during the contract in machinery and other equipments and all ancillary units, the contractor shall be solely responsible and liable for compensation and damages. The contractor will be liable against any legal action arising out of the negligence on the part of contractor in due performance of contract. However any third party legal complications due to this shall be the liability of contractor.

12 PERIOD OF CONTRACT:

Period of contract shall be 12 months after 10 days from date of award of contract. However, it may be extended for one year with mutual consent on same rate, terms and conditions (to be worked out based on approved rate). No price escalation shall be allowed during the entire period of the contract.

13 TERMS OF PAYMENT:

The due payment for the works allotted shall be payable as below: -

Payment for maintenance of the work shall be payable on monthly basis.

The bidder shall ensure that duly signed numbered daily job cards issued to the nominated person of the contractor by the department completed in all respect shall be submitted to official email ids of Executive Engineer and Assistant Engineer concerned latest by the next day. No payment shall be made for non-submission or delayed submission of job cards. The Job cards shall mention number of persons to whom work is issued vide the job Card and shall be duly signed by PHED employee deputed to issue the job cards and verified by Jen/Aen. Payment claimable by contractor shall be based on man-days deployed.

The Concerning Aen shall issue a Satisfactory work certificate along with each monthly bill and shall send to the office of Executive Engineer for the payment without which no payment shall be released. The concern Aen shall ensure that the payment has to be made as per nomenclature. No payment shall be made for overlapping of nomenclature amount.

No extra/excess work shall be done without prior permission of this office.

Jointing material shall be provided by the department.

Payment for Valves operation shall be made on number of valves operated daily and monthly basis (Proportionate basis). Quantity may vary as decided by Engineer In charge.

Valve operation timings decide by the Engineer in charge shall be strictly followed, any negligence shall attract penalty Rs 150 for each nonoperation or delay operation of listed valve. The list of valves to be operated shall be provided by the concern Aen/Jen to the Contractor.

14 PAYMENTS AGAINST RUNNING BILLS:

The contractor shall submit his bill at the end of every month along with the following record/ documents duly verified and countersigned by the Aen-in-Charge as an evidence of the contractor's satisfactory performance.

- (a) Signed and duly verified copy in the format approved by Engineer-in-charge. All required documents.

15 DEDUCTION AND RECOVERIES:

Statutory deductions:

The security deposit @ 10% the gross amount of the running bill shall be deducted from each running bill and shall be refunded as per rules on completion of the contract as per terms and conditions. The earnest money deposited shall be however, be adjusted while deducting security deposit from running bill of the contractor. There will be no maximum limit of security deposit.

The liability of all taxes including royalties, duties, octroi, and toll taxes etc. whatever applicable will be the liability of contractor. However statutory deductions of Income Tax, GST, service tax' royalty etc. will be made from all running/final bills as per prevalent rules in force.

16 COMPENSATION:

In case of unsatisfactory performance by contractor in operation and maintenance, compensation @0.25% of contract value per week of unsatisfactory performance, subject to maximum of 10% of contract value shall be levied. Regarding such liquidity damages the decision of the Executive Engineer shall be final and binding upon the contractor.

17 DEDUCTION AGAINST DELAYED REPAIR IN PIPE LINES:

For any delay in the repair of leakages/burst etc. compensation shall be levied as under: -

Any compensation so levied due to non-performance or poor performance of contract shall be deductible for running bills. Minimum no of persons, as mentioned in G-Schedule, has to provide by the tenderer on daily basis. These no of persons have to increase (without any limit) in case of number of line leakages and occurrence of water pollution are more in a particular day, as per satisfaction of Engineer In charge. Failure to this penalty shall be imposed as Rs. 500/ per day per labour. For example if contractor is ordered to provide 5 persons on a particular day and if he provides only three persons on that day then a penalty of rs. 1000/ will be imposed.

The minimum permanent staff to be deployed for each section by the contractor for carrying out the work shall be as per below

18 RECOVERIES:

Any recovery against past contract can be made from instant contract and any recovery against instant contract can be made from sum available in any other contracts as well as recoveries as per Acts & Rules.

19 ARRANGEMENT OF TOOLS AND TACKLES AND HEAVY EQUIPMENTS:

The contractor at his own cost shall arrange all sorts of tools, tackles required for operation and maintenance of the plant. However, department may assist the contractor with any tools if available in the discretion of Engineer-in-Charge in case of exigencies without any cost chargeable to the contractor.

20 STRIKE AND LAY OFF BY CONTRACTORS STAFF:

In the event of strike or any other failure on the part of contractor by the operation and maintenance staff employed by the contractor, the department shall be empowered to operate and maintain the pumping station, and AC/UPVC/MS/DI pipe lines at the sole risk and cost of the contractor.

21 ARRANGEMENT OF SPARES ETC, BREAKDOWN REPAIR AND SETTLEMENT OF DISPUTE AND RESPONSIBILITY AGAINST NEGLIGENCE:

- (a) The Contractor shall keep sufficient spares and parts required for preventive maintenance described as in schedule-G and various clause & paras of document.
- (b) In case of sudden break down, Engineer-in-charge will decide whether the break down is attributable to contractor's poor preventive maintenance or not after recovery of water supply. If break down is found on the part of contractor then he shall recover cost of repair/replacement and losses from his due payments, if not rectified/replaced at his cost.

22 TIME SCHEDULE AND OTHER CONDITIONS FOR BREAKDOWN REPAIRS IN TRANSMISSION SYSTEM:

The time allowed for completion of repair of burst and leakages etc. shall be under:

Each major breakdown shall have to be repaired within 3 hours; however, repair of bursts in MS pipe line shall be within 8 hours. The time taken for the repair of the job shall be counted from intimation given or known to the contractor. Minor leakages generally do not require removal of any pipe but may require removal of leakage in the existing joint by the method prescribed maximum period of 4 hours shall be allowed for the repair of such leakages. The JCB (Excavator cum loader), dewatering pumps and Crane of required capacity shall have to be arranged by contractor if required

Execution of the work against the risk and cost of contractor: -

The Department shall reserve the right to get the work done on the risk and cost of contractor without rescinding the contract after a notice given to the contractor and he fails to commence the work within 12 hours. In such case, compensation for delay in rectification of leakages/burst shall also be levied as per clause of Unit B-3.

23 TERMINATION

CONTRACTOR'S DEFAULT

The Department shall be entitled to terminate this Contract for the following reasons attributable to the contractor, unless arising because of a Force Majeure Event, or any cause related to the obligations of the Department.

- (a) Failure to perform obligations under this Contract i.e. for not making the system functional for a continuous period of more than 3 days.
- (b) Repudiation of this Contract by the Contractor or the evidencing of an intention by the Contractor not to be bound by the terms of this Contract.

- (c) The Contractor is ordered to be wound up by a court or files a petition for voluntary winding up except for the purpose of amalgamation or reconstruction provided that such amalgamation or reconstruction does not adversely affect the ability of the amalgamated or reconstructed entity to perform its obligations under this Contract, the successor has assumed in writing unconditional responsibility for the performance of the Contractor's obligations and the technical, financial and operating capability of the successor is satisfactory to the Department.
- (d) The Contractor abandons the operation of the Facility.

24 CONSEQUENCES OF TERMINATION BY DEPARTMENT

If the Department with reasonable grounds, terminates the contract the Secured Advances, and any other sums of the contractor with the Department, shall be forfeited and action shall be taken against him as per clause 3 of General Conditions of Contract, if deemed appropriate.

25 INDEMNIFICATION

The Contractor to indemnify the Department against the following: -

- (a) The Contractor shall at its own expense make good any physical loss or damage to the Facility occasioned by it during the performance of its obligations under this Contract if and to the extent such loss or damage is caused by the will full misconduct or failure to follow Good Engineering Practices of the Contractor, any sub-contractor or their respective agents or employees.
- (b) The Contractor shall indemnify, defend and hold harmless the Department and its officers, employees, agents and affiliates against all claims of loss, damage and expense of whatever kind and nature, including all related costs and expenses incurred in connection therewith, in respect of personal injury to or death of third parties and in respect of loss of or damage to any third party to the extent that the same arises out of:
 - (c) Any breach by the Contractor of its obligations hereunder;
 - (d) Any negligent act or omission on the part of the Contractor, its subcontractors or their respective agents or employees; and
 - (e) Any wilful misconduct or breach of statutory duty on the part of the Contractor, its subcontractors or their respective agents and employees.
 - (f) Any other event where such indemnification has been expressly mentioned in this Conditions of Contract for Operation and Maintenance.
 - (g) The Contractor shall indemnify, defend and hold harmless the Department and its, officers, employees, agents and affiliates against all claims of loss, damage and expense of whatever kind and nature, including all related costs and expenses incurred in connection therewith in respect of the death or injury to any person employed by the Contractor or its subcontractors in connection with the performance of the Contractor's obligations.
- (h) The Contractor shall indemnify the Department against all losses and claims in respect of:
 - I. Death of or injury to any person, or,
 - II. Loss of or damage to any property

The Contractor shall be responsible for safety & security of all pipelines and their appurtenances, valves chambers etc. Any loss or damages occurred due to negligence in safety measures shall be repaired free of cost by contractor. Also, the contractor will replace damaged part free of costs.

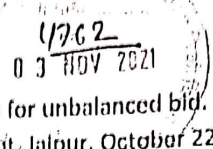

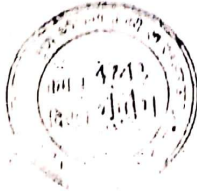

The Additional Performance Security shall be deposited in lump sum by the successful bidder before execution of Agreement. The Additional Performance Security shall be deposited through e-Grass, Demand Draft, Banker's Cheque, Government Securities or Bank Guarantee.

Explanation : For the purpose of this rule,-

- Unbalanced Bid means any bid below more than fifteen percent of Estimated Bid Value.
- Estimated Bid Value means value of subject matter of procurement mention in bidding documents by the Procuring Entity.
- Unbalanced Bid Amount means positive difference of eighty five percent of Estimated Bid Value minus Bid Amount Quoted by the bidder.



1. After existing clause 36D of Conditions of Contract of Appendix XI, a new clause 36E shall be added, as under :-

"Clause 36E: If any rates of Tax are increased or decreased, a new tax is introduced in India only, an existing Tax is abolished, or any change in interpretation or application of any Tax resulting from a change or Introduction in India only due to any National or State Statute, Ordinance, Decree or other law or any regulation or bye-law of any local or other duly constituted authority in India only, in the course of performance of contract, which was or will be assessed on the Contractor, in connection with the performance of the Contract, an equitable adjustment of the Contract price shall be made to fully take into account any such change by addition to the Contract Price or deduction there from, as the case may be.

However, these adjustments would be restricted to direct transactions between the Owner and Contractor only those items which are included in bid. Further, no adjustment of the Contract Price shall be made on account of variation in deemed export benefits, if any. Any increase or decrease which is included in price variation formula incorporated in the contract shall not be accounted for this purpose.

Such increase including GST shall not be made in the extended period of contract for which the contractor alone is responsible for delay as determined by authority for extension of time."

SCOPE OF WORK

NAME OF WORK: REGULAR MAINTENANCE OF VALVE OPERATION AND LEAKAGE REPAIRING WORK OF URBEN WATER SUPPLY SCHEME PEEPLU UNDER SUB. DIVISION PEEPLU."

SCOPE OF WORK OF Ris AC/PVC/HDPE/MS/DI PIPE LINES SYSTEM

GENERAL

Maintenance of pipelines irrespective of size and material which includes repairing of bursts and leakages, pollution control, survey and removal of choking, disconnection of illegal connections, collection and recording minimum 10 nos. residual chlorine samples during daily supply timings, interconnections and all works related to pipeline network in existing distribution/ rising main pipelines of all sizes by digging out suitable size of pit in soft and loose soil/ hard soil including cutting of black top, WBM and CC top of road of any size at work site. This will also include cutting of pipe ends, fixing of pipe piece with jointing material to make repair leak proof and refilling of pit by excavated sand by ramming it at sides of pipes and upto ground level. For entire job, contractor will use their own T&P. Contractor with his own resources shall arrange de-watering, JCB and tractor compressor if any and restore any amenity at his own cost damaged while performing the work in this item. The works includes daily patrolling and repair the leakages within stipulated time and complete maintenance of pipeline network of rising and distribution pipeline network within the scope of work for per km pipeline per month. Jointing material shall be provided by the department. Minimum labour for a following kms pipelines to be deployed.

2 RESPONSIBILITIES/JOB TO BE CARRIED OUT ON REGULAR BASIS.

- Surveillance of pipeline by patrolling party, checking and monitoring of pipeline, air valve, scour valve, chambers pedestals and earth cover etc. for successful maintenance of the pipeline.
- 2.2 Reporting about pipeline valve and appurtenances by the prescribed method in prescribed Performa to the Engineer-In-Charge.
 - 2.3 The Contractor shall be responsible for any theft, damages, sabotaging, security and safety of all electrical and mechanical installations in pump house campus & tube wells, pipe line, valves, components, appurtenances, chambers of specials and thrust block etc. Any loss on this account shall be recovered from the contractor. Contractor shall be responsible for watch and ward of pipeline and valves fixed over pipeline in valve chambers.
 - 2.4 For removing of unwanted trees, shrubs, bushes etc. over pipeline. He will be also responsible for making easy approach to pipeline.
 - 2.5 Contractor shall maintain the necessary infrastructure as per job requirement. For keeping updated record of consumer load survey details as per scope of work defined above.
 - (a) The Contractor shall regularly check the drains/sewer manholes on regular basis. Any service connections passing through the drains/sewer chambers shall be immediately disconnected/bye passed from the main water line as directed by the Engineer-In-Charge. Any Complaints regarding pollutions in water pipeline at consumer ends shall be raised / rectified with on war footing basis and supply of potable water with Minimum Residual Chlorine of 0.2 PPM must be ensured. A daily minimum 10 nos. of water samples for bacteriological/ residual chlorine at places decided by the JE/ AE shall be recorded.

- (b) No illegal connection on the distribution/rising pipelines maintained by the contractor shall be allowed which will be the responsibility of the contractor part and parcel of this contract.

3 RESPONSIBILITY/JOB TO BE CARRIED OUT PERIODICALLY:

- 3.1 Periodicals checking of sluice valve Air valve, non-return valve and other specials like bends tee etc. and should be recorded in the prescribed logbook. Carrying out periodical maintenance regularly such as greasing, gland packing, inspection, replacement of rubber sheet, nut bolts etc. of valve and appurtenances. Such maintenance should be carried out at least once in three months or as per direction of Engineer-In-Charge or as per respective manufacturer's code of practice.
- 3.2 The contractor is also required to make all possible efforts to bring down the NRW at 20% by using all scientific techniques.

4 REMOVAL OF LEAKAGES IN AC/PVC/MS/DI/CI PIPELINES

- 4.1 Removal of leakage in AC/PVC/MS/DI pipeline consists of the following items: -

(a) LEAKAGE REPAIRING ON JOINTS:

Repair of leakage on joint/pipeline includes excavation in all sorts of soils/rocks up to its working space around joint/pipe, bailing out of water either manually or by dewatering pump sets, caulking of joints with lead wool, hemp, cement sand mortar, to make it leak proof, wherever required and refilling of the trench of the repaired joint/pipe joint pipe with sand so that the pit/ trench is levelled, and no depression is left after compaction

The contractor shall take all safety measures to repair the pipe lines and refill the leakage pits with sand with proper compaction. Any accident is casualty on account of left out open pits or underground power cables will be the sole responsibility of the contractor.

(b) REPAIRING AND REPLACEMENT OF BURST AC/PVC/MS/DI/HDPE PIPELINES

In case of burst in pipelines, work shall include immediate detection of location, closure of nearest u/s and d/s SV valves and opening of scour valves in nearby vicinity within Two hour period of detection of location, excavation in all types of soils/rocks in the affected portion up to its working space required, dewatering and bailing out of water either manually or by using diesel/petrol/kerosene driven dewatering pump sets, breaking and taking out of damaged pipe from the trench and replacing by AC/PVC/MS/DI pipe of diameter equal to that of damaged pipe. This job also includes complete cutting, placing, jacking/rejacking, welding in case of MS pipe, fabrication and refilling of trench required for replacement of damaged pipe and transportation of damaged pipe from site to nearest PHED stores at pumps houses. Epoxy painted MS pipe, A.C./PVC pipe and other material of required size shall be provided by the department at stores (pump house), which shall be transported at burst site by the contractor. However, welding rods, machinery, T & P and skilled/unskilled labour is to be arranged by contractor.

The contractor shall immediately repair the damaged pipe line due to development works under taken by other departments such as JDA/ NNJ, /JVNL/BSNL etc., and restore supply.

The contractor shall take all safety measures to repair the pipe lines and refill the leakage pits with sand with proper compaction. Any accident is casualty on account of left out open pits or underground power cables will be the sole

responsibility of the contractor.

REMOVAL OF LEAKAGE FROM MS SPECIALS:

- LEAKAGE REPAIRING WITH DISLOCATION: - Leakage with dislocation of pipes/specials includes jacking/rejacking/ cutting, welding, dewatering and excavation in all sorts of soils/rocks, if required.
- LEAKAGE REPAIRING WITHOUT DISLOCATION IN PIPELINE: Leakage without dislocation of pipes/specials includes cutting, welding, dewatering and excavation in all sorts of soils/rocks, if required.

The contractor shall be liable of carrying out any such work, not included herein but required for satisfying public complaints, avoid disruption of Water Supply Scheme avoid water low pressure problems and loss of water etc. as per direction of Engineer-In-Charge.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS

1. HANDING OVER & TAKING OVER THE SCHEME.

The department shall hand over the complete scheme along with all ancillary units in working condition to the contractor. The contractor shall hand over the entire scheme and appurtenances in working condition on completion of contract.

2. INFORMATION & RECORDS :

Contractor shall have to maintain following records. However the Performa for the up keeping of records shall be provided by the department. All records shall be kept in good position, binded or as required & as instructed by the Engineer-in-Charge.

i) Pumping Log books at Head Works:

One log book for pumping sets running at head works for recording voltage, ampere of each connected pump set, pressure of each pipe line etc shall have to be entered on hourly basis. The time of running & close of pump sets shall be marked in the log book. All entries shall be marked clearly. All other information regarding operation of pump sets, operation of valves for taking water in SR and direct boosting shall be marked in the log books.

ii) Information regarding water supply in Town

a) **Distribution Register**

A separate register at head works shall have to be maintained showing daily pumping hours & distribution of water.

c) Material Consumption Records

Contractor shall have to maintain the stock register for receipt, consumption & balance of the material. Contractor shall have to maintain a performa showing the work done & material consumed. This performa shall be numbered & material consumption shall be verified by the representative of Engineer-in-Charge after completion of the maintenance work & respective entries shall be made in stock register. Contractor should be very particular about receipt & consumption of material. The contractor shall provide statement of receipt, consumption & MAS account. The stock register shall be verified before submitting the RA bill.

v) Complaint Register :

The contractor shall maintain a complaint register at head works. It should be easily available at pump house, so that any person from the public or any public representative can register his complaint about water supply in the villages. Compliance of the complaint shall have to be recorded with date and time.

vi) Inspection Register:

The contractor shall maintain an inspection register at head works. Contractor should produce the register whenever departmental authority visit the head works. Compliance of any instructions given by inspecting authority shall have to be done immediately & remark for the compliance with date & time shall have to be recorded.

3. MAINTENANCE OF SWITCH GEARS, VALVES etc

The contractor shall carryout both preventive & breakdown maintenance of the switch gear, valves etc. The contractor shall be responsible for safety of switchgears, he shall repair it at his own cost within reasonable time period.

Preventive maintenance shall have to be done as directed by Engineer-in-Charge. Break down maintenance shall have to be carried out immediately & not later than 24 Hrs. Maintenance of suction, delivery header, valves etc installed in the pump house shall be done by the contractor.

All material & spares required for preventive as well as for breakdown maintenance shall arranged by contractor at his own cost. No extra payment shall be admissible to the contractor on account of preventive & break down or other type of maintenance.

4. REPAIRS AND REWINDING OF PUMPING MACHINERY:

The contractor shall carryout both preventive & breakdown maintenance of the pump sets. All major / Minor repair of pump and machinery including rewinding of pump sets , cable, feeder control panel board including all accessories etc. will be done by contractor.

5. MAINTENANCE OF PIPE LINES & SPECIALS :

The contractor shall have to do both preventive & breakdown maintenance of pipe lines of all sizes & types of material. The contractor shall be responsible for patrolling of pipe lines, identifying leakage/ burst, repairing of leakage/ burst, identifying any type of choking in pipe line, removing the chocking (by

deploying required labour, T & P etc at earliest possible), transportation of material for the same from the store located at JEn Store of work. Contractor shall make his own arrangement for dewatering of pipe line, means of conveyance for labour etc. Contractor shall be responsible for repair & maintenance of all air valve, sluice valves, scour valves & non-return valves, other specials & appurtenances fixed in pipe line. The contractor shall be responsible for general repair & maintenance of all types of pipes DI of 250mm dia. Repair of pipelines shall be completed in reasonable time period as directed by Engineer in Charge. **Contractor will be wholly responsible for theft of water from Rising main by taking unauthorized water connection or damaging of pipe line.**

6. MAINTENANCE OF DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM:

Contractor shall be responsible for maintenance of distribution system. He shall operate the control valves for filling of SR's and direct boosting system . Contractor shall be responsible for watch & ward of CWR/ SR & CI/ GI or other fittings of system. He shall repair any leakage found in distribution system. He shall be responsible for daily water supply as per standard norms i.e. full capacity of SR's and direct boosting. He shall be also responsible for chlorination, if required. Bleaching powder for chlorination will be provided by the department.

7. MATERIAL FOR MAINTENANCE:

All material required for maintenance of pipeline only shall be arranged by department except consumables like glands, grease etc which will be arranged by contractor at his own cost. Also all T& P required for operation and maintenance shall be arranged by contractor.

The contractor has to maintain hygienic condition around SR & CWR for which he shall make arrangement to drain out the waste water at somewhat distance, or as directed by Engineer-in-Charge.

8. STAFF FOR OPERATION & MAINTENANCE:

The contractor shall employ sufficient number of staff (MINIMUM 1 Nos Belper & 1nos. Fitter), for the operation and maintenance of the scheme, only such persons who are skilled & experienced in their trades including electrician & fitter and the Engineer-in-Charges shall be at liberty to object to and ask the contractor to remove from the site any person employed by the contractor for the operation & maintenance of the work, who in the opinion of the Engineer-in-Charge misconduct or is incompetent or negligent, shall not be again employed upon work without permission of the Engineer-in-Charge.

9. THEFT & LOSS OF FIXED ASSETS ETC:

The cost of material like pump sets, switchgears, valves, pipe line appurtenance, etc. if theft or damaged, replaced, lost or not used properly shall be recovered from the contractor.

10. SAFETY PRECAUTION:

Necessary safety of equipments/ accessories shall be provided by the contractor to his employees to carry out the work of operation of electric pump sets etc.

Adequate safety precautions against accident during carrying out the work of operation & maintenance shall be strictly followed by the contractor at his own cost. Necessary medical first aid kit should be available at head works at all time.

Department shall not be responsible for any accident caused due to non compliance of safety precautions whatever it may be.

11. COMPENSATIONS FOR DAMAGE/ LOSS:

In the event of any damage/ loss of life and property during operation & maintenance of scheme, the contractor shall be solely responsible and liable for loss/ damage & compensation thereof. The department shall not be responsible for any such loss/ damage of life & property & shall not pay anything against the same.

12. GENERAL MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING OF HEADWORK'S

Contractor shall make arrangement for sweeping & cleaning of pump houses regularly.

13. PAYMENT TERMS :

Common conditions -

- a) The operation & maintenance cost be payable on monthly basis after completion of a month's period on presentation of the bill by the firm.
- b) All statutory deductions of security deposit, Income tax, Sales tax etc shall be made from all running account bills & final bill as per prevalent departmental rules. The amount against security deposit shall be refunded after 6 month of completion of the contract.
- c) No extra payment for loading, unloading and transportation of material and T&P shall be payable to contractor.

In case of unsatisfactory performance by the contractor in operation and maintenance, liquidated damages @ 0.25% of contract value per week of unsatisfactory performance, subject to maximum of 10% of contract value shall be levied as compensation. Regarding such compensation the decision of department shall be final & binding upon the contractor. This compensation shall be over and above the other penalty charges.

14. FAILURE OF CONTRACTOR

In the event of failure of the contractor or strike by the O&M staff the department shall be empowered to operate and maintain the water supply at the **sole risk and cost of the contractor**.
