Procedure for Technical BID qualification would be as follow:

- (a) The technical bid will be opened only of those bidders whose proper Bid Security, GST registration are found to be in order.
- (b) The Technical Bid envelope would be opened on the date **On 20.05.2026 at 5.00PM** (c) The Financial Bid envelope would be opened only of those bidders who fulfill all the **TECHNICAL QUALIFICATION** criteria.
- (d) Joint Ventures/ Association is not allowed.

2. Criteria:

Criteria for **TECHNICAL QUALIFICATION** would be as follows:-

- (i) Bidder should have experience of Consultancy work in last Seven Financial Years (Including current Financial Year, if any) and should full fill the following requirements:-
 - a) Bidder should have experience of preparation and sanction of DPR for Sewerage System & STP Project involving Survey (Topographic Survey, Population Census Survey), Soil Investigation etc and STP design as per latest technologies.
 - b) The minimum cost of project, for which the participating firm has completed the satisfactory work of preparing DPR at least one such accepted DPR work should not be less than Rs. **45.00 crores**.
- (ii) The Consultant/ Firm must have experience of 10 years in the field of Consultancy work. (The Year of Inception Certificate of Incorporation or Registration shall be considered as criteria for this)
- (iii) The Consultant/ Firm should possess the following Technical Key Persons / Utilities for the Consultancy Work:-
 - a) The Firm should have **Sewerage System Design Engineer** bearing M.Tech/ M.E. in **Environmental Engineering** from Recognized University having experience of

at least 10 years in his field of Designing. The employed Key Persons should be employer of the Bidder's Firm from at least last One year. And Firm also have latest Software i.e. Sewer CAD, Sewer GEMS, STAAD.Pro etc.

- b) Bidder must possess valid License of Latest Software (Sewer CAD, Sewer GEMS, STAAD.Pro etc) for Designing of Complete (**Sewerage System Design, STP's etc.**). For this, the Bidder must submit the Copy of valid software license issued in favour of Firm's Name or Firm's Representative Name.

Note :-

- (i) **Certificate issued by Govt. of India, State Govts., Union Territory, Govt. Undertakings, Autonomous Bodies shall only be considered for Criteria 2(i) (a) to (b). The Certificate issued should itself bear all the above requirements specifically.**
- (ii) **The Firm should submit the affidavit on Non Judicial Stamp Paper of Rs 500/- for the possession of Technical Key Persons (Sewerage System Designer, STP etc.) bearing M.Tech/ M.E. in Environmental Engineering from Recognized University and having experience of Minimum 10 years in the field of Hydraulic Structure Design (Sewerage System Designer, STP etc.) along with requisite experience as laid down for Criteria 2(i) (a) to (b).**

In addition, the firm should submit the proof of Key Persons employed in form of (Sewerage System Designer, STP etc.) Design Engineer by submitting the Salary Slip along with Bank Details of Employer for payment of Salary/ TDS Certificate Copy to such Environment Engineer (Sewerage System Designer, STP etc.) from at least last one year. Failure to submission of these, would led to rejection of Bid

3. Financial Turnover

The bidder should have achieved an annual financial turnover of at least **Rs. 33.00 Lacs** in any one of last seven financial years. However, the bidder may opt the current financial year.

5. Scope of Work:

Scope of work includes the preparation of detailed project report which should be technically correct and should justify the project for technical feasibility, financial sustainability, environmental compatibility, social and political acceptability and legal and regulatory feasibility.

The scope of work includes the following: -

(a) Reuse of treated effluent of Existing STP's :

- Available treated effluent can be reused in the nearby agriculture fields. Identification of possible end users (farmers) is required.
- Infrastructure needs to be developed for supplying treated effluent to existing parks situated at Vivek Vihar Scheme and other JODA Scheme.
- Provision of hydrants at each STP to fill treated effluent.

(b) Additional STP & sewer network for left out area's and newly developed area of JODA jurisdiction:

- Proposal of sewer network and Area Identification for left out area's and newly developed area i.e. along the ring road of jodhpur, JODA scheme Ramraj nagar, Thegdi nagar, Sardar patel nagar, RK Puram, Kureshi nagar, Pakrkar colony, Khasrara no. 713, Near about area of Gangana village, Sarthi sarovar, Mahdev Nagar, Motiba Nagar, Binjariya nagar, Boranda, Arti nagar, Chokha Village, Jhalamnd beyond Jojari river, Sangariya Village, Area near Nagour road and Jaipur Road of JODA jurisdiction and along both side of Jojari River ect.

- (c) **Augmentation of STPs Functional Capacity:-** To carryout survey of adjoining areas in order for augmentation of present STPs functional capacity.
- (d) **Drains Survey:-** To carryout survey of all drains of Jodhpur region which may carry any kind of Sewage and to propose the diversion of such sewage flow to the nearest Sewer line or to lay new Sewerage Network for the same, as the case may be.

Preparation of estimates of proposed work, preparation of implementation schedule, preparation of tender documents, Designing of Sewer network & STP also design of structural mechanical Electrical and Electromechanically. Final DPR, must be vetted from any MBM University/ IIT Jodhpur, as per direction of Engineer-in-charge.

Note:- It should be noted that there may be increase in the above said area.

6. Important:

- (a) The bidder must ensure that all the information required in the Documents is furnished by him complete in all respects. He would not be allowed to withdraw any document, or to rectify any information furnished therein, after submitting the bid.
- (b) In place of immediate availability of the certificates as mentioned above, the bidder should give an affidavit that the information furnished in schedule I, II & III is correct. If any information is found incorrect, the offer of the bidder shall be rejected and action will be initiated as per rules.
- (c) Bidders must do paging of all enclosure of bid documents.
- (d) Bids will be treated with all relevant clauses of RTPP Act, PWF&A Rules, SOP and other regulations in practice at Authority.

7. Rejection of bids:

- a) The department reserves the rights to reject any bid or to disqualify any or all the bidders, without assigning any reasons at any stage.

1. *Correction of arithmetical errors*

Provided that a financial bid is substantially responsive, the procuring entity will correct arithmetical errors during evaluation of financial Bids on the following basis:

- i. if there is a discrepancy between the unit price and the total price that is obtained by multiplying the unit price and quantity, the unit price shall prevail and the total price shall be corrected, unless in the opinion of the procuring entity there is an obvious misplacement of the decimal point in the unit price, in which case the total price as quoted shall govern and the unit price shall be corrected;
- ii. (ii) if there is an error in a total corresponding to the addition or subtraction of subtotals, the subtotals shall prevail and the total shall be corrected; and
- iii. (iii) if there is a discrepancy between words and figures, the amount in words shall prevail, unless the amount expressed in words is related to an arithmetic error, in which case the amount in figures shall prevail subject to (i) and (ii) above.

If the Bidder that submitted the lowest evaluated bid does not accept the correction of errors, its bid shall be disqualified and its bid security shall be forfeited or its bid securing declaration shall be executed.

2. *Procuring Entity's Right to Vary quantities.*

If the Bidder that submitted the lowest evaluated Bid does not accept the correction of errors, its Bid shall be disqualified and its Bid Security shall be forfeited or its Bid Securing Declaration shall be executed.

2. Procuring Entity's Right to Vary Quantities

(i) At the time of award of contract, the quantity of Goods, works or services originally specified in the Bidding Document may be increased or decreased by a specified percentage, but such increase or decrease shall not exceed twenty percent, of the quantity specified in the Bidding Document. It shall be without any change in the unit prices or other terms and conditions of the Bid and the conditions of contract.

(ii) If the Procuring Entity does not procure any subject matter of procurement or procures less than the quantity specified in the Bidding Document due to change in circumstances, the Bidder shall not be entitled for any claim or compensation except otherwise provided in the Conditions of Contract.

(iii) In case of procurement of Goods or services, additional quantity may be procured by placing a repeat order on the rates and conditions of the original order. However, the additional quantity shall not be more than 50% of the value of Goods of the original contract and shall be within one month from the date of expiry of last supply. If the Supplier fails to do so, the Procuring Entity shall be free to arrange for the balance supply by limited Bidding or otherwise and the extra cost incurred shall be recovered from the Supplier.

3. Dividing quantities among more than one Bidder at the time of award (In case of procurement of Goods)

As a general rule all the quantities of the subject matter of procurement shall be procured from the Bidder, whose Bid is accepted. However, when it is considered that the quantity of the subject matter of procurement to be procured is very large and it may not be in the capacity of the Bidder, whose Bid is accepted, to deliver the entire quantity or when it is considered that the subject matter of procurement to be procured is of critical and vital nature, in such cases, the quantity may be divided between the Bidder, whose Bid is accepted and the second lowest Bidder or even more Bidders in that order, in a fair, transparent and equitable manner at the rates of the Bidder, whose Bid is accepted.
