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Short Term Quotation

For and on behalf of the Government of Jammu & Kashmir, short term quotations are invited from experienced vendors/individuals for providing Light Goods Vehicle or equivalent (on hiring basis) to be used for carriage of officials/ PAS/equipment etc and prepared as IEC Van with banners installed and PA System mounted on it during the WIP led Nasha Mukh JK Mega Padyatra scheduled in the district on 1st June 2026.

Terms and Conditions:

1. The quotations in sealed envelope should reach this office by or before 30-05-2026 up to 01:00 PM. The bids shall be opened at 02:00 PM on the same day in presence of the participating vendors/ individuals/ their representatives.
2. The vehicle shall also be used for carriage of PA System, equipments, officials etc to and for the venue, Laroo Bus Stand Kulgam on 31st May and 1st June 2026.
3. The vehicle shall move along the padyatra route Venue to culmination point i.e. Ghantaghar Kulgam and through the interiors and outskirts of main town on 1st June 2026 with banners installed, ensuring clear visibility to the public, along with operation of portable sound system for wider publicity of NMUK campaign.
4. The rates should be quoted in clear terms (both in figures and words) excluding fuel charges but including driver/other charges and all applicable taxes for two (02) days viz 31st May and 1st June 2026.
5. The fuel due to the vehicle for the distances covered for carriages as well as publicity part to and for this office on 31st May and 1st June 2026 shall be borne by this office as per the government rates.
6. The vehicle must be roadworthy, properly registered, insured, and in good mechanical condition with valid RC, Insurance, PUC and all other necessary documents.
7. The driver must possess a valid driving licence and be experienced. Any violation shall be the vendor's/owners's responsibility.
8. The vendor shall ensure proper and secure installation of banners on both sides of the vehicle so that banners remain stable, visible, and do not pose any safety hazard during movement.
9. The vehicle should be suitable for rally/padyatra movement at slow speed, allowing effective public visibility of banners.
10. The vehicle shall have adequate space and safety provisions for departmental officials to sit/stand and operate the portable PAS during the rally.
11. All arrangements including fuel, maintenance, labour, and operation shall be the responsibility of the vendor.
12. The department shall not be responsible for any accident, damage, or legal liability during execution.
13. Incomplete or conditional quotations shall be rejected.
14. The office reserves the right to accept or reject any or all quotations without assigning reasons.
15. Payment shall be made after satisfactory completion of the assignment and availability of funds under the relevant budget head.
