- The contractor submitting the tender should read the schedule of quantities, additional conditions, additional specifications, particular specifications, CPWD- 6 and other terms and conditions given in the NIT and drawings. The bidder should also read the General Conditions of Contract for CPWD Works 2023 with up to date correction slips, which is available as Government of India Publications; however, provisions included in the tender document shall prevail over the provisions contained in the standard form. The set of drawings and NIT shall be available in the office of **Executive Engineer (E.), Nagpur Central Elect. Division, CPWD, Nagpur**. The contractor should also visit the site of work and acquaint himself with the site conditions before tendering. He should only submit his tender if he considers himself eligible and he is in possession of all the required documents. The following conditions, which already form part of the tender conditions, are specially brought to his notice for compliance while submitting the tender online. They are requested to comply following instructions.
 - Tenders with any condition including that of conditional rebates shall be rejected forthwith.

- b) **The successful bidder shall be required to submit a Performance Guarantee of**
 - i) **5% (Five Percent) of the tendered amount or Estimated Cost put to Tender (ECPT) (Whichever is higher).**
 - ii) **Where the tendered amount is less than eighty percent (80%) of the estimated cost put to tender (ECPT), The performance Guarantee, in addition to the requirement under (i) above, shall be increased by an amount equal to the difference between eight percent (80%) of the ECPT and the tendered amount** within 7 days of issue of letter of intent. This period can be further extended by Engineer-in-Charge up to a maximum period of 3 days on the written request of the contractor and with late fee as defined in Schedule F.
 - c) GST and Labour-Cess etc. as applicable shall be borne by the contractor himself. The contractor shall quote his rates considering all such taxes and hence their quoted rates should be inclusive of all the tax components.
3. It will be obligatory on part of the Contractor/ Bidder to tender for and sign the tender documents for all the component parts. The department reserves right to accept tender in full or in part without assigning any reasons.
 4. The intending bidder must read the terms and conditions of CPWD-6 carefully. He should only submit his bid if he considers himself eligible and he is in possession of all the documents required.
 5. Information and Instructions for bidders posted on website shall form of bid document.
 6. The enlistment of the contractors should be valid on the last date of submission of bids. In case the last date of opening of bid is extended, the enlistment of contractor should be valid on the original date of opening of tender.
 7. The bid document consisting of plans, specifications, the schedule of quantities of various types of items to be executed and the set of terms and conditions of the contract to be complied with and other necessary documents can be seen in the office of **Executive Engineer (E.), Nagpur Central Elect. Division, CPWD, Nagpur** on all working days between 11.00 AM to 4.00 PM except Sunday and public holidays and downloaded from website <https://etender.cpwd.gov.in> free of cost.
 8. But the bid can only be submitted after deposition of original EMD either in the office of Executive Engineer inviting bids or division office of any Executive Engineer, CPWD within the period of bid submission and uploading the mandatory scanned documents such as Insurance Surety Bonds, Account Payee Demand Draft or Bankers Cheque or Fixed Deposit Receipts or / and Bank Guarantee (for balance amount as prescribed) from any of the Commercial Bank towards EMD in favour of **"Executive Engineer (E), Nagpur Central Electrical Division, CPWD, Nagpur"** as mentioned in NIT, receipt of deposition of original EMD to division office of any Executive Engineer, (including NIT issuing EE/ AE), CPWD and other documents as specified.
 9. The bids will be submitted upto **3.00 PM on 04/06/2026**. The bid shall be opened at 3:30 PM on **04/06/2026**.
 10. Those contractors not registered on the website mentioned above, are required to get registered beforehand. If needed they can be imparted training on online bidding process as per details available on the website.
 11. The intending bidder must have valid class-III digital signature to submit the bid.
 12. The Contractor can deposit original EMD either in the office of Executive Engineer inviting bids or division office of any Executive Engineer, CPWD within the period of bid submission of receiving division office is situated). The contractor shall obtain the receipt of EMD from the concerned Executive Engineer in the prescribed format uploaded by NIT issuing Executive Engineer. The bid document as uploaded can be viewed and downloaded free of cost by anyone including intending bidder. But the bid can only be submitted after uploading the mandatory scanned documents such as Insurance Surety Bonds, Account Payee Demand Draft or Bankers Cheque or Fixed Deposit Receipts or / and Bank Guarantee (for balance amount as prescribed) from any of the Commercial Bank towards EMD in favour of respective Executive Engineer, copy of receipt of original EMD and other documents specified on the website.
 13. The Executive Engineer of all divisions of CPWD should receive the original EMD for tender of other division.
 14. The Executive Engineer receiving EMD in original form shall examine the EMD deposited by the bidder and shall issue a receipt of deposition of earnest money to the agency in a given format uploaded by tender inviting EE. The receipt may be issued by the EE/AAO/AE(P)/AE.

15. The Executive Engineer receiving original EMD shall also intimate tender inviting Executive Engineer about deposition of EMD by the agency by email/fax/telephonically.
16. The original EMD receiving Executive Engineer shall release the EMD after verification from the e-tendering portal website (<https://etender.cpwd.gov.in>) free view> advance search> awarded tenders) that the particular contractor is not L-1 tenderer and work is awarded.
17. The tender inviting Executive Engineer will call for original EMD of the L-1 tenderer from EMD receiving Executive Engineer immediately.
18. On opening date, the contractor can login and see the bid opening process. After opening of bids he will receive the competitor bid sheets.
19. Contractor can upload documents in the form of JPG format and PDF format.
20. In addition to this, while selecting any of the cells a warning appears that if any cell is left blank the same shall be treated as "0". Therefore, if any cell is left blank and no rate is quoted by the bidder, rate of such item shall be treated as "0" (ZERO).
21. The required documents meeting the criteria to qualify as "approved and eligible contractors of CPWD" along with other documents as mentioned under para "List of Documents to be scanned and uploaded within the period of bid submission" below, as uploaded by the agency and hard copies received subsequently shall be checked. The financial bid of only those agencies shall be opened who are found to be eligible agencies, as per this NIT.
22. The department reserves the right to reject any prospective application without assigning any reason and to restrict the list of qualified contractors to any number deemed suitable by it, if too many bids are received satisfying the laid down criterion.
23. The letter of award shall be issued to lowest bidder only on receipt of copy of Labour license, Registration with EPFO, ESIC, BOCW Welfare Board and PF Nos. or submitting the proof of applying for these thereof along with P.G.

Enlisted contractors of class-III, IV and V can participate in tenders within the jurisdiction as detailed in table-9 as per their tendering limit for CPWD works, or as amended from time to time. Enlisted contractors of any class shall also have to meet the other requirements of eligibility as per NIT for Class-III, IV and V enlisted only.

- IV. GST Registration Certificate if already obtained by the bidder.
If the bidder has not obtained GST registration as applicable, then he shall scan and upload following undertaking along with bid documents.
"If work is awarded to me, I/we shall obtain GST registration certificate, as applicable, within one month from the date of receipt of award letter or before release of any payment by CPWD, whichever is earlier, failing which I/we shall be responsible for any delay in payments which will be due towards me/us on account of the work executed and/or for any action taken by CPWD or GST department in this regard".

1. Online Percentage Rate tenders are invited on behalf of President of India from approved and eligible contractors in Building & Road (B&R) Category (Earstwhile Composite) for the work of **SITC of LED fittings, BLDC fan & split type air conditioning system for office building (G+2) at CGST & Central Excise, Datala Road, Chandrapur..**
- 1.1 The work is estimated to cost **Rs.14,14,835 /-**. This estimate, however, is given merely as a rough guide.
- 1.1.1 The authority competent to approve NIT for the combined cost and belonging to the major discipline will consolidate NITs for calling the bids. He will also nominate Division which will deal with all matters relating to the invitation of bids.
For composite bids, besides indicating the combined estimated cost put to bid, should clearly indicates the estimated cost of each component separately. The eligibility of bidders will correspond to the combined estimated cost of different components put to bid.
2. Agreement shall be drawn with the successful bidder on prescribed Form No. CPWD 7 which is available as a Govt. of India Publication and also available on website www.cpwd.gov.in. Bidders shall quote his rates as per various terms and conditions of the said form which will form part of the agreement.
3. The time allowed for carrying out the work will be **04 Months** from the date of start as defined in schedule 'F' or from the first date of handing over of the site, whichever is later, in accordance with the phasing, if any, indicated in the tender documents.
4. The site for the work is available. : YES
5. The bid document consisting of plans, specifications, the schedule of quantities of various types of items to be executed and the set of terms and conditions of the contract to be complied with and other necessary documents except Standard General Conditions Of Contract Form can be seen from website <https://etender.cpwd.gov.in/> in free of cost.
6. After submission of the bid the contractor can re-submit revised bid any number of times but before last time and date of submission of bid as notified.
7. While submitting the revised bid, contractor can revise the rate of one or more item(s) any number of times (he need not re-enter rate of all the items) but before last time and date of submission of bid as notified.
8. When bids are invited in three stage system and if it is desired to submit revised financial bid then it shall be mandatory to submit revised financial bid. If not submitted then the bid submitted earlier shall become invalid.
9. Earnest Money in the form of Insurance Surety Bonds, Account Payee Demand Draft, Fixed Deposit Receipts, Banker's Cheque or Bank Guarantee (for balance amount as prescribed) from any of the Commercial Bank (drawn in favour of **Executive Engineer (E), Nagpur Central Electrical Division, CPWD, Nagpur**) shall be scanned and uploaded to the e-tendering website within the period of bid submission. The original EMD should be deposited either in the office of Executive Engineer inviting bids or division office of any Executive Engineer, CPWD within the period of bid submission. The EMD receiving Executive Engineer shall issue a receipt of deposition of earnest money deposit to the bidder in a prescribed format (enclosed) uploaded by tender inviting EE in the NIT.
This receipt shall also be uploaded to the e-tendering website by the intending bidder upto the specified bid submission date and time. (Modified vide OM No.D G/MAN/328. Dtd. 04.01.2016).

A part of earnest money is acceptable in the form of bank guarantee also. In such case, minimum 50% of earnest money or Rs. 20 lakh, whichever is less, shall have to be deposited in shape prescribed above, and balance can be accepted in the form of Bank Guarantee issued by a Commercial Bank having validity for six months or more from the last date of receipt of bids which is to be scanned and uploaded by the intending bidders.

Copy of Enlistment Order and other documents as specified in the press notice shall be scanned and uploaded to the e-tendering website within the period of tender submission.

However, certified copy of all the scanned and uploaded documents as specified in press notice shall have to be submitted by the lowest bidder only within a week physically in the office of tender opening authority.

Online bid documents submitted by intending bidders shall be opened only of those bidders, whose original EMD deposited with any division of CPWD and other documents scanned and uploaded are found in order.

The bid submitted shall be opened on **04/06/2026 at 03.30 PM.**

10. The bid submitted shall become invalid if:
 - (i) The bidder is found ineligible.
 - (ii) The bidder does not deposit original EMD with division office of any Executive Engineer, CPWD.
 - (iii) The bidder does not upload all the documents (including GST Registration) as stipulated in the bid document including the copy of receipt for deposition of original EMD.
 - (iv) If any discrepancy is noticed between the document as uploaded at the time of submission of bid and hard copies as submitted physically by the lowest bidder in the office of tender opening authority. (Modified vide OM No. DG/MAN/328 Dtd. 04.01.2016).
 - (v) If a tenderer quotes 'Nil' rates against each item in Percentage rate tender or does not quote any percentage above/below on the total amount of the tender or any section/subhead in percentage rate tender, the tender shall be treated as invalid and will not be considered as lowest tenderer.
11. The contractor whose bid is accepted will be required to furnish performance guarantee at specified percentage of the tendered amount as mentioned in schedule E and within the period specified in Schedule F. This guarantee shall be in the form of Insurance Surety Bonds, Account Payee Demand Draft, Fixed Deposit Receipt of Bank Guarantee from any of the Commercial Bank in accordance with the prescribed form. In case the contractor fails to deposit the said performance guarantee within the period as indicated in Schedule "F". Including the extended period if any, the Earnest Money deposited by the contractor shall be forfeited automatically without any notice to the contractor. The Earnest Money deposited along with bid shall be returned after receiving the aforesaid performance guarantee.
The contractor whose bid is accepted will also be required to furnish either copy of applicable licenses/ registrations or proof of applying for obtaining labour licences, registration with EPFO, ESIC and BOCW Welfare Board including Provident Fund Code No. if applicable and also ensure the compliance of aforesaid provisions by the sub contractors, if any engaged by the contractor for the said work and programme Chart (Time & Progress) within the period specified in Schedule F.
12. The description of the work is as follows :-
Intending Bidders are advised to inspect and examine the site and its surroundings and satisfy themselves before submitting their tenders as to the nature of the ground and sub-soil (so far as is practicable), the form and nature of the site, the means of access to the site, the accommodation they may require and in general shall themselves obtain all necessary information as to risks, contingencies and other circumstances which may influence or affect their tender. A bidder shall be deemed to have full knowledge of the site whether he inspects it or not and no extra charge consequent on any misunderstanding or otherwise shall be allowed. The bidders shall be responsible for arranging and maintaining at his own cost all materials, tools & plants, water, electricity access, facilities for workers and all other services required for executing the work unless otherwise specifically provided for in the contract documents. Submission of a bid by a bidder implies that he has read this notice and all other contract documents and has made himself aware of the scope and specifications of the work to be done and of conditions and rates at which stores, tools and plant, etc. will be issued to him by the Government and local conditions and other factors having a bearing on the execution of the work.
13. The competent authority on behalf of the President of India does not bind itself to accept the lowest or any other bid and reserves to itself the authority to reject any or all the bids received without the assignment of any reason. All bids in which any of the prescribed condition is not fulfilled or any condition including that of conditional rebate is put forth by the tenderer shall be summarily rejected.
14. Canvassing whether directly or indirectly, in connection with tenderers is strictly prohibited and the bids submitted by the contractors who resort to canvassing will be liable for rejection.

15. The competent authority on behalf of President of India reserves to himself the right of accepting the whole or any part of the bid and the bidders shall be bound to perform the same at the rate quoted.
16. The contractor shall not be permitted to bid for works in the CPWD Circle (Division in case of contractors of Horticulture/Nursery category) responsible for award and execution of contracts, in which his near relative is posted a Divisional Accountant or as an officer in any capacity between the grades of Superintending Engineer and Junior Engineer (both inclusive). He shall also intimate the names of persons who are working with him in any capacity or are subsequently employed by him and who are near relatives to any gazetted officer in the Central Public Works Department or in the Ministry of Urban Development. Any breach of this condition by the contractor would render him liable to be removed from the approved list of contractors of this Department.
17. No Engineer of gazette rank or other Gazette Officer employed in Engineering or Administrative duties in an Engineering Department of the Government of India is allowed to work as a contractor for a period of one year after his retirement from Government service, without the prior permission of the Government of India in writing. This contract is liable to be cancelled if either the contractor or any of his employees is found any time to be such a person who had not obtained the permission of the Government of India as aforesaid before submission of the bid or engagement in the contractor's service.
18. The bid for the works shall remain open for acceptance for a period of Thirty (30) days from the date of opening of bids in case of single bid system/ ~~Sixty (60) days from the date of opening of technical bids in case bids are invited on 2 or 3 bid/envelope system~~ (strike out as the case may be). If any bidders withdraws his bid before the said period or issue of letter of acceptance, whichever is earlier, or makes any modification in the terms and conditions of the bid which are not acceptable to the department, then the Government shall, without prejudice to any other right or remedy, be at liberty to forfeit 50% of the said earnest money as aforesaid. Further the bidders shall not be allowed to participate in the rebidding process of the work. (Modified Vide OM No. - DG/CON/293 dated 01.07.2016).
19. This notice inviting Tender shall form a part of the contract document. The successful bidder/contractor, on acceptance of his bid by the Accepting Authority shall within 15 days from the stipulated date of start of the work, sign the contract consisting of:-

20. Running payment for the major component shall be made by EE of major discipline to the main contractor. Running payment for minor components shall be made by the Engineer-in-Charge of the discipline of minor component directly to the main contractor. The EMB shall be maintained through ERP independently by Engineer-in-Charge of major and minor components.
21. The intending bidders are required to update their profile in CPWD e- tender portal and to upload their bids well in advance of last date of submission of tender. The technical specifications are to be read in conjunction with above and in case of variations, technical specifications of tender document shall apply. Nothing extra shall be paid on account of additional features in the technical specifications as the same are to be read along with schedule of quantities for the work.

Location: **CGST & Central Excise, Datala Road, Chandrapur**

1.1 The Department shall not issue any T & P and nothing extra shall be paid on this account.

1.2 The work to be awarded by this tender shall be treated as indivisible works contract.

2.0 No foreign exchange shall be made available by the Department for importing (purchase) of equipment, plants, machinery, materials of any kind or any other items required to be carried out during execution of the work. 1.2 All mounting boxes for plate type accessories shall be of metallic construction and of the same make as that of the plate type switches and accessories.

3.1 COPPER AND ALUMINIUM CABLES

3.1.1. This specification covers the supply, installation, testing and commissioning of 1100 V grade cables.

3.1.2 The design, manufacture and performance of the cables should conform to the relevant IS.

4.0 MOULDED CASE CIRCUIT BREAKERS

4.1 The MCCBs shall comprise single units of triple pole/four pole construction as specified, shall be rated for 415 V AC.

4.2 All live parts shall be totally enclosed and shrouded with a heat resistant moulded insulating material housing. Operating mechanism shall be quick make, quick break and trip free type.

4.2.1 The MCCB shall be provided with the following features in microprocessor Release:

a) All the LED Bulbs/ LED fittings shall be guaranteed for a period of 5 Years and the agency shall submit guarantee /warranty certificate issued by the OEM / Manufacturer, specifically issued for this work/ agreement, before payment of final bill.

b) 50% of the Performance Guarantee for tendered amount of LED fittings, shall be refunded to the contractor soon after the completion of the work and after recording of the completion certificate.

c) 50% of the Performance Guarantee for tendered amount of LED fittings, shall be retained as Security Deposit.

- e) Sample of any quantity & any type of LED fitting at random selected from the material supplied at site as per discretion of Engineer-In-charge may be sent to any NABL/UL accredited lab for the checking and verification of its performance parameter as per LM-79/ 80 report. This expenditure cost shall be borne by the department. However, in case of failure of sample or the sample not found as per specification, the expenditure on this A/C shall be recovered from the bill of the contractor and the material shall required to be removed from the site.
- 8.0 The contractor shall arrange to submit LM -79 & LM -80 reports from LED manufacturer for each and every type of LED fittings.
- 9.0 In the acceptable makes of fitting model No. of one of the acceptable make has been mentioned for guidance. However, the contractor is free to supply any of the 3 makes, provided the parameters of the fittings match with the fitting model No. mentioned in NIT. The decision of Engineer-in-charge shall be final.
- 10.0 The lamp color temperature shall be intimated by Engineer-in-charge/his representative at site.
- 11.0 In the acceptable makes of fitting model No. of one of the acceptable make has been mentioned for guidance. However, the contractor is free to supply any of the 3 makes, provided the parameters of the fittings match with the fitting model No. mentioned in NIT. The decision of Engineer-in-charge shall be final.
- 12.0 The contractor has to submit a copy of all the original bill / receipt for purchasing the material from manufacturer/authorized dealer for bonafied use at site at the time of submitting of bill.
- 13.0 ***Work may be carried out on Sundays, Holidays or in odd hours as per convenience of the client/ allottee for which no claim for idle labour shall be entertained.***

16. OEM authorization letter should be enclosed at the time of submission of technical data sheet for Audio/Video equipments , for approval of the engineer in charge.
