

Terms and Conditions for Restoration and CAMC of Fire Fighting System of DJLHC Building

1. The bidder should visit the site and asses requirements for initial restoration and CAMC before quote in the tender.
2. Bidder should quote separately for initial restoration part and CAMC part.
3. After initial restoration, all parts of the firefighting system should be fully functional & duly checked by institute engineers before start of AMC.
4. Successful bidder has to complete the initial restoration of the complete system within 60 days from issuing of the purchase order.
5. Only bidders have valid OEM authorization or valid authorized work permit and experience can participate in this tender.
6. The institute will not pay any charges for site visit (Transportation, food, lodging charges or any other charges).
7. All routine supply of materials needs to be replaced within the CAMC period to maintain operational readiness of the firefighting system should be covered within the quoted price of the tender.
8. CAMC of the firefighting system should be comprehensive with supply of all consumable materials needed within the quoted price of the tender.
9. CAMC will start after the completion of the initial restoration of the complete system duly certified by the institute engineers.
10. Successful bidder has to start the work within 7 days after issuing of purchase order.
11. Successful bidder should attend any breakdown within 24 hours of the raising complain as it comes under the emergency system.
12. All Service/Breakdown attend report acknowledged by the institute has to be submitted to the institute for billing purposes.
13. Bidder should quote in this tender for initial restoration with CAMC of the firefighting system separately.
14. Bidder should upload price breakup for each item separately for the initial restoration part of this tender.
15. The Successful bidder should provide training for fire rescue and firefighting operation to the institute personnel and other personnel as decided by the institute from time to time and should issue certificate to the individual personnel for successful completion and performance of the training by the successful bidder within the quoted price of the tender.
16. The successful bidder has to conduct fire drills at least once every six months within the quoted price of the tender.
17. All components required rectification or replacement for missing/damaged components (Page-C/22 to C/26) is tentative as on date of estimation. The bidder has to visit the site and take rate of the items any missing/damaged items has to be replaced by the bidders cost of which is included in the tender cost.
18. Successful bidders should provide fire safety clearance certificate from the applicable local authority (fire department) cost of which is included in the tender cost.

Payment Terms

1. Payment will be made on quarterly basis following the payment terms of the GeM.
2. Billing will be done as per the actual basis for the initial restoration part of this tender.
