1.	The contract shall be valid for a period of TWO YEARS from the date of issue of purchase order or till the entire quantity of gas supplies are executed whichever is earlier. Supply shall be drawn on as and when required basis.	
2.	The contractor shall quote DAP RR Site price basis only. Price shall remain firm & fixed during the currency of contract.	
3.	The contractor's scope of work includes the following:- collection, loading & unloading at contractor's works safe transportation (to & fro), Filling, supply & delivery of gas tonners. Loading & unloading at RR Site shall be in our (NPCIL) scope, bidders shall quote rates accordingly.	
4.	Bidder should quote rates for all the items i.e. item nos. 1 to 3. If rate of any one of the items is not quoted, then bid will be summarily rejected.	
5.	Evaluation of offers will be based on the overall landed price quoted for all items.	
6.	Inspection shall be carried out at site as per our specification and the test result of our chemical lab shall be final and binding on the supplier.	
7.	Supply requisition shall be placed by our authorized personnel by e-mail. Contractual Delivery Date will be reckoned from the date of such intimation for each requisition. In case of delay in supply, above date of intimation will be taken into account for calculating liquidated damages.	
8.	Supply shall be usually drawn in a lot of not less than 8 tonners. However, in case of urgent requirements, lesser quantity shall also be drawn	
9.	Before filling the tonners, the Contractor shall scrutinize the fitness of the tonners and shall replace the spares and / or carry out all operations as may be required as mentioned with prior approval of the Purchaser.	
10.	<p>The Contractor shall collect the empty tonners from site and filled tonners should reach our RR Site within 15 days from the date of intimation for each requisition. However, in case of exigencies, contractor should make all efforts for early delivery. However, for LD purpose, if 15th day is holiday at NPCIL, RR SITE, then next working day will be considered as 15th day and 15th day is excluding the date of intimation.</p> <p>The tonners offered for Hydro testing and refilling (if any with NPCIL approval) has to be supplied within a period of 30 days from the date of intimation of each requisition. However in case of exigencies, Contractor should make all efforts for early delivery. For LD purpose, if 30th day is holiday at NPCIL, RR SITE, then next working day will be considered as 30th day and 30th day is excluding the date of intimation.</p> <p>In the event of placement of purchase order, the contractor should execute all requisitions placed on them by the purchaser during the currency of the contract i.e. all requisition(s) placed on or before the expiry of contract validity period.</p>	
11.	In the event of contract, the contractor shall be obliged to discharge all obligations under the contract for all requisitions raised within the contract validity period. However, the delivery period shall be reckoned from the date of each requisition.	
12.	Before filling the tonners, the Contractor shall scrutinize the fitness of the tonners and shall replace the spares and / or carry out all operations as may be required as mentioned with prior approval of the Purchaser.	

13.	In the event, Hydrostatic testing of the tonners is required to be carried out in approved lab as per the specification of Petroleum and Explosive Safety Organization, Nagpur. Hydro test certificate should be submitted in original by contractor.							
14.	Services mentioned in the tender at Sr. no. 2 (Replacement of valve) & 3 (Hydrostatic test/hydro testing) shall be arranged with prior permission from NPCIL. Damaged/ replaced parts shall be sent back along with supply.
