CHECK LIST FOR CONTRACTORS FOR SUBMISSION OF BIDS

1. The bidder should read all the instructions, terms & conditions, contract clauses, nomenclature of items, specifications etc. contained in the tender documents very carefully, before quoting the rates. The tenderer should also read the CPWD General Conditions of Contract 2023 for **Maintenance work** (with correction slips upto last date of submission of tender) which will be part of the agreement.
2. The agency shall quote the rate for complete scope of work in both words and figures.
3. The contractor shall quote his rates keeping in mind the scope of work, time line, specifications, terms & conditions, additional conditions and special conditions etc. and nothing shall be payable extra whatsoever unless otherwise specified.
4. The contractor shall also furnish Performance Guarantee **(a) 5% of tendered value or Estimated Cost Put to Tender (ECPT) (whichever is higher). (b) Where the tendered amount is less than eighty percent (80%) of the Estimated Cost Put to Tender (ECPT), the Performance Guarantee, in addition to the requirement under (a) above, shall be increased by an amount equal to the difference between eighty percent (80%) of the ECPT and the tendered amount** in addition to the other deposits mentioned elsewhere in the contract for proper of the agreement. The Performance Guarantee shall be in the shape of FDR or Bank guarantee as per Performa given in Annexure enclosed.
5. In the event of the tender being submitted by a firm, it must be signed separately by each partner thereof or in the event of the absence of any partner, it must be signed on his behalf by a person holding a power of attorney authorizing him to do so. Such power of attorney should be produced with the tender and it must be disclosed that the firm is duly registered under the Indian partnership act, 1952.
6. GST / other taxes as applicable shall be paid by the contractor himself. Amount quoted by the bidder shall be inclusive of all taxes & nothing extra shall be payable. The department shall deduct the mandatory deductions at source from the R.A bills as applicable. However for statutory deduction of income tax & GST, necessary TDS certificate shall be given by department. The contractor shall quote his rates considering all such deductions.
7. The tender, which is not duly signed by authorized signatory or is conditional shall be treated as non-responsive and shall be summarily rejected.
8. Online bid documents submitted by intending bidders shall be opened only of those bidders, whose EMD deposited with any division office of CPWD, anywhere in India and other documents scanned and uploaded are found in order.

1. Specialized Agencies who fulfill the following requirements shall be eligible to apply.
 - a. Should have completed the similar works as mentioned below during the last Seven Years ending previous day of last date of submission of Bids.

“Similar work” shall mean work of **“Hiring of. Inspection Vehicles”** in any Central / State Government / PSU etc. The value of executed works shall be brought to current costing level by enhancing the actual value of work at simple rate of 7% per annum, calculated from the date of completion to previous day of last date of submission of bids. The completion certificate shall be signed an officer not less than the rank of Executive Engineer / Project Manager.

2. The intending bidder must read the terms and conditions of CPWD-6 carefully. He should only submit his bid if he considers himself eligible and he is in possession of all the documents required.

3. Information and Instructions for bidders posted on website shall form part of bid document.
4. The bid document consisting of plans, specifications, the schedule of quantities of various types of items to be executed and the set of terms and conditions of the contract to be complied with and other necessary documents can be seen and downloaded from website www.etender.cpwd.gov.in or www.cpwd.gov.in free of cost.
5. 7. The intending bidder must have valid class-III digital signature to submit the bid.
8. On opening date, the contractor can login and see the bid opening process. After opening of bids he will receive the competitor bid sheets.
9. Contractor can upload documents in the form of JPG format and PDF format. Bidder should ensure that the document uploaded is legible and full documents page is properly scanned.
10. Contractor must ensure to quote his percentage rate (above/below) in the attached schedules. However, if a tenderer does not quote any percentage above / below on the total amount of the tender or any section / sub head in percentage rate tender, the tender shall be treated as invalid and will not be considered as lowest tenderer.

- 1.1.1** The authority competent to approve NIT for the combined cost and belonging to the major discipline will consolidate NITs for calling the bids. He will also nominate Division which will deal with all matters relating to the invitation of bids.

accommodation they may require and in general shall themselves obtain all necessary information as to risks, contingencies and other circumstances which may influence or affect their bid. A bidder shall be deemed to have full knowledge of the site whether he inspects it or not and no extra charge consequent on any misunderstanding or otherwise shall be allowed. The bidder shall be responsible for arranging and maintaining at his own cost all materials, tools & plants, water, electricity access, facilities for workers and all other services required for executing the work unless otherwise specifically provided for in the contract documents. 12. The competent authority on behalf of the President of India does not bind itself to accept the lowest or any other bid and reserves to itself the authority to reject any or all the bids received without the assignment of any reason. All bids in which any of the prescribed condition is not fulfilled or any condition including that of conditional rebate is put forth by the bidder shall be summarily rejected.
13. Canvassing whether directly or indirectly, in connection with bidders is strictly prohibited and the bids submitted by the contractors who resort to canvassing will be liable to rejection.
14. The competent authority on behalf of President of India reserves to himself the right of accepting the whole or any part of the bid and the bidder shall be bound to perform the same at the rate quoted.
15. The contractor **(enlisted or non-enlisted in CPWD)** shall not be allowed to participate in the tender for works in the CPWD Zone /circle /Division /Sub-Division responsible for award and/or execution of contracts(s) in which his near relative is posted as Divisional Accountant or as an officer in any capacity between the grades of the Chief Engineer and Junior engineer (both inclusive.) he shall also intimate the names of persons who are working or are subsequently employed by him and who are near relative to any officer working in the CPWD. Any breach of this condition by the contractor would render him liable to **be debarred for a period upto two years from tendering in CPWD as decided by the accepting authority mentioned in Schedule F and his decision will be excepted from clause 25.** **NOTE:** By the term “near relatives” is meant wife, husband, parents and grand parents, children and grandchildren brother and sisters, uncles, aunts and cousin and their corresponding in-laws.
16. No Engineer of gazetted rank or other Gazetted Officer employed in Engineering or Administrative duties in an Engineering Department of the Government of India is allowed to work as a contractor for a period of one year after his retirement from Government service, without the previous permission of the Government of India in writing. This contract is liable to be cancelled if either the contractor or any of his employees is found any time to be such a person
