1.1 The work is estimated to cost **Rs.4,07,089/-**. **This estimate, however, is given merely as a rough guide. Criteria of eligibility for submission of bid documents**

1.2 Intending bidders is eligible to submit the bid provided he has definite proof from the appropriate authority, which shall be to the satisfaction of the competent authority, of having satisfactorily completed similar works of magnitude specified below.

1.2.1 a i) Three similar works each costing not less than **Rs.1.63 Lakhs** or Two similar works each costing not less than **Rs.2.44 Lakhs** or One similar work each costing not less than **Rs.3.26 Lakhs** with CPWD, M.E.S., BSNL, Railway, Department of post and State PWD/WRD of Tamil Nadu dealing with buildings for the following work. **The period for similar works in the last 7 years ending on the last day of the month previous to the one in which the tenders are invited.**

“Similar work” means Construction of Buildings, compound walls, Maintenance/Renovation Works of Buildings. The value of executed works Shall be brought to current costing level by enhancing the actual value of work at simple rate of 7% per annum; calculated from the date of completion to last date of receipt of applications for bid.

1.2.2 To become eligible for issue of bid, the bidders shall have to furnish an affidavit as under: -

I/We undertake and confirm that eligible similar works(s) has/have not been got executed through another contractor on back-to-back basis. Further that, if such a violation comes to the notice of Department, then I/we shall be debarred for bidding in CCW AIR in future forever. 2. Agreement shall be drawn with the successful bidders on prescribed Form No. CPWD 8 which is available as a Govt. of India Publication Bidders shall quote their rates as per various terms and conditions of the said form, which will form part of the agreement.
3. The time allowed for carrying out the work will be **Three (3) Months** from the date of start as defined in schedule 'F' or from the first date of handing over of the site, whichever is later, in accordance with the phasing, if any, indicated in the bid documents.
4. The site for the work is available.

5. The bid document consisting of plans, Specifications, the schedule of quantities of various types of items to be executed and the set of terms and conditions of the contract to be complied with and other necessary documents except Standard General Conditions of Contract Form can be seen on website <https://prasarbharati.eproc.in> free of cost.
6. After submission of the bid the contractor can re-submit revised bid any number of times but before last time and date of submission of bid as notified.
7. While submitting the revised bid, contractor can revise the rate of one or more item(s) any number of times (he need not re-enter rate of all the items) but before last time and date of submission of bid as notified.
8. When bids are invited in three-stage system and if it is desired to submit revised financial bid then it shall be mandatory to submit revised financial bid. If not submitted, then the bid submitted earlier shall become invalid.
9. Earnest Money shall be in the form of Treasury Challan or Demand Draft or Pay order or Banker's Cheque or Deposit at Call Receipt or Fixed Deposit Receipt (drawn in favour of **Executive Engineer(C), Civil Construction Wing, All India Radio, Chennai** shall be scanned and uploaded to the e-tendering website with in the period of bid submission.

Where the tendered amount is less than eighty percent (80%) of the Estimated cost put to tender(ECPT), The Performance Guarantee, in addition to the requirement under (a) above, shall be increased by an amount equal to the difference between eighty percent (80%) of the ECPT and the tendered amount within the period specified in Schedule F. 12. Intending Bidders are advised to inspect and examine the site and its surroundings and satisfy themselves before submitting their bids as to the nature of the ground and sub-soil (so far as is practicable), the form and nature of the site, the means of access to the site, the accommodation they may require and in general shall themselves obtain all necessary information as to risks, contingencies and other circumstances which may influence or affect their bid. A bidder shall be deemed to have full knowledge of the site whether he inspects it or not and no extra charge consequent on any misunderstanding or otherwise shall be allowed. 13. 14. Canvassing whether directly or indirectly, in connection with bidders is strictly prohibited and the bids submitted by the contractors who resort to canvassing will be liable for rejection.
15. The competent authority on behalf of President of India reserves to himself the right of accepting the whole or any part of the bid and the bidders shall be bound to perform the same at the rate quoted.
16. The contractor shall not be permitted to bid for works in the CCW AIR Circle responsible for award and execution of contracts, in which his near relative is posted a Divisional Accountant or as an officer in any capacity between the grades of Superintending Engineer and Junior Engineer (both inclusive). He shall also intimate the names of persons who are working with him in any capacity or are subsequently employed by him and who are near relatives to any gazette officer in the CCW AIR in the Ministry of Information and Broadcasting. Any breach of this condition by the contractor would render him liable to be removed from the approved list of contractors of this Department.

17. No Engineer of Gazetted Rank or other Gazetted Officer employed in Engineering or Administrative duties in an Engineering Department of the Government of India is allowed to work as a contractor for a period of one year after his retirement from Government service, without the prior permission of the Government of India in writing. This contract is liable to be cancelled if either the contractor or any of his employees is found any time to be such a person who had not obtained the permission of the Government of India as aforesaid before submission of the bid or engagement in the contractor's service.
18. The bid for the works shall remain open for acceptance for a period of **thirty (30) days** from the date of opening of bids. If any bidders withdraw his bid before the said period or issue of letter of acceptance, whichever is earlier, or makes any modifications in the terms and conditions of the bid which are not acceptable to the department, then the Government shall, without prejudice to any other right or remedy, be at liberty to forfeit 50% of the said earnest money as aforesaid. Cement Corporation of India, Zuari cement, India Cements, Chettinadu cement corporation, Madras cements Ltd, or from any other reputed cement Manufacturer having a production capacity not less than one million tons per annum as approved by ADG for that sub region..

The tenderers may also submit a list of names of cement manufacturers which they propose to use in the work. The tender accepting authority reserves right to accept or reject name(s) of cement manufacturer(s) which the tenderer proposes to use in the work. No change in the tendered rates will be accepted if the tender accepting authority does not accept the list of cement manufacturers, given by the tenderer fully or partially.

The supply of cement shall be taken in 50 kg. Bags bearing manufacturer's name and ISI marking. Samples of cement arranged by the contractor shall be taken by the Engineer-in-Charge and got tested in accordance with provisions of relevant BIS codes. In case the test result indicate that the cement arranged by the contractor does not conform to the relevant BIS codes, the same shall stand rejected, and it shall be removed from the site by the contractor at his own cost within a week's time of written order from the Engineer-in-Charge to do so.

2. The cement shall be brought at site in bulk supply of approximately 50 tonnes or as decided by the Engineer-in-Charge. The cement godown of the capacity to store a maximum of 2000 bags of cement shall be constructed by the contractor at site or work for which no extra payment shall be made.

Chief Engineer shall approve the steel manufactures for projects under their jurisdiction. NIT approving authority shall specify the manufacturers in the tender document.

2) The contractor shall have to obtain and furnish test certificates to the Engineer-in-charge in respect of all supplies of steel brought by him to the site of work.

3) Samples shall also be taken and got tested by the Engineer-in-charge as per the provisions in this regard in relevant BIS codes. In case the test results indicate that the steel arranged by the contractor does not conform to the specifications, the same shall stand rejected, and it shall be removed from the site of work by the contractor at his cost within a week time on written orders from the Engineer-in-charge to do so.

4) The steel reinforcement bars shall be brought to the site in bulk of 1 ton or more or as decided by the Engineer-in-charge.

Without prejudice to any of the rights of remedies under this contract, if the contractor dies, the Divisional Officer on behalf of the president of India shall have the option of terminating the contract without compensation to the contractor.

I, wherever any claims, against the contractor from the payment of sum money arises out or under the contractor, government shall be entitled to recover such by appropriating in part or whole, the security deposit of the contractor and to sell any Government promissory notes etc., forming the whole or part of such security.
