The Executive Engineer, Parliament Complex Civil Works Division, CPWD, New Delhi-110001 (Phone No.: 011-23034170) invites on behalf of the President of India online bids on CPWD e-Auction (<https://eauction.cpwd.gov.in>) for auction of unserviceable/dismantled materials on as-is-where-is-basis.

1. The closing time will be extended by specified 'X' minutes if any bid is received in the specified last 'Y' minutes before closing time of auction. Thereafter, the extended closing time will be extended by 'X' minutes every time a bid is received 'Y' minutes before the extended closing time. X=5 minutes and Y=5 minutes.
2. The intending bidders must carefully read these terms and conditions of e-auction.
3. The intending bidders may inspect the materials at store of located in **Parliament Library Building and Parliament House Annexe, New Delhi** between **11:00 AM to 04:00 PM** on **20.07.2026 to 21.07.2026**. The bidder can obtain entry passes from Assistant Engineer-I (**Mobile No. 8178280196**) and Assistant Engineer-III (**Mobile No. 9871960896**), PCCWD, Contact No. 011-23034478 & 011-23034523 and Junior Engineer, Sub Division-I (**Mobile No. 9934242302**) on any working day.
4. The bidders intending to participate in e-auction are required to register themselves on the portal CPWD e-Auction (<https://eauction.cpwd.gov.in>) by making online payment of annual fee of Rs.1,000/- (Rupees one thousand only) + Service Tax or as demanded by registration authority. If desired, they can be imparted training for online bidding process as per details available on the portal.
5. The bidders will deposit earnest money of Rs **2,582/-** in the form of demand draft or pay order or banker's cheque drawn in favour of the **Executive Engineer, Parliament Complex Civil Works Division, CPWD, New Delhi**. The earnest money shall be deposited either in the office of **Executive Engineer, Parliament Complex Civil Works Division, CPWD, New Delhi** or division office of any Executive Engineer of CPWD within the stipulated date and time. The place of issue of earnest money instrument shall be the same where the receiving division office is situated. The officer receiving earnest money shall issue a receipt to the bidder in the format given on Page-05. Earnest money shall be returned to the unsuccessful bidders on completion of e-auction.

6. To make online request to allow participation in a particular e-auction, the registered bidders are required to login to CPWD e-Auction (<https://eauction.cpwd.gov.in>) and upload earnest money instrument, receipt of earnest money deposited and other documents either in JPG or PDF format within the time specified in the e-auction notice. The applicants can upload a single file of size of 5 MB only but can upload multiple files.
7. **List of mandatory Documents to be uploaded while requesting to allow participation in e-auction to given below :-**
 1. Earnest money instrument
 2. Receipt of deposition of earnest money.
 3. Copy of PAN Card.
 4. Proof of address.
 5. E-mail address and Contact No.
 6. GST Registration Certificate.
8. Only those bidders will be authorized to participate in the auctions who have submitted complete documents and earnest money. The bidders are requested to login to CPWD e-Auction (<https://eauction.cpwd.gov.in>) to participate in the auction. During e-auction process, highest bid at any instant will be displayed. The bidders can modify bids accordingly any number of times.
9. The highest bidder (H1 Bidder) will be required to deposit bid security @ 25% of his bid money through Online in Non-Tax Receipt Portal through bhartkosh.gov.in in favour of the **Executive Engineer, Parliament Complex Civil Works Division, CPWD, New Delhi** (DDO ID : 143242 and PAO Code : 043144) (office mentioned in Bharatkosh portal as PCCWD) within two working day of closing of e-auction. The highest bidder shall also inform their e-mail address to the **Executive Engineer, Parliament Complex Civil Works Division, CPWD, New Delhi** for conveying acceptance of the bid. Balance bid amount (75% of bid amount) of the sale value shall also be submitted through online in Non-Tax Receipt Portal through bhartkosh.gov.in by highest bidder to the Executive Engineer Parliament Complex Civil Works Division, CPWD, Parliament Library Building, New Delhi (DDO ID:- 143242 and PAO Code : 043144) within 07 days of issue of acceptance letter e-mailed on the address given by highest bidder and also sent by speed post.
10. In case of bidder's failure to deposit the bid security @25% of his bid money within the prescribed time, his earnest money shall stand forfeited. In case of failure to deposit the balance of the sale value within the time prescribed in para-9 above, the earnest money and bid security @25% of his bid money shall be forfeited. The defaulting bidder shall be debarred from participating in re-auction.
11. The auctioned materials must be removed within 03 working days from the date of payment of balance sale value, either in the presence of successful bidder or an agent duly authorized by him in writing in this behalf. He will leave the storage place of the materials neat and clean.
12. If the successful bidder fails to remove the materials within 03 working days as specified above, the balance materials lying at the site will be confiscated by the office of the **Executive Engineer, Parliament Complex Civil Works Division, CPWD, New Delhi**.

13. The successful bidder would acquire lien on the auctioned materials after the payment of full bid money, and he will be responsible for any damage by way of pilferage, fire, or any natural calamity and no claim on this account shall be entertained.
14. The highest bid can be rejected without assigning any reason by the competent authority.
15. Any changes in above schedule will be notified only on CPWD e-auction website (<https://eauction.cpwd.gov.in>).
16. Any Tax /Duties as required by Law shall be payable extra by the purchaser, Same should be included in their offer.
17. The materials must be removed in the presence of the **Assistant Engineer-I and III Parliament Complex Civil Works Division, CPWD, New Delhi** or his authorized representative and weightment of empty and loaded truck shall be done in his presence if required.
18. No Claim for labour charges for collecting and stacking at a place will be entertained.
19. The highest bidder will have to pay all taxes if any leviable on the materials after acceptance of bid.
20. The bidder shall have to abide by the timing of the CPWD office.

Technical Terms and Conditions of Online e-auction

1. Prospective bidders shall ensure this process before participation in e-auction.
2. Participants have to get themselves registered on the e-auction portal i.e. CPWD e-Auction (<https://eauction.cpwd.gov.in>).
3. The User ID issued by the online service provider will be activated permitting the bidder to enter into the website of the service provider for bidding.
4. Bidders should not disclose their User ID as well as password and other material information relating to the bidding to any one and to safeguard its secrecy.
5. Bidders are advised to change the password immediately on receipt from the e-auctioning portal.
6. **Time Extension:** If any market leading bid (bid higher than the highest at the point in time) is received within the last five minutes of closing time, the time of auction sale will get automatically extended by another five minutes and subsequently, if no further bid higher than the last quoted highest bid is received within the said extended five minutes, the auction sale will be automatically closed at the expiry of the extended five minutes.
7. **Bids:** Once the bid is placed, the bidder cannot reduce or withdraw the bid for whatever reason. If done so, the EMD amount shall be forfeited.
8. The bidders are required to quote for the rate with reference to the scrap as per Annexure-I put on e-auction over and above the reserve price mentioned in the Annexure. E-auction will start and end as per schedule mentioned in offer document. The bid for e-auction shall start with minimum one increment above the reserve sale rate. Minimum increment of bid in e-auction for rate shall be Rs. 1000/- entity or multiple thereof. The reserve price as mentioned in the document may not be treated as final price.
9. The bidder shall be solely responsible for all consequences arising out of the bid submitted by him (including any wrongful bidding) and no complaint/ representation will be entertained in this regard by the CPWD/Service provider Hence bidders are cautioned to be careful to check the bid amount and alter/rectify their bid if required before confirming the bid submitted.

Note of caution for the Bidders:

- i) Bidders may encounter certain unforeseen problems such as time lag, heavy traffic, and system/power failure at the Bidders end. To avoid losing out on bidding because of abovementioned reasons, it is advised to have reliable internet connection and ICT equipment and not to wait for the last moment for submitting your bid.
- ii) The Bidder is expected to carefully examine all the instructions, guidelines, terms and conditions and formats of the E-Auction. Failure to furnish all the necessary information as required or submission of a proposal not substantially responsive to all the requirements of the E-Auction shall be at Bidder's own risk and may be liable for rejection.
