6. Those contractors not registered on the website mentioned above, are required to get registered before and. If needed they can be imparted training on online bidding process as per details available on the website.
7. The intending bidder must have valid class-III digital signature to submit the bid.
8. On opening date, the contractor can login and see the bid opening process. After opening of bids he will receive the competitor bid sheets.
9. Contractor can upload documents in the form of JPG format and PDF format.
10. Contractor must ensure to quote percentage rate of works component as given in template. The column meant for quoting percentage rate in figures appears in pink colour and the moment rate is entered, it turns sky blue.
11. In addition to this, while selecting any of the cells a warning appears that if any cell is left blank the same shall be treated as "0". Therefore, if any cell is left blank and no rate is quoted by the bidder, rate of such item shall be treated as "0" (ZERO). However, if tenderer does not quote any percentage above or below on the total amount of the tender or any section / sub head in percentage tender, the tender shall be treated as invalid and not consider lowest tender.

9. Earnest Money in the form of Insurance surety Bonds, Account Payee Demand Draft, Fixed Deposit Receipt, Banker's Cheque or Bank guarantee including e-Bank Guarantee (for balance amount as prescribed) from any of the Commercial Banks (drawn in favour of **Executive Engineer(E), Agartala Central Electrical Division (ACED), CPWD, Agartala.**) shall be scanned and uploaded to the e-tendering website within the period of bid submission. 11. The contractor whose bid is accepted, will be required to furnish performance guarantee at specified percentage of the tendered amount as mentioned in Schedule 'E' and within the period specified in Schedule F. This guarantee shall be in the form of Insurance Surety Bonds, Account Payee Demand Draft, Fixed Deposit Receipt or Bank Guarantee from any of the Commercial Banks in accordance with the prescribed form. In case the contractor fails to deposit the said performance guarantee within the period as indicated in Schedule 'F', including the extended period if any, then Earnest Money deposited by the contractor shall be forfeited automatically without any notice to the contractor. The Earnest Money deposited along with the bid shall be returned after receiving the aforesaid Performance Guarantee. The Contractor **whose bid is accepted will also be required to furnish either copy of applicable licenses/registrations or proof of applying for obtaining labour licenses, registration with EPFO, ESIC and BOCW Welfare Board including Provident Fund Code No. if applicable and also ensure the compliance of aforesaid provisions by the sub-contractors, if any engaged by the contractor for the said work within the period specified in Schedule F.**

12. The description of work is as follows:

Intending bidders are advised to inspect and examine the site and its surroundings and satisfy themselves before submitting their bids as to the nature of the ground and sub-soil (so far as is practicable), the form and nature of the site, the means of access to the site, the accommodation they may require and in general shall themselves obtain all necessary information as to risks, contingencies and other circumstances which may influence or affect their bid. A bidders shall be deemed to have full knowledge of the site whether he inspects it or not and no extra charge consequent on any misunderstanding or otherwise shall be allowed. The bidders shall be responsible for arranging and maintaining at his own cost all materials, tools & plants, water, electricity access, facilities for workers and all other services required for executing the work unless otherwise specifically provided for in the contract documents. Submission of a bid by a bidders implies that he has read this notice and all other contract documents and has made himself aware of the scope and specifications of the work to be done and of conditions and rates at which stores, tools and plant, etc. will be issued to him by the Government and local conditions and other factors having a bearing on the execution of the work.

13. The competent authority on behalf of the President of India does not bind itself to accept the lowest or any other bid and reserves to itself the authority to reject any or all the bids received without the assignment of any reason. All bids in which any of the prescribed condition is not fulfilled or any condition including that of conditional rebate is put forth by the bidders shall be summarily rejected.
14. Canvassing whether directly or indirectly, in connection with bidders is strictly prohibited and the bids submitted by the contractors who resort to canvassing will be liable to rejection.
15. The competent authority on behalf of President of India reserves to himself the right of accepting the whole or any part of the bid and the bidders shall be bound to perform the same at the rate quoted.
16. The contractor shall not be permitted to bid for works in the CPWD Circle (Division in case of contractors of Horticulture/Nursery category) responsible for award and execution of contracts, in which his near relative is posted a Divisional Accountant or as an officer in any capacity between the grades of Superintending Engineer to Junior Engineer (both inclusive). He shall also intimate the names of persons who are working with him in any capacity or are

subsequently employed by him and who are near relatives to any gazette officer in the Central Public Works Department or in the Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs. Any breach of this condition by the contractor would render him liable to be removed from the approved list of contractors of this Department.

17. No Engineer of Gazetted Rank or other Gazetted Officer employed in Engineering or Administrative duties in an Engineering Department of the Government of India is allowed to work as a contractor for a period of one year after his retirement from Government service, without the prior permission of the Government of India in writing. This contract is liable to be cancelled if either the contractor or any of his employees is found any time to be such a person who had not obtained the permission of the Government of India as aforesaid before submission of the bid or engagement in the contractor's service.
18. The bids for the work shall remain open for acceptance for a **period of 30 (thirty) Days from the date of opening of bids in case of single bid system and 75 (seventy-five) days from the date of opening of technical bids in case bids are invited in 2 or 3 bid system.**
Further.
 - (i) If any tenderer withdraws his tender or makes any modification in the terms & conditions of the tender which is not acceptable to the department within 7 days after last date of submission of bids, then the Government shall without prejudice to any other right or remedy be at liberty to forfeit 50% of the earnest money absolutely irrespective of letter of acceptance for the work is issued or not.
