

Zoo Animals. It is the sole responsibility of the contractor in case of any mis-happening or harm to Zoo Animals by his workers.

- 37) The contractor shall keep the site neat & clean during execution of the work and cover the building materials with cloths. In case of any mis-happening with visitors or animals due to scattered materials / malba at his site the contractor shall be held responsible for the same.
- 38) In case of any fine imposed by Zoo authorities due to scattered malba / building materials or any harm to Zoo animals due to malba / materials or by worker of the contractor the same shall be paid by contractor within prescribed period otherwise same shall be recovered from the bills or securities / performance guarantee of the contractor.

List of Documents to be scanned and uploaded within the period of tender submission

- 1) Insurance Surety Bond, Demand Draft/ Account Payee Banker's Cheque / FDR/ Bank Guarantee of any commercial Bank against EMD.
- 2) Receipt of deposit of EMD in any divisions of CPWD/CCU, MoEF&CC
- 3) Enlistment Order of the Contractor in appropriate class and category in CPWD.
- 4) ESI & EPF certificate of the contractor.
- 5) PAN Card issued by Income Tax Department.
- 6) GST Registration Certificate, if already obtained by the bidder.

If the bidder has not obtained GST registration as applicable, then he shall scan and upload following under taking along with bid documents.

"If work is awarded to me, I/we shall obtain GST registration certificate, as applicable, within one month from the date of receipt of award letter or before release of any payment by CPWD, whichever is earlier, failing which I/we shall be responsible for any delay in payments which will be due towards me/us on account of the work executed and/or for any action taken by CPWD or GST department in this regard".

- 7) Any other Document as specified in the NIT.
