Note: The contractor shall quote his percentage rates including GST and any other applicable taxes, levy or Cess etc. and nothing extra shall be reimbursed on this account. This provision will supersede all the provisions in GCC and elsewhere in the tender document in regard to Levy/Taxes payable by contractor.

- The intending bidder must read the terms and conditions of CPWD-6 carefully. He should only submit his bid if he considers himself eligible and he is in possession of all the documents required.
- Information and Instructions for bidders posted on website shall form part of bid document.
- The bid document consisting of plans, specifications, the schedule of quantities of various types of items to be executed and the set of terms and conditions of the contract to be complied with and other necessary documents can be seen and downloaded from website <https://etender.cpwd.gov.in> or www.cpwd.gov.in , **free of cost.**
- Those contractors who are not registered or have not uploaded their profile on the website mentioned above, are required to get registered/ update their profile beforehand. The necessary training material including the videos with step to step process are available on download section of <https://etender.cpwd.gov.in>.
- But the bid can only be submitted after deposition of original EMD either in the office of Executive Engineer inviting bids or division office of any Executive Engineer CPWD with in the period of bid submission and uploading the mandatory scanned documents such as **Insurance Surety Bonds, Account Payee Demand draft or Bankers Cheque or Fixed Deposit**

Receipts or/and Bank Guarantee (**for balance amount as prescribed**) from any of the **commercial** Bank towards EMD in favour of Executive Engineer as mentioned in NIT, receipt of deposition of original EMD to division office of any Executive Engineer (including NIT issuing EE/AE), CPWD and other documents as specified.

6. The intending bidder must have valid class-III digital signature certificate with encryption key (combo type) to perform any operations/transactions on the e-tendering portal/website and the bidder should download and install the eMsigner on their system as per instructions available on download section of <https://etender.cpwd.gov.in>.
7. On opening date, the contractor can login and see the bid opening process. After opening of bids he will receive the competitor bid sheets.
8. Contractor can upload documents in the form of **JPG** format and **PDF** format.
9. It is mandatory to upload scanned copies of all the documents stipulated in the bid documents. If the documents stipulated in the bid documents are not uploaded, then bid will become invalid and shall summarily be rejected.
10. Contractor must ensure to quote rate in the prescribed column(s). The column(s) meant for quoting rate in figures appears in **yellow** colour and the moment rate is entered, it turns sky blue.

In addition to this, while selecting any of the cells a warning appears that if any cell is left blank the same shall be treated as “0”. Therefore, if any cell is left blank and no rate is quoted by the bidder, rate of such item shall be treated as “0” (ZERO).

However, If a tenderer quotes nil rates against each item in item rate tender or does not quote any percentage above/below on the total amount of the tender or any section / sub head in percentage rate tender, the tender shall be treated as invalid and will not be considered as lowest tenderer.

11. The department reserves the right to reject any or all bids without assigning any reason thereof and may restrict the list of qualified bidders to any number deemed suitable by it, if too many bids are received satisfying the minimum laid down criteria.
12. After submission of the bid, the bidder can re-submit revised bid any number of times but before last date and time of submission of bid as notified. While submitting the revised bid, bidder can revise the quoted rates of one or more items any number of times but before last date and time of submission of bid as notified.
13. This work is to be carried out in existing campus. The contractor must ensure that there will be no problem to the client of existing campus for running their activities.
14. The tenderer should also read the General Conditions of Contract 2023 for Maintenance Works corrected upto previous day of the last date of submission of the tender.
15. Tenders with any condition including that of conditional rebates in the tender document shall be rejected forthwith.
16. The contractor shall have to execute guarantee bonds in respect of water supply and sanitary installation works, water proofing and bituminous works.
17. GST and all other taxes/levies on materials as applicable shall be paid by the contractor himself. The contractor shall quote his rates considering all such taxes.
18. All test registers and material at site register shall be maintained by the contractor which will be reviewed by the officers of CPWD at regular intervals The material shall be tested as per frequency given in CPWD specifications/Relevant IS Code for the respective items.
19. Recording the hindrance on the part of contractor in the hindrance register is mandatory which shall be reviewed in Division office at each running account bill. The net delay shall be worked out after taking into cognizance of hindrances on part of department and contractor both.

20. In e-tendering, the intending bidder does not sign any document physically and entire bid document is submitted through digital signature.
21. Intending bidders may upload and submit milestones on the basis of their resources and methodology at the time of tendering as indicated in the table under clause 5 of “Schedule-F” otherwise it will be assumed that the bidder is agreeable to milestones mentioned in table.
22. **The agency shall follow the standard operating procedures and guidelines scrupulously at the construction site to contain the outbreak of COVID-19. it is the sole responsibility of the agency to adhere to the SoPs issued by CPWD and other orders & Guidelines issued by Various Governments (Govt. of India and/or state Govt. and/or Dist. Administration or Local Govt. The quoted rates shall inclusive of all such required measures and materials like Soaps, Detergents, Sanitizers, Disinfectants, Masks, Gloves and other personal protection equipment’s to contain COVID-19 and nothing extra shall be paid.**
23. **In case any Extra item is to be paid for which Analysis of rate is prepared by the department on the basis of all basic rates of item and labour and their respective coefficients which are available in DAR/DSR (which have been incorporated in NIT), then the item so prepared shall be treated as DSR item only and the rate for such extra item shall be paid as per the said Schedule rate enhanced or reduced by the applicable cost index and multiplied by (Contract amount divided by estimated cost put to tender). All other extra items shall be paid as per procedure mentioned in OM No. DG/CON/Maintenance 2023/07 dated 05.03.2024 issued by CPWD Directorate.**
24. In case of **non-enlisted contractor** being first lowest in any of the tender then either contractor himself or his authorized representative shall take compulsory ERP training through any of the CPWD Regional Training Institutes (RTIs) at Delhi, Mumbai, Chennai and Kolkata, National CPWD Academy (NCA) Ghaziabad, Training arranged by Graduates of ERP “Train the Trainers Programme” conducted by NCA, Ghaziabad or through any other special training arranged by ERP unit of CPWD within two months from the date of issue of Intent letter. Training will be valid only when non enlisted contractor is registered in LMS of ERP and certificate is issued through LMS of ERP. Failure to do so, a recovery of Rs. 10,000/- per week shall be made from the R/A bill without giving any show cause notice in this regard.

1. The Assistant Engineer- III, Construction Division-XIV, CPWD, East Block-4, Level-2, R.K. Puram, New Delhi-110066 (Tel No. 26162087/26181713, Email: deleecd14.cpwd@nic.in) invites on behalf of the President of India invites online **percentage rate bid** from approved and eligible contractor of CPWD/ authorized travel agent for the following work:

Construction of 40 Nos. Type-II Quarters including demolition of 32 Nos. SPS structure at NSG, Samalkha, New Delhi. (SH: Providing services of commercial inspection vehicle on hire basis for the O/o AE-III, CD-XIV, R.K. Puram, New Delhi).

The enlistment of the contractors should be valid on the last date of submission of bids.

In case the last date of submission of bid is extended, the enlistment of contractor should be valid on either of the two dates i.e. the original date of submission of bids or extended date of submission of bids.

- 1.1 The work is estimated to cost **Rs. 2,97,365/-**. This estimate, however, is given merely as a rough guide.
- 1.2 Approved CPWD enlisted contractors in appropriate class/ authorized travel agent shall be eligible for bid.
- 2 Agreement shall be drawn with the successful bidder on prescribed Form No. CPWD 7 which is available as a Govt. of India Publication and also available on web site <https://etender.cpwd.gov.in> or www.cpwd.gov.in Bidder shall quote their rates as per various terms and conditions of the said form which will form part of the agreement.
- 3 The time allowed for carrying out the work will be **06 Months** from the date of start as defined in schedule 'F' or from the first date of handing over of the site, whichever is later, in accordance with the phasing, if any, indicated in the tender documents.
- 4 (i) The site for the work will be made available.
Accordingly, intending bidders are advised to inspect and examine the site and its surroundings and satisfy themselves before submitting their bids as to the nature of the ground and sub-soil, the form and nature of the site, the means of access to the site, the accommodation they may require and in general shall themselves obtain all necessary information as to risks, contingencies and other circumstances which may influence or affect their bid. A bidder shall be deemed to have full knowledge of the site whether he inspects it or not and no extra claims/payments consequent on any misunderstanding or otherwise shall be allowed. The bidders shall be responsible for arranging and maintaining at his own cost all materials, tools & plants, water, electricity, access, facilities for workers and all other services required for executing the work unless otherwise specifically provided for in the contract documents. Submission of bid implies that he has read this notice and all other contract documents and has made himself aware of the scope and specifications of the work to be done and local conditions and other factors having a bearing on the execution of the work.
- 5 The bid document consisting of plans, specifications, the schedule of quantities of various types of items to be executed and the set of terms and conditions of the contract to be complied with and other necessary documents except Standard General Conditions of

Contract Form can be seen on website <https://etender.cpwd.gov.in> or www.cpwd.gov.in free of cost.

- 6 After submission of the bid the contractor can resubmit revised bid any number of times but before last time and date of submission of tender as notified.
- 7 While submitting the revised bid, contractor can revise the rate of one or more item(s) any number of times. (He need not re-enter rate of all the items) but before last time and date of submission of tender as notified.
- 8 **Earnest Money Deposit/Bid Security:-**
Earnest Money in the form of **Insurance Surety Bonds, Account Payee Demand draft, Fixed Deposit Receipts, Banker's Cheque or Bank Guarantee (as prescribed)** issued by a **commercial Bank (drawn in favour of Executive Engineer, DAD, CPWD, R.K. Puram, New Delhi)** shall be scanned and uploaded to the eTendering website within the period of bid submission.
- 9 The original EMD shall be deposited either in the office of Executive Engineer inviting bids or Division office of any Executive Engineer, CPWD within period of bid submission. The EMD receiving Executive Engineer (including NIT issuing EE/AE) shall issue a receipt of deposition of earnest money deposit to the bidder in a prescribed format (**Form-A**) uploaded by the tender inviting AE/EE in the NIT.)
This receipt shall also be uploaded to the e- tendering website by the intending bidder up to the specified bid submission date and time.
A part of earnest money is acceptable in the form of bank guarantee also. In such case, minimum 50% of earnest money or Rs. 20 lac, whichever is less, shall have to be deposited in shape prescribed above, and balance may be deposited in shape of Bank Guarantee of any scheduled bank having validity for Six months or more from the last date of receipt of bids which is to be scanned and uploaded by the intending bidders.
- 10 Copy of Enlistment order and other documents as specified in the press notice shall be scanned and uploaded to the e-tendering website within the period of bid submission. (If applicable) However, certified copies of all the scanned and uploaded documents as specified in press notice shall have to be submitted by the lowest bidder only within a week physically in the office of tender opening authority. Online bid documents submitted by intending bidders shall be opened only of those bidders, whose documents scanned and uploaded are found in order.
- 11 The bid submitted shall be opened at 3:30 P.M. on 31.07.2026.
- 12 The bid submitted shall become invalid if:
 - (i) The bidder is found ineligible.
 - (ii) The bidder does not upload scanned copies of all the documents stipulated in the bid document.
 - (iii) If any discrepancy is noticed between the documents as uploaded at the time of submission of bid and hard copies as submitted physically by the lowest tenderer in the office of tender opening authority.
 - (iv) If a bidder quotes nil rates against each item in the item rate tender or does not quote any percentage above/below on the total amount of the tender or any section/Sub head in percentage rate tender, the tender shall be treated as invalid and will not be considered as the lowest tenderer.

- 13 The contractor whose bid is accepted, will be required to furnish performance guarantee of 5% (Five Percent) of the bid amount within the period specified in Schedule F. This guarantee shall be in the form of cash (in case guarantee amount is less than Rs.10,000/-) or deposit at Call receipt of any scheduled bank/Banker's cheque of any scheduled bank/Demand Draft of any scheduled bank/Pay order of any Scheduled Bank (in case guarantee amount is less than Rs. 1,00,000/-) or Government Securities or Fixed Deposit Receipts or Guarantee Bonds of any Scheduled Bank or the State Bank of India in accordance with the prescribed form.

In case, the contractor fails to deposit the said performance guarantee within the period as indicated in Schedule 'F', including the extended period, if any, the Earnest Money deposited by the contractor shall be forfeited automatically without any notice to the contractor. The earnest money deposited along with bid shall be returned after receiving the aforesaid performance guarantee.

- 14 The contractor whose bid is accepted will also be required to furnish either copy of applicable licenses/registration or proof of applying for obtaining labour licenses, registration with EPFO, ESIC and BOCW welfare board including Provident Fund Code No. if applicable and also ensure the compliance of aforesaid provisions by the sub-contractors, if any, engaged by the by the contractor for the said work and programme Chart (Time and Progress) within the period specified in schedule 'F'.
- 15 The description of the work is as follows:

Intending Bidders are advised to inspect and examine the site and its surroundings and satisfy themselves before submitting their bids as to the nature of the ground and sub-soil (so far as is practicable), the form and nature of the site, the means of access to the site, the accommodation they may require and in general shall themselves obtain all necessary information as to risks, contingencies and other circumstances which may influence or affect their tender. A bidders shall be deemed to have full knowledge of the site whether he inspects it or not and no extra charge consequent on any misunderstanding or otherwise shall be allowed. The bidders shall be responsible for arranging and maintaining at his own cost all materials, tools & plants, water, electricity access, facilities for workers and all other services required for executing the work unless otherwise specifically provided for in the contract documents. Submission of a bid by a bidders implies that he has read this notice and all other contract documents and has made himself aware of the scope and specifications of the work to be done and of conditions and rates at which stores, tools and plant, etc. will be issued to him by the Government and local conditions and other factors having a bearing on the execution of the work.

- 16 The competent authority on behalf of the President of India does not bind itself to accept the lowest or any other bid and reserves to itself the authority to reject any or all the bids received without the assignment of any reason. All bids in which any of the prescribed condition is not fulfilled or any condition including that of conditional rebate is put forth by the tenderer shall be summarily rejected.
- 17 Canvassing whether directly or indirectly, in connection with bidders is strictly prohibited and the bids submitted by the contractors who resort to canvassing will be liable to rejection.

- 18 The competent authority on behalf of President of India reserves to himself the right of accepting the whole or any part of the tender and the bidders shall be bound to perform the same at the rate quoted.
- 19 The contractor shall not be permitted to bid for works in the CPWD Circle (Division in case of contractors of Horticulture/Nursery category) responsible for award and execution of contracts, in which his near relative is posted a Divisional Accountant or as an officer in any capacity between the grades of Superintending Engineer and Junior Engineer (both inclusive). He shall also intimate the names of persons who are working with him in any capacity or are subsequently employed by him and who are near relatives to any gazetted officer in the Central Public Works Department or in the Ministry of Urban Development. Any breach of this condition by the contractor would render him liable to be removed from the approved list of contractors of this Department.
- 20 No Engineer of gazetted rank or other Gazetted Officer employed in Engineering or Administrative duties in an Engineering Department of the Government of India is allowed to work as a contractor for a period of one year after his retirement from Government service, without the previous permission of the Government of India in writing. This contract is liable to be cancelled if either the contractor or any of his employees is found any time to be such a person who had not obtained the permission of the Government of India as aforesaid before submission of the tender or engagement in the contractor's service.
- 21 (i) The bids for the works shall remain open for acceptance for a period of **Thirty (30) days** from the date of opening of bids. If any tenderer withdraws his tender or makes any modification in the terms and conditions of the tender which is not acceptable to the department within 7 days after last date of submission of bids, then the Government shall, without prejudice to any other right or remedy be at the liberty to forfeit 50% of the earnest money absolutely irrespective of letter of acceptance for the work issued or not.
(ii) If any tenderer withdraws his tender or makes any modification in the terms and conditions of the tender which is not acceptable to the department after expiry of 7 days after last date of submission of bids, then the Government shall, without prejudice to any other right or remedy be at the liberty to forfeit 100% of the earnest money absolutely irrespective of letter of acceptance for the work issued or not.
(iii) In case of forfeiture of earnest money as prescribed in para (i) and (ii) above, the bidders shall not be allowed to participate in the rebidding process of the same work.
- 22 This notice inviting Bid shall form a part of the contract document. The successful bidders/contractor, on acceptance of his bid by the Accepting Authority shall within 15 days from the stipulated date of start of the work, sign the contract consisting of:-
(a) The Notice Inviting Bid, all the documents including additional conditions, specifications and drawings, if any, forming part of the bid as uploaded at the time of invitation of bid and the rates quoted online at the time of submission of bid and acceptance thereof together with any correspondence leading thereto.
(b) Standard C.P.W.D. Form 7 amended up to last date of submission of bids.
- 23 **For Composite Bids:**
- 23.1 The Assistant Engineer- III, Construction Division – XIV, CPWD, in charge of the major component will call bids for the composite work. The bid document and Earnest Money will be fixed with respect to the combined estimated cost put to tender for the combined bid.
- 23.2 The bid document will include following three components:

Part A:- CPWD-6, CPWD-7 including schedule A to F for the major component of the work, Standard CPWD General Conditions of Contract 2020 for Maintenance Works as amended / modified upto last date of submission of tender.

Part B:- General / specific conditions, specifications and schedule of quantities applicable to major component of the work.

Part C:- Schedule A to F for minor component of the work. (Competent authority under clause 2 and clause 5 shall be same authority as mentioned in schedule A to F for major components). General/specific conditions, specifications and schedule of quantities applicable to minor component(s) of the work.

- 23.3 The bidders must associate himself, with agencies as per NIT conditions.
- 23.4 The eligible bidders shall quote rates for all items of major component as well as for all items of minor components of work.
- 23.5 After acceptance of the bid by competent authority, the Assistant Engineer in charge of major component of the work shall issue letter of award on behalf of the President of India. After the work is awarded, the main contractor will have to enter into one agreement with Assistant Engineer in charge of major component and has also to sign two or more copies of agreement depending upon number of EE/DDH in charge of minor components. One such signed set of agreement shall be handed over to EE/DDH in charge of minor component. Assistant Engineer of major component will operate part A and part B of the agreement. EE/ DDH in charge of minor component(s) shall operate Part C along with Part A of the agreement.
- 23.6 Entire work under the scope of composite bid including major and all minor components shall be executed under one agreement.
- 23.7 Security Deposit will be worked out separately for each component corresponding to the estimated cost of the respective component of works.
- 23.8 The main contractor has to associate agency(s) for specilized component(s) conforming to eligibility criteria as defined in the bid document and has to submit detail of such agency(s) to Engineer-in-charge of minor component(s) within prescribed time. Name of the agency(s) to be associated shall be approved by Engineer-in-charge of minor component(s).
- 23.9 In case the main contractor intends to change any of the above agency/agencies during the operation of the contract, he shall obtain prior approval of Engineer-in-charge of relevant specialized component(s). The new agency/agencies shall also have to satisfy the laid down eligibility criteria. In case Engineer-in-charge is not satisfied with the performance of any agency, he can direct the contractor to change the agency executing such items of work and this shall be binding on the contractor.
- 23.10 The main contractor has to enter into MoU with agency(s) associated by him for execution of minor component(s). Copy of such agreement shall be submitted to EE/DDH in charge of each relevent component as well as to Assistant Engineer in charge of major component. In case of change of associate contractor, the main agency has to enter into MoU/Agreement with the new contractor associated by him.
- 23.11 Running payment for the major component shall be made by Assistant Engineer of major discipline to the main contractor. Running payment for minor components shall be made by the Engineer-in-charge of the discipline of minor component directly to the main contractor.

- 23.11A The composite work shall be treated as complete when all the components of the work are complete. The completion certificate of the composite work shall be recorded by Engineer-in-charge of major component after record of completion certificate of all other components.
- 23.11B Final bill of whole work shall be finalized and paid by the Assistant Engineer of major component. Engineer(s) in charge of minor component(s) will prepare and pass the final bill for their component of work and pass on the same to the Assistant Engineer of major component for including in the final bill for composite contract.
24. The Contractor shall be deemed to have satisfied himself before tendering as to the correctness and sufficiency of his tender for the works and of the rates and prices quoted in the schedule of Quantities, which rates and prices shall, except as otherwise provided, cover all his obligations under the Contract and all matters and things necessary for the proper completion and maintenance of the works.
