- a) Experience of having successfully completed similar works during the last 7 years ending last day of the month previous to the one in which tenders are invited. (Applicable for CPWD enlisted as well as Non-CPWD contractor).
- (i) One similar completed works each of value not less than 80% of the Estimated cost put to tender (ECPT)
- OR**
- (ii) Two similar completed works each of value not less than 60% of the Estimated cost put to tender (ECPT)

- (iii) Three similar completed works each of value not less than 40% of the Estimated cost put to tender (ECPT)

Similar Works means: - “Supplying, Installation Testing & Commissioning of Audio System”

The value of executed works shall be brought to current costing level by enhancing the actual value of work at simple rate of 7% per annum; calculated from the date of completion to the last date of submission of tenders. Qualified similar work may be physically inspected by CPWD to ascertain the completion, performance on quality of works for finalizing the Eligibility in Eligibility Bid.

- b) **Certificate of Financial Turn over:** Should have had Average Annual Financial Turnover of Rs. **46.07** Lakh (30% of Estimated Cost) on construction works during the last three years ending 31st March 2026 (Scanned copy of Certificate from CA with Unique Document Identification Number (UDIN) to be uploaded). The value of annual turnover figures shall be brought to the current value by enhancing the actual turnover figures at simple rate of 7% per annum. (Note: There is no need to upload entire voluminous balance sheet)

- c) **Profit/Loss:** Should not have incurred any loss (profit after tax should be positive) in more than two years during the last five years ending 31st March 2026.
- d) Should have a **Banker's Certificate** from a commercial Bank for Rs. **61.43** Lakh (40% of the Estimated Cost) or **Net Worth certificate** issued by certified Chartered Accountant with Unique Document Identification Number (UDIN) of minimum 10 % amount of ECPT (Scanned copy of original to be uploaded).
- e) Should have bidding capacity equal to or more than the estimated cost of the work put to tender. The bidding capacity shall be worked out by the following formula:

$$\text{Bidding Capacity} = \{[A \times N \times 1.5] - B\}$$
Where,
A = Maximum turnover in construction works executed in any one year during the last seven years taking into account the completed as well as works in progress. The value of annual turnover shall be brought to current costing level by enhancing at a simple rate of 7% per annum.
N = Number of years prescribed for completion of work for which bids have been invited. The value of N shall be taken as 1 (one), where the completion period is less than one year.
M = Multiplier factor, the value of M may be taken as under :- **1.5 for the bids with estimated cost upto Rs. 1000 crore.**
B = Value of existing commitments of ongoing works during the period of execution of work for which bids have been invited.
- 2) The intending bidder must read the terms and conditions of **CPWD-6** carefully. He should only submit his bid if he considers himself eligible and he is in possession of all the documents required.
- 3) Information and Instructions for bidders posted on website shall form part of bid document.
- 4) The bid document consisting of plans, specifications, the schedule of quantities of various types of items to be executed and the set of terms and conditions of the contract to be complied with and other necessary documents can be seen and downloaded from website www.etender.cpwd.gov.in free of cost.

- 7) Those contractors not registered or have not updated their profile on the website mentioned above, are require to get registered/ update their profile beforehand. The necessary training materials including the videos with step-to-step process are available on download section of <https://etender.cpwd.gov.in>
- 8) The intending bidder must have valid class-III digital signature certificate with encryption key (combo type) to perform any operations/ transections on the e-tendering portal/ website and the bidder should download and install the em-Signer on their system as per instructions available on download section of <https://etender.cpwd.gov.in>.
- 9) On opening date, the contractor can login and see the bid opening process. After opening of bids, he will receive the competitor bid sheets.
- 10) Contractor can upload documents in the form of JPG format or PDF format.
- 11) Contractor must ensure to quote rate in percentage form. The column meant for quoting rate in % figures appear in yellow color and the moment rate is entered; it turns sky blue. In addition to this, while selecting any of the cells a warning appears that if any cell is left blank the same shall be treated as “0”. Therefore, if any cell is left blank and no rate is quoted by the bidder, rate of such item shall be treated as “0” (Zero).

- 1.2. All information called for in the enclosed forms should be furnished against the relevant columns in the forms. If for any reason, information is furnished on a separate sheet, this fact should be mentioned against the relevant column. Even if no information is to be provided in a column, a "nil" or "no such case" entry should be made in that column. If any particulars/query is not applicable in case of the bidder, it should be stated as "not applicable". The bidders are cautioned that not giving complete information called for in the application forms or not giving it in clear terms or making any change in the prescribed forms or deliberately suppressing the information may result in the bid being summarily disqualified. Bids made by telegram or e-mailed or telex and those received late will not be entertained.
- 1.3. References, information and certificates from the respective clients certifying suitability, technical knowledge or capability of the bidder should be signed by an officer not below the rank of Executive Engineer or equivalent.
- 1.4. The bidder may furnish any additional information, which he thinks is necessary to establish his capabilities to successfully complete the envisaged work. He is, however, advised not to furnish superfluous information. No information shall be entertained after submission of eligibility criteria document unless it is called for by the Employer.

2. Definitions:

- 2.1. In this document the following words and expressions have the meaning hereby assigned to them.
- 2.2. Employer: Means the President of India, acting through the Executive Engineer & SM (E), BPC, CPWD Bhopal or his successor thereof.
- 2.3. Bidder: Means the individual, proprietary firm, firm in partnership, limited company private or public or corporation.
- 2.4. "Year" means "Financial Year" unless stated otherwise

3. Method of application:

- 3.1. If the bidder is an individual, the application shall be signed by him above his full type written name and current address.
- 3.2. If the bidder is a proprietary firm, the application shall be signed by the proprietor above his full typewritten name and the full name of his firm with its current address.
- 3.3. If the bidder is a firm in partnership, the application shall be signed by all the partners of the firm above their full typewritten names and current addresses, or, alternatively, by a partner holding power of attorney for the firm. In the latter case a certified copy of the power of attorney should accompany the application. In both cases a certified copy of the partnership deed and current address of all the partners of the firm should accompany the application.
- 3.4. If the bidder is a limited company or a corporation, the application shall be signed by a duly authorized person holding power of attorney for signing the application accompanied by a copy of the power of attorney. The bidder should also furnish a copy of the Memorandum of Articles of Association duly attested by a Public Notary.

4. Final decision making authority:

SPECIAL CONDITIONS FOR ELECTRICAL WORKS FOR COMPOSITE TENDERS

1. The main agency shall have to submit credential of the proposed associated agencies for verification and approval of the department in Performa at Annexure I within 15 days of award of work. Consent letter of such selected agencies for association shall also be enclosed in the prescribed format (Annexure-II). Main agency may propose up to three names of eligible associates for the specific electrical component for individual E&M services within 15 days of award of work. Proposed agency must be registered in CPWD in appropriate class.
2. After obtaining concurrence of department for such association, the main agency shall finalize one associate for execution of the Electrical component of the work. The main contractor has to enter into agreement with the contractor associated by him for execution of the work. Copy of such agreement shall be submitted to EE (E) in charge of electrical component for approval by Engineer in-charge as well as to EE(E) in charge of major component. (As per Annexure - III)
3. All technical discussions shall be attended by the associate agency and the main agency. Commercial / Technical submissions for the individual electrical works shall be signed and submitted by the associate agency along with the main agency.
4. Price-bid for Audio System components shall be submitted by the main agency.
5. Award of work shall be made by the Engineer-in-charge of the major component to the main agency for complete work.
6. The main contractor shall be entirely responsible and answerable for all the works done by his associated electrical contractors regarding their quality, adherence to the laid down specification, terms and conditions, warranty/guarantee etc. and he shall be liable to bear any compensation that may be levied by the department under any of the clauses of the agreement.
7. The manufacturer's guarantee/warranty for all the electrical accessories shall be for minimum period as specified for the individual E&M services in the NIT from the date of taking over of the installation by the department. Necessary documents of handing / taking over of the installation will be duly signed by the three parties namely EE (E), the main contractor and the associate contractors. The main contractor will ensure that the maintenance during the guarantee period shall also be carried out by the associate contractors. One year/ as specified in the NIT guarantee is to be provided free of cost as per item in the schedule of quantity and specification thereof.
8. The main contractor shall also give necessary general power of attorney under the contract to the associated electrical contractors to enable him to receive instructions from electrical engineers of the department at site, sign the site order book, bills MBs for acceptance of measurement and receive stipulated materials etc.
9. The main contractor shall be responsible for coordinating the activities of all the works and will ensure progress of all works as per the laid down program. - a) SITC of Audio System installation of hardware equipment, Management Software & Licenses.
- b) Training of the Operators & Engineers in operation and routine maintenance.
- 1.1 The final acceptance shall be done by the department, to ensure the system meets requirements, standards and specifications asset out in these documents for satisfactory working of Audio Video & Stage Lighting. However, the department shall be free to get the material and installation inspected by the third party at its own cost and take action as per its recommendation. The observations so made shall be abided by the contractor and shall be binding upon him.
- 1.2 The contractor shall keep sufficient spare at the site after the completion of work till Warrantee period from the date of completion.
- 1.3 Operational Training shall be provided to at least two personnel nominated by the engineer-in-charge including trouble shooting raining for a minimum period of 7 days.
2. The contractor shall be fully responsible for the safe custody of the material issued or brought by him to site for doing the work.

12. Extent of work

16. Indemnity
