- 1.1 The work is estimated to cost **Rs. 3,28,704/-** This Estimate, however, is given merely as a rough guide.
- 1.1.1 The authority competent to approve NIT for the combined cost and belonging to the major discipline will consolidate NIT's for calling the bids. He will also nominate Division which will deal with all matters relating to the invitation of bids.

For composite bid, besides indicating the combined estimated cost put to bid, should clearly correspond to the combined estimated cost of different components put to bid.
- 1.2. Intending bidders is eligible to submit the bid provided he has definite proof from the appropriate authority, which shall be to the satisfaction of the competent authority, of having satisfactorily completed similar works of magnitude specified.

To become eligible for issue of bid, the bidders shall have to furnish an affidavit as under:-

I/We undertake and confirm that eligible similar works(s) has/have not been got executed through another contractor on back to back basis. Further that, if such a violation comes to the notice of Department, then I/we shall be debarred for bidding in CPWD in future forever. A bidders shall be deemed to have full knowledge of the site whether he inspects it or not and no extra charge consequent on any misunderstanding or otherwise shall be allowed. Any breach of this condition by the contractor would render him liable to be removed from the approved list of contractors of this Department.
16. No Engineer of Gazetted Rank or other Gazetted Officer employed in Engineering or Administrative duties in an Engineering Department of the Government of India is allowed to work as a contractor for a period of one year after his retirement from Government service, without the prior permission of the Government of India in writing. This contract is liable to be cancelled if either the contractor or any of his employees is found any time to be such a person who had not obtained the permission of the Government of India as aforesaid before submission of the bid or engagement in the contractor's service.

AND WHEREAS the Principal/Owner values full compliance with all relevant laws of the land, rules, regulations, economic use of resources and of fairness/transparency in its relation with its Bidder(s) and Contractor(s).

AND WHEREAS to meet the purpose aforesaid both the parties have agreed to enter into this Integrity Agreement (hereinafter referred to as "**Integrity Pact**" or "**Pact**"), the terms and conditions of which shall also be read as integral part and parcel of the Tender/Bid documents and Contract between the parties.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of mutual covenants contained in this Pact, the parties hereby agree as follows and this Pact witnesses as under:

Article 1: Commitment of the Principal/Owner

- 1) The Principal/Owner commits itself to take all measures necessary to prevent corruption and to observe the following principles:

- (a) No employee of the Principal/Owner, personally or through any of his/her family members, will in connection with the Tender, or the execution of the Contract, demand, take a promise for or accept, for self or third person, any material or immaterial benefit which the person is not legally entitled to.

The Principal/Owner will, in particular, before and during the Tender process, provide to all Bidder(s) the same information and will not provide to any Bidder(s) confidential / additional information through which the Bidder(s) could obtain an advantage in relation to the Tender process or the Contract execution.
 - (c) The Principal / Owner shall endeavor to exclude from the Tender process any person, whose conduct in the past has been of biased nature.

Article 2: Commitment of the Bidder(s)/Contractor(s)

The imposition and duration of the exclusion will be determined by the severity of transgression and determined by the Principal/Owner. Such exclusion may be forever or for a limited period as decided by the Principal/Owner.

- 1) The Bidder declares that no previous transgressions occurred in the last 5 years with any other Company in any country confirming to the anticorruption approach or with Central Government or State Government or any other Central/State Public Sector Enterprises in India that could justify his exclusion from the Tender process.
- 2) If the Bidder makes incorrect statement on this subject, he can be disqualified from the Tender process or action can be taken for banning of business dealings/ holiday listing of the Bidder/Contractor as deemed fit by the Principal/ Owner.

- 3) If the Bidder/Contractor can prove that he has resorted / recouped the damage caused by him and has installed a suitable corruption prevention system, the Principal/Owner may, at its own discretion, revoke the exclusion prematurely.

Article 5: Equal Treatment of all Bidders/Contractors/Subcontractors

- 1) The Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) undertake(s) to demand from all subcontractors a commitment in conformity with this Integrity Pact. The Bidder/Contractor shall be responsible for any violation(s) of the principles laid down in this agreement/Pact by any of its Subcontractors/sub-vendors.
- 2) The Principal/Owner will enter into Pacts on identical terms as this one with all Bidders and Contractors.
- 3) The Principal/Owner will disqualify Bidders, who do not submit, the duly signed Pact between the Principal/Owner and the bidder, along with the Tender or violate its provisions at any stage of the Tender process, from the Tender process.

Article 6- Duration of the Pact

This Pact begins when both the parties have legally signed it. It expires for the Contractor/Vendor 12 months after the completion of work under the contract or till the continuation of defect liability period, whichever is more and for all other bidders, till the Contract has been awarded.

If any claim is made/lodged during the time, the same shall be binding and continue to be valid despite the lapse of this Pacts as specified above, unless it is discharged/determined by the Competent Authority, CPWD.

Article 7- Other Provisions

- 1) This Pact is subject to Indian Law, place of performance and jurisdiction is the Head quarters of the Division of the Principal/Owner, who has floated the Tender.
- 2) Changes and supplements need to be made in writing. Side agreements have not been made.
- 3) If the Contractor is a partnership or a consortium, this Pact must be signed by all the partners or by one or more partner holding power of attorney signed by all partners and consortium members. In case of a Company, the Pact must be signed by a representative duly authorized by board resolution.
- 4) Should one or several provisions of this Pact turn out to be invalid; the remainder of this Pact remains valid. In this case, the parties will strive to come to an agreement to their original intentions.
- 5) It is agreed term and condition that any dispute or difference arising between the parties with regard to the terms of this Integrity Agreement / Pact, any action taken by the Owner/Principal in accordance with this Integrity Agreement/ Pact or interpretation thereof shall not be subject to arbitration.

Article 8- LEGAL AND PRIOR RIGHTS

All rights and remedies of the parties hereto shall be in addition to all the other legal rights and remedies belonging to such parties under the Contract and/or law and the same shall be deemed to be cumulative and not alternative to such legal rights and remedies aforesaid. For the sake of brevity, both the Parties agree that this Integrity Pact will have precedence over the Tender/Contact documents with regard any of the provisions covered under this Integrity Pact.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS

Scope of work: It is proposed to provide MOEI & Fans i/c RMO of Substation equipment , DG set, Water supply Pump set Lift, Fire alarm and fire fighting equipment, VRF type AC units , Streetlights etc at CMLRE Puthuvypin, Kochi during 2026-27. SH: Annual Comprehensive maintenance contract of 2 Nos 13 Passenger Lift and 02 Nos 08 Passenger Lifts (Make - JOHNSON LIFTS & ESCALATORS).

1 . GENERAL

The work shall be generally carried out in accordance with tender/bid specifications and the following specifications / rules.

- 1.1 . CPWD General Specifications for Electrical Works Part-I- Internal 2023, Part-II External 2023, General Specifications for Electrical works (Part-III – Lifts & Escalators) – 2003.with up-to-date amendments
- 1.2 . Commercial and Additional conditions for this work.
- 1.3 . The Indian Electricity Act, 2003, as amended up to date.
- 1.4 . CEA (Measures relating to Safety and Electric Supply) Regulations, 2023 as amended up-to date.

2 . COMMERCIAL CONDITIONS

- (a) Type of Contract: The work to be awarded by this tender shall be treated as indivisible works contract.
- (b) Income tax, GST, labour cess & other statutory deductions etc. shall be made at source as per the prevalent laws. The deductions of Security Deposit, Income-Tax etc. shall be done after calculation of the due payment and net payment shall be reduced accordingly.
- (c) RATES: The rates quoted by the tenderer, shall be firm and inclusive of all taxes (including GST, labour cess etc.).
- (d) The tenderer shall himself assess the requirements of materials, contingencies and other site specific constraints for execution of the work and that may affect the work and no extra charge attributed due to any misunderstanding or otherwise shall be allowed.

3 . COMPLETENESS OF TENDER

All sundry equipment, fittings, unit assemblies, accessories, hardware items, foundation bolts, termination lugs for electrical connections, and all other items which are necessary for efficient operation of the work unless specifically otherwise elsewhere in the document shall be deemed to have been included in the tender irrespective of the fact whether such items are specifically mentioned in the tender documents or not.

7.2. The extent of work pertaining to each item of work is detailed in the particular specifications for the respective item mentioned in this document and shall be invariably followed.

8. **INDEMNITY**

The successful tenderer shall at all times indemnify the department, consequent on this works contract. The successful tenderer shall be liable, in accordance with the Indian Law and Regulations for any accident occurring due to any cause and the contractor shall be responsible for any accident or damage incurred or claims arising therefrom during the period of erection, construction and putting into operation/maintenance of the equipment and ancillary equipment under the supervision of the successful tenderer. The successful tenderer shall also provide all insurance including third party insurance as may be necessary to cover the risk. No extra payment would be made to the successful tenderer on account of the above.

9. **TOOLS & TACKLES**

No tools and tackles would be made available by the department. The successful tenderer shall make his own arrangement for all these facilities.

10. **LOCATION**

The work is to be executed at proposed at **CMLRE, Puthuvype, Kochi**. The Contractor is advised to visit the site before submission of their tender and ensure that equipment being offered by them can be accommodated in the spaces available and for assessing the scope of work.

11 . CO-OPERATION WITH OTHER AGENCIES:

The successful tenderer shall co-ordinate with other contractors, agencies, user department and exchange freely so as to make the execution of contract a smooth one. No remuneration is claimable for such co-operation. If any unreasonable hindrance is caused in maintenance on this account, the loss of service on this account will be recovered from the contractor for that period on pro rata basis.

12 . SAFETY CODES & STATUTORY REGULATIONS

13.1 . Nothing in this specification shall be construed to relieve the successful tenderer of his responsibility for comprehensive maintenance of the equipment and its accessories in accordance with applicable statutory regulations and safety codes.

13.2 . Successful tenderer shall arrange for compliance with statutory provisions of safety regulations and safety codes in respect of labour employed on the work by the tenderer. Failure to provide such safety requirement would make the tenderer liable for penalty as per tender conditions. In addition, the department will be at liberty to make arrangement for the safety requirements at the cost of successful tenderer and recover the cost thereof from him.

13 . VERIFICATION OF CORRECTNESS OF EQUIPMENT AT DESTINATION

The contractor shall have to produce all the relevant records to certify that the genuine equipment from the manufacturers has been supplied and erected.

14 . QUALITY & GENUINENESS OF MATERIAL

Adequate care may be taken such that only tested and genuine materials of proper quality are used in work shall be ensured by firm.

- (a) The firm will be required to procure material directly from the manufacturer/ their authorised dealers to ensure genuineness & quality and as per the approved makes only. Proof in this regard shall be submitted by the contractor to the department, if so required.
- (b) Inspection at factory, as required, shall be arranged by the firm on a mutually agreed date, if stipulated. Department shall reserve the right to waive inspection in lieu of suitable test certificate, at its discretion.
- (c) All the materials to be supplied by the contractor shall be procured & brought to site as per requirement at site of work in consultation with department so that these materials are not damaged & their manufacturer's warranty is not getting void.

Nothing in this specification shall be construed to relieve the successful tenderer of his responsibility for the design, manufacture and installation of the equipment with all accessories in accordance with currently applicable statutory regulations and safety codes.

16 . POWER SUPPLY

The power supply for carrying out the work is available at site of work.

17 . WATER SUPPLY

The water supply for carrying out the work is available at site of work.

PARTICULAR SPECIFICATIONS

1. The firm has to depute trained maintenance staff / authorized person only for safe operation of lift.
2. The firm has to carry out monthly servicing adjustments, lubricants, repair or replacement of necessary parts and make entries accordingly in the maintenance schedule book of the lift kept with JE (E) in charge.
3. Monthly checking includes Door Assembly, Lift Car, Controller, ARD, Traction system etc. and Check Report should be submitted to the Engineer – In – Charge.
4. Breakdown calls to be attended free of cost when occurs.
5. Land line / Mobile Number of the technician to be displayed in the lift car / Door side in every floor.
6. The rates are inclusive of GST and other Taxes.
7. Responsibility for comprehensive maintenance of lift in sound condition except its daily operation shall be in scope of the contract.
8. The lift operator, Junior Engineer (E) and the Assistant Engineer (E) are the authorized officials of department for reporting the complaints either over telephone / in writing / in person and they are also authorized to sign service reports. However, gate pass for removal of any company materials from site shall require the signature of the JE(E) / AE(E) or persons authorized by them.
9. A log book shall be maintained and details of servicing as well as break down calls attended should be recorded in the log book with the date and time of complaint as well as date and time of attending / rectification, scheduled services carried out and this should be signed by the complainant as well as the representative of the contractor.
10. Genuine materials of **M/s. JOHNSON LIFTS & ESCALTORS** or third party vendors authorized by lift manufacturer should only be used in the work for service and repairs. The department reserves right to reject if it is found sub standard and does not conform to relevant standards.
11. **Scope of Work:**
 - (a) Renew all wire ropes and chains (where fitted) as often as required to maintain an adequate factor of safety to equalize the tension on all hoisting ropes, repair or replace conductor cables and hoist way and machine room elevator wiring.
 - (b) Examine periodically all safety devices and governors and make all customary safety tests.
 - (i) Machine, Worm Gear, Thrust Bearings, Drive Sheave, Drive Sheave Bearings, Break contract, Linings components.
 - (ii) Motor, Motor Generator, Motor Windings, rotating elements, Commutator, Brushes, Brush holders, Bearings, Coils, Resistance for operating and motor circuits, magnet frames and other mechanical parts.

(iii) Controller, Selector, Leveling, Devices, Cams, Relays, solid State components, e.g. PCB's, Transducers, Resistors, Condensers, Power amplifiers, Transformers, Contacts, Leads, Dashpots, timing Devices, Steel.

(iv) Selector tapes and mechanical and electrical driving equipment.

(v) Governor, governor sheave, shaft assembly, bearings, contacts and governor jaws.

(vi) Car and hall mechanical buttons, car and hall position indicators, hall lanterns, car direction indicators and all other car and landing signal fixtures as installed.

(vii) Deflector or secondary sheave, bearings, car and counterweight guide rails and buffers, top and bottom limit switches, governor tension sheave assembly, car counterweight guide shoes including rollers of gibs.

(viii) Interlocks on hoist way door, hoist way door hangers, guides, automatic power operated door operator, car door hanger, car contact, accessories safety shoes, load weighting equipment, car frame, car safety mechanism and platform will be furnished will be furnished by the firm on an exchange basis under which replaced parts become the property of firm.

(ix) In case of discontinue manufacture of any of the above mentioned items the firm will apprise the department for any modifications.

12. The firm will maintain current JOHNSON LIFTS & ESCLATORS engineering wiring diagram for the term of this agreement only. The firm will provide emergency minor adjustment Call Back service at no extra charge will be extended round the clock on all working days as well as holidays. However, any other repairs or service will be performed during normal working hours on normal working days. In case there is any extra requirement for deputing the staff on duty due to VVIP function the same will be paid extra.

13. The department will report details of unsatisfactory running or irregular performance of the equipment and will keep clean and in good condition those parts excluded from this agreement and will provide the machine room with adequate lighting, cooling, moisture control and or ventilation as may be required in the judgment of firm to assist its men in providing the work set out hereunder and in enhancing the effective operation of the equipment. The ambient temperature in the machine room should remain and will keep away from any areas enclosing mechanical or electrical equipment, persons other than firm's authorized employees.

14. The Department will provide the firm unrestricted ready access to all area of the building in which and any parts of the units are located and to keep all machine rooms and pit areas free from water, stored material and rubbish / debris.

If any unit is malfunctioning or in a dangerous condition, the department shall immediately notify the firm and until the firm rectifies the problem and to remove the unit from service and take all possible precautions to prevent its access or use.

15. The department agrees to display any publicity material relating to safety / use of equipment's and warnings to passengers in connection with the use of the elevators.

16. All the defects shall be resolved within 4 hours of informing the complaints by telephone calls. In case of major defects, the same shall be rectified most urgently within minimum required time.
17. Payment shall be made quarterly basis.
18. In case of failure to attend the complaint for more than 24 hours without reasonable cause, a prorata recovery @ Rs.1000/- per lift per day shall be made from the running account bills.
19. The firm has to maintain the lifts as per instructions of the Engineer-in-Charge or his authorized representative at site, for smooth running / operation of the lifts. The decision of the Engineer-in-Charge shall be binding and final.
20. The staff deputed by the firm shall have to abide by the security regulations of the building.
21. It shall be firm's sole responsibility to maintain the complete lifts system upto statutory safety regulations. Failure to do so, causing an accident, resulting in payment of liquidated damage; the same shall be borne by the firm.
22. Any minor addition / alteration or change of design required for smooth and efficient working of lifts as deemed necessary by the department, shall be carried out by the firm within the quoted cost.
23. Any minor civil work involved in day to day maintenance shall be carried out by the firm within the quoted cost. Any damage caused during day to day maintenance shall be made to good to original finish, free of cost by the firm.
24. The lifts have to work in the variable ambient conditions of the environment and at normal electric supply available at lift control room. Department does not guarantee towards any improvement of environmental or electric supply conditions.
25. The firm shall keep all the lifts operative all the times, however incase of repairs beyond reasonable control, the firm shall put the elevators in perfect serviceable conditions taking the minimum shutdown period, which will be intimated to the department at the time of such repair.
26. The firm shall be responsible for any damages due to any kind of accident, incase it occurs when maintenance or any repair work is being executed by it.
27. Contractor shall make his own arrangement for all the tools, tackles, measuring instruments and consumables required for the execution of the work.
28. The contractor shall examine the quantum of work and shall satisfy himself before submitting tender. He shall himself assess the requirements of materials, contingencies and other circumstances which may affect his tender. No extra charges on account of any misunderstanding or otherwise shall be allowed.
29. The Contractor shall be deemed to have satisfied before tendering, as to correctness and sufficiency of his tender, the work and prices. This shall except as otherwise provided, all obligation under the contracts and all matters and things necessary for the proper completion and maintenance of the works.

30. The Contractors shall, at his own expense arrange for the safety provisions as required by the Engineer-in-charge in respect of all workers directly or indirectly employed for the work and shall provide all facilities in connection there with. In case the contractors fails, to make arrangements and provide necessary facilities, the Engineer – in - charge shall be entitled to do so, and recover the cost there of, from the contractor.

31. The contractor shall not any time do cause or permit any nuisance on the work site or do anything which shall cause unnecessary disturbance or inconvenience to occupants.

32. Payment shall be made against submission of running bills on quarterly basis for complete work.

33. The contractor shall be responsible for any damage or theft and shall have to make good to its original shape and description as and when damage/theft etc. is noticed or taken place due to the wrong operation of the equipment's or negligence of the contractor's staff. The decision of Engineer-in-charge in this respect will be final and binding.

34. If any material is required for urgent repair(beyond routine maintenance), which is to be supplied by the department, free of cost and not available with department, the contractor has to provide the same on the written request of Engineer-In-Charge on extra cost permissible as per relevant conditions of contract.

35. If any material shall be supplied by the department to replace the faulty one, dismantled materials are to be returned back to the department after replacing the new one.

36. The department reserves the right to discontinue the contract without assigning any reason at any time with a notice of one month. No claim shall be entertained on this account.

37. The contractor has to follow the local security /safety rules and regulations prevailing in the area.

38. **The Scope of AMC includes cost of repair and replacement of all parts except Car electric incoming mains, main switch, EPABX Telephone intercom, all kinds of TFT/LED/LCD displays, Access control system, fans and light fittings, mirror, alarm bell and buzzer, emergency light, alarm devices and batteries and physical damages of the following components like Car enclosures, Car flooring, hist way enclosure, hoist way and car door, door and gate handles, door beading, door glasses, door frames, sills, push box covers in landings which will be charged extra as per actuals.**
