- The intending bidder must read the terms and conditions of CPWD-6 carefully. He should only submit his bid if he considers himself eligible and he is in possession of all the documents required.
- Information and Instructions for bidders posted on website shall form part of bid document.
- The intending bidder must have valid class-III digital signature to submit the bid.
- The bid can only be submitted after deposition of original EMD, which should be deposited either in the office of Executive Engineer inviting bids or division office of any Executive Engineer, CPWD within the period of bid submission. The EMD receiving Executive Engineer (including NIT issuing EE/AE) shall issue a receipt of deposition of earnest money deposit to the bidder in a prescribed format (enclosed) uploaded by tender inviting EE in the NIT. The Bid can only be submitted after

uploading the mandatory scanned documents such as Demand Draft or Pay order or Banker's Cheque or Deposit at call Receipt or Fixed Deposit Receipts and Bank Guarantee of any Scheduled Bank towards cost of bid document and EMD in favour of respective Executive Engineer and processing Fee in favour of ITI Limited and other documents as specified.

Unless all intending tenderer/bidders who have uploaded/submitted their bids by the last date of tender have submitted their original hard copy of EMDs which is verified from the issuing bank, tenders cannot be accepted and to be treated as invalid tender.

The bidders already registered on the e-tendering portal will have option to continue by paying tender processing fee upto one year from the date of registration, or to switch over to (new) registration without tender processing fee any time. All new registrations from 01-04-2015 will be without tender processing fee.

5. The Bid document consisting of plans, specifications, the Schedule of quantities of various types of items to be executed and the set of terms and conditions of the contract to be complied with and other necessary documents can be seen from website www.etender.cpwd@gov.in and www.eprocure.gov.in or www.cpwd.gov.in free of cost.
6. Those bidders not registered on the website mentioned above, are required to get registered beforehand. If needed they can be imparted training on online bidding process as per details available on the website.
7. On opening date, the contractor can login and see the bid opening process. After opening of bids he will receive the competitor bid sheets.
8. Bidder can upload documents in the form of JPG format and PDF format.
9. Bidder must ensure to quote rate of each item. The column meant for quoting rate in figures appears in pink colour and the moment rate is entered, it turns sky blue.

In addition to this, while selecting any of the cells a warning appears that if any cell is left blank the same shall be treated as "0".

Therefore, if any cell is left blank and no rate is quoted by the bidder, rate of such item shall be treated as "0" (ZERO).

The enlistment of the bidders should be valid on the last date of submission of tenders, if applicable. In case the last date of submission of tender is extended, the enlistment of bidder should be valid on the original date of submission of tenders, if applicable.

Earnest Money in the form of Treasury Challan or Demand Draft or Pay order or Banker's Cheque or Deposit at Call Receipt (drawn in favour of **Executive Engineer (E), DED-101, CPWD NEW DELHI** or Bank Guarantee of any Scheduled Bank shall be scanned and uploaded to the e-tendering website within the period of tender submission and original should be deposited in office of **Executive Engineer (E), DED-101, CPWD NEW DELHI**.

A part of earnest money is acceptable in the form of bank guarantee also. In such case, 50% of earnest money or Rs. 20 lakh, whichever is less, will have to be deposited in shape prescribed above, and balance in shape of Bank Guarantee. Interested contractor who wish to participate in the tender has also to make following payments in the form of Demand Draft/Pay order or Banker's Cheque of any Scheduled Bank and to be scanned and uploaded to the e-tendering website within the period of tender submission:

Copy of Enlistment Order, registration of GST and latest return of GST etc. as required shall be scanned and uploaded on the e-tendering website within the period of tender submission.

All the bid documents such as eligibility documents, Certificate of Registration for GST, and acknowledgement of up to date filed return etc. should be scanned and uploaded in complete form. All the incomplete bids shall be summarily rejected and no clarification shall be sought thereafter.

Online bid documents submitted by intending bidders shall be opened only of those bidders, who have deposited earnest money deposit and other documents scanned and uploaded are found in order.

The enlistment of the contractors should be valid on the last date of submission of tenders.

In case the last date of submission of tender is extended, the enlistment of contractor should be valid on the original date of submission of tenders.

- 1.1 **The work is estimated to cost Rs. 5,90,040/-** This estimate, however, is given merely as a rough guide.
- 1.1.1 The authority competent to approve NIT for the combined cost and belonging to the major discipline will consolidate NITs for calling the tenders. He will also nominate Division which will deal with all matters relating to the invitation of tenders. For composite tender, besides indicating the combined estimated cost put to tender, should clearly indicate the estimated cost of each component separately. The eligibility of tenderer will correspond to the combined estimated cost of different components put to tender. –N.A.–
- 1.2 Intending tender is eligible to submit the bid provided he has definite proof from the appropriate authority, which shall be to the satisfaction of the competent authority, of having satisfactorily completed similar works of magnitude specified below:- –N.A.–

Criteria of eligibility for submission of tender documents

- 1.2.1 Conditions for Non-CPWD contractors only, if tenders are also open to non-CPWD contractors.

For works estimated cost upto tendering limit of class -I Buildings & Roads (erstwhile Composite/ Building/ infrastructure) category Contractor (However, for Horticulture category, it may be modified as per bidding limit of CPWD class I contractors of Horticulture category).

One completed work costing not less than Rs. executed with the structural system technology as proposed by bidder in the letter of transmittal during the last 7 years ending last day of the month previous to the one in which tenders are invited. This work

can be part of eligible work at 1.2.1 (i) above or as a separate work.

Note :-

For works costing above Rs. 3 Crore but up to Rs. 15 Crore, (the figure of Rs.3 Crore and Rs. 15 Crore may be modified as per tendering limit of CPWD CPWD 6 for e-tendering modified up to 26.08.10 class II and CPWD Class I contractors respectively of respective discipline such as Electrical, Horticulture and Furniture etc. as the case may be) when tenders are open to non CPWD contractors also, then class II contractors of CPWD shall also be eligible if they satisfy the eligibility criteria specified in 1.2.1 above. –N.A.–

1.2.2 Criteria of eligibility for CPWD as well as non-CPWD contractors. -N.A.-

For works estimated to cost above the tendering limit of class -I (Super) Buildings & Roads (erstwhile Composite/ Building/ infrastructure) category Contractor (However for Horticulture category, it may be modified as per bidding limit of CPWD class I contractors of Horticulture Category).

- (i) Three similar works each of value not less than Rs..... or two similar works each of value not less than Rs.....or one similar work of value not less than Rs.....(all figures rounded to nearest convenient figure) during the last 7 years ending last day of the month previous to the one in which tenders are invited.
- (ii) For EPC tender under Mode- I/II only (Applicable for CPWD enlisted contractors of appropriate class also). One completed work costing not less than Rsexecuted with the structural system technology as proposed by bidder in letter of transmittal during the last 7 years ending last day of the month previous to the one in which tenders are invited. If the bidder does not have adequate experience of opted technology then the bidder can associate with contractor having requisite experience of executing work in structural system with the opted technology. Bidder has to submit MoU in the prescribed format (Anexure-68 of SOP) with such associate contractor, along with his tender, for structural system in opted technology only. The associated contractor must satisfy the eligibility criteria of having successfully completed one work of opted technology having the cost of structural system not less than 20% of the estimated cost put to tender during the last seven years ending last day of month previous to the one in which tender is invited.

In case separate cost of structural system of a particular technology is not available in the experience certificate of associated contractor, it will be taken as 30% of completed cost of project/work.

Associated contractor should not have been debarred from any Ministry or any govt. organization in the last five years.

The value of executed works shall be brought to current costing level by enhancing the actual value of work at simple rate of 7% per annum, calculated from the date of completion to the last date of submission of bid. This is applicable for 1.2.1 as well as 1.2.2 (Para 1.2.1(i) and Para 1.2.2(i) are not applicable for CPWD enlisted contractors of appropriate class. Para 1.2.1(ii) and Para 1.2.2(ii) are also applicable for CPWD enlisted contractors of appropriate class). –N.A.–

To become eligible for issue of tender, the tender shall have to furnish an affidavit as under:-

I/We undertake and confirm that eligible similar works(s) has/have not been got executed through another contractor on back to back basis. Further that, if such a violation comes to the notice of Department, then I/we shall be debarred for tendering in CPWD in future forever. Also, if such a violation comes to the notice of Department before date of start of work, the Engineer- in-Charge shall be free to forfeit the entire amount of Earnest Money Deposit/Performance Guarantee. (Scanned copy to be uploaded at the time of submission of bid) –N.A.–

- 1.2.3 When bids are invited from non CPWD contractors and CPWD class II contractors as per provisions of clause 1.2.1 above, it will be mandatory for non CPWD contractors and CPWD class-II contractors to upload the work experience certificate(s) and the affidavit as per the provisions of clause 1.2.2. –N.A.–

But for such bids, Class-I contractors of CPWD are eligible to submit the bids without submission of work experience certificate and affidavit. Therefore, CPWD class-I contractors shall upload two separate letters for experience certificate and affidavit that these documents are not required to be submitted by them. Uploading of these two letters is mandatory otherwise system will not clear mandatory fields.

2. Agreement shall be drawn with the successful tender on prescribed Form No. CPWD 7/8 (or other Standard Form as mentioned) which is available as a Govt. of India Publication. Tender shall quote his rates as per various terms and conditions of the said form which will form part of the agreement.
3. The time allowed for carrying out the work will be **02 Months** from the date of start as defined in schedule 'F' or from the first date of handing over of the site, whichever is later, in accordance with the phasing, if any, indicated in the tender documents.

5. The bid document consisting of plans, specifications, the schedule of quantities of various types of items to be executed and the set of terms and conditions of the contract to be complied with and other necessary documents except Standard General Conditions of Contract Form can be seen from website <https://etender.cpwd.gov.in> or www.cpwd.gov.in free of cost.
6. After submission of the bid the contractor can re-submit revised bid any number of times but before last time and date of submission of tender as notified.

7. While submitting the revised bid, contractor can revise the rate of one or more item(s) any number of times (he need not re-enter rate of all the items) but before last time and date of submission of tender as notified.
8. When tenders are invited in three stage system and if it is desired to submit revised financial bid then it shall be mandatory to submit revised financial bid. If not submitted then the tender submitted earlier shall become invalid.
9. Earnest Money in the form of Treasury Challan or Demand Draft or Pay order or Banker's Cheque or Deposit at Call Receipt or fixed deposit receipt (drawn in favour of **Executive Engineer (E), DED-101, CPWD NEW DELHI**) shall be scanned and uploaded to the e-tendering website within the period of tender submission. **The bid can only be submitted after deposition of original EMD, which should be deposited either in the office of Executive Engineer inviting bids or division office of any Executive Engineer, CPWD within the period of bid submission. A part of earnest money is acceptable in the form of bank guarantee also. In such case, minimum 50% of earnest money or Rs. 20 lakh, whichever is less, shall have to be deposited in shape prescribed above, and balance may be deposited in shape of Bank Guarantee of any scheduled bank having validity for six months or more from the last date of receipt of bids which is to be scanned and uploaded by the intending bidders.

Copy of Enlistment Order, certificate of work experience and other documents as specified in the press notice shall be scanned and uploaded to the e-tendering website within the period of bid submission. However, certified copy of all the scanned and uploaded documents as specified in press notice shall have to be submitted by the lowest bidder only within a week physically in the office of tender opening authority.

Online bid documents submitted by intending bidders shall be opened only of those bidders, **whose original EMD deposited with any division of CPWD and other documents scanned and uploaded are found in order.**

The bid submitted shall be opened at **15:30 hrs on 06.08.2026.**

- 9A) The contractors registered prior to 01.04.2015 on e-tendering portal of CPWD shall have to deposit tender processing fee at existing rates, or they have option to switch over to the new registration system without tender processing fee any time.

10. The bid submitted shall become invalid if:

- i) The bidder is found ineligible.
 - ii) The bidder does not deposit original EMD with division office of any Executive Engineer, CPWD **(The EMD document shall only be issued from the place in which the office of receiving division office is situated).**
 - iii) The bidder does not upload all the documents ***(including GST registration)*** as stipulated in the bid document ***including the copy of receipt for deposition of original EMD instrument.***
 - iv) If any discrepancy is noticed between the documents as uploaded at the time of submission of bid and hard copies as submitted physically by the lowest bidder in the office of tender opening authority.
- 11.** The contractor whose bid is accepted will be required to furnish performance guarantee at specified percentage of the tendered amount as mentioned in schedule E and within the period specified in Schedule F. This guarantee shall be in the form of Insurance Surety Bonds, Account Payee Demand Draft, Fixed Deposit Receipt or Bank Guarantee from any of the Commercial Banks in accordance with the prescribed form.. In case the contractor fails to deposit the said performance guarantee within the period as indicated in Schedule 'F', including the extended period if any, the Earnest Money deposited by the contractor shall be forfeited automatically without any notice to the contractor. The earnest money deposited along with bid shall be returned after receiving the aforesaid performance guarantee. The contractor whose bid is accepted will also be required to furnish either copy of applicable licenses/ registrations or proof of applying for obtaining labour licenses, registration with EPFO, ESIC and BOCW Welfare Board including Provident Fund Code No. If applicable and also ensure the compliance of aforesaid provisions by the subcontractors, if any engaged by the contractor for the said work within the period specified in Schedule F.

12. The description of the work is as follows :-

Intending Tenders are advised to inspect and examine the site and its surroundings and satisfy themselves before submitting their tenders as to the nature of the ground and sub-soil (so far as is practicable), the form and nature of the site, the means of access to the site, the accommodation they may require and in general shall themselves obtain all necessary information as to risks, contingencies and other circumstances which may influence or affect their tender. A tender shall be deemed to have full knowledge of the site whether he inspects it or not and no extra charge consequent on any misunderstanding or otherwise shall be allowed. The tender shall be responsible for arranging and maintaining at his own cost all materials, tools & plants, water, electricity access, facilities for workers and all other services required for executing the work unless otherwise specifically provided for in the contract documents. Submission of a tender by a tender implies that he has read this notice and all other contract documents and has made himself aware of the scope and specifications of the work to be done and of conditions and rates at which stores, tools and plant, etc. will be issued to him by the Government and local conditions and other factors having a bearing on the execution of the work.

- 13.** The competent authority on behalf of the President of India does not bind itself to accept the lowest or any other tender and reserves to itself the authority to reject any or all the tenders received without the assignment of any reason. All tenders in which any of the prescribed conditions is not fulfilled or any condition including that of conditional rebate is put forth by the tender shall be summarily rejected.

14. Canvassing whether directly or indirectly, in connection with tender is strictly prohibited and the tenders submitted by the contractors who resort to canvassing will be liable to rejection.
15. The competent authority on behalf of President of India reserves to himself the right of accepting the whole or any part of the tender and the tender shall be bound to perform the same at the rate quoted.
16. The contractor shall not be permitted to tender for works in the CPWD Circle (Division in case of contractors of Horticulture/Nursery category) responsible for award and execution of contracts, in which his near relative is posted a Divisional Accountant or as an officer in any capacity between the grades of Superintending Engineer and Junior Engineer (both inclusive). He shall also intimate the names of persons who are working with him in any capacity or are subsequently employed by him and who are near relatives to any gazetted officer in the Central Public Works Department or in the Ministry of Urban Development. Any breach of this condition by the contractor would render him liable to be removed from the approved list of contractors of this Department.
17. No Engineer of gazetted rank or other Gazetted Officer employed in Engineering or Administrative duties in an Engineering Department of the Government of India is allowed to work as a contractor for a period of one year after his retirement from Government service, without the previous permission of the Government of India in writing. This contract is liable to be cancelled if either the contractor or any of his employees is found any time to be such a person who had not obtained the permission of the Government of India as aforesaid before submission of the tender or engagement in the contractor's service.
18. 3. No T&P shall be issued by the department.
