20. INCOME TAX (TDS)

24. Conflict of Interest among Bidders / Agents

A bidder shall not have conflict of interest with other bidders. Such conflict of interest can lead to anti-competitive practices to the detriment of Procuring Entity's interests. The bidder found to have a conflict of interest shall be disqualified. A bidder may be considered to have a conflict of interest with one or more parties in this bidding process, if:

- a) they have proprietor/ partner(s)/ Director(s) in common; or
- b) they receive or have received any direct or indirect subsidy/ financial stake from any of them; or
- c) they have the same legal representative/ agent for purposes of this bid; or
- d) they have relationship with each other, directly or through common third parties, that puts them in a position to have access to information about or influence on the bid of another bidder; or
- e) bidder participates in more than one bid in this bidding process. Participation by a bidder in more than one Bid will result in the disqualification of all bids in which the parties are involved. However, this does not limit the inclusion of the components/ sub-assembly/ assemblies from one bidding manufacturer in more than one bid.
- f) in cases of agents quoting in offshore procurements, on behalf of their principal manufacturers, one agent cannot represent two manufacturers or quote on their behalf in a particular tender enquiry. One manufacturer can also authorize only one agent/ dealer. There can be only one bid from the following:

However, it should be noted that whenever the clear work front is available for execution of the work and the statutory permission is not restricting for work execution during the rain period, the work should be executed as per instruction of E-I-C. For such instances, the period mentioned above shall be considered under execution period. Proper records with relevant documents for the same shall be kept by the successful bidder while executing the work.
- d. No mobilization period or idling will be allowed during the contract period.
- e. The completion date will be deemed to be the date on which all works on the Contract are demonstrated to be complete to the satisfaction of the GETCO/Engineer and is complete in all respects as per the terms and conditions of this Contract.
