1. The intending bidder must read the terms and conditions of CPWD-6 carefully. He should submit his bid if only he considers himself eligible and he is in possession of all the documents required.
2. Information and Instructions for bidders will form part of NIT and to be uploaded on <https://etender.cpwd.gov.in> website.
3. The enlistment of the contractors should be valid on the last date of submission of tenders. In case the last date of submission of tender is extended, the enlistment of contractor should be valid on the original date of submission of tenders.
4. But the bid can only be submitted after deposition of original EMD either in the office of Executive Engineer inviting bids or division office of any Executive Engineer, CPWD within the period of bid submission (The EMD document shall only be issued from the place in which the office of receiving division office is

situated) and uploading the mandatory scanned documents such as Insurance Surety Bond, Account Payee Demand Draft, Fixed Deposit Receipt, Bankers Cheque or Bank Guarantee(as prescribed) from any of the Commercial Bank towards EMD in favour of Executive Engineer as mentioned in NIT, receipt for deposition of original EMD to division office of any Executive Engineer (including NIT issuing EE/ AE), CPWD and other documents as specified.

A part of earnest money (EMD) is acceptable in the form of bank guarantee also. In such cases, 50% of earnest money or Rs. 20 Lakh whichever is less, will have to be deposited in shape prescribed above and balance can be accepted in form of Bank Guarantee of any Commercial bank. The bank guarantee submitted as a part of Earnest Money shall be valid for a period of six months or more from the last date of submission of bid.

- 5.** Those Contractors who are not registered or have not updated their profile on the website mentioned above, are required to get registered/update their profile beforehand. The necessary training materials including the videos with step to step process are available on download section of <https://etender.cpwd.gov.in>.
- 6.** The intending bidder must have valid class-III digital signature certificate with encryption key (combo type) to perform any operations /transactions on the e-tendering portal/website and the bidder should download and install the eMSigner on their system as per instructions available on download section of <https://etender.cpwd.gov.in>.
- 7.** On the opening date, the contractor can login and see the bid opening process. After opening of bids he will receive the competitor bid sheets.
- 8.** Contractor can upload documents in JPG format and PDF format. Bidder should ensure that the document uploaded is legible and full documents page is properly scanned.
- 9.** Contractor must ensure to quote the percentage rate in the prescribed column(s) meant for quoting rate in figures appears in yellow colour and the moment rate is entered, it turns sky blue. In addition to this, while selecting any of the cells a warning appears that if any cell is left blank the same shall be treated as "0". Therefore, if any cell is left blank and no rate is quoted by the bidder, rate of such item shall be treated as "0" (ZERO).
- 10.** If the contractor is found ineligible after opening of bids, his bid shall become invalid.
- 11.** GST on all materials as well as GST on Work Contract and Labour Welfare Cess etc., or any other tax applicable in respect of this contract shall be payable by the Contractor. Percentage rate quoted by him shall be inclusive of such taxes, levies etc. and Government will not entertain any claim for reimbursement whatsoever in respect of the same. The percentage rates of the contract shall be inclusive of all taxes and levies and nothing extra shall be paid

12.Information and instruction for Executive Engineer for e-tendering.

- (i) Executive Engineer/Engineer in Charge/DDH of any divisions/projects of CPWD or any other officer designated by CPWD Directorate from time to time, are authorized to receive the EMDs. These authorities should receive the original EMD for their tenders or tenders of any other divisions/projects.
- (ii) The NIT approving authority/Tender inviting authority at the time of issue of NIT also fills and upload the following prescribed format of receipt of deposition of original EMD along with NIT.

2. Agreement shall be drawn with the successful bidders on Form No. CPWD 7 ~~or other Standard Form as mentioned~~, which is available as a Govt. of India Publication and also available on website "www.cpwd.gov.in". Bidders shall quote their percentage as per various terms and conditions of the said form which will form part of the agreement.
- 3 **The time allowed for carrying out the work will be 06 months from the date of start as defined in schedule 'F' or from the first date of handing over of the site, whichever is later, in accordance with the phasing, if any, indicated in the bid documents.**
- 4 The site for the work is available.
5. The bid document consisting of plans, specifications, the schedules of quantities of various types of items to be executed and set of terms and conditions of the contract to be complied with and other necessary documents except standard general conditions of contract form can be seen on website <https://etender.cpwd.gov.in> or www.cpwd.gov.in free of cost
6. After submission of the bid the contractor can re-submit revised bid any number of times but before last time and date of submission of bid as notified.
- 7 While submitting the revised bid, contractor can revise the rate of one or more item(s) any number of times (he need not re-enter rate of all the items) but before last time and date of submission of bid as notified.
8. Earnest Money in the form of Insurance Surety Bond, Account Payee Demand Draft, Fixed Deposit Receipt, Bankers Cheque or Bank Guarantee(as prescribed) from any of the Commercial Bank (drawn in favour of Executive Engineer, CPWD, Kannur) shall be scanned and uploaded to the e-Tendering website within the period of bid submission. The original EMD should be

deposited either in the office of Executive Engineer inviting bids or division office of any Executive Engineer, CPWD within the period of bid submission. The EMD receiving Executive Engineer (including NIT issuing EE/AE) shall issue a receipt of deposition of earnest money deposit to the bidder in a prescribed format (enclosed) uploaded by tender inviting EE in the NIT.

A part of earnest money is acceptable in the form of bank guarantee also. In such case, minimum 50% of earnest money or Rs. 20 lac, whichever is less, shall have to be deposited in shape prescribed above, and balance may be deposited in shape of Bank Guarantee of any Commercial bank having validity for 90 days or more from the last date of receipt of bids which is to be scanned and uploaded by the intending bidders.

The earnest money given by the tenderers except the lowest tenderer shall be refunded immediately after the expiry of stipulated bid validity period or immediately after the acceptance of the successful bidder, whichever is earlier. 9. The bid submitted shall become invalid and e-tender processing fee shall not be refunded if:
 - (i) The bidder does not upload all the documents as stipulated in the bid document.
 - (ii) The bidder hide facts and furnish false information, details and certificates and has not furnished the certified performance of work as per NIT condition.
 - (iii) If a tenderer quotes nil rates against each item in item rate tender or does not quote any percentage above/below on the total amount of the tender or any section/sub head in percentage rate tender, the tender shall be treated as invalid and will not be considered as lowest tenderer.
- 10 The contractor whose bid is accepted, will be required to furnish performance guarantee at specified percentage of the bid amount as mentioned in Schedule E and within the period specified in Schedule F. This guarantee shall be in the form of Insurance Surety Bond, Account Payee Demand Draft, Fixed Deposit Receipt or Bank Guarantee (as prescribed) from any of the Commercial Bank.

In case the contractor fails to deposit the said performance guarantee within the period as indicated in Schedule 'F', including the extended period if any, the Earnest Money deposited by the contractor shall be forfeited automatically without any notice to the contractor. The earnest money deposited along with bid shall be returned after receiving the aforesaid performance guarantee. The contractor whose bid is accepted will also be required to furnish either copy of applicable licenses/ registrations or proof of applying for obtaining labour licenses, registration with EPFO, ESIC and BOCW Welfare Board including Provident Fund Code No. If applicable and also ensure the compliance of aforesaid provisions by the sub contractors, if any engaged by the contractor for the said work within the period specified in Schedule F

A bidder shall be deemed to have full knowledge of the site whether he inspects it or not and no extra charge consequent on any misunderstanding shall be allowed. The bidders shall be responsible for arranging and maintaining at their own cost all materials, tools & plants, water, electricity access, facilities for workers and all other services required for executing the work unless otherwise specifically provided for in the contract documents. Submission of a bid by a bidder implies that he has read this notice and all other contract documents and has made himself aware of the scope and specifications of the work to be done and of conditions and rates at which stores, tools and plant, etc. will be issued to him by the Government and local conditions and other factors having a bearing on the execution of the work.~~

- 12 The competent authority on behalf of the President of India does not bind itself to accept the lowest or any other bid and reserves to itself the authority to reject any or all the bids received without the assigning of any reason. All bids in which any of the prescribed conditions is not fulfilled or any condition including that of conditional rebate is put forth by the bidders shall be summarily rejected.
- 13 Canvassing whether directly or indirectly, in connection with bids is strictly prohibited and the bids submitted by the contractors who resort to canvassing will be liable for rejection.

- 14 The competent authority on behalf of President of India reserves to himself the right of accepting the whole or any part of the bid and the bidders shall be bound to perform the same at the rates quoted.

GST or any other tax applicable in respect of inputs procured by the contractor for the contract shall be payable by the contractor and Government will not entertain any claim whatsoever in respect of the same. However, component of GST at time of supply of service (as provided in CGST ACT 2017) provided by the contract shall be varied if different from that applicable on the last date of receipt of tender including extension if any.

15. The contractor shall not be permitted to bid for works in the CPWD Circle (Division in case of contractors of Horticulture/Nursery category) responsible for award and execution of contracts, in which his near relative is posted a Divisional Accountant or as an officer in any capacity between the grades of Superintending Engineer and Junior Engineer (both inclusive). He shall also intimate the names of persons who are working with him in any capacity or are subsequently employed by him and who are near relatives to any gazetted officer in the Central Public Works Department or in the Ministry of Urban Development. Any breach of this condition by the contractor would render him liable to be removed from the approved list of contractors of this Department.

16. No Engineer of Gazetted Rank or other Gazetted Officer employed in Engineering or Administrative duties in an Engineering Department of the Government of India is allowed to work as a contractor for a period of one year after his retirement from Government service, without the prior permission of the Government of India in writing. This contract is liable to be cancelled if either the contractor or any of his employees is found any time to be such a person who had not obtained the permission of the Government of India as aforesaid before submission of the bid or engagement in the contractor's service.

- 17** The bid for the works shall remain open for acceptance for a period of thirty (30) days from the date of opening of bids. Further

- (i) If any bidder withdraws his bid or make any modification in the terms & conditions of the tender which is no acceptable to the department within 7 days after the last date of submission of bids, then the Government shall, without prejudice to any other right or remedy, be at liberty to forfeit 50% of the earnest money absolutely irrespective of letter of acceptance for the work is issued or not.
- (ii) If any bidder withdraws his bid or make any modification in the terms & conditions of the tender which is no acceptable to the department after expiry of 7 days after the last date of submission of bids, then the Government shall, without prejudice to any other right or remedy, be at liberty to forfeit 100% of the earnest money absolutely irrespective of letter of acceptance for the work is issued or not.

1. The contract is likely to commence w.e.f. 27.07.2026 and shall continue for a period of Six months, unless it is curtailed or terminated by this Office owing to deficiency of service, sub-standard quality of personnel deployed, breach of contract, reduction or cessation of the requirements of work or indiscipline.
2. The contract shall automatically expire after Six months from commencement of the contract.
3. The contract may be extended, on the same terms and conditions or with some addition/deletion/ modification' for a further period not exceeding one month at the mutual consent of contractor and the Executive Engineer, CPWD, Kannur.
4. The contracting Company/ Firm/ Contractor will be required to pay minimum wages as prescribed under the Minimum Wages as per Acts under Central/ State Government. The contractor will maintain proper records as required under Law/Acts. It shall be the duty of the contracting company /contractor to enhance the wages of the employee's subject to any statutory obligation / raise from time to time as instructed by authorities concerned in this behalf.
