1. The intending bidder must read the terms and conditions of CPWD-6 carefully. He should only submit his bid if he considers himself eligible and he is in possession of all the documents required.
2. Information and Instructions for bidders posted on website shall form part of bid documents.
3. The bid document consisting of plans, specifications, the schedule of quantities of various types of items to be executed and the set of terms and conditions of the contract to be complied with and other necessary documents can be seen and downloaded from website www.etender.cpwd.gov.in (or) cpwd.gov.in free of cost.
4. The contractor can deposit original EMD either in the office of the Executive Engineer inviting bids or division office of any Executive Engineer, CPWD, within the period of bid submission. (The EMD documents shall only be issued from the place from which the office of receiving division office is situated). The contractor shall obtain the receipt of EMD from the concerned Executive Engineer in the prescribed format uploaded by NIT issuing Executive Engineer. The bid document as uploaded can be viewed and downloaded free of cost by anyone including intending bidder. 5. 8. On opening date, the contractor can login and see the bid opening process. After opening of bids he will receive the competitor bid sheets.
9. Contractor can upload documents on the form of JPG format and PDF format.
10. If a tenderer does not quote any percentage above / below / At par on the total amount of the tender or any section / subhead in percentage rate tender, the tender shall be treated as invalid and will not be considered as lowest tenderer.
11. CGST@1%, SGST@1% & Labour Cess 1% etc., as applicable shall be borne by the contractor himself. The contractor shall quote his rates considering all such taxes including GST. **Any recovery towards GST is notified by the competent authority, the same shall be effected and no claim whatsoever shall be entertained by CPWD. The contractor shall quote his rates accordingly.**
12. SC/ST contractors enlisted under class V category are exempted from processing fee payable to ITI.
13. GST @ 2% to be recovered in each running/final bill.

The enlistment of the contractors should be valid on the last date of submission of Tenders. In case the last date of submission of tender is extended, the enlistment of Contractor should be valid on the original date of submission of tenders.

- 1.1 The work is estimated to cost of **Rs.11,48,595/-**. This estimate cost, however, is given merely as a rough guide.

- 1.1.1 The authority competent to approve NIT for the combined cost and belonging to the major discipline will consolidate NITs for calling the tenders. He will also nominate Division which will deal with all matters relating to the invitation of tenders. For composite tender, besides indicating the combined estimated cost put to tender, should clearly indicates the estimated cost of each component separately. The eligibility of tenderer will correspond to the combined estimated cost of different components put to tender.

- 1.2 Intending tenderer is eligible to submit the tender provided he has definite proof from the appropriate authority, which shall be to the satisfaction of the competent authority, of having satisfactorily completed similar works of magnitude specified below:

2. Agreement shall be drawn with the successful tenderers on prescribed Form No. CPWD 7/8 (or other Standard Form as mentioned) which is available as a Government of India Publication and also available on website **www. CPWD.gov.in**. Tenderers shall quote his rates as per various terms and conditions of the said form which will form part of agreement.

3. The time allowed for carrying out the work will be **12 (TWELVE) Months** from the date of start as defined in Schedule “F” or from the first date of handing over the site, whichever is later, in accordance with the phasing, if any, indicated in the tender documents.

4. (i) **The site for the work is available. OR**

~~The site for the work shall be made available in phased manner. After completion of the work in the site in hand the site for the next phase shall be made available.*~~

5. The tender document consisting of plans, specifications, the schedule of quantities of various types of items to be executed and the set of terms and conditions of the contractor to be complied with and other necessary documents except Standard General Conditions of Contractor Form can be seen from website [www. Tenderwizard.com/](http://www.Tenderwizard.com/) CPWD, www.etender.cpwd.gov.in (or) www.cpwd.gov.in free of cost.
6. After submission of the bid the contractor can re-submit revised bid any number of times but before last time and date of submission of bid as notified.
7. While submitting the revised bid, contractor can revise the rate of one or more item(s) any number of times (he need not re-enter rate of all the items) but before last time and date of submission of bid as notified.
8. When bids are invited in three stage system and if it is desired to submit revised financial bid then it shall be mandatory to submit revised financial bid. If not submitted then the bid submitted earlier shall become invalid.
9. ***Earnest Money in the form of Treasury Challan or Demand Draft or Pay order or Banker's Cheque or Deposit at Call receipt (drawn in favour of **Executive Engineer, Chennai IV Division, CPWD, Chennai.**) or Fixed deposit Receipt (drawn in favour of **Executive Engineer, Chennai IV Division, CPWD, Chennai.**) shall be scanned and uploaded to the e- Tendering website within the period of bid submission. The Original EMD should be deposited either in the office of Executive Engineer inviting bids or division office of any Executive Engineer, CPWD within the period of bid submission. (The EMD document shall only be issued from the place in which the office of receiving division office is situated. A part of earnest money is acceptable in the form of bank guarantee also. In such case, minimum 50% of earnest money or Rs. 20 lac, whichever is less, shall have to be deposited in shape prescribed above, and balance may be deposited in shape of Bank Guarantee including e- Bank Guarantee of any Commercial bank having validity for a period of 90 days for single bid works and 180 days for two bid system or more from the last date of receipt of bids which is to be scanned and uploaded by the intending bidders.

The earnest money given by all the tenderers except the lowest tenderer shall be refunded immediately after the expiry of stipulated bid validity period or immediately after acceptance of the successful bidder, whichever is earlier. However, in case of two/ three bid system, earnest money deposit of bidders unsuccessful during technical bid evaluation etc. should be returned within 30 days of declaration of result of technical bid evaluation.

Copy of Enlistment Order and certificate of work experience and other documents as specified in the notice inviting e- tender shall be scanned and uploaded on the e-Tendering website within the period of bid submission. However, certified copy of all the scanned and uploaded documents as specified in e-tender notice shall have to be submitted by the lowest bidder within a week physically in the office of tender opening authority. Online bid documents submitted by intending bidders shall be opened only of those bidders, whose original EMD deposited with any division of CPWD and other documents scanned and uploaded are found in order.

The bid submitted shall be opened at 15:30 hrs on 16.07.2026.

The contractors registered prior to 01.04.2015 on e –tendering portal of CPWD shall have to deposit tender processing fee at existing rates, or they have option to switch over to the new registration system without tender processing fee any time.

10. The bid submitted shall become invalid and e-Tender processing fee (if applicable) shall not be refunded if:
- (i) The bidder is found ineligible.
 - (ii) (ii) The bidder does not upload scanned copies of all the documents stipulated in the bid document.
 - (iii) (iii) If any discrepancy is noticed between the documents as uploaded at the time of submission of bid and hard copies as submitted physically by the lowest bidder in the office of bid opening authority.

11. The contractor whose bid is accepted will be required to furnish performance guarantee of the bid amount within the period specified in Schedule F. This guarantee shall be in the form of cash (in case guarantee amount is less than Rs.10000/-) or Deposit at Call receipt of any scheduled bank/Banker's Cheque of any scheduled bank/Demand Draft of any scheduled bank/Pay order of any Scheduled Bank of any scheduled bank (in case guarantee amount is less than Rs.1,00,000/-) or Government Securities or Fixed Deposit Receipts or Guarantee Bonds of any Scheduled Bank or the State Bank of India in accordance with the prescribed form. In case the contractor whose bid is accepted fails to deposit the said performance guarantee within the period as indicated in Schedule "F", including the extended period if any, the Earnest Money deposited by the contractor shall be forfeited automatically without any notice to the contractor. **The Earnest Money deposited along with tender shall be returned after receiving the aforesaid performance guarantee.** The contractor whose bid is accepted will also be required to furnish either copy of applicable licenses/registrations or proof of applying for obtaining labour licenses, registration with EPFO, ESIC and BOCW Welfare Board including Provident Fund code No. if applicable and also ensure the compliance of aforesaid provisions by the sub-contractors, if any engaged by the contractor for the said work and Programme Chart (Time and Progress) within the period specified in Schedule F.
12. Intending Tenders are advised to inspect and examine the site and its surroundings and satisfy themselves before submitting their tenders as to the nature of the ground and sub-soil (so far as is practicable), the form and nature of the site, the means of access to the site, the accommodation they may require and in general shall themselves obtain all necessary information as to risks, contingencies and other circumstances which may influence or affect their tender. A tenderer shall be deemed to have full knowledge of the site whether he inspects it or not and no extra charge consequent on any misunderstanding or otherwise shall be allowed. The tenderer shall be responsible for arranging and maintaining at his own cost all materials, tools & plants, water, electricity access, facilities for workers and all other services required for executing the work unless otherwise specifically provided for in the contract documents. Submission of a tender by a tenderer implies that he has read this notice and all contract documents and has made himself aware of the scope and specifications of the work to be done and of conditions and rate at which stores, tools and plant, etc. will be issued to him by the government and local conditions and other factors having a bearing on the execution of the work.

13. The competent authority on behalf of the President of India does not bind itself to accept the lowest or any other tender and reserves to itself the authority to reject any or all the tenders received without the assignment of any reason. All tenders in which any of the prescribed condition is not fulfilled or any condition including that of conditional rebate is put forth by the tenderer shall be summarily rejected.
14. Canvassing whether directly or indirectly, in connection with tenders is strictly prohibited and the tenders submitted by the contractors who resort to canvassing will be liable to rejection.
15. The competent authority on behalf of President of India reserves to himself the right of accepting the whole or any part of the tender and the tenderer shall be bound to perform the same at the rate quoted.
16. The contractor shall not be permitted to tender for works in the CPWD Circle (Division in case of Contractors of Horticulture/ Nursery category) responsible for award and execution of contracts, which his near relative is posted a Divisional Accountant or as an officer in any capacity between the grades of Superintending Engineer and Junior Engineer (both inclusive). He shall also intimate the names of persons who are working with him in any capacity or are subsequently employed by him and who are near relatives to any gazette officers in the Central Public Works Department or in the Ministry of Urban Affairs. Any breach of this condition by the contractor would render him liable to be removed from the approved list of contractors of this Department.
17. No Engineer of gazette rank or other gazetted officers employed in Engineering or Administrative duties in an Engineering Department of the Government of India is allowed to work as a contractor for the period of one permission of the Government of India in writing. This contract is liable to be cancelled if either the contractor or any of his employees is found any time to be such a person who had not obtained the permission of the Government of India as aforesaid before submission of the tender or engagement in the contractor's service.
 - a. The tender for the works shall remain open for acceptance for the period of **Seven (7) days** from the date of opening of tender. If any bidders withdraws his bid before the said period or makes any modification in the terms and conditions of the tender which are not acceptable to the department, then the Government shall, without prejudice to any other right or remedy, be at liberty to forfeit 50% of the said earnest money as aforesaid. Further the tenderer shall not be allowed to participate in the re-tendering process of the work. **(Vide OM No.DG/CON/293 Dated 01.07.2016).**

We, the said bank further undertakes to pay to the Government any money so demanded notwithstanding any dispute or disputes raised by the contractor(s) in any suit or proceeding pending before any court or Tribunal relating thereto, our liability under this present being absolute and unequivocal. The payment so made by us under this bond shall be a valid discharge of our liability for payment therein under and the contractor(s) shall have no claim against us for making such payment.

3. We.....further agree that the guarantee herein (indicate the name of the bank) contained shall remain in full force and effect during the period that would be taken for the performance of the said agreement and that it shall continue to be enforceable till all the dues of the Government under or by virtue of the said agreement have been fully paid and its claims satisfied or discharged or till Engineer-in-charge on behalf of the government certified that the terms and conditions of the said agreement have been fully and properly carried out by the said contractor(s) and accordingly discharges this guarantee.

4. 2. And whereas the parties are aware that Shri is on cadre of CPWD, presently on deputation as Arbitrator, Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs, Government of India / presently a CPWD empaneled Arbitrator.
3. I/We agree for the appointment of Shri.....as the sole Arbitrator for adjudication of the disputes, and we hereby waive the applicability of Section 12(5) of the Arbitration & Conciliation Act, 1996.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS

For Vehicle

1. Engineer-in-Charge shall notify the agency of any change in schedule of hired car(s). The notification shall be provided 24 hours prior to change.
2. Engineer-in-Charge shall either accept or reject the log book entries within a maximum of 7 days after updated by Agency. Failure to take action on log book entries updated by Agency shall result in auto acceptance of reading provided by Agency.
3. Agency shall ensure that assigned vehicle and driver report as per schedule provided by user department / Engineer-in-Charge / individual officer. In an event of delay in arrival beyond 15 minutes, user shall have right to hire other taxi services (which may or may not be of similar hired car category). The fare charges shall be charged to the Agency.
4. Agency agrees to terms and conditions of the contract and shall ensure full compliance to them.
5. Agency to ensure that all maintenance works related to assigned vehicle shall be carried out in off duty hours.
6. Agency to ensure that vehicle deployed shall arrive at designated location on time and with full tank of fuel.
7. In the event of any break-down, servicing and repairs of vehicles, the Agency at his own cost shall make alternate arrangement by providing similar or higher class of vehicle(s) for which agreement is entered into. Failure to do so will evoke penalty or possible termination of contract.
8. The Agency shall not be allowed to sub-let the Contract. The Agency can act as an aggregator of vehicles/ individual drivers. However, it is the Agency who shall be responsible to the Engineer-in-Charge for the Contract being signed.
9. **The Agency shall only provide vehicles which have the comprehensive insurance.**
10. **Police verifications for deployed staff shall be ensured by Agency.**
11. Agency shall update the log book on in standard proforma which shall supplied by the JE/AE/EE at least once in every 7 days. Failure to do so shall be penalized as per this contract.
12. All attempts shall be made to provide quality services.
13. The vehicle should be registered as a commercial vehicle in same state as the service is requested in.

14. Deployed vehicle shall have properly cleaned interiors and exteriors. Suitable air freshener and if required air purifiers shall be installed within vehicle at the cost of agency if applicable.
15. The vehicle **should not be older than 3 years** from date of this service request
16. **The vehicle(s) provided by the Agency shall have valid Registration Certificate, full comprehensive insurance to cover third party and occupants, fitness certificate, PUC, permit etc. and any other relevant permits/licenses essentially required by the RTO and any other statutory bodies for commercial operations, and must be revalidated before the expiry of the due date during the tenure of the contract period.**
17. The Agency shall ensure that the vehicles deployed by him are maintained well, cleaned thoroughly both internally and externally, boot kept clear off dust, rubbish, oil and any personal belongings of the driver.
18. All vehicles shall be equipped with an emergency medical kit and a fire extinguisher.
19. It shall be ensured that all electrical connections including lights (both back and front), horn, turn indicators, air conditioning (if requested as an add on) and other vehicle systems shall be periodically checked and maintained by Agency to avoid any inconvenience to user departments.
20. The Agency shall be responsible for the acts and deeds of drivers of the vehicles including Sl. No. 21 to 29.
21. The driver in no case shall report to duty in an inebriated state or consume alcohol while on duty.
22. The drivers/staff of the vehicles deployed for user department duties maintain polite & courteous behavior towards department users as well as to other departmental staff. Following may be **construed as “Misbehavior” and shall attract penalties** as per provisions of the contract. Repeated instances may result in termination of services.
 - a. Denial of duty during standard business hours of 8 am to 8 pm, or business hours as notified by user departments
 - b. Use of abusive language
23. Driver must be provided a working mobile phone and contact number be provided to user department.
24. In an event that for any reasons the driver changes his contact number during the tenure of the contract then agency will immediately notify the user department of the above change.
25. The driver shall be reachable at all times during duty hours.
26. **Only drivers that possess a valid commercial driving license shall be deployed by the agency.**

27. Driver should be properly dressed in neat and clean attire.
28. The driver shall not report for duty in an inebriated state. In such an event user department shall have full rights to terminate the contract with immediate effect.
29. Any complaint from the users/staff of the user department with respect to their behaviour/ uniform will be viewed seriously and it will be brought to the notice of the Agency, who shall take suitable action.
30. The hiring charges will be inclusive of fuel cost, lubricants, spare parts, maintenance, salary of the drivers/staff, payment of insurance/road/state taxes/permit/certificates etc. as per description of items.
- 31. The Agency shall take comprehensive insurance cover with third party unlimited liability risk of the vehicles detailed for the user department requirement. Engineer-in-charge shall not be liable for any damages whatsoever to public property and /or any third person due to any accident arising out of and in the course of deployment of Agencies vehicle.**
- 32. The Agency shall be solely responsible for any claims by any third party and/or employees of user department traveling in the vehicle for any injuries caused by the driver of the vehicle whether by accident or otherwise.**
- 33. The user department will in no way be responsible for violation of traffic rules and /or infringement of any other law for the time being in force, either by the driver of the vehicle or by the Agency. The driver as well as Agency shall comply with relevant rules and regulations of Motor Vehicles Act and Rules applicable at present or in future during the tenure of the contract and as may be enforced from time to time for which user departments would not be held liable/responsible in any manner what-so- ever. Onus of compliance of all the applicable Laws/Acts/Rules including those under Motor Vehicle Acts/Rules shall rest with the Agency only and user/user departments will not be liable in any manner.**
- 34. The Agency shall be responsible for ensuring compliance with the provisions related to Labour Law [Central/State] and specially Minimum Wages Act, Payment of Wages Act, PF, ESI Act, Payment of Bonus Act, Contract Labour [R&A] Act, Workmen Compensation Act etc. as applicable from time to time. The employees of the Agency shall not be deemed to be employees of the user department hence the compliance of the applicable acts laws will be the sole responsibility of the Agency.**

35. The Agency shall be personally responsible for any theft, misconduct and /or disobedience on the part of drivers so provided by him.
36. During the contract period, if the vehicle is seized or detained or requisitioned by Police/Motor Vehicle Authority or any other authorities for whatsoever reasons that will be at the Agency's risk. Also, alternate vehicle of similar or higher category will be provided by Agency without any extra charges.
37. The cars deployed for duty for the user department shall at no point of time carry any person other than personnel authorized by user department. The Agency has to ensure the safety of passengers by avoiding negligent driving by their drivers such as over speeding, rash driving, and driving vehicle without brakes/defective brakes.
- 38. Separate duty slip will be maintained for each vehicle, which will be signed by the authorized signatory of the user department. Before each car is allotted for duty, the odometer reading shall be noted down by the driver and subsequent entries for starting time/closing time, places visited etc. for each duty during office hours and after completion of duty, the driver shall again note down the odometer reading and get it checked and signed by the user of the vehicle deployed by the administration of the user department. On the basis of each vehicle's duty slip, the Agency shall prepare monthly bills enclosing therewith a consolidated statement of each vehicle's monthly running and original copies of duty slip.**
- 39. The Agency shall provide at his own cost proper uniform and badges as per MOTOR VEHICLES RULES, 1993 (amended upto date) and photo identity cards to the drivers.**
- 40. At the option of the Govt. user Agency shall provide vehicle tracking system and will submit the record /data of journey including pickup time and drop time along with mileage. The mileage count will start from the location of pickup and no extra kilometers from the garage to the pickup point will be provided.**
- 41. The Agency will have to intimate the bank account number, and other details of the bank to enable the user department to credit the payments directly into the account. The payment shall be subject to any deductions such as penalties, statutory deduction etc.**
42. Toll Tax, Octroi, Parking Charges and other statutory levies, if any, paid during the journey would be billed on actual.

Penalties will be levied on the service provider, for the violation of Service Level Agreement of the contract as mentioned below:

43. Breach of contractual obligations: The following incidents will be considered as the breach of contract and will result in immediate termination of services.

- a. Invalid registration papers of vehicles deployed
- b. Operating vehicles without or expired comprehensive insurance coverage with unlimited liability of risk
- c. Tampering with odometer
- d. Any attempt to forge service related documentation

44. Breach of Contract: Breach of Contract shall result in penalties as per provisions of contract.

Breach of CONTRACT shall be defined as – if performance levels go below defined “lower performance” levels as specified in Contract.

45. Events of default – Following events may result in termination of services. The decision of Engineer-in-charge in this regard would be deemed final and binding.
