The GST Policy Wing, Central Board of Indirect Taxes & Customs has, on a reference seeking clarification on compulsory GST registration under the CGST Act, 2017 in each state in which work is to be taken up on contract, clarified as below.

**Sec. 22 (1):** Every supplier shall be liable to be registered under this Act in the State or Union territory, other than special category States, **from where he makes a taxable supply of goods or services or both**, if his aggregate turnover in a financial year exceeds twenty lakh rupees.....

Therefore, GST registration is required in the State/UT from where the contractor makes a taxable supply of goods or services or both, and not in other states. Accordingly, the following modification is made in SOP for CPWD Works Manual, 2019.
