- The intending bidder must read the terms and conditions of **CPWD-6** carefully. He should only submit his tender if he considers himself eligible and he is in possession of all the documents required.
- Information and Instructions for bidders posted on website shall form part of tender document.
- The bid document consisting of plans, specifications, the schedule of quantities of various types of items to be executed and the set of terms and conditions of the contract to be complied with and other necessary documents can be seen and downloaded from website <https://etender.cpwd.gov.in> or www.cpwd.gov.in free of cost.
- But the bid can only be submitted **after deposition of original EMD either in the office of Executive Engineer inviting bids or division office of any Executive Engineer, CPWD within the period of bid submission** and uploading the mandatory scanned documents such as Insurance Surety Bonds, Account Payee Demand Draft or Banker's Cheque or Fixed Deposit Receipts or / and Bank Guarantee (for balance amount as prescribed) from any Commercial Bank towards EMD in favour of **the Executive Engineer (E), Hindan Central Electrical Division, CPWD, AFS Hindan, Ghaziabad**, receipt for deposition of original EMD to division office of any Executive Engineer, (including NIT issuing EE/AE)CPWD and other documents as specified.

5. Those contractors who are not registered or have not updated their profile on the website mentioned above, are required to get registered /update their profile beforehand. The necessary training materials including the videos with step-to-step process are available on download section of <https://etender.cpwd.gov.in>.
6. The intending bidder must have valid class-III digital signature **certificate with the encryption key (combo type) to perform any operations / transactions on the e-tendering portal/ website and the bidder should download and install the eMsigner on their system as per instructions available on download section of <https://etender.cpwd.gov.in>.**
7. On opening date, the contractor can login and see the tender opening process. After opening of tenders, he will receive the competitor tender sheets.
8. Contractor can upload documents in the form of JPG format and PDF format.
9. Contractor must ensure to quote rate in the prescribed column (s) meant for quoting rate in figures appears in **Yellow** colour and the moment rate is entered, it turns **sky blue**.

In addition to this, while selecting any of the cells a warning appears that if any cell is left blank the same shall be treated as “0”.

Therefore, if any cell is left blank and no rate is quoted by the bidder, rate of such item shall be treated as “0” (ZERO).

However, if a tenderer quotes nil rates against each item in the item rate tender or does not quote any percentage above/below on the total amount of the tender or any section/ sub head in percentage rate tender, the tender shall be treated as invalid and will not be considered as lowest tenderer.

10. SC/ST contractors enlisted under class V category are exempted from processing fee payable to ITI.
11. **If the bidder has not possessed valid electrical license of appropriate voltage to execute electrical work, then in such a case the bidder shall scan and upload following under taking along with other bid documents.**

(A) The building category contractor shall have to associate other agency for execution of this work, which fulfills the eligibility criteria mentioned below.

In case the last date of submission of bid is extended, the enlistment of contractor should be valid on the original date of submission of bids.

1.1 The work is estimated to cost **Rs. 3,28,199/-**. This estimate, however, is given merely as a rough guide.

1.2 Intending bidders is eligible to submit the bid provided he has definite proof from the appropriate authority, which shall be to the satisfaction of the competent authority, of having satisfactorily completed similar works of magnitude specified below:-

2. Agreement shall be drawn with the successful bidders on prescribed Form No. CPWD 7 (or other Standard Form as mentioned) which is available as a Govt. of India Publication and also available on website <http://etender.cpwd.gov.in> Bidders shall quote his rates as per various terms and conditions of the said form which will form part of the agreement.

3. The time allowed for carrying out the work will be **1 (One) Month** from the date of start as defined in schedule 'F' or from the first date of handing over of the site, whichever is later, in accordance with the phasing, if any, indicated in the bid documents.

4. The site for the work is available.

5 The bid document consisting of plans, specifications, the schedule of quantities of various types of items to be executed and the set of terms and conditions of the contract to be complied with and other necessary documents except Standard General Conditions of Contract Form can be seen on website <http://etender.cpwd.gov.in>

6. After submission of the bid the contractor can re-submit revised bid any number of times but before last time and date of submission of bid as notified.

7 While submitting the revised bid, contractor can revise the rate of one or more item(s) any number of times (he need not re-enter rate of all the items) but before last time and date of submission of bid as notified.

8. When bids are invited in three stage system and if it is desired to submit revised financial bid then it shall be mandatory to submit revised financial bid. If not submitted then the bid submitted earlier shall become invalid.

9. Insurance Surety Bonds/Account Payee Demand Draft/ Fixed Deposit Receipt/Banker's Cheque Bank Guarantee of any Commercial Bank against EMD (drawn in favour of Executive Engineer (E), HCED, CPWD, HAF, HINDAN, GHAZIABAD) shall be scanned and uploaded to the e-Tendering website within the period of bid submission. The original EMD should be deposited either in the office of Executive Engineer inviting bids or division office of any Executive Engineer, CPWD within the period of bid submission. The EMD receiving Executive Engineer (including NIT issuing EE/AE) shall issue a receipt of deposition of earnest money deposit to the bidder in a prescribed format (enclosed) uploaded by tender inviting EE in the NIT.

A part of earnest money is acceptable in the form of bank guarantee also. In such case, minimum 50% of earnest money or Rs. 20 lac, whichever is less, shall have to be deposited in shape prescribed above, and balance may be deposited in shape of Bank Guarantee of any scheduled bank having validity for six months or more from the last date of receipt of bids which is to be scanned and uploaded by the intending bidders.

Copy of Enlistment Order and certificate of work experience and other documents shall be scanned and uploaded to the e-Tendering website within the period of bid submission. Online bid documents submitted by intending bidders shall be opened only of those bidders, whose original EMD deposited with any division of CPWD and other documents scanned and uploaded are found in order.

9A The contractors registered prior to 01.04.2015 on e-tendering portal of CPWD shall have to deposit tender processing fee at existing rates, or they have option to switch over to the new registration system without tender processing fee any time.

The bid submitted shall be opened at **18:00 PM on 18.08.2026**

10. The bid submitted shall become invalid and e-Tender processing fee shall not be refunded if:
- (i) The bidder is found ineligible.
 - (ii) The bidder does not upload scanned copies of all the documents stipulated in the bid document.
 - (iii) If any discrepancy is noticed between the documents as uploaded at the time of submission of bid.
 - (iv) If a tenderer quotes nil rates against each item in item rate tender or does not quote any percentage above/below on the total amount of the tender or any section / sub head in percentage rate tender, the tender shall be treated as invalid and will not be considered as lowest tenderer.

1. The contractor whose bid is accepted will be required to furnish performance guarantee of 5% of the estimated cost put to tender (ECPT) or contract amount whichever is higher. The Additional Performance Guarantee (APG) shall be equivalent to the difference between the 80% amount of ECPT and quoted amount. Direction in Performance Guarantee as per OM no. DG/Manual -2024/20 dated 27-02-2026 issued from file no. CSQ/CM/16(1)/2026 e file 9212995(DFA/9365789). This guarantee shall be in the form of earnest money Deposit at Call receipt of any scheduled bank/Banker's cheque of any scheduled Account Payee, Demand Draft of any scheduled bank/ Insurance Surety Bonds of any Scheduled Bank (in case guarantee amount is less than Rs. 1,00,000/-) or Government Securities or Fixed Deposit Receipts or Guarantee Bonds of any Scheduled Bank or the State Bank of India in accordance with the prescribed form. In case the contractor fails to deposit the said performance guarantee within the period as indicated in Schedule 'F', including the extended period if any, the Earnest Money deposited by the contractor shall be forfeited automatically without any notice to the contractor. The earnest money deposited alongwith bid shall be returned after receiving the aforesaid performance guarantee. The contractor whose bid is accepted will also be required to furnish either copy of applicable licenses/registrations or proof of applying for obtaining labour licenses, registration with EPFO, ESIC and BOCW Welfare Board including Provident Fund Code No. If applicable and also ensure the compliance of aforesaid provisions by the sub contractors, if any engaged by the contractor for the said work within the period specified in Schedule F.

2. The description of the work is as follows:

Intending Bidders are advised to inspect and examine the site and its surroundings and satisfy themselves before submitting their bids as to the nature of the ground and sub-soil (so far as is practicable), the form and nature of the site, the means of access to the site, the accommodation they may require and in general shall themselves obtain all necessary information as to risks, contingencies and other circumstances which may influence or affect their bid. A bidders shall be deemed to have full knowledge of the site whether he inspects it or not and no extra charge consequent on any misunderstanding or otherwise shall be allowed. The bidders shall be responsible for arranging and maintaining at his own cost all materials, tools & plants, water, electricity access, facilities for workers and all other services required for executing the work unless otherwise specifically provided for in the contract documents. Submission of a bid by a bidders implies that he has read this notice and all other contract documents and has made himself aware of the scope and specifications of the work to be done and of conditions and rates at which stores, tools and plant, etc. will be issued to him by the Government and local conditions and other factors having a bearing on the execution of the work.

13- The competent authority on behalf of the President of India does not bind itself to accept the lowest or any other bid and reserves to itself the authority to reject any or all the bids received without the assignment of any reason. All bids in which any of the prescribed condition is not fulfilled or any condition including that of conditional rebate is put forth by the bidders shall be summarily rejected.

14. Canvassing whether directly or indirectly, in connection with bidders is strictly prohibited and the bids submitted by the contractors who resort to canvassing will be liable for rejection.

15. The competent authority on behalf of President of India reserves to himself the right of accepting the whole or any part of the bid and the bidders shall be bound to perform the same at the rate quoted.

16. The contractor shall not be permitted to bid for works in the CPWD Circle (Division in case of contractors of Horticulture/Nursery category) responsible for award and execution of contracts, in which his near relative is posted a Divisional Accountant or as an officer in any capacity between the grades of Superintending Engineer and Junior Engineer (both inclusive). He shall also intimate the names of persons who are working with him in any capacity or are subsequently employed by him and who are near relatives to any gazetted officer in the Central Public Works Department or in the Ministry of Urban Development. Any breach of this condition by the contractor would render him liable to be removed from the approved list of contractors of this Department.

17. No Engineer of Gazetted Rank or other Gazetted Officer employed in Engineering or Administrative duties in an Engineering Department of the Government of India is allowed to work as a contractor for a period of one year after his retirement from Government service, without the prior permission of the Government of India in writing. This contract is liable to be cancelled if either the contractor or any of his employees is found any time to be such a person who had not obtained the permission of the Government of India as aforesaid before submission of the bid or engagement in the contractor's service.

18. The bid for the works shall remain open for acceptance for a period of **thirty(30)days** from the date of opening of bids (i) If any tenderer withdraws his tender or makes any modification in the terms & conditions of the tender which is not acceptable to the department within 7 days **after last date of submission of bids**, then the Government shall, without prejudice to any other right or remedy, be at liberty to forfeit 50% of the earnest money absolutely **irrespective of letter of acceptance for the work is issued or not.**(ii) If any tenderer withdraws his tender or makes any modification in the terms & conditions of the tender which is not acceptable to the department after expiry of 7 days **after last date of submission of bids**, then the Government shall without prejudice to any other right or remedy, be at liberty to forfeit 100% of the earnest money absolutely **irrespective of letter of acceptance for the work is issued or not.** Further the bidders shall not be allowed to participate in the rebidding process of the work

19. This notice inviting Bid shall form a part of the contract document. The successful bidders/contractor, on acceptance of his bid by the Accepting Authority shall within 15 days from the stipulated date of start of the work, sign the contract consisting of:-
