11. Contractor must ensure to quote rate of each item. The column meant for quoting rate in figures appears in pink color and the moment rate is entered, it turns sky blue.
12. In addition to this, while selecting any of the cells a warning appears that if any cell is left blank the same shall be treated as "0".
Therefore, if any cell is left blank and no rate is quoted by the bidder, rate of such item shall be treated as "0" (ZERO).
However, if a tenderer quotes nil rates against each item in item rate tender or does not quote any percentage above/below on the total amount of the tender or any section/sub head in Percentage Rate tender, the tender shall be treated as invalid and will not be considered as lowest tenderer.
13. The contractor whose bid is accepted will also be required to furnish either copy of applicable licenses/registrations or proof of applying for obtaining labour licenses, registration with EPFO, ESIC and BOCW Welfare Board and Programme Chart (Time and Progress) within the period specified in Schedule F. - 1.1.1 The authority competent to approve NIT for the combined cost and belonging to the major discipline will consolidate NITs for calling the bids. **Executive Engineer (E), Karnal Central Electrical Division, CPWD, Karnal** will deal with all matters relating to the invitation of bids.

- ~~1.1.2 For bid, besides indicating the combined estimated cost put to tender, should clearly indicate the estimated cost of each component separately. The eligibility of tenderer will correspond to the combined estimated cost of different components put to bid.~~

- 2 Agreement shall be drawn with the successful bidder on prescribed **Form No. CPWD 7** which is available as a Govt. of India Publication and also available on website **www.cpwd.gov.in**. Bidder shall quote his rates as per various terms and conditions of the said form which will form part of the agreement.

- 3 The time allowed for carrying out the work will be **12 Months** whichever is later, in accordance with the phasing, if any, indicated in the tender documents.

This contract is liable to be cancelled if either the contractor or any of his employees is found any time to be such a person who had not obtained the permission of the Government of India as aforesaid before submission of the tender or engagement in the contractor's service.

AND WHEREAS the Principal/Owner values full compliance with all relevant laws of the land, rules, regulations, economic use of resources and of fairness/transparency in its relation with its Bidder(s) and Contractor(s). AND WHEREAS to meet the purpose aforesaid both the parties have agreed to enter into this Integrity Agreement (hereinafter referred to as "**Integrity Pact**" or "**Pact**"), the terms and conditions of which shall also be read as integral part and parcel of the Tender/Bid documents and Contract between the parties.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of mutual covenants contained in this Pact, the parties hereby agree as follows and this Pact witnesses as under:

Article 1: Commitment of the Principal/Owner

- 1) The Principal/Owner commits itself to take all measures necessary to prevent corruption and to observe the following principles:

1. The work shall be executed as per CPWD General Specification of electrical works amended up to date.
2. The work shall be carried as per the direction and satisfaction of Engineer-in-charge.
3. The staff deployed on the work must possess qualification as given below:-
 - a) Fire Operator must have valid Electrical license or ITI in respective trade with minimum Five years experience in handling electrical equipments.
 - b) Helper/Khallasi having two years experience shall be 10th Pass & able to read & write Hindi.
4. The contractor will have to submit the details of worker like name, qualification, experience certificate as applicable to Engineer-in-Charge at the time of submission of PG.
5. The contractor shall be fully responsible for character and credentials and safety of the staff deployed by them at site. The staff deployed shall only be the liability of the contractor. No claim for continuation in service shall be entertained after expiry of contract period.
6. The contractor shall provide all necessary tools and plants to his workmen.
7. It is the responsibility of the contractor to keep the electrical installations neat & clean.
