- ~~The successful bidder/lowest bidder (to be called as Main Contractor) shall have to associate specialized agency(s) for execution of SITC of DG work work after acceptance of tender alongwith Performance Guarantee as per the details mentioned in “Special Conditions for association of Specialized Agencies”.~~
- The intending bidder must read the terms and conditions of CPWD-6 carefully. He should only submit his bid if he considers himself eligible and he is in possession of all the documents required.
- Information and Instructions for bidders posted on website shall form part of bid document.
- But the bid can only be submitted after deposition of original EMD either in the office of **Executive Engineer(E), ACED, CPWD, Agartala** inviting bid or Division office of any Executive Engineer, CPWD within the period of bid submission and uploading the mandatory scanned document such as Insurance surety Bonds, Account Payee Demand Draft or Bankers Cheque or Fixed Deposit Receipt or / and Bank guarantee (A part of earnest money is acceptable in the form of bank guarantee also. 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8. On opening date, the contractor can login and see the bid opening process. After opening of bids he will receive the competitor bid sheets.
9. Contractor can upload documents in the form of JPG format and PDF format.
10. Contractor must ensure to quote percentage rate of works component as given in template. The column meant for quoting percentage rate in figures appears in pink colour and the moment rate is entered, it turns sky blue.
11. In addition to this, while selecting any of the cells a warning appears that if any cell is left blank the same shall be treated as "0". Therefore, if any cell is left blank and no rate is quoted by the bidder, rate of such item shall be treated as "0" (ZERO). However, if tenderer does not quote any percentage above or below on the total amount of the tender or any section / sub head in percentage tender, the tender shall be treated as invalid and not consider lowest tender.
12. The department reserves the right to reject any prospective application without assigning any reason and to restrict the list of qualified contractors to any number deemed suitable by it, if too many bids are received satisfying the laid down criterion.

14. The intending contractor is advised to visit the site of work, of his own, to acquainting himself regarding site details etc. prior to quoting the tender.

To become eligible for issue of bid, the bidders shall have to furnish an affidavit as under:-

~~"I/We undertake and confirm that eligible similar works(s) has/have not been got executed through another contractor on back to back basis. Further that, if such a~~

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~~violation comes to the notice of Department, then I/we shall be debarred for bidding in CPWD in future forever. Also, if such a violation comes to the notice of Department before date of start of work, the Engineer in Charge shall be free to forfeit the entire amount of Earnest Money Deposit/Performance Guarantee. (Scanned copy to be uploaded at the time of submission of bid)~~

- ~~1-2-3 When bids are invited from non CPWD contractors and CPWD class II contractors as per provisions of **clause 1.2.1** above, it will be mandatory for non CPWD contractors and CPWD class II contractors to upload the work experience certificate(s) and the affidavit as per the provisions of **clause 1.2.2**.~~

~~But for such bids, Class I contractors of CPWD are eligible to submit the bids without submission of work experience certificate and affidavit. Therefore, CPWD class I contractors shall upload two separate letters for experience certificate and affidavit that these documents are not required to be submitted by them. Uploading of these two letters is mandatory otherwise system will not clear mandatory fields.~~

2. Agreement shall be drawn with the successful bidders on prescribed Form No. **CPWD 7/8** (or other Standard Form as mentioned) which is available as a Govt. of India Publication and also available on website www.cpwd.gov.in Bidders shall quote his rates as per various terms and conditions of the said form which will form part of the agreement.
3. The time allowed for carrying out the work will be **02 (Two) Months** from the date of start as defined in schedule 'F' or from the first date of handing over of the site, whichever is later, in accordance with the phasing, if any, indicated in the bid documents.

5. The bid document consisting of plans, specifications, the schedule of quantities of various types of items to be executed and the set of terms and conditions of the contract to be complied with and other necessary documents except Standard General Conditions of Contract Form can be seen on website www.etender.cpwd.gov.in or www.cpwd.gov.in free of cost.
6. After submission of the bid the contractor can re-submit revised bid any number of times but before last time and date of submission of bid as notified.
7. While submitting the revised bid, contractor can revise the rate of one or more item(s) any number of times (he need not re-enter rate of all the items) but before last time and date of submission of bid as notified.
8. When bids are invited in three stage system and if it is desired to submit revised financial bid then it shall be mandatory to submit revised financial bid. If not submitted then the bid submitted earlier shall become invalid.

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9. Earnest Money in the form of Insurance surety Bonds, Account Payee Demand Draft, Fixed Deposit Receipt, Banker's Cheque or Bank guarantee including e-Bank Guarantee (for balance amount as prescribed) from any of the Commercial Banks (drawn in favour of **Executive Engineer(E), Agartala Central Electrical Division (ACED), CPWD, Agartala.**) shall be scanned and uploaded to the e-tendering website within the period of bid submission. The original EMD should be deposited either in the office of **Executive Engineer (E), ACED, CPWD, Agartala** inviting bids or Division office of any Executive Engineer, CPWD within the period of bid submission. The EMD receiving Executive Engineer (including NIT issuing EE/AE) shall issue a Receipt of deposition of earnest money deposit to the bidder in a prescribed format (enclosed) uploaded by tender inviting EE in the NIT.

A part of earnest money is acceptable in the form of Bank Guarantee also. In such case, minimum 50% of earnest money or Rs.20 lakh, whichever is less, shall have to be deposited in shape prescribed above, and balance may be deposited in shape of Bank Guarantee including e-Bank Guarantee of any Commercial Bank having validity for a period of 90 days for single bid works and 180 days for two bid system or more from the last dater of receipt of bids which is to be scanned and uploaded by the intending bidders.

The earnest money given by all the tenderers except the lowest tenderer shall be refunded immediately after the expiry of stipulated bid validity period or immediately after acceptance of the successful bidder, whichever is earlier. However, in case of two/three bid system, earnest money deposit of bidders unsuccessful during technical bid evaluation etc. should be returned within 30 days of declaration of result of technical bid evaluation.

Copy of Enlistment Order and certificate of work experience and other documents as specified in the notice inviting e-tender shall be scanned and uploaded on the e-Tendering website within the period of bid submission. However, certified copy of all the scanned and uploaded documents as specified in e-tender notice shall have to be submitted by the lowest bidder within a week physically in the office of tender opening authority. Onlienabid documents submitted by intending bidders shall be opened only of those bides, who has deposited EMD with any division of CPWD and other documents scanned and uploaded are found in order.

The bid submitted shall be opened at 15:30 Hrs on 29/08/2026.

10. The bid submitted shall become invalid and e-Tender processing fee (if applicable) shall not be refunded if:
- (i) The bidder is found ineligible.
 - (ii) The bidder does not upload scanned copies of all the documents stipulated in the bid document.
 - (iii) If any discrepancy is noticed between the documents as uploaded at the time of submission of bid and hard copies as submitted physically by the **lowest BIDDER** in the office of tender opening authority.
 - (iv) If a tenderer quotes nil rates against each item in item rate tender or does not quote any percentage above/ below on the total amount of the tender or any section/ sub head in percentage rate tender, the tender shall be treated as invalid and will not be considered as lowest tenderer.
11. The contractor whose bid is accepted, will be required to furnish performance guarantee at specified percentage of the tendered amount as mentioned in Schedule 'E' and within the period specified in Schedule F. This guarantee shall be in the form of Insurance Surety Bonds, Account Payee Demand Draft, Fixed Deposit Receipt or Bank Guarantee from any of the Commercial Banks in accordance with the prescribed form. In case the contractor fails to deposit the said performance guarantee within the period as indicated in Schedule 'F', including the extended period if any, then Earnest Money deposited by the contractor shall be forfeited automatically without any notice to the contractor. The Earnest Money deposited

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alongwith the bid shall be returned after receiving the aforesaid Performance Guarantee. The Contractor **whose bid is accepted will also be required to furnish either copy of applicable licenses/registrations or proof of applying for obtaining labour licenses, registration with EPFO, ESIC and BOCW Welfare Board including Provident Fund Code No. if applicable and also ensure the compliance of aforesaid provisions by the sub contractors, if any engaged by the contractor for the said work within the period specified in Schedule F.**

12. The description of work is as follows:

Intending bidders are advised to inspect and examine the site and its surroundings and satisfy themselves before submitting their bids as to the nature of the ground and sub-soil (so far as is practicable), the form and nature of the site, the means of access to the site, the accommodation they may require and in general shall themselves obtain all necessary information as to risks, contingencies and other circumstances which may influence or affect their bid. A bidders shall be deemed to have full knowledge of the site whether he inspects it or not and no extra charge consequent on any misunderstanding or otherwise shall be allowed. The bidders shall be responsible for arranging and maintaining at his own cost all materials, tools & plants, water, electricity access, facilities for workers and all other services required for executing the work unless otherwise specifically provided for in the contract documents. Submission of a bid by a bidders implies that he has read this notice and all other contract documents and has made himself aware of the scope and specifications of the work to be done and of conditions and rates at which stores, tools and plant, etc. will be issued to him by the Government and local conditions and other factors having a bearing on the execution of the work.

13. The competent authority on behalf of the President of India does not bind itself to accept the lowest or any other bid and reserves to itself the authority to reject any or all the bids received without the assignment of any reason. All bids in which any of the prescribed condition is not fulfilled or any condition including that of conditional rebate is put forth by the bidders shall be summarily rejected.
14. Canvassing whether directly or indirectly, in connection with bidders is strictly prohibited and the bids submitted by the contractors who resort to canvassing will be liable to rejection.
15. The competent authority on behalf of President of India reserves to himself the right of accepting the whole or any part of the bid and the bidders shall be bound to perform the same at the rate quoted.
16. The contractor shall not be permitted to bid for works in the CPWD Circle (Division in case of contractors of Horticulture/Nursery category) responsible for award and execution of contracts, in which his near relative is posted a Divisional Accountant or as an officer in any capacity between the grades of Superintending Engineer to Junior Engineer (both inclusive). He shall also intimate the names of persons who are working with him in any capacity or are subsequently employed by him and who are near relatives to any gazette officer in the Central Public Works Department or in the Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs. Any breach of this condition by the contractor would render him liable to be removed from the approved list of contractors of this Department.
17. No Engineer of Gazetted Rank or other Gazetted Officer employed in Engineering or Administrative duties in an Engineering Department of the Government of India is allowed to work as a contractor for a period of one year after his retirement from Government service, without the prior permission of the Government of India in writing. This contract is liable to be cancelled if either the contractor or any of his employees is found any time to be such a person who had not obtained the permission of the Government of India as aforesaid before submission of the bid or engagement in the contractor's service.

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18. The bids for the work shall remain open for acceptance for a **period of 30 (thirty) Days from the date of opening of bids in case of single bid system and 75 (seventy five) days from the date of opening of Technical bids in case bids are invited in 2 or 3 bid system.**

Further.

- (i) If any tenderer withdraws his tender or makes any modification in the terms & conditions of the tender which is not acceptable to the department within 7 days after last date of submission of bids, then the Government shall without prejudice to any other right or remedy be at liberty to forfeit 50% of the earnest money absolutely irrespective of letter of acceptance for the work is issued or not.
 - (ii) If any tenderer withdraws his tender or makes any modification in the terms & conditions of the tender which is not acceptable to the department after expiry of 7 days after last date of submission of bids, then the government shall without prejudice to any other right or remedy, be at liberty to forfeit 100% of the earnest money absolutely irrespective of letter of acceptance for the work is issued or not.
 - (iii) In case of forfeiture of earnest money as prescribed in para (i) and (ii) above, the bidders shall not be allowed to participate in the rebidding process of the same work.
19. This notice inviting Bid shall form a part of the contract document. The successful bidder/contractor, on acceptance of his bid by the Accepting Authority shall within 15 days from the stipulated date of start of the work, sign the contract consisting of:-
- a) The Notice Inviting Bid, all the documents including additional conditions, specifications and drawings, if any, forming part of the bid as uploaded at the time of invitation of bid and rates quoted online at the time of submission of bid and acceptance thereof together with any correspondence leading thereto.
 - b) Standard C.P.W.D. Form 7/8 or other Standard C.P.W.D. Form as applicable.

20. For Composite Bids

20-1-1 The Executive Engineer in charge of the major component will call bids for the composite work. The cost of bid document and Earnest Money will be fixed with respect to the combined estimated cost put to tender for the composite bid.

20.1.2 ~~The bid document will include following three components:~~

~~**Part A:** CPWD-6, CPWD-7/8 including schedule A to F for the major component of the work, Standard General Conditions of Contract for CPWD 2014 as amended/modified upto.....~~

~~**Part B:** General / specific conditions, specifications and quantities applicable to major component of the work.~~

~~**Part C:** Schedule A to F for minor component of the work. (competent authority under clause 2 and clause 5 shall be same authority as mentioned in schedule A to F for major components), General/specific conditions, specifications and schedule of quantities applicable to minor component(s) of the work.~~

20.1.3 The bidders must associate himself, with agencies as per NIT conditions.

20.1.4 The eligible bidders shall quote rates for all items of major component as well as for all items of minor components of work.

20.1.5 After acceptance of the bid by competent authority, the EE in charge of major component of the work shall issue letter of award on behalf of the President of India.
