- Information and Instructions for bidders posted on website shall form part of bid document.
- The bid document consisting of plans, specifications, the schedule of quantities of various types of items to be executed and the set of terms and conditions of the contract to be complied with and other necessary documents can be seen and downloaded from website <https://etender.cpwd.gov.in> free of cost.
- But the bid can only be submitted after **deposition of original EMD either in the office of Deputy Director (Hort.) inviting bids or division office of any Executive Engineer, CPWD within the period of bid submission. (The EMD document shall only be issued from the place in which the office of receiving division office is situated)** and uploading the mandatory scanned documents such as Demand Draft or pay order or Banker's Cheque or Deposit at call Receipt or Fixed Deposit Receipts and Bank Guarantee of any Commercial Bank towards EMD in Favour of **Deputy Director (Horticulture), CPWD, Bhopal, receipt for deposition of original EMD to division office of any Executive Engineer, CPWD** and other documents as specified.
- Those contractors not registered on the website mentioned above, are required to get themselves registered beforehand. If needed they can be imparted training on online bidding process as per details available on the website.
- The intending bidder must have valid class-III digital signature to submit the bid.
- On opening date, the contractor can login and see the bid opening process. After opening of bids he will receive the competitor bid sheets.
- Contractor can upload documents in the form of **JPG** format and **PDF** format.

9. Contractor must ensure to quote Percentage rate . The column meant for quoting rate in figures appears in pink colour and the moment rate is entered, it turns sky blue.

In addition to this, while selecting any of the cells a warning appears that if any cell is left blank the same shall be treated as "0". **However, if a tenderer quotes nil rates against each item in item rate tender or does not quote any percentage above / below on the total amount of the tender or any section / sub head in Percentage rate tender, the tender shall be treated as invalid and will not be considered as lowest tenderer.**

1. Percentage rate tenders are invited on behalf of President of India from approved and eligible contractors of CPWD registered in Horticulture category for the work of :- **“M/o. Garden area attached to Narcotics Office & Colony Campus at Mall Road Murar and Narcotics Commissioner Bungalow at Murar, Gwalior during 2026-27. SH:- Complete maintenance of garden features.”** The enlistment of the contractors should be valid on the last date of submission of bids. In case the last date of submission of bid is extended, the enlistment of contractor should be valid on the original date of submission of bids.

1.1 The work is estimated Cost of ₹ 15,91,821/-.

This estimate, however, is given merely as a rough guide.

1.1.1 The authority competent to approve NIT for the combined cost and belonging to the major discipline will consolidate NITs for calling the bids. He will also nominate Division which will deal with all matters relating to the invitation of bids.

For composite bid, besides indicating the combined estimated cost put to bid, should clearly indicate the estimated cost of each component separately. The eligibility of bidders will correspond to the combined estimated cost of different components put to bid.

1.2 Intending bidder is eligible to submit the bid provided he has definite proof from the appropriate authority, which shall be to the satisfaction of the competent authority, of having satisfactorily completed similar works of magnitude specified below:-

Criteria of eligibility for submission of bid documents

1.2.1 Condition for Non-CPWD contractors only, if bids are also open to Non-CPWD contractor.

For works estimated cost up to modified as per bidding limit of CPWD class I / Group A contractors of respective discipline as the case may be).

Three similar works each of value not less than ₹ 401 lakh or two similar works each of value not less than ₹ 502 lakh or one similar work of value not less than ₹ 803 lakh in last 7 years ending previous day of last date of submission of bids.

Similar works means 'Building Work' and 'Civil Work'.

The value of executed works shall be at costing level by enhancing the actual value of work at simple rate of 7% per annum; calculated from the date of completion to last date of receipt of tenders.

Note :-

For works costing above Rs. 10.5 Crore but up to Rs. 30 Crore, (However for Horticulture and Furniture etc. discipline, the figure of Rs. 10.5 Crore and Rs. 30 Crore may be modified as per bidding limit of CPWD Class II/ Group B and CPWD Class I/ Group A contractors respectively of respective discipline as the case may be) when bids are open to non-CPWD contractors also, then Class II contractors of CPWD shall also be eligible if they satisfy the eligibility criteria specified in 1.2.1 above.

Class II contractors of CPWD should be registered for Western Region / Rajasthan / Delhi.

1.2.2 Criteria of eligibility for CPWD as well as non-CPWD contractors :

For works estimated to cost above Rs. 3020-Crores (However for Horticulture and Furniture etc. discipline, the figure of Rs. 30 Crore may be modified as per bidding limit of CPWD Class I contractor of respective discipline as the case may be.) NOT APPLICABLE.

To become eligible for issue of bid, the bidders shall have to furnish an affidavit as under:-
I/We undertake and confirm that eligible similar works(s) has/have not been got executed through another contractor on back to back basis. Further that, if such a violation comes to the notice of Department, then I/we shall be debarred for tendering in CPWD in future forever. Also, if such a violation comes to the notice of Department before date of start of work, the Engineer-in-Charge shall be free to forfeit the entire amount of Earnest Money Deposit/Performance Guarantee. (Scanned copy to be uploaded at the time of submission of bid).

1.2.3 For CPWD class II/ Non CPWD contractors ~~as per the provisions of clause 1.2.1 above, it will be mandatory to upload the work experience certificate (s) and the affidavit as per the provisions of clause 1.2.2.~~ **DELETED**

For such bids, Class-I contractors of CPWD are however eligible to submit the bids without submission of work experience certificate and affidavit. Therefore, CPWD class-I contractors shall upload two separate letters for experience certificate and affidavit to the effect that these documents are not required to be submitted by them. Uploading of these two letters is mandatory otherwise system will not clear mandatory fields.

1.3 To become eligible for issue of bid, the bidder shall have to furnish an affidavit as under:-

I/We undertake and confirm that eligible similar works(s) has/have not been got executed through another contractor on back to back basis. Further that, if such a violation comes to the notice of Department, then I/we shall be debarred for tendering in CPWD in future forever. Also, if such a violation comes to the notice of Department before date of start of work, the Engineer-in-Charge shall be free to forfeit the entire amount of Earnest Money Deposit/Performance Guarantee. (Scanned copy to be uploaded at the time of submission of bid).

2. Agreement shall be drawn with the successful bidders on prescribed Form No. CPWD 7 which is available as a Govt. of India Publication and also available on website **www.cpwd.gov.in**. Bidder shall quote his rates as per various terms and conditions of the said form, which will form part of the agreement.

3. The time allowed for carrying out the work will be **12 (Twelve) Months** from the date of start as defined in schedule 'F' or from the first date of handing over of the site, whichever is later, in accordance with the phasing, if any, indicated in the bid documents.

6. After submission of the bid the contractor can re-submit revised bid any number of times but before last date and time of submission of bid as notified.
7. While submitting the revised bid, contractor can revise the quoted rates but before last date and time of submission of bid as notified.
8. When bids are invited in three stage system and if it is desired to submit revised financial bid then it shall be mandatory to submit revised financial bid. If not submitted then the bid submitted earlier shall become invalid.
- 9 Earnest Money in the form of Treasury Challan or Demand Draft or Pay order or Banker's Cheque or Deposit at Call Receipt or Fixed Deposit receipt (drawn in favour of **Deputy Director (Horticulture), CPWD, Bhopal** shall be scanned and uploaded to the e-Tendering website within the period of bid submission. **The original EMD should be deposited either in the office of Executive Engineer inviting bids or division office of any Executive Engineer, CPWD within the period of bid submission. (The EMD document shall only be issued from the place in which the office of receiving division office is situated).** The EMD receiving Executive Engineer shall issue a receipt of deposition of earnest money deposit to the bidder in a prescribed format (enclosed at page No 32 this NIT) uploaded by tender inviting EE in the NIT .
The receipt shall also be uploaded to the e- tendering website by the intending bidder up to the specified bid submission date and time .
A part of earnest money is acceptable in the form of bank guarantee also. In such case, 50% of earnest money or Rs. 20 lakh, whichever is less, shall have to be deposited in shape prescribed above, and may be deposited in shape of Bank Guarantee of any scheduled Bank having validity for six months or more from the last date of receipt of bids which is to be scanned and uploaded by the intending bidders
Copy of Enlistment Order ~~and certificate of work experience~~ and other documents as specified in the press notice shall be scanned and uploaded to the e-Tendering website within the period of bid submission.

Online bid documents submitted by intending bidders shall be opened only of those bidders, whose original EMD deposited with any Division office of CPWD and other documents scanned and uploaded are found in order.

The bid submitted shall be opened at **11.30 AM** on **10.08.2026**.

- 9 A) The contractors registered prior to 01.04.2015 on e-tendering portal of CPWD shall have to deposit tender processing fee at existing rates or they have option to switch over to the new registration system without tender processing fee any time.
10. The bid submitted shall become invalid and e-Tender processing fee shall not be refunded if:
 - (i) The bidder is found ineligible.
 - (ii) The bidder does not deposit original EMD with Division office of any Executive Engineer, CPWD.
 - (iii) The bidder does not upload scanned copies of all the documents stipulated in the bid document.

- (iv) If a tenderer quotes nil rates against each item in Percentage rate tender or does not quote any percentage above / below on the total amount of the tender or any section /sub head in Percentage rate tender, the tender shall be treated as invalid and will not be considered as lowest tenderer.
11. The contractor whose bid is accepted will be required to furnish performance guarantee (drawn in favour of **Deputy Director (Horticulture), CPWD, Bhopal**) 5% (Five Percent) of the bid amount within the period specified in Schedule F. This guarantee shall be Deposit at Call Receipt of any Scheduled Bank/Banker's Cheque of any Scheduled Bank/Demand Draft of any Scheduled Bank/Pay Order of any Scheduled Bank (in case guarantee amount is less than Rs. 1,00,000/-) or Government Securities or Fixed Deposit Receipts or Guarantee Bonds of any Scheduled Bank or the State Bank of India in accordance with the prescribed form. In case the contractor fails to deposit the said performance guarantee within the period as indicated in Schedule 'F' including the extended period if any, the Earnest Money deposited by the contractor shall be forfeited automatically without any notice to the contractor. The Earnest Money deposited along with bid shall be returned after receiving the aforesaid performance guarantee. **The contractor whose bid is accepted will also be required to furnish either copy of applicable licenses / registrations or proof of applying for obtaining labour licenses, registration with EPFO, ESIC and BOCW Welfare Board including Provident Fund Code No. if applicable and also ensure the compliance of aforesaid provisions by the sub-contractors, if any, engaged by the contractor for the said work and Programme Chart (Time and Progress) within the period specified in Schedule F.**
12. **The description of the work is as follows:-**
The scope of work includes:- M/o. Garden area attached to Narcotics Office & Colony Campus at Mall Road Murar and Narcotics Commissioner Bunglow at Murar, Gwalior during 2026-27. SH:- Complete maintenance of garden features.
 Intending Bidders are advised to inspect and examine the site and its surroundings and satisfy themselves before submitting their bids as to the nature of the ground and sub-soil (so far as is practicable), the form and nature of the site, the means of access to the site, the accommodation they may require and in general shall themselves obtain all necessary information as to risks, contingencies and other circumstances which may influence or affect their bid. A bidder shall be deemed to have full knowledge of the site whether he inspects it or not and no extra charge consequent on any misunderstanding or otherwise shall be allowed. The bidder shall be responsible for arranging and maintaining at his own cost all materials, tools & plants, water, electricity access, facilities for workers and all other services required for executing the work unless otherwise specifically provided for in the contract documents. Submission of a bid by a bidder implies that he has read this notice and all other contract documents and has made himself aware of the scope and specifications of the work to be done and of conditions and rates at which stores, tools and plant, etc. will be issued to him by the Government and local conditions and other factors having a bearing on the execution of the work.
13. The competent authority on behalf of the President of India does not bind itself to accept the lowest or any other bid and reserves to itself the authority to reject any or all the bids received without the assignment of any reason. All bids in which any of the prescribed condition is not fulfilled or any condition including that of conditional rebate is put forth by the bidders shall be summarily rejected.

14. Canvassing whether directly or indirectly, in connection with bidders is strictly prohibited and the bids submitted by the contractors who resort to canvassing will be liable for rejection.
15. The competent authority on behalf of President of India reserves to himself the right of accepting the whole or any part of the bid and the bidder shall be bound to perform the same at the rate quoted.
16. The contractor (enlisted or non-enlisted in CPWD) shall not be allowed to participate in the tender for work(s) in the CPWD Zone/circle/Division/Sub-Division responsible for award and/or execution of contract(s) in which his near relative is posted as Divisional Accountant or as an officer in any capacity between the grades of the Chief Engineer and Junior Engineer (both inclusive). He shall also intimate the names of persons who are working or are subsequently employed by him and who are near relatives to any Officer working in the CPWD. Any breach of this condition by the contractor would render him liable to be debarred for a period upto two years from tendering in CPWD as decided by the accepting authority mentioned in Schedule F and his decision will be excepted from clause 25.
17. No Engineer of Gazetted Rank or other Gazetted Officer employed in Engineering or Administrative duties in an Engineering Department of the Government of India is allowed to work as a contractor for a period of one year after his retirement from Government service, without the prior permission of the Government of India in writing. This contract is liable to be cancelled if either the contractor or any of his employees is found any time to be such a person who had not obtained the permission of the Government of India as aforesaid before submission of the bid or engagement in the contractor's service.
18. The **bids** for the **works** shall remain open for acceptance for a period of **Thirty (30)** days from the date of opening of bids.
 - (i) If any tenderer withdraws his tender or makes any modification in terms & conditions of the tender which is not acceptable to the department ~~within 7 days after last date of submission of bids, then the Government shall without prejudice to any other right or remedy, be at liberty to forfeit 50 of the said earnest money take action as per EMD declaration Proforma absolutely irrespective of letter of acceptance for the work is issued or not.~~
 - (ii) ~~If any tenderer withdraws his tender or makes any modification in the terms & conditions of the tender which is not acceptable to the department after expiry of 7 days after last date of submission of bids, then the Government shall without prejudice to any other right or remedy, be at liberty to take action as per EMD declaration Proforma forfeit 100% of the earnest money absolutely irrespective of letter of acceptance for the work is issued or not.~~
 - (iii) ~~In case of forfeiture of earnest money as prescribed in para (i) and (ii) above,~~ the bidders shall not be allowed to participate in the rebidding process of the same work and also suspended for one year and shall not be eligible to bid for CPWD tenders from date of issue of suspension order.
19. This Notice Inviting Bid shall form a part of the contract document. The successful bidder / contractor, on acceptance of his bid by the Accepting Authority shall within 15 days from the stipulated date of start of the work, sign the contract consisting of:-
 - a) The Notice Inviting Bid, all the documents including additional conditions, specifications and drawings, if any, forming part of the bid as uploaded at the time of invitation of bid and the rates quoted online at the time of submission of bid and acceptance thereof together with any correspondence & negotiation leading thereto.
 - b) Standard C.P.W.D. Form 7 amended upto a date previous to last date of submission of.

20. For Composite Bids

20.1.1 The Executive Engineer in Charge of the major component will call bids for the composite work. The Earnest Money will be fixed with respect to the combined estimated cost put to tender for the composite bid.

20.1.2 The bid document will include following three components:

Part A:- CPWD-6, CPWD-7 including Schedule A to F for the major component of the work, Standard General Conditions of Contract for CPWD, 2020 as amended/ modified upto DG/CON/314 dated 24.02.2021.

Part B:- Particular Specifications and Special conditions, specifications and schedule of quantities as applicable to major component of the work.

Part C:- Schedule A to F for minor component of the work. (SE/EE in charge of major component shall also be competent authority under clause 2 and clause 5 as mentioned in Schedule A to F for major components). Special Conditions, additional terms & conditions, specifications and schedule of quantities applicable to minor component(s) of the work.

20.1.3 For electrical works, the bidder should have **valid electrical license from competent authority in the name of the contractor. However, the contractors is allowed to participate in tender with an undertaking that they will either obtain valid electrical license at the time of execution of electrical work or associate contractors having valid electrical license of eligible class.**

20.1.4 The eligible bidders shall **DELETED** major component as well as for minor components of work.

20.1.5 After acceptance of the bid by competent authority, the EE in-charge of major component of the work shall issue letter of award on behalf of the President of India. After the work is awarded, the main contractor will have to enter into one agreement with EE in charge of major component and has also to sign two or more copies of agreement depending upon number of EE's in charge of minor components. One such signed set of agreement shall be handed over to EE/DDH in charge of minor component. EE of major component will operate Part A and Part B of the agreement. EE in charge of minor component(s) shall operate Part C respectively along with Part A of the agreement.

20.1.6 Entire work under the scope of composite bid including major and all minor components shall be executed under one agreement.

20.1.7 Security Deposit will be worked out separately for each component corresponding to the estimated cost of the respective component of work.

20.1.8 If required, the main contractor has to associate agency(s) for minor component(s) conforming to eligibility criteria as defined in the bid document and has to submit detail of such agency(s) to Engineer-in-Charge of minor component(s) within prescribed time. Name of the agency(s) to be associated shall be approved by Engineer-in-Charge of minor component(s).

20.1.9	In case the main contractor intends to change any of the above agency/agencies during the operation of the contract, he shall obtain prior approval of Engineer-in-charge of minor component. The new agency/agencies shall also have to satisfy the laid down eligibility criteria. In case Engineer-in-Charge is not satisfied with the performance of any agency, he can direct the contractor to change the agency executing such items of work and this shall be binding on the contractor.
20.1.10	The main contractor has to enter into agreement with contractor(s) associated by him for execution of minor component(s). Copy of such agreement shall be submitted to EE/DDH in charge of each minor component as well as to EE in charge of major component. In case of change of associate contractor, the main contractor has to enter into agreement with the new contractor associated by him.
20.1.11	Running payment for the DELETED shall be made by EE of major discipline to the main contractor. Running payment for minor components shall be made by the Engineer-in-charge of the discipline of minor component directly to the main contractor.
20.1.12(A)	The composite work shall be treated as complete when all the components of the work are complete. The completion certificate of the composite work shall be recorded by Engineer -in -charge of major component after record of completion certificate of all other components.
20.1.12(B)	Final bill of whole work shall be finalized and paid by the EE of major component. Engineer(s) in charge of minor component(s) will prepare and pass the final bill for their component of work and pass on the same to the EE of major component for including in the final bill for composite contract.

21.0 A new provision of Integrity Pact (IP) was introduced in GCC-2023 it is mentioned that at the time of submission of bid, it shall be mandatory to sign the pact by the bidder failing which the bidder will stand disqualified from the tendering process and such bid would be summarily rejected.

In case of e-tendering, Integrity Pact shall be treated in the same manner as other components of the bid document. In e-tendering, the intending bidder does not sign any document physically and entire bid document is submitted through digital signature. Since IP is a part of bid document no separate physical submission is required with other documents to be submitted in the office of tender opening authority. In addition to other component of bid document, the Integrity Pact along shall also be signed between Deputy Director (Hort.) and successful bidder after acceptance of bid.

22.0 Jurisdiction of Courts

The Court of the place from where the letter of award of work has been issued shall have the jurisdiction to decide any dispute arising out of or in respect of the contract.

23.0 CPWD does not have funds of its own and it carries out the works of client departments from their funds (deposit, budgetary, authorization). The CPWD is making payments to the contractors after getting budget / authorization / deposit from various Ministries / Client Departments. The payment to the contractor can be done only on availability of funds for that work from client department and in case of delay in getting funds from Ministry / Client Department, CPWD will not be responsible for delay in payment and no any extra compensation on this account shall be granted apart from specified elsewhere in this document. The contractor has to quote his tender accordingly considering this aspect.

INTEGRITY PACT

(Integrity Pact is applicable for all works of estimated cost put to tender equal to or more than the threshold value given in Schedule-F)

President of India represented by the Engineer-in- Charge (hereinafter referred to as the Principal, which expression shall unless repugnant to the meaning or context hereof includes its successors and permitted assignees)

AND

(Hereinafter referred to as the **Bidder/Contractor** and which expression shall unless repugnant to the meaning or context hereof include its successors and permitted assignees)

Preamble

WHEREAS the Principal has floated the Tender (NIT No.....) (hereinafter referred to as the “**Tender**”) and intends to award, under laid down organizational procedure, contract for (Name of work).....
Hereinafter referred to as the Contract.

AND WHEREAS the Principal values full compliance with all relevant laws of the land, rules, regulations, economic use of resources and of fairness/transparency in its relation with its Bidder(s) and Contractor(s).

Agreement (hereinafter referred to as “**Integrity Pact**”), the terms and conditions of which shall also be read as integral part and parcel of the Tender/Bid documents and Contract between the parties.

In order to achieve these goals, the Principal will appoint Independent External monitors (IEMs) who will monitor the tender process and the execution of the contract for compliance with the principles mentioned hereunder.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of mutual covenants contained in this Pact, the parties hereby agree as follows and this Integrity Pact witnesses as under:

Articles

Article 1: Commitment of the Principal

The Principal commits itself to take all measures necessary to prevent corruption and to observe the following principles:

- (a) No employee of the Principal, personally or through any of his/her family members, will in connection with the Tender, or the execution of the Contract, demand, take a promise for or accept, for self or third person, any material or immaterial benefit which the person is not legally entitled to.
 - (b) The Principal will, during the Tender process, treat all Bidder(s) with equity and reason. The Principal will, in particular, before and during the Tender process, provide to all Bidder(s) the same information and will not provide to any Bidder(s) confidential / additional information through which the Bidder(s) could obtain an advantage in relation to the Tender process or the Contract execution.
 - (c) The Principal shall Endeavour to exclude from the Tender process any person, whose conduct in the past has been of biased nature.
- 2) If the Principal obtains information on the conduct of any of its employees which is a criminal offence under the Indian Penal code (IPC) / Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988 (PC Act) or is in violation of the principles herein mentioned or if there be a substantive suspicion in this regard, the Principal will inform the Chief Vigilance Officer and in addition can also initiate disciplinary actions as per its internal laid down policies and procedures.

Article 2: Commitment of the Bidder (s) / Contractor (s)

- 1) It is required that each Bidder / Contractor (including their respective officers, employees and agents) adhere to the highest ethical standards, and report to the Government / Department all suspected acts of **fraud or corruption or Coercion or Collusion** of which it has knowledge or becomes aware, during the tendering process and throughout the negotiation or award of a contract.
- 2) The Bidder(s) / Contractor(s) commits himself to take all measures necessary to prevent corruption. He commits himself to observe the following principles during his participation in the Tender process and during the Contract execution:
 - a) The Bidder(s) / Contractor(s) will not, directly or through any other person or firm, offer, promise or give to any of the Principal employees involved in the Tender process or execution of the Contract or to any third person any material or other benefit which he/she is not legally entitled to, in order to obtain in exchange any advantage of any kind whatsoever during the Tender process or during the execution of the Contract.

- b) The Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) will not enter with other Bidder(s) into any undisclosed agreement or understanding, whether formal or informal. This applies in particular to prices, specifications, certifications, subsidiary contracts, submission or non-submission of bids or any other actions to restrict competitiveness or to cartelize in the bidding process.
 - c) The Bidder(s) / Contractor(s) will not commit any offence under the relevant IPC/PC Act. Further the Bidder(s) / Contractor(s) will not use improperly, (for the purpose of competition or personal gain), or pass on to others, any information or documents provided by the Principal/Owner as part of the business relationship, regarding plans, technical proposals and business details, including information contained or transmitted electronically.
 - d) The Bidder(s)/ Contractor(s) of foreign origin shall disclose the names and addresses of agents / representatives in India, if any. Similarly Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) of Indian Nationality shall disclose names and addresses of foreign agents/representatives, if any. Either the Indian agent on behalf of the foreign principal or the foreign principal directly could bid in a tender but not both. Further, in cases where an agent participate in a tender on behalf of one manufacturer, he shall not be allowed to quote on behalf of another manufacturer along with the first manufacturer in a subsequent/parallel tender for the same item.
 - e) The Bidder(s)/ Contractor(s) will, when presenting his bid, disclose any and all payments he has made, is committed to or intends to make to agents, brokers or any other intermediaries in connection with the award of the Contract.
 - f) Bidder(s) / Contractor(s) who have signed the Integrity Pact shall not approach the courts while representing the matter to IEMs and shall wait for their decision in the matter.
- 3) The Bidder(s) / Contractor(s) will not instigate third persons to commit offences outlined above or be an accessory to such offences.
- 4) The Bidder(s) / Contractor(s) will not, directly or through any other person or firm indulge in fraudulent practice **willful misrepresentation or omission of facts or submission of fake / forged documents in order to induce public official to act in reliance thereof, with the purpose of obtaining unjust advantage by or causing damage to justified interest of others and/or to influence the procurement process to the detriment of the Government interests.**

- 5) The Bidder(s) / Contractor(s) will not, directly or through any other person or firm use Coercive Practices (which shall include the act of obtaining something, compelling an action or influencing a decision through intimidation, threat or the use of force directly or indirectly, where potential or actual injury may befall upon a person, his / her reputation or property) to influence their participation in the tendering process.

Article 3: Consequences of Breach

Without prejudice to any rights that may be available to the Principal under law or the Contract or its established policies and laid down procedures, the Principal shall have the following rights in case of breach of this Integrity Pact by the Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) and the Bidder / Contractor accepts and undertakes to respect and uphold the Principal absolute right:

- 1) If the Bidder (s) / Contractor(s), either before award or during execution of Contract has committed a transgression through a violation of Article 2 above or in any other form, such as to put his reliability or credibility in question, the Principal after giving 14 days notice to the contractor shall have powers to disqualify the Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) from the Tender process or terminate / determine the Contract, if already executed or exclude the Bidder/Contractor from future contract award processes. The imposition and duration of the exclusion will be determined by the severity of transgression and determined by the Principal. **Such exclusion may be forever or for a limited period as decided by the Principal.**
- 2) Forfeiture of Earnest Money Deposit/ Performance Guarantee / Security Deposit: If the Principal has disqualified the Bidder(s) from the Tender process prior to the award of the Contract or terminated/determined the Contract or has accrued the right to terminate/determine the Contract according to Article 3(1), the Principal apart from exercising any legal rights that may have accrued to the Principal, may in its considered opinion forfeit the entire amount of Earnest Money Deposit/ Performance Guarantee and Security Deposit of the Bidder /Contractor.
- 3) **Criminal Liability:** If the Principal obtains knowledge of conduct of a Bidder or Contractor, or of an employee or a representative or an associate of a Bidder or Contractor which constitutes corruption within the meaning of PC Act, or if the Principal has substantive suspicion in this regard, the Principal will inform the same to law enforcing agencies for further investigation.

Article 4: Previous Transgression

- 1) The Bidder declares that no previous transgressions occurred in the last 3 years with any other Company in any country confirming to the anticorruption approach or with Central Government or State Government or any other Central/State Public Sector Enterprises in India that could justify his exclusion from the Tender process.
- 2) If the Bidder makes incorrect statement on this subject, he can be disqualified from the Tender process or action can be taken for banning of business dealings/holiday listing of the Bidder/Contractor as deemed fit by the Principal.
- 3) If the Bidder/Contractor can prove that he has resorted / recouped the damage caused by him and has installed a suitable corruption prevention system, the Principal may, at its own discretion, revoke the exclusion prematurely.

Article 5: Equal Treatment of all Bidders/Contractors/Subcontractors

- 1) The Bidder(s) / Contractor(s) undertake(s) to demand from all sub contractors a commitment in conformity with this Integrity Pact. The Bidder /Contractor shall be responsible for any violation(s) of the principles laid down in this agreement by any of its Subcontractors / sub-vendors.
- 2) The Principal will enter into Pacts on identical terms as this one with all Bidders and Contractors.
- 3) The Principal will disqualify Bidders who do not submit the duly signed Integrity Pact between the Principal and the bidder along with the Tender or violate its provisions at any stage of the Tender process.

Article 6- Duration of the Pact

This Integrity Pact begins when both the parties have legally signed it. It expires for the Contractor 12 Months after the completion of work under the contract or expiry of defect liability period or last payment made under the contract, whichever is later and for all other bidders, 6 months after the Contract has been awarded.

If any claim is made/lodged during the time, the same shall be binding and continue to be valid despite the lapse of this Integrity Pact as specified above, unless it is discharged/determined by the ADG/SDG, CPWD concerned.

Article 7- Other Provisions

- 1) This Integrity Pact is subject to Indian Law, place of performance and jurisdiction is the **Head quarters of the Division** of the Principal, who has floated the Tender.

- 2) Changes and supplements as well as termination notice need to be made in writing.
- 3) If the Contractor is a partnership or a consortium, this Integrity Pact must be signed by all the partners or by one or more partner holding power of attorney signed by all partners and consortium members. In case of a Company, the Integrity Pact must be signed by a representative duly authorized by board resolution.
- 4) Should one or several provisions of this Integrity Pact turn out to be invalid; the remainder of this Pact remains valid. In this case, the parties will strive to come to an agreement to their original intentions.
- 5) Issues like Warranty/Guarantee etc. shall be outside the purview of IEMs.
- 6) It is agreed term and condition that any dispute or difference arising between the parties with regard to the terms of this Integrity Pact, any action taken by the Principal in accordance with this **Integrity Pact or interpretation** thereof shall not be subject to arbitration.
- 7) In view of the nature of integrity pact, the Integrity Pact is irrevocable and shall remain valid even if the main tender/ contract is terminated till the currency of the integrity pact.
- 8) If any complaint regarding violation of IP is received directly by the Principal in respect of the contract, the same shall be referred to the IEM for comments/ recommendations.

Article 8- INDEPENDENT EXTERNAL MONITOR (IEM)

- 1) The Principal appoints competent and credible Independent External Monitor for this Pact after approval by Central Vigilance Commission (Names and address of IEMs are as mentioned in Schedule-F). The task of the Monitor is to review independently and objectively, whether and to what extent the parties comply with the obligations under this agreement.
- 2) The monitor is not subject to instructions by the representatives of the parties and performs his/her functions neutrally and independently. The Monitor would have access to all contract documents, whenever required. It will be obligatory for him/her to treat the information and documents of the Bidders/contractors as confidential.
- 3) The Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) accepts that the IEM has the right to access without restriction to all project documentation of the Principal including that provided by the Contractor. The Contractor will also the IEM, upon his/her request and demonstration of a valid interest, unrestricted and unconditional access to their project documentation. The same is applicable to sub-contractors.
- 4) The IEM is under contractual obligation to treat the information and documents of the Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) /Sub-contractor(s) with confidentiality. The IEM has also signed 'Non-Disclosure of Confidential Information' and 'Absence of Conflict of Interest'. In case if any conflict of interest arising at a later date, the IEM shall inform the Engineer-in-Charge and recuse himself/ herself from that case.
- 5) As soon as the IEM notices, or believes to notice, a violation of this agreement, he/she will so inform the Management of the Principal and request the Management to discontinue or take corrective action, or to take other relevant action. The IEM can in this regard submit non-binding recommendations. Beyond this, the IEM has no right to demand from the parties that they act in a specific manner, refrain from action or tolerate action.

- 6) The IEM will submit a written report to the SDG/ADG concerned within 8 to 10 weeks from the date of reference or intimation to him by the Principal and, should be occasion arise, submit proposals for correcting problematic situations.
- 7) If the IEM has reported to the ADG/SDG concerned, a substantiated suspicion of an offence under relevant IPC/PC Act, and the ADG/SDG concerned has, within a reasonable time, not taken visible action to proceed against such offence or reported it to the Chief Vigilance Officer, the IEM may also transmit this information directly to the Central Vigilance Commissioner.
- 8) The Principal will provide to the IEM sufficient information about all meetings among the parties related to the project provided such meeting could have impact on contractual relations between the Principal and the contractor. The parties will offer to the IEM the option to participate in such meetings.
- 9) The word IEM or monitor would include both singular and plural.

Article 9- LEGAL AND PRIOR RIGHTS

All rights and remedies of the parties hereto shall be in addition to all the other legal rights and remedies belonging to such parties under the Contract and/or law and the same shall be deemed to be cumulative and not alternative to such legal rights and remedies aforesaid. For the sake of brevity, both the Parties agree that this Integrity Pact will have precedence over the Tender / Contract documents with regard any of the provisions covered under this Integrity Pact.

3. The contractor shall make his own arrangements for obtaining electric/water connections, if required, and make necessary payment directly to the Department concerned.
4. The Department shall not be responsible for any injury partial or permanent or death of any workers at site due to accident or mal functioning of the equipment or by negligence of the staff.
5. The contractor shall at his own expense arrange for safety provision as per CPWD safety code.
6. No compensation shall be payable to the Contractor for any damage caused by rains, storms, earthquakes and other calamity during the execution of work.
7. It shall be the sole responsibility of the Contractor to ensure before undertaking the maintenance work that number of trees/shrubs/hedge/ lawn area all are in healthy conditions no casualty and deficiency of plants exist at site and he has to bring the same into the notice of the Dy. 29. The contractor shall have registration with EPFO and ESIC for safeguard interest of his workers. The contractor shall make deduction on account of EPF & ESIC to labour/staff deployed by him on the work he will furnish detail of each worker at Division office with Bill.
30. All the engaged workers are to be equipped with photo identity cards issued by the contractor and contractor will maintain their particulars (i.e. Name, Father's Name, Local Address and permanent address etc.). A copy of the same will be provided to the Officer-in-charge before start of Work. The expenditure on this account will be borne by contractor and nothing will be reimbursed for it.
31. The attendance register shall be maintained by the contractor. Officer-in-charge can verify this register at any time. This will be submitted with each RA bill along with particulars as mentioned above.

32. In case of absence from duty by labour, an amount @ double of current minimum wages shall be recovered from the contractor's bill.
33. In order to ensure the suitability of good earth supplied for Horticulture purpose, lab test will be required for every 300 cum of good earth supplied.
34. The contractor shall follow provision of contract labour (Regulation and Abolition) ACT- 1970 & minimum wages ACT.
35. GST as applicable. In case of any variation in GST or other Tax liability to contractor need to manage / bear in future himself.
36. Any damage/ mis-happenings/ legal proceedings/ compassion occurred during the executing of the contract shall be borne by the contractor & department shall not be responsible for any such occurrence.
37. All expenditure to be incurred for testing of samples e.g. packing, sealing, transportation, loading, unloading etc. including testing charges shall be borne by the contractor. (As per Office Memorandum No. DG/MAN/410 Dated: 22.10.2021).
38. The contractor shall maintain Register, Log Book and Photos with date for the work as per Schedule.
39. Payment for maintenance charges
 - (a) The contractor will start maintenance of existing plant, shrubs and trees, which are in good condition, from date of start of work and payment for maintenance will be made as per his quoted rate.
 - (b) The maintenance of area where the contractor will do new plantation will be done at his cost for one month after plantation. This one month will be counted after plantation work is completed in batch sizes of at-least 1500 sqm and declared completed by Officer-in-Charge. After this one month of maintenance at the cost of contractor, payment for maintenance for new plantation area will be made as per his quoted rate. Due to site constraints, Officer-in-charge may reduce the batch size as per his discretion.
40. The staff deployed for horticulture work must have good knowledge about horticulture works/operations like hedge cutting, lawn mowing, planting of trees/seedlings, lawn maintenance, potted plants maintenance etc. and supervisor should be well behaved, experienced and qualified to communicate with the clients, occupants, staff and officers.
41. The contractor or his representative should be available at site on every visit, of officer-in-charge as well as visit of senior officers.
42. A minimum of **05 Nos. Mali's for 09 months & 06 Nos. Mali's for 03 months** will be employed daily by the contractor.
43. Additional labour will be provided by the contractor as & when required nothing shall be paid extra for it.

SPECIFICATIONS OF PLANTS (SH 3 TO 10 OF DSR)

The plants included under Sub Head 3 to 10 should be as per following specification.

1. The plants should be full of fresh and healthy foliage.
2. The plants should be free from insect, pest and diseases.
3. Plant should be well developed and healthy.
4. The height of the plants will be measured from top of the pots.
5. The plants should be well settle and should not be newly shifted/Transplanted.
6. The plants should be true to the variety and Variety name should be tagged.
7. Moss stick used should be made on plastic pipe.
8. Moss stick should be straight and properly fixed in the pot.
9. The rejected plants materials should be removed from the site immediately.
10. Moss stick should be covered with the plants in case of plants supplied with moss stick.
11. The Plant should be well stablished and should have good foliage.
12. Good earth and manure used for filling the pot/poly bag should be free from any inert material and mixed to proper ratio.
13. Pot/ Poly bag used for filling the plants should be of proper size.
14. There should be proper drainage in pots for plants.
15. The flowering plants should also have proper flowering and should be true to the variety.
16. All plant should have the tendency of growth and should not be stunted or deshaped.
17. There should be no stagnation of water in the pots.
18. Plant should not have any physiological disorder.
19. Tips of the Plants should have intact, there should not be any damages etc.
20. In case of flowering pots flower should be on bud stage/semi bloom stage.
21. In case of potted plant pots should have uniformity/same size and quality.
22. Plants of bigger height should be properly supported/stacked by bamboo stick.
23. Pots/Polybags soil should not be infectious and plant should have free from all kind of diseases.
24. Bulbs, seeds, seedling, suckers should properly treated with fungicides before supply.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS**GOOD EARTH**

1. The good earth/soil shall be suitable for gardening free from Kanker, Moorum, Shingle, rocks, stones, brick bats, building rubbish and any other foreign matter. The earth shall be free from clods or lumps of size bigger than 75 mm in any direction. It shall have P.H. value ranging between 6.5 to 8.5
2. The earth shall be stacked at site in stacks not less than 50 cm high and of volume not less than 3.0 cum.
3. Length, breadth & height of stacks shall be measured correct to a cm. The volume of the stacks shall be reduced by 20% for voids before payment unless otherwise described.

MANURE/ SLUDGE

1. The manure shall be well decayed organic & vegetable matter obtained in the dry state, free from grits, brick-bats, pebbles, stone and any other unwanted materials. It shall be obtained from approved disposal work.
2. Manure/sludge shall be stacked at site in stacks not less than 50cm height and of volume not less than 3 cum.
3. Length, breadth & height of stacks shall be measured correct to a cm. The volume of the stacks shall be reduced by 8% for looseness in stacking to arrive at the net quantity for payments.
