A. For CPWD registered contractors: -

- CPWD registered contractor in appropriate class on the last date of receiving the tenders in B&R category are eligible to bid for this work.
- The **CPWD registered contractor** should have the experience of “**work related to SITC of Video Conferencing System etc.**” or the **CPWD registered contractor associates specialized agency** having experience of “**work related to SITC of Video Conferencing System etc.**” as mentioned below during the last 7 years ending last date of published tender”.

B3. Should not have incurred any loss (profit after tax should be positive) in more than two years during the last five years ending 31st March 2025, duly certified and audited by the Chartered Accountant.

B4. Should have a Banker’s Certificate from a commercial Bank for 40% of the Estimated Cost put to tender (ECPT)

Or

Net Worth Certificate from CA with Unique Documents Identification Number (UDIN) of minimum 10% amount of ECPT (Scanned copy of original to be uploaded).

2. The intending bidder must read the terms and conditions of CPWD-6 carefully. He should only submit his bid if he considers himself eligible and he is in possession of all the documents required.
3. Information and Instructions for bidders posted on website shall form part of bid document.
4. The bid document consisting of plans, specifications, the schedule of quantities of various types of items to be executed and the set of terms and conditions of the contract to be complied with and other necessary documents can be seen and downloaded from website etender.cpwd.gov.in free of cost.

5. But the bid can only be submitted after deposition of original EMD either in the office of Executive Engineer inviting bids or division office of any Executive Engineer, CPWD within the period of bid submission and uploading the mandatory scanned documents such as Banker's Cheque, Demand Draft, Fixed Deposit Receipt (FDR), Insurance Surety Bond and Bank Guarantee of any Commercial Bank or through NTRP (www.bharatkosh.gov.in) towards EMD in favour of Executive Engineer(E), ECD-II, CPWD, Sena Bhawan, New Delhi, receipt for deposition of original EMD to division office of any Executive Engineer, CPWD and other documents as specified.
6. Those contractors, who are not registered or have not updated their profile on the website mentioned above, are required to get registered / update their profile beforehand. The necessary training materials including the videos with step to step process are available on download section of <https://etender.cpwd.gov.in>.
7. The intending bidder must have valid Class-III digital signature certificate with encryption key (combo type) to perform any operations / transactions on the e-tendering portal / website and the bidder should download and install the eMsigner on their system as per instructions available on download section of <https://etender.cpwd.gov.in>
8. On opening date, the contractor can login and see the bid opening process. After opening of bids he will receive the competitor bid sheets.
9. Contractor can upload documents in the form of JPG format and PDF format.
10. Certificate of Financial Turn over: At the time of submission of bid contractor may upload Affidavit/Certificate from CA mentioning Financial Turnover of last 7 years or for the period as specified in the bid document and further details if required may be asked from the contractor after opening of technical bids. There is no need to upload entire voluminous balance sheet.
11. Contractor must ensure to quote rate in the prescribed column(s) meant for quoting rate in figures appears in yellow colour and the moment rate is entered, it turns sky blue.

In addition to this, while selecting any of the cells a warning appears that if any cell is left blank the same shall be treated as "0". Therefore, if any cell is left blank and no rate is quoted by the bidder, rate of such item shall be treated as "0" (ZERO).

However, If a tenderer quotes nil rates against each item in item rate tender or does not quote any percentage above/below on the total amount of the tender or any section / sub head in percentage rate tender, the tender shall be treated as invalid and will not be considered as lowest tenderer.

- ~~15. The department reserves the right to reject any prospective application without assigning any reason and to restrict the list of qualified contractors to any number deemed suitable by it, if too many bids are received satisfying the laid down criterion.~~

Percentage rate bids are invited on behalf of President of India from approved and eligible contractors of CPWD from **“the approved and eligible contractors of CPWD in Building & Road Category in appropriate class / OEM / Specialized agencies dealing in the field of Video conferencing System”** in Two bid system for the following work: -

Name of Work: Supply, Installation, Testing & Commissioning of Video Conferencing setup at the residential office of the Hon'ble Minister of Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation, KL Bhawan, New Delhi. FY 2026-27.

The enlistment of the contractors should be valid on the last date of submission of bids. In case the last date of submission of bid is extended, the enlistment of contractor should be valid on the original date of submission of bids.

- 1.1 The work is estimated to cost **Rs. 15,48,340/-**. This estimate, however, is given merely as a rough guide.
- 1.1.1 The authority competent to approve NIT for the combined cost and belonging to the major discipline will consolidate NITs for calling the bids. He will also nominate Division which will deal with all matters relating to the invitation of bids. For composite bid, besides indicating the combined estimated cost put to bid, should clearly indicate the estimated cost of each component separately. The eligibility of bidders will correspond to the combined estimated cost of different components put to bid.
- 1.2 Intending bidders is eligible to submit the bid provided he has definite proof from the appropriate authority, which shall be to the satisfaction of the competent authority, of having satisfactorily completed **works as mentioned in INFORMATION AND INSTRUCTIONS FOR BIDDERS FOR e-TENDERING FORMING PART OF BID DOCUMENT**
- 1.2.1 To become eligible for issue of bid, the bidders shall have to furnish an affidavit as under:-

I/We undertake and confirm that eligible similar works(s) has/have not been got executed through another contractor on back to back basis. Further that, if such a violation comes to the notice of Department, then I/we shall be debarred for bidding in CPWD in future forever. Also, if such a violation comes to the notice of Department before date of start of work, the Engineer-in-Charge shall be free to forfeit the entire amount of Earnest Money Deposit/Performance Guarantee. (Scanned copy to be uploaded at the time of submission of bid)

2. Agreement shall be drawn with the successful bidders on prescribed Form No. **CPWD 7/8** (or other Standard Form as mentioned) which is available as a Govt. of India Publication and also available on website **etender.cpwd.gov.in** Bidders shall quote his rates as per various terms and conditions of the said form which will form part of the agreement.

3. The time allowed for carrying out the work will be **02 Month** from the date of start as defined in schedule 'F' or from the first date of handing over of the site, whichever is later, in accordance with the phasing, if any, indicated in the bid documents.
4. The site is clear for the execution of work.
5. After submission of the bid the contractor can re-submit a revised bid any number of times but before last time and date of submission of bid as notified.
6. While submitting the revised bid, the contractor can revise the rate of one or more item(s) any number of times (he need not re-enter rate of all the items) but before last time and date of submission of bid as notified.
7. When bids are invited in three stage system and if it is desired to submit a revised financial bid then it shall be mandatory to submit revised financial bid. If not submitted then the bid submitted earlier shall become invalid.
8. Earnest Money in the form of Insurance Surety Bonds, Account Payee Demand Draft, Fixed Deposit Receipt, Banker's Cheque or Bank Guarantee including e- Bank Guarantee (for balance amount as prescribed) from any of the Commercial Banks or through NTRP (www.bharatkosh.gov.in) drawn in favour of Executive Engineer(E), ECD-II, CPWD, Sena Bhawan, New Delhi shall be scanned and uploaded on the e-Tendering website within the period of bid submission. The original EMD should be deposited either in the office of Executive Engineer inviting bids or division office of any Executive Engineer, CPWD within the period of bid submission. The EMD receiving Executive Engineer (including NIT issuing EE/AE) shall issue a receipt of deposition of earnest money deposit to the bidder in a prescribed format (enclosed) uploaded by tender inviting EE in the NIT.

A part of earnest money is acceptable in the form of bank guarantee also. In such case, minimum 50% of earnest money or Rs. 20 lac, whichever is less, shall have to be deposited in shape prescribed above, and balance may be deposited in shape of Bank Guarantee of any scheduled bank having validity for six months or more from the last date of receipt of bids which is to be scanned and uploaded by the intending bidders.

The earnest money given by all the tenderers except the lowest tenderer shall be refunded immediately after the expiry of stipulated bid validity period or immediately after acceptance of the successful bidder, whichever is earlier. However, in case of two/ three bid system, earnest money deposit of bidders unsuccessful during technical bid evaluation etc. should be returned within 30 days of declaration of result of technical bid evaluation.

Copy of Enlistment Order and certificate of work experience and other documents as specified in the notice inviting e- tender shall be scanned and uploaded on the e-Tendering website within the period of bid submission. However, certified copy of all the scanned and uploaded documents as specified in e- tender notice shall have to be submitted by and uploaded documents as specified in e- tender notice shall have to be

submitted by the lowest bidder within a week physically in the office of tender opening authority. Online bid documents submitted by intending bidders shall be opened only of those bidders, who has deposited EMD with any division of CPWD and other documents scanned and uploaded are found in order. The bid submitted shall be opened at 03:30 PM on **/**/**.

10. The bid submitted shall become invalid and e-Tender processing fee shall not be refunded if:
 - i. The bidder is found ineligible.
 - ii. The bidder does not upload scanned copies of all the documents stipulated in the bid document.
 - iii. If any discrepancy is noticed between the documents as uploaded at the time of submission of bid and hard copies as submitted physically by the lowest bidder in the office of bid opening authority.
 - iv. If a tenderer quotes nil rates against each item in item rate tender or does not quote any percentage above/below on the total amount of the tender or any section / sub head in percentage rate tender, the tender shall be treated as invalid and will not be considered as lowest tenderer.
11. The contractor whose bid is accepted will be required to furnish performance guarantee at specified percentage of the tendered amount as mentioned in schedule E and within the period specified in Schedule F. This guarantee shall be in the form of Insurance Surety Bonds, Account Payee Demand Draft, Fixed Deposit Receipt or Bank Guarantee from any of the Commercial Banks or through NTRP (www.bharatkosh.gov.in) in accordance with the prescribed form. In case the contractor fails to deposit the said performance guarantee within the period as indicated in Schedule 'F', including the extended period if any, the Earnest Money deposited by the contractor shall be forfeited automatically without any notice to the contractor. The earnest money deposited along with bid shall be returned after receiving the aforesaid performance guarantee. The contractor whose bid is accepted will also be required to furnish either copy of applicable. The contractor whose bid is accepted will also be required to furnish either copy of applicable licenses/ registrations or proof of applying for obtaining labour licenses, registration with EPFO, ESIC and BOCW Welfare Board including Provident Fund Code No. If applicable and also ensure the compliance of aforesaid provisions by the sub-contractors, if any engaged by the contractor for the said work within the period specified in Schedule F.

~~Intending Bidders are advised to inspect and examine the site and its surroundings and satisfy themselves before submitting their bids as to the nature of the ground and sub-soil (so far as is practicable), the form and nature of the site, the means of access to the site, the accommodation they may require and in general shall themselves obtain all necessary information as to risks, contingencies and other circumstances which may influence or affect their bid. A bidders shall be deemed to have full knowledge of the site whether he inspects it or not and no extra charge consequent on any misunderstanding or otherwise shall be allowed. The bidders shall be responsible for arranging and maintaining at his own cost all materials, tools & plants, water, electricity access, facilities for workers and all other services required for executing the work unless otherwise specifically provided for in the contract documents. Submission of a~~

~~bid by a bidders implies that he has read this notice and all other contract documents and has made himself aware of the scope and specifications of the work to be done and of conditions and rates at which stores, tools and plant, etc. will be issued to him by the Government and local conditions and other factors having a bearing on the execution of the work.~~

13. The competent authority on behalf of the President of India does not bind itself to accept the lowest or any other bid and reserves to itself the authority to reject any or all the bids received without the assignment of any reason. All bids in which any of the prescribed condition is not fulfilled or any condition including that of conditional rebate is put forth by the bidders shall be summarily rejected.
14. Canvassing whether directly or indirectly, in connection with bidders is strictly prohibited and the bids submitted by the contractors who resort to canvassing will be liable for rejection.
15. The competent authority on behalf of President of India reserves to himself the right of accepting the whole or any part of the bid and the bidders shall be bound to perform the same at the rate quoted.
16. The contractor shall not be permitted to bid for works in the CPWD Circle (Division in case of contractors of Horticulture/Nursery category) responsible for award and execution of contracts, in which his near relative is posted as Divisional Accountant or as an officer in any capacity between the grades of Superintending Engineer and Junior Engineer (both inclusive). He shall also intimate the names of persons who are working with him in any capacity or are subsequently employed by him and who are near relatives to any gazetted officer in the Central Public Works Department or in the Ministry of Urban Development. Any breach of this condition by the contractor would render him liable to be removed from the approved list of contractors of this Department.
17. No Engineer of Gazetted Rank or other Gazetted Officer employed in Engineering or Administrative duties in an Engineering Department of the Government of India is allowed to work as a contractor for a period of one year after his retirement from Government service, without the prior permission of the Government of India in writing. This contract is liable to be cancelled if either the contractor or any of his employees is found any time to be such a person who had not obtained the permission of the Government of India as aforesaid before submission of the bid or engagement in the contractor's service.
18. The bids for the work shall remain open for acceptance for a period of 30 (thirty) days from the date of opening of bids in case of single bid system and 75 (seventy five) days from the date of opening of technical bids in case bids are invited in 2 or 3 bid system.

- (i) If any tenderer withdraws his tender or makes any modification in the terms & conditions of the tender which is not acceptable to the department within 7 days after last date of submission of bids, then the Government shall without prejudice to any other right or remedy, be at liberty to forfeit 50% of the earnest money absolutely irrespective of letter of acceptance for the work is issued or not.

General Terms & Conditions

1. Introduction

These conditions are intended to amplify the General Conditions of Contract, and shall be read in conjunction with the same. For any discrepancy between the General Conditions and these Special Conditions, the more stringent shall apply.

2. Related Documents

These additional specifications are to be read in conjunction with the specification given in the tender. In case any item/ items or part thereof are not covered under these specifications, the same shall be carried out as per relevant part of the **CPWD General Specification for Electrical Works Part-I Internal-2023, Part-II External-2023, and Part IV (Sub-Station) 2013, Part VII (DG Set), Part V Wet Riser & Sprinkler Systems, HVAC - 2024** as amended upto dates, relevant electricity act BIS/IEC and as per direction of Engineer –in - Charge. These additional specifications are to be read in conjunction with above and in case of variations; specifications given in this additional condition shall apply. However, nothing extra shall be paid on account of these additional specifications and conditions, as the same are to be read along with schedule of quantities for the work. In case of discrepancy among the specifications/conditions as mentioned above the precedence given in general condition of contract shall be followed.

3. Site Information

The tenderer should, in his own interest, visit the site and familiarize himself with the site conditions before tendering. For any clarification, tenderer may discuss with the Engineer-in-Charge.

4. Conformity With Statutory Acts, Rules, Standards And Codes

- (i) All components shall conform to relevant Indian Standard Specifications, wherever existing, amended to date.
- (ii) All electrical works shall be carried out in accordance with the provisions of Indian Electricity Act, 2023 and Indian Electricity Rules, 1956 amended to date. They shall also conform to CPWD General Specifications for Electrical works, Part-I: Internal, 2023 and Part-II: External, 2023 as amended to date.
- (iii) All components shall conform to Energy Conservation Building Code 2007 of India as amended or revised up to date.

5. Safety Codes And Labour Regulations

- (i) In respect of all labour employed directly or indirectly on the work for the performance of the **SITC of Video Conferencing System** works contractor's part of work, the contractor at his own expense, will arrange for the safety provisions as per the statutory provisions, B.I.S recommendations, factory act, workman's compensation act, CPWD code and instructions issued from time to time. Failure to provide such safety requirements would make the tenderer liable for penalty as provided in the labour laws/ GCC for each violation. In addition the Engineer-in-charge shall be at liberty to make arrangements and provide facilities as aforesaid and recover the cost from the contractor.

- (ii) The contractor shall provide necessary barriers, warning signals and other safety measures while executing the works or wherever necessary so as to avoid accident. He shall also indemnify CPWD against claims for compensation arising out of negligence in this respect. Contractor shall be liable, in accordance with the Indian Law and Regulations for any accident occurring due to any cause. - (iii) Contractor has to provide uniform for the workers for both the seasons and instruct the labour to always in uniform while performing the duty. If any worker found without uniform the penalty of Rs. 200/- for each occasion will be imposed and amount will be recovered from the bill.

6. **Works to be done by the contractor**

Unless otherwise mentioned in the tender documents, the following works shall be done by the contractor and therefore, their cost shall be deemed to be included in their tendered cost- whether specifically indicated in the schedule of work or not: -

- (i) Making good all damages caused to the structure during installation and restoring the same to their original finish.
- (ii) Minor building work necessary for installation of equipments, making opening in the wall/floors/slabs/tables or modifications in the existing openings wherever provided and restoring the same to their original condition/ finish and necessary grouting etc. as required. The acceptable makes of the various equipments/ components/ accessories have been indicated in “Acceptable Makes” annexed with this document. The bidders shall work out the cost of the offers on this basis. Alternate make/ model is not acceptable.

9. **Machinery for Erection**

All tools and tackles required for unloading/ handling of equipments and materials at site, their assembly, erection, testing and commissioning shall be the responsibility of the contractor.

10. **Payment**

Quarterly payment will be made on completion of compliance of all terms & conditions of agreement.

11. **Completeness of the tender, submission of programme, approval of drawings and commencement of work.**

(i) **Completeness of the tender**

All sundry equipments, fittings, assemblies, accessories, hardware items, gaskets, and associated items, supports, termination lugs for electrical connections, cable glands, junction boxes and all other items which are useful and necessary for proper assembly and efficient working of the various equipments and components of the work shall be deemed to have been included in the tender, irrespective of the fact whether such items are specifically mentioned in the tender or not.

(ii) **Submission of Name of workers and supervisor etc.**

The contractor shall submit the name, IDs and credentials of all workers and staff to be deployed by them at site to the Engineer-in-Charge for approval before start of work OR 10 days prior from date of start.

12. **Extent of Work**

The work comprises Repairing replacement of Fire Fighting System of Fire Fighting system. This includes entire labour including supervision and all material necessary to meet satisfactory operation of the system.

13. **Compliance with Regulations and Indian Standards:**

- (i) All works shall be carried out in accordance with relevant regulation, both statutory and those specified by the Indian Standards related to the works covered by this specification. In particular, the equipment and installation will comply with the following:
- (ii) Factories Act.
- (iii) Indian Electricity Rules.
- (iv) B.I.S. & other standards as applicable.
- (v) Workmen’s compensation Act.
- (vi) Statutory norms prescribed by local bodies like CEA, Power Supply Co., etc.

14. **Indemnity:**

The successful tenderer shall at all times indemnify the department, consequent on this works contract. The successful tenderer shall be liable, in accordance with the Indian Law and Regulations for any accident occurring due to any cause and the contractor shall be responsible for any accident or damage incurred or claims arising there from during the period of erection, construction and putting into operation the equipments and ancillary equipment under the supervision of the successful tenderer in so far as the latter is responsible. The successful tenderer shall also provide all insurance including third party insurance as may be necessary to cover the risk. No extra payment would be made to the successful tenderer on account of the above.

15. **Co-Ordination with other agencies**

The contractor shall co-ordinate with all other agencies involved in the work so that the work of other agencies is not hampered due to delay in his work. Ducting, piping, cabling or any other work, which directly affect the progress of building work, shall be given priority.

16. **Quality of materials and workmanship**

- (i) The components of the installation shall be of such design so as to satisfactorily function under all conditions of operation.
- (ii) All equipments and materials to be used in work shall be manufactured in factories of good repute having excellent track record of quality manufacturing, performance and proper after sales service.
- (iii) None of the equipment/ machines supplied shall be more than Twelve months old from date of supply at site, Copy of Excise Gate Pass/ Invoice/ Shipment /Custom Clearance certificate/ details (in case of Imported equipments) shall be submitted to prove the date of manufacture & genuineness of the equipments/ machines supplied.

17. **Care of the building**

Care shall be taken by the contractor during execution of the work to avoid damage to the building. He shall be responsible for repairing all such damages and restoring the same to the original finish at his cost. He shall also remove all unwanted and waste materials arising out of the installation from the site of work from time to time.

18. **Inspection and testing**

All the material purchased by the contractor shall not be more than three months before award of work. Proof of purchasing from such authorised source like copy of bill/ challan etc. shall be submitted to the department before claiming on account bill for payments.

19. **Final Inspection & Testing**

Final Inspection & testing will be done by the Engineer-in-Charge or his representative as per details indicated in CPWD Specifications.

20. Attendance of staff & workers deployed at site:- Daily attendance of staff/workers of contractor deployed at site shall be marked through Aadhar based bio-metric or other similar scanner attendance system. The hardware, software, machine, wifi-connection

etc for this purpose shall be provided by the contractor within the quoted rates. They shall keep the system in perfect working all the times and submit monthly attendance sheet of BAS while claiming payments.

21. **Safety measures**

All equipments shall incorporate suitable safety provisions to ensure safety of the operating personnel at all times. The initial and final inspection reports shall bring out explicitly the safety provisions incorporated in each equipment.

22. The firm shall have to obtain necessary Security Passes/Entry Passes by doing all necessary formalities before start of work. The department will only assist for the same.

23. Any delay at the end of agency on account of obtaining passes shall not be entertained for extension of time for the work.

24. No claim shall be entertained by the department if any accident occurs during currency of this contract. The contractor has to arrange and provide to his workmen, all safety devices and observe all precaution to avoid any accident. The contractor shall be totally responsible for safety of their workman deployed at site.

25. The contractor shall handover inventory after completion of the contract the firm.

26. All the Nominal Tools and other T&P required for this work shall be arranged by the contractor at his own cost.

27. The department reserves the right to terminate the contract before the expiry of contract without assigning any reason and also to exclude any item of NIT while awarding the work without assigning any reason thereof.

28. The payment shall be made on submission of bills by the contractor in compliance to conditions of agreement on mutually agreed basis.

29. If any quantity deviation in the agreement items based on the design at the time of execution of work, agency has to execute the deviated quantity items within the agreement rate only.

30. The agency shall visit the site and acquaint the quantum, nature of work and get familiarized with the site conditions before quoting the rates.

31. If there is any difference or discrepancy between the description of items as given in the Schedule of Quantities, technical specifications for individual items of work (including additional and commercial conditions) and IS Codes etc., the following order of preference shall be followed:

- a. Schedule of quantities
- b. Additional and Commercial Conditions
- c. Technical specifications specified in the tender
- d. General Conditions of Contract for CPWD Works
- e. Drawings

f. CPWD General Specifications

g. Relevant IS or any other International code in case IS code is not available.

32. No T&P shall be issued to the agency by deptt.
33. No advance payment shall be made.
34. All the materials, used by the contractor should be got approved from the Engineer-in-Charge or his authorized representative before installation. No payment will be made for any unapproved or sub-standard materials used on the work. Rejected materials should be removed from the site of work within 48 hours, by the contractor.
35. Department will not provide the store to the agency and watch and ward of materials will be responsibility of contractor till completion/ hand over to the client department.
36. The contractor shall be solely responsible for any accident during execution of work & should take all preventive & safety measures. The department shall not be responsible in this respect for any lapse on the contractor part.
37. The contractor shall be liable and responsible for any kind of litigation in the court of law during execution of work, and any compensation there to has to be born by the contractor and the department shall not be involved in anyway.
- ~~38. All termination of electrical cables for sizes higher than 4 sq. mm shall have to be done with proper thimbles/ reducer. Copper thimble/ reducer shall be used for copper cable and aluminum ones for Al. cables. Nothing extra shall be paid by the department however end termination of power cables shall be paid extra.~~

42. The contractor has to work in restricted area and in restricted time due to security reasons. He shall be bound by the instructions of security staff and Engineer-in-Charge in this respect.
43. The models and makes shall be decided by the Engineer-In-Charge at site and to be got approved before execution of work.

- ~~44. Dismantling of complete false ceiling/conduit/DB/MS channel/poles/cables/GI Pipes etc. are not allowed at a time, Work should be done partly based on the availability of permission from client and direction of engineer in charge.~~
- ~~45. Time line for this project is very less so agency has to submit the letter for makes of material approval immediately and place the order as early as possible to complete the work within a time limit.~~
46. All the petty materials like Vim, Colin, Old dhoti/duster, soap bar, PVC insulated copper conductor control cables, PVC Tape, Test Lamp, Thimble/ Ferrule, battery terminals, log book, complaint register etc. required for general up keeping shall be deemed to be included in the scope of work and shall be arranged by the contractor within the quoted rate.
47. If the employee of the contractor goes to court or any other legal authorities etc. in or anywhere in India at any time in connection to this contract the department shall not be made a party of it in any way the employee of the contractor/ or by the contractor himself. This fact should be clearly and legally told to all the employees by the contractor and the contractor shall be fully responsible for all losses/ damages/ misconduct etc. arises on this account. No claim of any staff deployed by the contractor, for absorption in govt. job shall be entertained.
48. Any damage to the installation/ building during execution of work shall be made good by the contractor at his own cost. Repair work if any, should be done with proper cement and sand ratio and to be match with existing finish.
49. Safety of the staff deployed will be the responsibility of the contractor who must ensure the safety of the staff adequately, as per CPWD safety rules. Govt. /CPWD will not be responsible for any mishap, injury accident or death of the staff. No claim in this regard shall be entertained/accepted by the department.
50. The staff engaged by the contractor shall possess valid electrical license should be well behaved, polite and courteous. Any complaint against staff on behavior shall be taken very seriously and such staff should be removed by the contractor immediately from the site and arrange replacement for the same failing which the Engineer-in-charge has the power to cancel the contract and the contractor shall have no claim of loss/ compensation for this.
51. All T&P including ladders, wire drawing equipment, electrical chase cutting equipment, drill machine, meggar, earth resistance testing equipment etc., required for the work shall have to be arranged by the contractor. No T & P shall be issued by the department.
- ~~52. The contractor shall pay to his staff not less than minimum wages approved by the Government of India from time to time.~~
- ~~53. The operator has to upkeep the machinery / switch board and entire system properly neat and clean out for which no extra payment would be made.~~

54. The contractor shall quote the rate which shall be inclusive all taxes, and welfare benefits payable to the workers etc. and nothing shall be paid extra on this account. Any type of conditional offer shall be summarily rejected.
55. The following documents related to staff/labour to be deployed at site is to be submitted for issue of pass within 7 days of issued of award letter.
- a) 2 Nos.- Passport size photograph of labour/staff.
 - b) POLICE CLEARANCE CERTIFICATE (PCC) not older than 1 year.
 - c) 2 Nos.- ID proof of the labour/ staff.
 - d) Application for labour token/Pass on letter head of agency duly signed by contractor.
56. The contractor has to submit proof like copy of challan / bill etc. for purchasing the material from genuine source / authorized dealer / manufacturer without any hiding / omitting.

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ADDITIONAL CONDITIONS

1. The work shall be carried out as per relevant CPWD General Specifications for Electrical works Part – I Internal 2023 amended up to date and as per the directions of Engineer-in- Charge.
2. Contractor is advised to visit the site & check and go through all equipments mentioned in Schedule of Work and also confirm the prevailing market rates before quoting the tender. Nothing shall be paid by Department.
3. If any item is to be different than whatever mentioned in the schedule of work it should specifically be brought out to the notice of department while quoting for the tender.
4. The rates quoted shall be inclusive of all Taxes and duties, nothing extra shall be paid on this Account.
5. No T& P shall be issued by the department.
6. No extra payment payable for wastage of labour.
7. Department shall in no way be involved in any dispute of whatever kind, between the contractor and the staff engaged by him.

8. Payment Terms

On account payments for part work (after stipulated and statutory deductions) as assessed by the Engineer – in-charge for the applicable items in the Contract shall be payable at part rates not exceeding the percentage indicated against the stages of work as below.

The contractor shall take all precautions while deploying manpower and provide suitable manpower immediately occurrence of such incidents in writing by Engineer in- charge at his own cost
12. The contractor shall furnish Name & Contract Number of the person, who should be contracted during emergency.

13. No labour huts shall be allowed inside the campus of above said work. The contractor shall make his own arrangement for the stay of labour outside the campus including transportation and nothing extra shall be payable on this account
14. The Contractor shall also be required to follow the rules & restrictions imposed on working/movement/stacking of materials by the local competent authority at all times. Nothing extra shall be payable on this account.

19. The staff deputed in the work shall be contractor's liability, therefore no claim for continuous or regular employment with the department.
20. The department shall not provide any store accommodation for the stores brought by the contractor or issued by the department.
21. Damage to the building during execution of work shall be made good by the contractor matching with the surrounding surface, otherwise the same shall be got done at the cost of working contractor.
22. Any damage done to the existing installations by contractor's staff shall be replaced by the contractor at his own cost and risk, to the entire satisfaction of the Engineer-in- Charge.
23. The makes of material will be as per attached list of approved makes against each item of work or as per instructions of Engineer in charge.
24. The contractor shall take all precautions for safety of the workman. If any accident/mishap occur, the department shall not be responsible for the same. Consequently any compensation payable shall be at the contractor's cost.
25. Any malba generated due to dismantling/execution shall be cleared from the site of work immediately without any extra cost failing which same shall be done by the department and suitable recovery shall be made from the bill of the contractor.
26. The entry of labour/workers and materials into the KL Bhawan, New Delhi is through temporarily working passes by Security of KL Bhawan, New Delhi for which contractor has to submit the details as required for issue of passes. Any type of losses due to delay and non- issue of passes/permit shall not be the responsibility of department. No claim whatever due to the above aspects shall be entertained by the department.

27. Any misbehaviour, impersonation & security breaches caused by the labour will not be tolerable at all. The contractor shall be fully responsible for such acts of omission if any legal action is initiated by the competent authority for violating the security measures.
28. The agency has to provide all technical literature of the items taken in NIT.
29. All the items shall be purchase through OEM or their authorized distributor or dealers only. In support of purchase photocopy of GST paid invoice will be submitted by the firm.
30. The bidder shall provide onsite warranty for a period of 3 years covering all components.
