1. Eligible Criteria**(A) For CPWD registered contractor**

- The CPWD registered contractor should have valid registration upto the last date of receipt of tender in appropriate class.
- Should have experience of satisfactorily completed similar works **during last seven years** Ending previous day of last date of submission of tenders **(Form-A)** as below:-

- Three similar completed works each costing not less than 20.23 Lacs.
Or
- Two similar completed works, each costing not less than 30.35 Lacs.
Or
- One similar completed work of costing not less than 40.47 Lacs.

The Similar work mean “Providing services of Computer Operator & MTS”.

The value of executed work shall be brought to current costing level by enhancing the actual value of work at simple rate of 7% per annum, calculated from the actual date of completion to previous day of last date of receipt of bids through e-procurement.

2. Conditions for Contractor:

The contractor whose bid is accepted will be required to furnish performance guarantee “(a) 5% of tendered value or Estimated Cost Put to Tender (ECPT) (whichever is higher) and (b) Where the tendered amount is less than eighty percent (80%) of the Estimated Cost Put to Tender (ECPT), the Performance Guarantee, in addition to the requirement under (a) above, shall be increased by an amount equal to the difference between eighty percent (80%) of the ECPT and the tendered amount .” as mentioned in schedule E and within the period specified in Schedule F. This guarantee shall be in the form of Insurance Surety Bonds, Account Payee Demand Draft, Fixed Deposit Receipt or Bank Guarantee from any of the Commercial Banks in accordance with the prescribed form. 12. 14. The competent authority on behalf of President of India reserves to himself the right of accepting the whole or any part of the bid and the bidders shall be bound to perform the same at the rate quoted.
15. The contractor shall not be permitted to bid for works in the CPWD Circle responsible for award and execution of contracts, in which his near relative is posted a Divisional Accountant or as an officer in any capacity between the grades of Superintending Engineer and Junior Engineer (both inclusive). He shall also intimate the names of persons who are working with him in any capacity or are subsequently employed by him and who are near relatives to any Gazetted officer in the Public Works Department or in the Ministry of Urban Development. Any breach of this condition by the contractor would render him liable to be removed from the approved list of contractors of this Department.
16. No Engineer of Gazetted Rank or other Gazetted Officer employed in Engineering or Administrative duties in an Engineering Department of the Government of India is allowed to work as a contractor for a period of one year after his retirement from Government service, without the prior permission of the Government of India in writing. This contract is liable to be cancelled if either the contractor or any of his employees is found any time to be such a person who had not obtained the permission of the Government of India as a fore said before submission of the bid or engagement in the contractor's service.

Preamble

WHERE AS the Principal/Owner has floated the Tender (NIT No. 06/EE/BFD-V/Bhuj/2026-27 (here in after referred to as "Bid") and intends to award, under laid down organizational procedure contract for **Providing services of skilled, semi-skilled, unskilled labour for offices under BFD-V at Bhuj from the contingency of "Replacement of existing 104.00 km damaged fencing with improved smart fencing from BP 1051 to BP 1135 (Phase-3) along Indo-Pak Border in Gujarat Sector Bhuj**

AND WHEREAS the Principal/Owner values full compliance with all relevant laws of the land, rules, regulations, economic use of resources and of fairness/transparency in its relation with its Bidder(s) and Contractor(s).

AND WHEREAS to meet the purpose aforesaid both the parties have agreed to enter into this Integrity Agreement(here in after referred to as "**Integrity Pact**" or "**Pact**"),the terms and conditions of which shall also be read as integral part and parcel of the Tender/ Bid documents and Contract between the parties.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of mutual covenants contained in this Pact, the parties here by agree as follow sand this Pact witnesses as under:

Article1: Commitment of the Principal/Owner

- 1) The Principal / Owner commits itself to take all measures necessary to prevent corruption and to observe the following principles:
 - (a) No employee of the Principal/Owner, personally or through any of his/her family members, will in connection with the Tender, or the execution of the Contract, demand, take a promise for or accept, for self or third person ,any material or immaterial benefit which the person is not legally entitled to.
 - (b) The Principal/ Owner will, during the Tender process, treat all Bidder(s) with equity and reason. The Principal/Owner will, in particular, before and during the Tender process, provide to all Bidder(s) the same information and will not provide to any Bidder(s) confidential / additional information through which the Bidder(s) could obtain an advantage in relation to the Tender process or the Contract execution.

- II) The Principal / Owner shall endeavor to exclude from the Tender process any person, whose conduct in the past has been of biased nature.
- (i) If the Principal/Owner obtains information on the conduct of any of its employees which is a criminal offence under the Indian Penal code (IPC)/Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988 (PC Act) or is in violation of the principles herein mentioned or if there be substantive suspicion in this regard, the Principal/Owner will inform the Chief Vigilance Officer and in addition can also initiate disciplinary actions as per its internal laid down policies and procedures.

Article 2: Commitment of the Bidder (s)/Contractor(s)

- (i) It is required that each Bidder/Contractor (including their respective officers, employees and agents) adhere to the highest ethical standards, and report to the Government /Department all suspected acts of fraud or corruption or Coercion or Collusion of which it has knowledge or becomes aware, during the tendering process and throughout the negotiation or award of a contract.
- (ii) The Bidder(s) /Contractor(s) commits himself to take all measures necessary to prevent corruption. He commits himself to observe the following principles during his participation in the Tender process and during the Contract execution:
- a) The Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) will not, directly or through any other person or firm, offer, promise or give to any of the Principal/Owner's employees involved in the Tender process or execution of the Contract or to any third person any material or other benefit which he/she is not legally entitled to, in order to obtain any exchange or advantage of any kind whatsoever during the Tender process or during the execution of the Contract.
- (iii) The Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) will not enter with other Bidder(s) into any undisclosed agreement or understanding, whether formal or informal. This applies in particular to prices, specifications, certifications, subsidiary contracts, submission or non-submission of bid so as to restrict competition or to cartelize in the bidding process.
- a) The Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) will not commit any offence under the relevant IPC/PC Act. Further the Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) will not use improperly, (for the purpose of competition or personal gain), or pass on to others, any information or documents provided by the Principal/Owner as part of the business relationship, regarding plans, technical proposals and business details, including information contained or transmitted electronically.
- (iv) The Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) of foreign origin shall disclose the names and addresses of agents/ representatives in India, if any. Similarly Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) of Indian Nationality shall disclose names and addresses of foreign agents/representatives, if any. Either the Indian agent on behalf of the foreign principal or the foreign principal directly could bid in a tender but not both. Further, in cases where an agent participates in a tender on behalf of one manufacturer, he shall not be allowed to quote on behalf of another manufacturer along with the first manufacturer in a subsequent/parallel tender for the same item.
- (v) The Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) will, when presenting his bid, disclose any and all payments he has made, is committed to or intends to make to agents, brokers or any other person in connection with the award of the Contract.
- 3) The Bidder(s) /Contractor (s) will not instigate third persons to commit offences outlined above or be an accessory to such offences.
- 4) The Bidder(s)/ Contractor(s) will not, directly or through any other person or firm indulge in fraudulent practice **means a willful misrepresentation or omission of facts or**

Submission of fake/forged documents in order to induce public official to act in reliance thereof, with the purpose of obtaining unjust advantage by or causing damage to justified interest of others and/or to influence the procurement process to the detriment of the Government interests.

- 5) The Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) will not, directly or through any other person or firm use Coercive Practices (means the act of obtaining something, compelling an action or influencing a decision through intimidation, threat or the use of force directly or indirectly, where potential or actual injury may befall upon a person, his /her reputation or property to influence their participation in the tendering process).

Article3: Consequences of Breach

Without prejudice to any rights that may be available to the Principal/Owner under law or the Contract or its established policies and laid down procedures, the Principal/Owner shall have the following rights in case of breach of this Integrity Pact by the Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) and the Bidder/Contractor accepts and undertakes to respect and uphold the Principal/Owner's absolute right:

- 1) If the Bidder(s)/Contractor(s), either before award or during execution of Contract has committed a transgression through a violation of Article 2 above or in any other form, such as to put his reliability or credibility in question, the Principal/Owner after giving 14 days' notice to the contractor shall have powers to disqualify the Bidder(s) /Contractor(s) from the Tender process or terminate/determine the Contract, if already executed or exclude the Bidder/Contractor from future contract award processes. The imposition and duration of the exclusion will be determined by the severity of transgression and determined by the Principal/Owner. **Such exclusion may be forever or for a limited period as decided by the Principal/Owner.**
- 2) **Forfeiture of EMD/Performance Guarantee /Security Deposit :** If the Principal /Owner has disqualified the Bidder(s) from the Tender process prior to the award of the Contract or terminated/determined the Contract or has accrued the right to terminate/determine the Contract according to Article 3(1), the Principal/Owner apart from exercising any legal rights that may have accrued to the Principal/Owner, may in its considered opinion forfeit the entire amount of Earnest Money Deposit, Performance Guarantee and Security Deposit of the Bidder/Contractor.
- 3) **Criminal Liability:** If the Principal/Owner obtains knowledge of conduct of a Bidder or Contractor, or of an employee or a representative or an associate of a Bidder or Contractor which constitutes corruption within the meaning of IPC Act, or if the Principal/ Owner has Substantive suspicion in this regard, the Principal/Owner will inform the same to law enforcing agencies for further investigation.

Article4: Previous Transgression

- (i) The Bidder declares that no previous transgressions occurred in the last 5 years with any other Company in any country confirming to the anticorruption approach or with Central Government or State Government or any other Central/State Public Sector Enterprises in India that could justify his exclusion from the Tender process.
- (ii) If the Bidder makes incorrect statement on this subject, he can be disqualified from the Tender process or action can be taken for banning of business dealings/ holiday listing of the Bidder/Contractor as deemed fit by the Principal/Owner.

If the Bidder/Contractor can prove that he has resorted/recouped the damage caused by him and has installed a suitable corruption prevention system, the Principal/Owner may, at its own discretion, revoke the exclusion prematurely.

Article5: Equal Treatment of all Bidders/Contractors/Subcontractors

- 1) The Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) undertake(s) to demand from all sub-contractors a commitment in conformity with this Integrity Pact. The Bidder/Contractor shall be responsible for any violation(s) of the principles laid down in this agreement/Pact by any of its Subcontractors/sub-vendors.
- 2) The Principal/Owner will enter into Pacts on identical terms as this one with all Bidders and Contractors.
 - (i) The Principal/Owner will disqualify Bidders, who do not submit, the duly Signed Pact between the Principal/Owner and the bidder, along with the Tender or violate its provisions at any stage of the Tender process, from the Tender process.

Article6-DurationofthePact

- 1) This Pact begins when both the parties have legally signed it. It expires for the Contractor/Vendor 9 months after the completion of work under the contract or till the continuation of defect liability period, whichever is more and for all other bidders, till the Contract has been awarded.
- 2) If any claim is made/lodged during the time, the same shall be binding and continue to be valid despite the lapse of this Pacts as specified above, unless it is discharged/determined by the Competent Authority, PWD.

Article7-OtherProvisions

- (i) This Pact is subject to Indian Law, place of performance and Jurisdiction is the **Headquarters of the Division** of the Principal/Owner, who has floated the Tender.
- (ii) Changes and supplements need to be made in writing. Side agreements have not been made.
- (iii) If the Contractor is a partnership or a consortium, this Pact must be signed by all the partners or by one or more partner holding power of attorney signed by all partners and consortium members. In case of a Company, the Pact must be signed by a representative duly authorized by board resolution.
- (iv) Should one or several provisions of this Pact turn out to be invalid; the remainder of this Pact remains valid. In this case, the parties will strive to come to an agreement to their original intentions.
- (v) It is agreed term and condition that any dispute or difference arising between the parties with regard to the terms of this Integrity Agreement /Pact, any action taken by the Owner/Principal in accordance with this **Integrity Agreement/ Pact or interpretation thereof shall not be subject to arbitration.**

Article 8- LEGAL AND PRIOR RIGHTS

All rights and remedies of the parties hereto shall be in addition to all the other legal rights and remedies belonging to such parties under the Contract and/or law and the same shall be deemed to be cumulative and not alternative to such legal rights and remedies aforesaid. For the sake of brevity, both the Parties agree that this Integrity Pact will have precedence over the Tender/Contact documents with regard any of the provisions covered under this Integrity Pact.

1. All necessary recoveries as per rules will be made from the contractor's bill.
2. As contract labour, shall have no claim for regular employment in the department.
3. The whole work/part work can be closed as per requirement of the department and no compensation etc. shall be all owed on this account.
4. Payment will be made after getting attendance certificate from respective office & online payment receipt submission.
5. No advance payment will be made to agency on any account.
6. The rates for all items of work shall, unless clearly specified otherwise, include cost of all labour, material, tools and plants and other inputs involved in the execution of the item and **nothing extra shall be payable on this account.**
7. The contractor(s) shall quote all-inclusive rates against the items in the schedule of quantities and **nothing extra shall be payable for any of the conditions and specifications** mentioned in the tender documents unless specifically mentioned otherwise.
8. The Contractor shall assume all liability, financial or otherwise in connection with this contract and shall protect and indemnify the Department from any damages and claims that may arise on any account. 10. The personnel of the Contractor shall not be the employees of the Engineer in Charge and they shall not claim from the Engineer-in-Charge any salary or allowances, compensation, damages or anything arising out of their employment/duty under this contract. The contractor shall make them known about this position in writing before deployment under this agreement.
11. **The contractor shall also abide by and comply with the Labour Laws, Workmen Compensation Act, EPF Laws, ESIC Laws, Income Tax laws and Minimum Wages laws, Contract Labour (Regulations Abolition Act) bonus Act. or any other law in force.**
12. Manpower engaged by the contractor shall be trained for providing services. The Contractor shall not employ any person below the age 18 years old. The man power so provided shall maintain office decorum and shall behave properly with the office employees.
13. The Contractor shall not Sub-Contract or Sub-let, transfer or assign the contract or any other part thereof. In the event of the contractor contravening this condition, Engineer in Charge shall be entitled to place the contract elsewhere on the contractors risk and cost and the contractor shall be liable for any loss or damage, which the Engineer in Charge may sustain in consequence or arising out of such replacing of the contract.
14. The Engineer in Charge shall not be under any obligation for providing empanelment to any of the personnel

of the Contractor after the expiry of the contract. The Engineer in Charge does not recognize any employee employer's relationship with any of the workers of the Contractor.

15. The time allotted is 12 Months.

16. All payments shall be made in Indian Currency by means of an ECS/RTGS.

17. If the person remain absent on any working day the agency has to made alternate arrangement for the same.

18. The person engaged through this agreement has to maintain the secrecy of office record. If it is found that any secrecy / document is leaked / sent to any unauthorized person through mail / pen drive, or any other means the service of person shall be terminated from the service on the same day and agency has to engage the another person immediately. Penal action against such person shall agency be initiated depending upon merits of case.

19. Payment of Wages:

- i. It shall be duty of the contractor ensure the disbursement of minimum wages & over time latest by 7th day of each months through bank account of each every worker deployed.
