1. The intending bidder must read the terms and conditions of CPWD-6 carefully. He should only submit his bid if he considers himself eligible and he is in possession of all the documents required.
2. Information and Instructions for bidders posted on website shall form part of bid document.
3. The bid document consisting of plans, specifications, the schedule of quantities of various types of items to be executed and the set of terms and conditions of the contract to be complied with and other necessary documents can be seen and downloaded from website <https://etender.cpwd.gov.in> free of cost.
4. But the bid can only be submitted after deposition of original EMD either in the office of Executive Engineer inviting bids or division office of any Executive Engineer, CPWD within the period of bid submission and uploading the mandatory scanned documents such as Insurance Surety Bonds, Account Payee Demand draft or Bankers Cheque or Fixed Deposit Receiptsor/ and Bank Guarantee (for balance amount as prescribed) from any of the Commercial Bank towards EMD in favour of Executive Engineer as mentioned in NIT, receipt for deposition of original EMD to division office of any Executive Engineer (including NIT issuing EE/ AE), CPWD and other documents as specified.
5. Those contractors who are not registered or have not updated their profile on the website mentioned above, are required to get registered / update their profile beforehand. The necessary training materials including the videos with step to step process are available on download section of <https://etender.cpwd.gov.in>
6. The intending bidder must have valid Class-III digital signature certificate with encryption key (combo type) to perform any operations / transactions on the e-tendering portal / website and the bidder should download and install the eMsigner on their system as per instructions available on download section of <https://etender.cpwd.gov.in>.

7. On opening date, the contractor can login and see the bid opening process. After opening of bids he will receive the competitor bid sheets.
8. Contractor can upload documents in the form of JPG format and PDF format.
9. Contractor must ensure to quote rate in the prescribed column(s) meant for quoting rate in figures appears in yellow colour and the moment rate is entered, it turns sky blue.

In addition to this, while selecting any of the cells a warning appears that if any cell is left blank the same shall be treated as "0". Therefore, if any cell is left blank and no rate is quoted by the bidder, rate of such item shall be treated as "0" (ZERO). However, If a tenderer quotes nil rates against each item in item rate tender or does not quote any percentage above/below on the total amount of the tender or any section / sub head in percentage rate tender, the tender shall be treated as invalid and will not be considered as lowest tenderer.

10. Bidders are advised to keep visiting the above-mentioned web sites from time to time (till the deadline for bid submission or/and extended date of bid submission) for any updates in respect of the tender documents, if any. Failure to do so shall not absolve the applicant of his liabilities to submit the applications complete in all respect including updates thereof, if any. An incomplete application may be liable for rejection.

11. The intending bidder must read the terms and conditions of CPWD-6 carefully. He should only submit his bid if he considers him self eligible and he is in possession of all the documents required.

12. The contractor shall have to make his own arrangement for housing facilities for staff and labour away from maintenance site and shall have to transport the labour between construction site and labour camp at his own cost. No labour huts will be allowed to be constructed at the site. The decision about store at site shall rest with the Engineer-in-charge and the contractor shall have no claim on this account.

13. C.P.W.D Contractor's Labour Regulations:-

- (i) Wages due to every worker shall be paid to him direct by contractor through Bank or ECS or online transfer to his bank account.
- (ii) All wages shall be paid through Bank or ECS or Online Transfer.
- (iii) Shall be the duty of the contractor to ensure the disbursement of wages through bank account of labour.
- (iv) The contractor shall obtain from the junior Engineer or any other authorized representative of the Engineer-in-charge as the case may be, a certificate under his signature at the end of the entries in the "Register of Wages" or the "Wage cum-Muster Roll" as the case may be in the following form:-

1 The enlistment of the contractors should be valid on the last date of submission of bids. In case the last date of submission of bid is extended, the enlistment of contractor should be valid on the original date of submission of bids.

1.1 The work is estimated to cost to **Rs. 10,74,601/-** this estimate, however, is given merely as a rough guide.

1.2 Intending bidders is eligible to submit the bid provided he has definite proof from the appropriate authority, which shall be to the satisfaction of the competent authority, of having satisfactorily completed similar works of magnitude specified in "information & instruction for contractors for e-tendering".

2. Agreement shall be drawn with the successful bidder on prescribed Form No. **C.P.W.D.-7** (or other standard Form as mentioned) which is available as a Govt. of India Publication and also available on website <https://etender.cpwd.gov.in>. Bidders shall quote his rates as per various terms and conditions of the said form which will form part of the agreement.

3. The time allowed for carrying out the work will be **2 months** from the date of start as defined in schedule 'F' or from the first date of handing over of the site, whichever is later, in accordance with the phasing, if any, indicated in the bid documents.

5. The bid document consisting of plans, specifications, the schedule of quantities of the various types of items to be executed and the set of terms and conditions of the contract to be complied with and other necessary documents except Standard General Conditions of Contract Form can be seen on website <https://etender.cpwd.gov.in> or www.cpwd.gov.in of cost.

6. After submission of the bid the contractor can re-submit revised bid any number of times but before last time and date of submission of bid as notified.

7. While submitting the revised bid, contractor can revise the rate of one or more item(s) any number of times (he need not re-enter rate of all the items) but before last time and date of submission of bid as notified.

8. Earnest Money in the form of insurance Surety Bonds, Account Payee Demand Draft, Fixed Deposit Receipt, Banker's Cheque or Bank Guarantee (for balance amount as prescribed) from any of the Commercial Banks (drawn in favour of "**Executive Engineer, DR. 9. The bid submitted shall become invalid if:-

- (i) The bidder is found ineligible.
 - (ii) The bidder does not deposit original EMD either in the office of Executive Engineer inviting bids or with division office of any Executive Engineer, CPWD (The EMD documents shall only be issued from the place in which the office of receiving division office is situated).
 - (iii) The bidder does not upload all documents (including GST registration) as stipulated in the bid document including the copy of receipt for deposition of original EMD instrument.
 - (iv) If any discrepancy is noticed between the documents as uploaded at the time of submission of bid and hard copies as submitted physically by the lowest tenderer in the office of tender opening authority.

10. The contractor whose bid is accepted will be required to furnish performance guarantee of 5% (Five Percent) of tendered value or Estimated Cost Put to Tender (ECPT) (whichever is higher) and including the additional performance guarantee as mentioned in schedule – E and within the period specified in Schedule F. This guarantee shall be in the form of insurance Surety Bonds, Account Payee Demand Draft, Fixed Deposit Receipt, Banker's Cheque or Bank Guarantee (for balance amount as prescribed) from any of the Commercial Bank drawn in favour of Executive Engineer, CPWD, Dr.RML Hospital, New Delhi accordance with the prescribed form. 12. Intending Bidders are advised to inspect and examine the site and its surroundings and satisfy themselves before submitting their bids as to the nature of the ground and sub-soil (so far as is practicable), the form and nature of the site the means of access to the site, the accommodation they may require and in general shall themselves obtain all necessary information as to risks, contingencies and other circumstance which may influence or effect their bid. A bidders shall be deemed to have full knowledge of the site whether he inspects it or not and no extra charge consequent on any misunderstanding or otherwise shall be allowed. The bidders shall be responsible for arranging and maintaining at his own cost all materials, tools and plants, water, electricity access, facilities for workers and all other services required for executing the work unless otherwise specifically provided for in the contract documents. Submission of a bid by a bidder implies that he has read this notice and all other contract documents has made himself aware of the scope and specifications of the work to be done and of conditions and rates at which stores, tools and plants etc., will be issued to him by the Government and local conditions and other factors having a bearing on the execution of the work.
13. The competent authority on behalf of the President of India does not bind itself to accept the lowest or any other bid and reserves to itself the authority to reject any or all the bids received without assignment of any reason. All bids in which any of the prescribed condition is not fulfilled or any condition including that of conditional rebate is put forth by the bidders shall be summarily rejected.
14. Canvassing whether directly or indirectly, in connection with bidders is strictly prohibited and the bids submitted by the contractors who resort to canvassing will be liable for rejection.

15. The competent authority on behalf of President of India reserves to himself the right of accepting the whole or any part of the bid and the bidders shall be bound to perform the same at the rate quoted.
16. The contractor shall not be permitted to bid for works in the CPWD Circle (Division in case of contractors of Horticulture/Nursery category) responsible for award and execution of contracts in which his near relative is posted as Divisional Accountant or as an officer in any capacity between the grades of Superintending Engineer and Junior Engineer (both inclusive). He shall also intimate the names of persons who are working with him in any capacity or are subsequently employed by him and who are near relatives to any gazetted officer in the Central Public Works Department or in the Ministry of Urban Development. Any breach of this condition by the contractor would render him liable to be removed from the approved list of contractors of this Department.
17. No. Engineer of Gazetted rank or other Gazetted officer employed in Engineering or Administrative duties in an Engineering Department of the Government of India is allowed to work as a contractor for a period of one year after his retirement from Government service, without the prior permission of the Government of India in writing. This contract is liable to be cancelled if either the contractor or any of his employees is found any time to be such a person who had not obtained the permission of the Government of India as aforesaid before submission of the bid or engagement in the contractor's service.
18. **The bids for the work shall remain open for acceptance for a period of 30 (thirty) days from the date of opening of bids. Further.**
 - (i) If any tenderer withdraws his tender or makes any modification in the terms & conditions of the tender which is not acceptable to the department within 7 days after last date of submission of bids, then the Government shall without prejudice to any other right or remedy, be at liberty to forfeit 50% of the earnest money absolutely irrespective of letter of acceptance for the work is issued or not.
 - (ii) If any tenderer withdraws his tender or makes any modification in the terms & conditions of the tender which is not acceptable to the department after expiry of 7 days after last date of submission of bids, then the Government shall without prejudice to any other right or remedy, be at liberty to forfeit 100% of the earnest money absolutely irrespective of letter of acceptance for the work is issued or not.
 - (iii) In case of forfeiture of earnest money as prescribed in para (i) and (ii) above, the bidders shall not be allowed to participate in the rebidding process of the same work.

19. This Notice inviting Bid shall form a part of the contract document. The successful bidder/ Contractor, on acceptance of his bid by the Accepting Authority, shall within 4 months from the Stipulated date of start of the work, sign the contract consisting of:-
 - (a) The Notice inviting Bid, all the documents including additional conditions, specifications and Drawings, if any, forming part of the bid as uploaded at the time of invitation of bid and the rates quoted online at the time of submission of bid and acceptance thereof together with any correspondence leading thereto.

20. The intending bidders are required to update their profile in CPWD e- tender portal and to upload their bids well in advance of last date of submission of tender. The e- tendering bidders are also advised not to wait to raise any issues till the last date of submission of bid in their own interest.

IMPORTANT POINTS TO BE OBSERVED BY BIDDERS BEFORE SUBMISSION OF TENDERS

1. The bidder shall see the site of work physically, its accessibility, way and means for mobilization and manpower at hospital site etc. and other related activities before quoting his rates. The quoted rates shall be for carrying out complete activities of work including all materials, T&P, labour, carriage and other inputs. Unless otherwise specified no claim whatsoever will be admissible on this account.
2. The contractor shall engage all manpower as per requirement of work and make all arrangements to make their permission passes from the concerned Hospital Authorities/Local authorities as per prevailing bylaws/restrictions, if any, for working at site of work as the site is located at Dr.RML Hospital premises at DIZ Area, New Delhi. Nothing extra shall be paid on this account.
3. The work is carried out in the reputed Dr. RML Hospital premises at DIZ Area, New Delhi where daily huge footfall about of eight thousand patients and their attendants, office staff, securities persons etc. Progress of work may suffer due to restriction from working hours as the hospital authorities may ask to differ time for work from normal working hours for health safety of patients. The Bidder should quote his rates accordingly keeping the above conditions in mind. The labour and machinery might have to work during odd hours as well from safety point of view and in coordination with hospital authorities. No claim whatsoever shall be admissible on this account.
4. This work is of paramount importance and to be carried out with due diligence as the work will be used by the hospital staff and patients. Bidders are advised to take such urgency and importance into account before quoting rates.
5. The intending bidders should visit the site and ascertain the site conditions etc. The site will be handed over on “as is where is” basis in parts or full. No claim whatsoever shall be entertained by the department on this account.
6. The contractor must have to ensure not to damage the existing structures if any coming at site or on the way to access the site. The damage done, if any by the contractor shall be made good at his or her own risk & cost. No claim whatsoever shall be entertained by the department on this account.
7. If required, the work may be open to inspection by ‘Third Party’ as nominated by Engineer-in-charge and contractor shall fully co-operate and provide necessary assistance during the inspections. The contractor shall comply with the observations of such ‘Third Party’ inspections/quality control team and provisions of Clause-16 of GCC-2023 for maintenance/construction work shall be applicable in this regard.
8. The contractor has to adhere to all the rules and conditions as stipulated by local Administration of statutory authorities Delhi for execution of the work such as installation of Plants & Machineries, labour issues, etc. and abiding with all rules and regulations laid down by the statutory authorities from time to time. In case of any default, it will be the sole responsibility of the contractor for any repercussions thereof. Any legal and administrative issues on this subject with statutory authorities Delhi shall be the sole responsibility of the contractor. However, for the purpose of making any formal request required to be made by the department. The Engineer-in-charge shall facilitate in the matter. No claim whatsoever shall be admissible on this account.

9. Any payments required to be paid to statutory authorities Delhi related to installation, erection, operation, maintenance and transportation of machineries for working at site shall be borne by the contractor. Contractor will also obtain any further clearances as and when required from statutory authorities Delhi.
10. Mandatory recoveries shall be made from the running account bills as per prevailing norms during course of execution.
11. The Security Deposit shall be refunded after the prescribed period as stipulated in the agreement or after the final bill has been passed after the work is handed over to hospital authorities in all respect, whichever is later. No claim whatsoever shall be admissible on this account. This condition will be read with the provisions of clause-17 of GCC-2023 for maintenance/construction work.
12. The Contractor himself or his authorized representative will join the inspection team, fixed to hand over the completed work to RML hospital authorities and is bound to rectify all defects pointed out/intimated by the board members and nothing extra will be paid on this account. If he fails to do so, the defects will be rectified at his risk & cost by the department and will be recovered from his security deposits and/or any other dues lying with the Department.
13. The contractor has to start the work after submitting the work programme duly approved by the Engineer-in-charge. Physical progress shall be similar to the work programme submitted by the contractor and in accordance with the mile stone as in schedule 'F'.
14. GENERAL CONDITIONS

1. The work shall be carried out as per CPWD specifications 2019 Vol I & II with upto date correction slip to the date of receipt of tender. Where CPWD specifications are silent, relevant B.I.S. codes shall be applicable. If the item is not available in the relevant B.I.S. codes then the decision of the Engineer-in-charge shall be final.
2. The contractor has to make his own arrangement for all the materials required for the work and get them approved from the Engineer-in-charge before using the same in the work.
3. The dismantling wherever required shall be done in a manner that no other portions of the building or its fixtures are damaged. If any damage is done to the building it will be made good by the contractor at his own cost and no claim what so ever will be entertained on the work.
4. **The contractor must get himself acquainted with the proposed site for the works and study specifications and conditions carefully before tendering, no claim whatsoever on this account shall be entertained later on.**
5. The work shall be carried out complying in all respects with the requirement of relevant bylaws of the N.D.M.C. or any other local body.
6. All incidental charges of any kind for the materials to be arranged by the contractor whatsoever including cartage, storage, cutting and wastage etc. shall be borne by the contractor himself and nothing extra will be paid to him on this account.
7. The contractor shall have to carry out the work according to the programme mutually decided between him and the Engineer-in-charge of the work. No claim for idle-labour on any account shall be entertained.
8. Necessary recoveries such as water charges, Income Tax, GST, Labour welfare cess etc. as per applicable rate shall be made from the any amount due to the contractor.
9. **The quantities of items should not be executed beyond the agreement quantities without prior permission of the Engineer-in-Charge.**
10. Contractor will have to make his own arrangement for tools and plant & machinery required for the work and department will not supply any tools and plants.
11. The contractor should study the General Conditions of Contract before tendering. This shall be the part of the agreement. It is available in the office of EE/AE & in market.
12. Testing charges shall be borne by the contractor in all cases. All expenditure to be incurred for testing of samples e.g. packing, sealing, transportation, loading, unloading etc including testing charges shall be borne by the contractor, for the testing from the laboratories approved by ADG/SDG time to time.
13. Any damages done to the electric fittings, installations, while using them shall be made good by him at his own cost.
14. **Dr. RML Hospital is facing space crunch as of now due to some big construction activities going on and also due to heavy patient rush. Accordingly, agency has to make their own arrangements for stay of their workers and for the construction of the store also, outside the Hospital complex. Agency shall quote their rates keeping in mind the said situation. Nothing extra shall be paid over and above the quoted rates.**
15. The rates of items include all leads, lifts, heights etc. No extra payment shall be made on any account.
16. **If contractor uses electricity of department, a recovery @ 0.5% shall be made on gross bill amount from each bill. If no electricity is required, then no recovery shall be made on this account.**
17. Site may be made available in parts. The contractor shall start the work within 72 hours from the time the instructions to execute the work are given through site order book/letter/ or otherwise.
18. Agency shall be fully responsible for watch and ward of site, fittings etc. till the work is completed and accepted/taken over by the department. Nothing extra shall be paid for same.
19. The contractor shall make his own arrangement of water required for the work as per clause 31 of the general conditions of the contract for CPWD works and clause 31A of the said conditions stands deleted. However 1% (one percent) water charges shall be recovered on the gross amount of bill from the contractor, if government water is used.
20. Other agencies working at site may also simultaneously execute the work entrusted to them and the contractor shall offer necessary co-operation wherever required to other agencies.
21. The Contractor's Engineers should present at the site on all working days or as working hours allowed by Engineer-in-charge shall carry mobile phones to enable the Engineer-in-charge to have proper communication with them. Nothing extra shall be paid to the contractor on this account and his quoted rates for various items under this contract will be inclusive of this obligation.
22. The contractor shall make all safety arrangement required for the labour engaged by him at his own cost. All consequences due to negligence or due to lapse of security/safety or otherwise shall remain with the contractor. The department shall not be responsible for any mishap, injury, accident or death of the contractor's staff and/or labour. The contractor shall adhere to CPWD Safety Code as given in GCC 2023 for Construction/maintenance works. No claim whatsoever in this regard shall be entertained/accepted by the department.

ADDITIONAL CONDITIONS

1. **Inspection of materials and work:** All the materials brought to the site by the contractor for use in the work as well as fabricated work shall be subject to inspection and approval by the Engineer-in-charge.
2. **Removal of rejected materials:** In case any materials are rejected by the Engineer-in-Charge, the same shall be removed from the site within 48 hours, failing which the same may be got removed by the Engineer-in-charge at the risk and cost of the contractor.
3. **Manufacturer's Test Certificate:** The contractor shall produce Manufacturer's Test Certificate for material supplied by him & for use in work at site. The test(s) shall be carried out as per relevant specifications/ BIS Code as directed by Engineer-in-charge.
4. Contractor should ensure the availability of material at site duly tested as per specifications and approved by the Engineer-in-charge. Dismantling etc. shall not be carried out before the availability of approved material at site. The decision of Engineer-in-Charge shall be final and binding.
5. Area such as corridor, rooms etc. are to be should be cleaned every day. Wherever the malba / rubbish occurs on account of work at upper floors / roof, the same shall be brought down through stair case or with some mechanical arrangement only and shall not be thrown to the ground directly from upper floors and has to be disposed off at specified dumping point in the area. In no case malba / rubbish / unserviceable material or Construction material shall be stacked or dumped near the staircase / path /road berms / road / lawn / outside premises even for temporarily purpose. **The contractor shall have to make all the arrangement for Carriage, stacking and disposal of malba/dismantled unservicable at the specific location in the hospital campus at his own cost. Nothing extra shall be paid for placing the malba at specific approved point, even for lead exceeding 50 metre & lift exceeding 1.5 Metre, as specified in the item.**
6. If the contractor fails to comply the above conditions for removal / disposal of malba, a fine of Rs.500/- for each fault per day shall be recovered from the contractor. The department may remove the malba so generated and dumped, by issue a notice or instruction through site order book at the risk and cost of the contractor. (In this case, item for disposal of malba at approved municipal ground shall not be paid).
7. No claim / dispute shall be entertained on the conditions at any stage either during execution of work or after completion of work and decision of the Engineer-in-charge shall be final and binding.
8. Unless and until specified in the item the contractor shall make his own arrangement for lifting / hoisting / placing of steel girders / steel sections by suitable arrangement either manually or by mechanical crane etc. as approved by the Engineer-in-charge upto all heights in the building at no extra cost.
9. The contractor shall stack the building materials away from the building at site as approved by the Engineer-in-charge and nothing extra for lead / lift of material for bringing the materials manually in the premises shall be paid.
10. During execution of work the agency may have to dismantle certain existing items of the work other than taken in schedule of quantity. This dismantled materials received during demolition, if not taken back by the Department, shall be recovered at the rates as follows: -
 - a) Wooden window/doors/shutters with or without frames shall be recovered @ Rs.200/- per Sqm except M.S. bars.
 - b) Sectional windows / steel door windows / C.I / G.I. Pipes etc. at Rs. 30/- per Kg.
 - c) Old C.I. flushing cistern including fittings at Rs. 250/- per cistern.
 - d) Aluminium sections, tees, angles, channels etc. at Rs. 160/- per kg.
 - e) Plyboards / flushing cistern & other PVC materials etc. Rs. 12/- per kg by weight.

The decision of Engineer in charge for dismantled materials to be taken back & for mode of payment & for recovery etc. shall be final and binding.
11. The contractor shall at his own cost make arrangement for weighing of the dismantled materials at site of work.
12. The dismantled bricks, brick tile and red sand stone shall be accounted for recovery from the contractor at rate described below:-

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13. Before starting the work the contractor shall chalk out a programme in consultation with the Junior Engineer /Assistant Engineer-In-charge as to inform the occupants at least one week ahead. The contractor shall have to adhere to this programme failing which contractor shall be responsible for any inconvenience caused to the occupants. In order to ensure that the work is carried out according to the programme drawn up the contractor shall ensure adequate supply of the material and employ required labour strength for execution of work. In case contractor fails to arrange / employ adequate labour to stick the programme, the Engineer-in-charge may supplement the labour and cost of the labour shall be recovered from the contractor after issue of one day's notice to the contractor. No claim for idle labour shall be entertained. The contractor shall depute his representatives daily at site of work for the record of the department.
14. The contractor shall prepare one sample of all items which should be got approved from the Engineer-in-charge. Only on acceptance of sample work, contractor will be allowed to commence the work and sample is to be preserved by contractor till the whole work is completed. The quality of work should be confirmed to the approved samples.
15. The contractor shall note that the items of work in any room shall be undertaken at one time, one after the other and completed at one stretch in time allowed for the same by the Engineer-in-charge.
16. The contractor and/or his authorized representative should see the site order book every day and get the compliance noted by the J.E. /A.E. / Engineer-in-charge.
17. The rooms/sites where the work is to be executed on any day shall be got approved from the representatives of the Engineer-in-charge at the site of work. No work shall be carried out in any room/site without the approval of the representative of the Engineer at the site of work. Such work carried out without the approval of the representative of the work shall be rejected and will not be measured and paid for.
18. The substandard work shall be rejected out-rightly. The decision of the Engineer-in-charge shall be final and binding in this regard.
19. Nothing extra shall be paid to the contractor for excess consumption of materials in case of material arranged by him.
20. Any damages done to the existing structure shall be made good by the contractor at his own risk and cost.
21. The rates of all items of work shall unless clearly specified include the cost of all labour, material and other aspects involved in the execution of work.
22. Due to security reason the contractor shall have to arrange timetable of labour according to the security staff and Engineer-in-charge instructions. The contractor should see the site before the execution of work.
23. The contractor shall make his own arrangement for getting the permission to ply the trucks from the traffic police.
24. Passes shall be arranged by the department for inside the building only.
25. The contractor shall be responsible for behaviour and conduct of his workers. No worker with doubtful integrity or having a bad record shall be engaged by the contractor.
26. The contractor shall have to remove all splashes after completing the work. In case the splashes are not removed by the contractor the same shall be got removed by the Engineer-in-charge and necessary recovery for the cost of removal of splashes shall be made from the contractor.
27. The work shall be carried out in the manner complying in all respects with the requirement of relevant bye-laws of the local bodies under the jurisdiction of which the work is to be executed and nothing extra shall be paid on this account.
28. For completing the work in time, the contractor might be required to work in two or more shifts including night shifts and no claim whatsoever shall be entertained on this account, notwithstanding the fact that the contractor will have to pay to the labourers and other staff engaged directly or indirectly on the work according to the provisions of the labour regulation and the agreement entered upon and/or extra amount for any other reason.
29. The contractor must take adequate precautions to ensure that no spillage of construction material/malba/building rubbish takes place on to the carriageway. Failure to observe this will make the contractor liable to pay compensation @ Rs. 100/- (Rs. One Hundred only) per day, per metre length of each carriage way as affected by spill over of any construction material, subject to a maximum of 5% (Five percent) of the estimated cost of the work put to the tender. The decision of Engineer-in-charge in this regard, shall be final and binding on the contractor.
30. The temporary warning lamps shall be installed at all barricades during the hours of darkness and kept lit at all times during these hours.
31. The malba/rubbish shall be disposed off by mechanical transport to the approved municipal dumping ground for which payment shall be made as per item in the agreement. The lead specified

in the agreement is indicative only. The rate to be quoted by the agency /contractor for disposal upto the approved municipal dumping ground shall be inclusive of all and nothing extra over and above the agreement item(s) shall be paid. If the quantum, of malba, so generated from the work is less than one truck load, the same shall have to be collected in wheel barrow /trolley and shall be dumped at the specified dumping point, approved by the Engineer in-charge, in the area and the same should be lifted as soon the one truck load is collected or within three days which ever is earlier. **Malba is to be disposed at nearest approved MCD dumping ground by mechanical transport as per direction of Engineer-in-charge. Payment will be made on production of MCD receipt.**

32. **Water Proofing Work:-**

The tenderer shall associate specialized agencies for water proofing work with **M.O.U. as per Annexure-A & Annexure-B** who have satisfactorily completed three water proofing works of similar nature of each costing not less than 40% of tendered amount of corresponding water proofing item, or two water proofing works of similar nature each costing not less than 60% of tendered amount of corresponding water proofing item or one similar work costing not less than 80% of tendered amount of corresponding water proofing item; during the last seven years ending last day of the month previous to the one in which tenders are invited. The value of executed works shall be brought to current costing level by enhancing the actual value of work at simple rate of 7% per annum; calculated from the date of completion to previous day of last day of submission of tenders.

However, the main contractor shall also be eligible to carry out himself the water proofing works without associating any specialized agency provided they fulfil the above prescribed eligibility criteria.

GUARANTEE BOND:- Ten years guarantee bond of water proofing item in prescribed proforma, herewith shall be submitted by the contractor which shall also be signed by the contractor to meet their liability/liabilities under the guarantee bond.

10% of total cost of water proofing item (excluding cost of external plaster on masonry, if water proofing compound added in external plaster also) shall be retained as additional security deposit and the amount so withheld would be released after ten years from the date of completion of the entire work under the agreement. If the performance of the work done is found unsatisfactory and any defects noticed during the guarantee period, they shall be rectified by the agency within 10 days of receipt of intimation of defects in the work. If the defects pointed out are not attended to within the specified period, the same will be got done from another agency at the risk and cost of the agency. However, the security deposit deducted may be released in full against bank guarantee of equivalent amount in favour of Engineer in charge, if so decided by the Engineer in charge. The Security deposit against this item of work shall be in addition to the security deposit mentioned elsewhere in contract form.

34. **Recovery of the dismantled (Unserviceable) material:-**

During the execution of the work if any dismantled material found to be unserviceable and credit to the work the rates should not be less than are as (i) Fuel Wood/PVC material and the like similar materials @ 12/- per kg. (ii) GI Pipe/SCI Pipe/MS Grill/CI Pipe etc. and the like similar materials @ Rs. 30/- per kg (iii) CP Brass/Brass etc. & the like similar material @ 350/- & (iv) Aluminium material etc. and the like similar materials @ 160/- per kg (should not be less than as mentioned) and nothing extra shall be paid on account of these materials.

PARTICULAR SPECIFICATIONS

1. The work, in general, shall be executed as per description of item, specifications attached, updated CPWD Specifications, MoRTH Specification with correction slips issued up to the date of receipt of tender and relevant BIS Codes, BSEN codes, ISO Codes & ASTM Codes.
2. All the works unless otherwise specified hereinafter or permitted by Engineer-in-charge shall be done in accordance with the latest editions of CPWD specification and relevant BIS Codes, BSEN codes, ISO Codes & ASTM Codes as on the date of receipt of tenders or any other specified code.

Any additional standard specifications or criteria published by the BIS or other foreign standard and in practice upto the date of receipt of tenders shall also taken into account. In the absence of any definite provisions an any particular issue in the above mentioned specifications / relevant BIS Codes, BS, EN codes, ISO Codes & ASTM Codes, the design and construction shall be in conformity with the Sound Engineering Practice and in all such matters the decision of the Engineer-in-charge shall be final and binding on the contractor and nothing shall be paid extra.

3. In case of any discrepancy or contradiction amongst the specified standards the following order of preferences shall generally prevail.
 - i. Nomenclature of items etc. given in Schedule of Quantities.
 - ii. Particular Specifications, Special conditions and additional specifications if any.
 - iii. Drawings attached with the tender.
 - iv. CPWD Specifications, 2019 Vol. I & II with up-to-date correction slips.
 - v. MoRTH Specifications for Roads & Bridge works (Fifth revision) published by IRC.
 - vi. Relevant BIS Codes with the latest revisions.
 - vii. Relevant IRC Codes with the latest revisions.
 - viii. International standards such as BS, EN, ASTM etc. and accepted international practice as approved by Engineer-in-Charge.
 - ix. Sound Engineering Practice as per directions of the Engineer-in-Charge.

If there are varying or conflicting provision made in any document forming part of the contract, the Engineer-in-charge shall be the deciding authority with regard to the Intention / interpretation of the document and his decision shall be binding without any reservations.

4. The contractor shall ensure quality control measures on different aspects of construction materials, workmanship and correct construction methodologies to be adopted. He shall have to submit quality assurance programme within two weeks of the award of the work. The quality assurance programme should include method statement for various items of work to be executed along with check list to enforce quality control.
 - 4.1 The contractor shall submit samples of brand / make of various materials to be used for the approval of the Engineer-in-Charge along with samples. All approved samples shall be displayed at the site office along with copy of the approvals.
 - 4.2 The contractor shall submit shop drawings of staging and formwork arrangement etc. for the approval of Engineer-in-Charge. Unless stated otherwise, the rate for concrete in plain concrete or reinforced concrete or prestressed concrete, shall be deemed to include all formwork required in accordance with this Section, which shall not be measured separately. The contractor shall also submit bar bending schedule for approval of Engineer-in-charge before execution.

5. **CONDITIONS FOR STEEL**

- 5.1 The contractor shall procure steel reinforcement bars conforming to relevant BIS codes from main producers as approved by the ministry of Steel and secondary producers or re-rollers having valid BIS licence. For TMT bars conforming to relevant BIS code, procurement shall be made from main producers and secondary producers having valid BIS licence. The contractor shall have to obtain and furnish test certificates to the Engineer – In – Charge in respect of all supplies of steel brought by him to the site of work. Samples shall also be taken and got tested by the Engineer – In – Charge as per the provisions in this regard in relevant BIS codes. In case the test results indicate that the steel arranged by the contractor does not conform to BIS codes, the same shall stand rejected and shall be removed from the site of work by the contractor at his cost within a week's time from written order from the Engineer-in-Charge to do so.
- 5.2 The contractor will produce original challan / voucher for purchase of steel reinforcement from approved manufacturer as a proof of having the steel reinforcement purchased from approved manufacturer.
- 5.3 The steel reinforcement shall be brought to the site in bulk supply of 10 tonnes or more or as decided by the Engineer-in-Charge. Every consignment of steel brought to site shall be accompanied with test certificate issued by the manufacturer.
- 5.4 The steel reinforcement shall be stored by the contractor at site of work in such a way as to prevent distortion and corrosion by applying coating of corrosion inhibitor slurry as per nomenclature of the item and nothing extra shall be paid on this account. Bars of different sizes and lengths shall be stored separately to facilitate easy counting and checking.
- 5.5 For checking nominal mass, tensile strength, bend test, rebend test etc. specimen of sufficient length shall be cut from each size of the bar at random at frequency not less than that specified below:-

- 5.6 The actual issue and consumption of steel on work shall be regulated and proper accounts maintained as provided in Clause-10 of the contract. The theoretical consumption of steel shall be worked out as per procedure prescribed in clause 42 of the contract and shall be governed by conditions laid therein. No payment for excess consumption of steel shall be allowed. However, for consumption lesser upto the permissible theoretical variation, recovery shall be made in accordance with conditions of contract at schedule 'F' (CPWD-8), without prejudice to action for acceptance of work / item at reduced rate or rejection as the case may be.
- 5.7 Steel brought to site and steel remaining unused shall not be removed from site without the written permission of the Engineer-in -Charge.
- 5.8 The mild steel and medium tensile steel bars to be used shall conform to IS: 432 and cold twisted bars and TMT bars shall conform to IS : 1786.
- 5.9 (i) Reinforcement including authorised spacer bars and lappings shall be measured in length of different diameters as actually (not more than as specified in the drawings) used in the work nearest to a centimetre. Wastage and unauthorized overlaps shall not be measured.

(ii) Records of actual sectional weights shall also be kept diawise and lotwise. The average sectional weight for each diameter shall be arrived at from samples from each lot of steel received at site. The decision of the Engineer - in - Charge shall be final for the procedure to be followed for determining the average sectional weight of each lot. Quantity of each diameter of steel received at site of work each day will constitute one single lot for the purpose. The weight of steel by conversion of length of various sizes of bars based on the actual weighted average sectional weight shall be termed as Derived Actual Weight.

(iii) (a) If the Derived Weight as in sub - para (ii) above is lesser than the Standards weight then the Derived Actual Weight shall be taken for payment.

(b) If the Derived Actual Weight is found more than the Standard Weight, then the Standard Weight as worked out in sub - para (ii) above shall be taken for payment. In such case nothing extra shall be paid for the difference between the Derived Actual Weight and the standard weight.

5.10.1 Thermo - Mechanically Treated Bars (TMT Bars) shall be used in all R.C.C. works. TMT Bars of Fe 415 grade conforming to IS - 1786 Specifications shall be procure from Main producers as approved by Min. of Steel and secondary producers having valid BIS licence.

5.10.2 Every care should be taken to avoid mixing different types of grades of bars in the same structural members as main reinforcement to satisfy clause 25.1 of IS: 456.

5.10.3 The point of change over shall be planned at any one particular level and shall be done through columns only. At the point of change over, it shall be necessary to increase the area of main steel in columns by 10% and the length of lap of bars by 50%.

6. CONDITIONS FOR CEMENT

(i) The contractor shall Procure 43 grade (conforming to IS 8112) ordinary Portland cement, as required in the work, from reputed manufacturers of cement, having a production capacity of one million tonnes or more per annum, such as A.C.C., Ultratech, Birla, J.K. Cement, etc. as approved by Ministry of Industry, Government of India, and holding licence to use ISI certification mark for their product whose name shall be got approved from Engineer-in-charge. Supply of cement shall be taken in 50 kg. Bags bearing manufacturer's name and ISI marking.

(ii) The contractor shall assess theoretical requirement of cement to be used in the work. The cement shall be brought at site in supply of approximately 50% of the total assessed requirement or 100 bags whichever ever is more. In case assessed requirement is less than 100 bags, then agency has to bring whole quantity in one lot. However decision of the Engineer-in-Charge shall be final.

(iii) The cement godown of the capacity to store a minimum of 200 bags of cement shall be constructed by the contractor at site of work for which no extra payment shall be made. Double lock provision shall be made to the door of the cement godown. The keys of one lock shall remain with the Engineer-in-Charge or his authorized representative and the keys of the other lock shall remain with the contractor. The contractor shall be responsible for the watch and ward and safety of the cement godown. The contractor shall facilitate the inspection of the cement godown by the Engineer-in-Charge at any time.

(iv) The contractor shall produce manufacturer's test certificate for cement for each lot of cement, which the contractor has brought at site. The contractor shall also produce bill of purchase from manufacturer or their authorized dealer in addition.

- (v) The actual issue and consumption of cement on work shall be regulated and proper accounts maintained as provided in Clause 10 of the contract. The theoretical consumption of cement shall be worked out as per procedure prescribed in Clause 42 of the contract and shall be governed by conditions laid therein.
- (vi) Cement brought to site and cement remaining unused after completion of work shall not be removed from site without written permission of the Engineer-in-Charge.
- (vii) Damaged cement shall be removed from site immediately by the contractor on receipt of a notice in writing from the Engineer-in-Charge. If he does not do so within three days of the receipt of such notice, the-Engineer-in-charge shall get it removed at the cost of the contractor.

7. READY MIXED CONCRETE.

The contractors should declare at the time of tendering as to how he will arrange design mix concrete i.e. whether he would install fully automatic concrete batching plant at the site of work or would arrange design mix concrete from approved ready mix concrete plant. **The contractor shall procure RMC from the reputed manufacturers preferred make. In case, the RMC is procured by the contractor from the agency other than preferred make, approval of NIT making authority shall be essential.** Contractor should, however, note that no reason for delay on account of time taken in deciding Job Mix Formula shall be accepted. If the contractor decides to procure ready-mixed- concrete from RMC plants, he shall, within a week of award of the work, submit a list of at least three R.M.C. plant companies of repute along with the details of such plants indicating name of owner/company, its location, capacity, technical establishment, past experience and text of Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) proposed to be entered between purchaser and supplier to the satisfaction of Engineer-in-charge, who, after satisfying himself about quality/capability of the company, shall give approval in writing (subject to drawl of MOU). The MOU shall be drawn with RMC plant owner/company and submitted to Engineer-in-charge within a week of such approval. The contractor will not be allowed to purchase ready-mixed-concrete without completion of above stated formalities for use in this project.

Notwithstanding the approval granted by Engineer-in-charge in aforesaid manner, the contractor shall be fully responsible for quality of concrete including input control, production control, transportation and placement etc. The Engineer-in-charge will reserve right to deploy his representative to inspect plant site at any stage and reject the material / concrete if he is not satisfied about quality of material/ product. The contractor should, therefore, draw MOU/ agreement with RMC owner / company very carefully keeping all terms and conditions/specifications forming a part of this tender document.

 - ii) All Samples of materials including cement concrete cubes is taken jointly with Contractor by JE, if there is no JE, out of this at least 50% samples shall be taken in presence of AE in charge and 10 % sample shall be taken in presence of EE. All the necessary assistance is to be provided by the contractor. Cost of sample of materials including testing charges is to be borne by the contractor and he/she is responsible for safe custody of samples to be tested at site.
 - iii) All the test in field lab setup at construction site is carried out by the Engineering Staff deployed by the contractor preferably.
