GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1.0 SCOPE OF WORK

- 1.1 CCI in LBZ area, New Delhi E&M services is provided by DED-102, CPWD.
- 1.2 The following E&M works are proposed to be carried during upgradation/ renovation:
 - a) Façade lighting works .

2.0 Introduction

These conditions are intended to amplify the General Conditions of Contract, and shall be read in conjunction with the same. For any discrepancy between the General Conditions and these Special Conditions, the more stringent shall apply.

3.0 Location

The work is to be carried out at CCI, Rafi Marg, New Delhi.

4.0 Related Documents

These additional specifications are to be read in conjunction with the specification given in the tender. In case any item/ items or part thereof are not covered under these specifications, the same shall be carried out as per relevant part of the CPWD General Specification for Electrical Works Part-I Internal -2013, Part-II External-1995, amended upto dates, relevant electricity act BIS/IEC and as per direction of Engineer-in-Charge. These additional specifications are to be read in conjunction with above and in case of variations; specifications given in this additional condition shall apply. However, nothing extra shall be paid on account of these additional specifications and conditions, as the same are to be read along with schedule of quantities for the work. In case of discrepancy among the specifications/conditions as mentioned above the precedence given in general condition of contract shall be followed. The E&M agency shall possess a Valid Electrical Licence.

5.0 Site Information

The site is available for work. The tenderer should, in his own interest, visit the site and familiarize himself with the site conditions before tendering.

6.0 Safety Codes and Labour Regulations

In respect of all labour employed directly or indirectly on the work for the performance of contractor's part of work, the contractor at his own expense, will arrange for the safety provisions as per the statutory provision, B.I.S. recommendations, factory act, workman's compensation act, CPWD code and instructions issued from time to time. Failure to provide such safety requirements would make the tenderer liable for penalty for Rs. 2000/- for each violation. In addition the Engineer-in-charge, shall be at liberty to make arrangements and provide facilities as aforesaid and recover the cost from the contractor. The contractor shall provide necessary barriers, signals and other safety measures while executing the installation or wherever necessary so as to avoid accident. He shall also indemnify CPWD against claims for compensation arising out of negligence in this respect. Contractor shall be liable, in accordance with the Indian law and Regulations for any accident occurring due to any cause. The contractor shall also provide all insurance including third party insurance as may be necessary to cover the risk. No extra payment would be made to the contractor due to the above provisions thereof.

7.0 Works to be done by the contractor

Unless otherwise mentioned in the tender documents, the following works shall be done by the contractor and therefore, their cost shall be deemed to be included in their tendered cost- whether specifically indicated in the schedule of work or not: -

- i) Complete wiring.
- ii) Making good all damages caused to the structure during installation and restoring the same to their original finish.
- iii) Minor building work necessary for installation of equipments, making opening in the wall/floors/slabs/tables or modifications in the existing openings wherever provided and restoring the same to their original condition/ finish and necessary grouting etc. as required. Opening in the slab/retaining walls/brick wall etc. shall be made by means of core cutting machines only.
- iv) Sealing of all floor slab/wall openings provided by the Department or made by the contractor for laying cables from fire safety points of view.

8.0 Rates

10.0 Power Supply

- a) Arrangement of temporary water and electricity required by Contractor, shall be made by him at his own cost and also necessary permissions shall be obtained by him directly from concerned authorities, under intimation to the Department. Also, all initial cost and running charges, and security deposit, if any, in this regard shall be borne by him. The Contractor shall abide by all the rules/ bye laws applicable in this regard and he shall be solely responsible for any penalty on account of violation of any of the rules/byelaws in this regard. Nothing extra shall be payable on this account. The contractor is strictly prohibited to use ground water by digging bore well from the site premises. He may bring water from outside through tankers from authorized sources.
- b) The Contractor shall be responsible for maintenance and watch and ward of the complete installation and water / electricity meter and shall also be responsible for any pilferage, theft, damage, penalty etc. in this regard. The Contractor shall indemnify the Department against any claim arising out of pilferage, theft, damage, penalty etc. whatsoever on this account. Security deposit for the work shall be released only after No Dues Certificates are obtained from the local Authorities from whom temporary electric/ water / telephone connection have been obtained by the Contractor. Nothing extra shall be payable on this account.
- c) The Department shall in no way be responsible for either any delay in getting electric and/or water connections for carrying out the work or not getting connections at all. No claim of delay or any other kind, whatsoever, on this account shall be entertained from the Contractor. Also contingency arrangement of stand-by water & electric supply shall be made by the Contractor for commencement and smooth progress of the work so that work does not suffer on account of power failure or disconnection or not getting connection at all. No claim of any kind whatsoever shall be entertained on this account from the Contractor. Nothing extra shall be payable on this account.

1.0 Cleanliness of site

- i) The Contractor shall not stack building material/malba/muck on the land or road of the local development authority or on the land owned by the others, as the case may be. So the muck, rubbish etc. shall be removed periodically as directed by the Engineer-in-Charge, from the site of work to the approved dumping grounds as per the local byelaws and regulations of the concerned authorities and all necessary permissions in this regard from the local bodies shall be obtained by the Contractor. Nothing extra shall be payable on this account. In case, the Contractor is found stacking the building material/malba as stated above, the Contractor shall be liable to pay the stacking charges/penalty as may be levied by the local body or any other authority and also to face penal action as per the rules, regulations and bye-laws of such body or authority. The Engineer –in-Charge shall be at liberty to recover, such sums due but not paid to the concerned authorities on the above counts, from any sums due to the Contractor including amount of the Security Deposit and performance guarantee in respect of this contract agreement.
- ii) The contractor shall take instructions from the Engineer-In-Charge regarding collection and stacking of materials at any place. No excavated earth or building rubbish shall be stacked on areas where other buildings, roads, services and compound walls are to be constructed.

The site of work shall be always kept clean due to constraints of space and to avoid any nuisance to the users of buildings in the adjacent area. The Contractor shall take all care to prevent any water- logging at site. The waste water, slush etc. shall not be allowed to be collected at site. It may be directly pumped into the creek with prior approval of the concerned authorities. For discharge into public drainage system, necessary permission shall be obtained from relevant authorities after paying the necessary charges, if any, directly to the authorities. The work shall be carried out in such a way that the area is kept clean and tidy. All the fees/charges in this regard shall be borne by the Contractor. Nothing extra shall be payable on this account.

12.0 Preferred Makes

The preferred makes of the various equipments/ components/ accessories have been indicated in "Preferred Makes" annexed with this document. The bidders shall work out the cost of the offers on this basis. Alternate make/ model are not acceptable.

13.0 Machinery for Erection

All tools and tackles required for unloading/ handling of equipments and materials at site, their assembly, erection, testing and commissioning shall be the responsibility of the contractor.

14.0 Completeness of the Tender

i) Completeness of the tender:-

All sundry equipments, fittings, assemblies, accessories, hardware items, foundation blots, supports, termination lugs for electrical connections connecting wires/ cables, cable glands, junction boxes and all other items which are useful and necessary for proper assembly and efficient working of the various equipments and components of the work shall be deemed to have been included in the tender, irrespective of the fact whether such items are specifically mentioned in the tender or not.

ii) Submission of program:-

The successful tenderer, after receipt of the letter of award, shall submit his program for submission of drawings, supply of equipment, installation, testing, commissioning and handing over of the installation to the Engineer-in-charge..

iii) Commencement of Work

The contractor shall submit the complete scheme and drawings etc. of the complete system and shall commence work as soon as the drawings submitted by him are approved either in full or in part as the case may be.

15.0 Extent of Work

The work shall comprises of entire labour including supervision and all material necessary to meet a complete installation and such tests and adjustment and commissioning, as may be required by the department. The term complete installation shall not only mean major items of the plant and equipments covered by the specification but all incidental sundry components necessary for complete execution and satisfactory performance of installation with all layout charts whether or not those have been mentioned in detail in the tender documents in connection with this contract. Further, it is clarified that nothing extra will be paid on account of following works which are required for completion of work.

16.0 Compliance with Regulations and Indian Standards:

(i) All works shall be carried out in accordance with relevant regulation, both statutory and those specified by the Indian Standards related to the works covered by this specification. In particular, the equipment and installation will comply with the following:

- a) Factories Act.
- b) Indian Electricity Rules.
- c) B.I.S. & other standards as applicable.
- d) Workmen's compensation Act.
- e) Statutory norms prescribed by local bodies like CEA, Power Supply Co., etc.

(ii) Nothing in this specification shall be construed to relieve the successful tenderer of his responsibility for the design, manufacture and installation of the equipment with all accessories in accordance with currently applicable statutory regulations and safety codes.

(iii) Successful tenderer shall arrange for compliance with statutory provisions of safety regulations and departmental requirements of safety codes in respect of labour employed on the work by the tenderer. Failure to provide such safety requirement would make the tenderer liable for penalty of Rs. 500/- for each default. In addition, the department will be at liberty to make arrangement for the safety requirements at the cost of tenderer and recover the cost thereof from him.

17.0 Co-Ordination with other Agencies

The contractor during the execution of the works shall co-ordinate with other agencies associated work with the project and shall work in harmony with them without causing any hindrance or obstruction on the progress of work in any way.

18.0 Mobilization Advance:

No mobilization advance shall be paid for this work.

19.0 Insurance and Storage :

All consignments are to be duly insured upto the destination from warehouse at the cost of the contractor. The insurance covers shall be valid till the equipment is handed over duly installed, tested and commissioned.

20.0 Verification of Correctness of Equipment at Destination:

The contractor shall have to produce all the relevant records to certify that the genuine equipments from the manufacturers has been supplied and erected.

21.0 Painting:

This shall include cost of painting of the entire installation. The agency shall be required to do only touching to the damages caused to the painting during transportation, handling & installation at site, if there is no major damage to the painting. All iron works shall be painted at the work before dispatch to the site with two coats of anti corrosive primer paint. One coat of final finishing of approved color may be done at the factory before dispatch if considered necessary by the tenderer on such components, which will not need removal of such parts at site during assembly/erection work. Marking of identification of each equipment as per direction of engineer-in-charge shall be got done.

22.0 Quality of Materials and Workmanship

- i) The components of the installation shall be such design so as to satisfactorily function under all conditions of operation.
- ii) The entire work of manufacture/fabrication, assembly and installation shall conform to sound engineering practice.
- iii) All equipments and material to be used in work shall be manufactured in factories of good repute having excellent track record of quality manufacturing, performance and proper after sales service.
- iv) All equipments and materials to be used in the work shall be brand new having its date of manufacturing not more than 6 month old from the date of delivery at site with manufacturer's certificates, warrantee cards, technical catalogues, instructions, manuals and wiring diagrams etc.
- v) In order to ensure genuineness of equipments/materials, copy of invoice of each equipments/materials, custom clearance paper in case of imported materials duly authenticated by bidder shall be invariably produce to engineer-in-charge.

23.0 Care of the Building

Care shall be taken by the contractor during execution of the work to avoid damage to the building. Care shall also be taken by the contractor to avoid the damage to any of these existing service/service lines, any part of the building etc. If any damage is caused to any of the existing services/service lines, or any part of the building the same shall be repaired/rectified and made functional or restored so its original finish by the contractor immediately at his own expenses failing which the same shall be repaired/ rectified and made functional by department at the risk and cost of the contractor. The decision of the Engineer-in-charge in this regard shall be final & binding. He shall also remove all unwanted and waste materials arising out of the installation from the site of work from time to time.

24.0 Inspection and Testing

(a)Final Inspection and Testing

Upon completion of work the performance test shall demonstrate the following among other things:

- i) Equipment installed complies with specification in all respects and is of the correct rating for the duty and site conditions.
- ii) All items operate efficiently and quietly to meet the specified requirements as per the warranty /guaranty.
- iii) All circuits are correctly protected /modify as per the site protective devices are properly coordinated.
- iv) All non current carrying metal parts are properly and safely grounded in accordance with the specifications and appropriate codes of practice.
- v) The contractor shall provide all necessary instruments and labour for testing. He shall make adequate records of test procedures and readings and shall repeat any tests requested by the Engineer in charge. Test certificate duly signed by authorized person shall be submitted for scrutiny.
- vi) If it is proved that the installation or part thereof is not satisfactorily carried out then the contractor shall be liable for the rectification and retesting of the same as called for by the Engineer in charge. All tests shall be carried out in the presence of representative of Engineer in charge.
- vii) The above general requirements as to testing shall be read in conjunction with any particular requirements specified elsewhere. All tests shall be carried out by a test house approved by the Engineer in charge.
- viii) The system shall be tested in the presence of Engineer in charge's representative at Supplier's works in accordance with latest prevailing standards and codes. The successful passing of any such tests will not

however prejudice the right of Purchaser to reject the system and its accessories, if they do not comply with specifications when erected or perform complete satisfactory operation as intended.

- ix) Final Inspection and testing will be done by the Engineer-in-Charge or his representative as per details indicated in relevant section of Technical Specifications.

(b) **Safety Measures**

All equipments shall incorporate suitable safety provision to ensure safety of the operating personnel at all times. The initial and final inspection reports shall bring out explicitly the safety provisions incorporated in each equipment.

25.0 Guarantee

- i) The contactor shall guarantee the complete system to maintain the specified conditions under all conditions of ambient temperature.
- ii) All equipments shall be guaranteed for a period of **12 months** from the date of acceptance and taking over of the installation by the department against unsatisfactory performance and/or breakdown due to defective design, material, manufacture, workmanship or installation. The equipment or component or any part thereof so found defective during the guarantee period shall be repaired or replaced free of cost to the satisfaction of the Engineer-in-Charge. In case it is felt by the department that undue delay is being caused by the contactor in doing this, the same will be got done by the department at the risk and cost of the contractor. The decision of Engineer-in-Charge in this regard shall be final.

25.1 The Bidder shall give the Guarantee for the following, during defect liability period of 1 year, among other things:

- a). **Quality, strength and performance of the materials used as per manufacturer's standards.**
- b). **Safe mechanical and electrical stress on all parts under all specified conditions of operation.**
- c). **Any complaint is to be attended as and when required, on call basis, during defect liability period of 1 year and nothing extra shall be paid on this account.**

25.2 LED Fitting Guarantee.

- a). **During the defect liability period of 5 years for LED lights, any defect in the LED luminaries including drivers and all associated accessories are to be rectified within 48 hrs, at no additional cost. Failing which a penalty at the rate of Rs.500/- per complaint per day shall be recovered from the amount withheld.**
- b). **The agency should submit LM79 and LM80 reports issued from NABL Lab along with 5 years guarantee / warrantee from Luminaries Manufacturer of LED fittings to be provided.**
- c). **The amount of 5% of agreement item of LED luminaries / bulb shall be deducted from every running as well as final bills of contractor and retained as Performance Guarantee of LED luminaries for five year after completion of work. This will be refunded @ 1% after every year after successfully completion of guarantee period (5 year).**
- d). **Security Deposit**

Security Deposit @2.5% of tendered amount shall be deducted from the payments.

26.0 Tender Drawings

The drawings appended with bid documents if any are intended to show space allotted for various equipments. The equipments offered shall be suitable for installation in the spaces shown in these drawings.

- (a) Drawings and Technical Particulars of Materials/ Equipments for approval on award of the work
 - (b) The contractor shall prepare and submit following drawings, documents in four sets after the award of work for approval before commencement of installation. The approval of drawings and documents however does not absolve the contractor of his responsibility to supply the equipments/ materials as per agreement. In case of any contradiction between the approved drawings and agreement the decision of the Engineer-in-Charge shall be final and binding on the contractor. All shop drawing shall be prepared on computer through Autocad system based on Architectural drawings and site measurement within two weeks of award of work.
- The technical particulars of each items meeting the agreement requirement.
 - Single line diagram, control schematic showing make type and description of all components and accessories.
 - Control wiring details
 - Any other drawings relevant to the work.

These shop drawings and documents shall contain all information required to complete the Project as per specifications and as required by the Engineer in charge. These Drawings shall contain details of construction, size, arrangement, operating clearances, performance characteristics and capacity of all items of equipment,

also the details of all related items of work by other contractors. Each shop drawing shall contain tabulation of all measurable items of equipment/materials/works and progressive cumulative totals from other related drawings to arrive at a variation-in-quantity statement at the completion of all shop drawings. Minimum 4 sets of drawings shall be submitted after final approval along with soft copy.

Where the contractor proposes to use an item of equipment, other than that specified or detailed on the drawings, which requires any redesign of the structure, partitions, foundation, wiring or any other part of the mechanical, electrical or architectural layouts; all such re-design, and all new drawings and detailing required therefore, shall be prepared by the contractor at his own expense and gotten approved by the Engineer in charge. Any delay on such account shall be at the cost of and consequence of the Contractor.

Where the work of the contractor has to be installed in close proximity to, or shall interfere with work of other trades, he shall assist in working out space conditions to make a satisfactory adjustment. If so directed by the Engineer in charge, the contractor shall prepare composite working drawings and sections at a suitable scale, not less than 1:50, clearly showing how his work is to be installed in relation to the work of other trades. If the Contractor installs his work before coordinating with other trades, or so as to cause any interference with work of other trades, he shall make all the necessary changes without extra cost to the Engineer in charge.

After the approval of all the relevant shop drawings, the contractor shall submit four copies of a comprehensive variation statement in quantity, and itemized price list of recommended (by manufacturers) imported and local spare parts and tools, covering all equipment and materials in this contract. The Engineer in charge shall make recommendation for acceptance of anticipated variation in contract amounts and also advise to initiate action for procurement of spare parts and tools at the completion of project.

(c) Completion drawings

Contractor shall periodically submit completion drawings as and when work in all respects is completed in a particular area. These drawings shall be submitted in the form of four sets of CD's and four portfolios (300 x 450 mm) each containing complete set of drawings on approved scale indicating the work as - installed. These drawings shall clearly indicate following:

- (i) Location and details of each item
- (ii) Complete wiring diagram, as installed and scheduled showing all connections in the complete electrical system.

27.0 Documents to be Furnished on completion of Installation

Upon completion and commissioning of entire system the contractor shall submit a draft copy of comprehensive operating instructions, maintenance schedule and log sheets for all systems and equipment included in this contract. This shall be supplementary to manufacturer's operating and maintenance manuals. Upon approval of the draft, the contractor shall submit four (4) complete bound sets of typewritten operating instructions and maintenance manuals; one each for retention by Engineer in charge's site representative or two set for Operating Personnel. These manuals shall also include basis of design, detailed technical data for each piece of equipment as installed, spare parts manual and recommended spares for 07 years period of maintenance of each equipment. These manuals shall include:

- i. completion drawings showing all equipments installed
- ii. Description of the work carried out/installed.
- iii. Operating instructions.
- iv. Maintenance instructions including procedures for preventive maintenance.
- v. Three sets Manufacturers technical catalogues of all equipments and accessories.
- vi. Spare parts list.
- vii. Trouble shooting charts.
- viii. Type and routine test certificates of major items.
- ix. Operation and maintenance manual of all major equipments, detailing all adjustments, operation and maintenance procedure.

28.0 After Sales Services

The contractor shall ensure adequate and prompt after sales service free of cost during guarantee period, and against payment after guarantee period is over, in the form of maintenance, spares and personal as and when required during normal life span of the equipments and shall minimize the breakdown period. In case of equipment supplied by other manufacturers, the firm shall submit the guarantee from manufacturer for the same before the entire installation is taken over.

31.0 Liaisoning and Co-operation with other agencies:

The successful tenderer shall co-ordinate with other contractors and agencies engaged in the operation and maintenance of the building so as to make the execution of this works contract smooth. If any unreasonable hindrance is caused to other agencies / damage is caused to the existing installation resulting in loss of work or disruption in services during the course of work, such expenditure incurred upon restoration and

loss of work shall be recovered from the successful tenderer. Water proofing of pits shall not be damaged under any circumstances.

32.0 Verification of correctness of Equipment at Destination :

The contractor shall have to produce all the relevant records to certify that the genuine equipment from the manufacturers has been supplied and erected.

33.0 Order of Preference:

Should there be any difference or discrepancy between the description of items as given in the Schedule of Quantities, technical specifications for individual items of work (including additional and commercial conditions) and IS Codes etc., the following order of preference shall be followed:

- a. Schedule of quantities
- b. Additional and Commercial Conditions
- c. Technical specifications specified in the tender
- d. General Conditions of Contract for CPWD Works
- e. Drawings
- f. CPWD General Specifications
- g. Relevant IS or any other International code in case IS code is not available

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TERMS & CONDITIONS FOR IEI WORK

1. The work shall be carried out strictly in accordance with CPWD specifications for Electrical works 2013 (Internal) and 1995 part-II (External) as amended upto date in accordance with Indian Electricity Rules, 1956 India electrical Act, 2003 as amended upto date and as per instructions of the engineer-in-charge including as below and nothing will be paid extra.
2. **The E&M agency shall posses a Valid Electrical License.**
3. The electrical work shall be carried out as per actual requirement and quantity is given in the schedule of work may vary of either side and it is side possible that some of the item given in the Schedule of work may not REQUIRED TO BE executed. The decision of Engineer-in-charge of the work, in this regard, shall be final and binding on the Tenderers. However tenderers are required to quote their rates for all the items given in the schedule of works attached.
4. All materials to be used on this work should brought in by the contractor to facilitate testing before use and shall be got approved from the Engineer-in-charge before installation at site.
5. The work shall be carried out according to approved drawing/details which shall be subsequently issued to the successful tenderer for execution of work and as per instructions of the Engineer-in-charge who will have the right to change the layout as per requirements at site and the contractor shall not have any right to change in layout.
6. All damages done to the building during execution of Electrical work shall be the responsibility of the contractor and the same will be made good immediately at his own cost to the satisfaction of the Engineer-in-charge. Any expenditure incurred by in this condition shall be recovered from the contractor and decision of the Engineer-in-charge about recovery shall be final.
7. All the debris of the electrical works should be removed and the contractor should be clear the site immediately clear off any rejected material from the site.
8. The bad workmanship will not be accepted and defects shall be rectified at contractor's cost to the satisfaction of the Engineer-in-charge. The program of electrical works are to be co-ordinate in accordance with the building work and no claim, for idle labor will stipulated in the tender, electrical work shall to be completed along with completion of civil work.
9. Issue of material to the contractor wherever stipulated, shall be in accordance with to the requirement at site from time to time depending upon the progress of work.
10. Cement for bonafide work is to be arranged & used by the contractor himself and nothing extra will be paid on this account.
11. The contractor or his representative is to sign the site order book as & when required by the Engineer-in-charge and comply with the remarks therein.
12. The Contractor shall make his own arrangement at his own cost of electrical general tools and plants required for the work.
13. The makes, size of conduit and wires, shall be got approved from the Engineer-in-charge before taking up the execution.
14. Main Board and main distribution Board: the work shall be carried out according to the drawings/details as approved by the Engineer-in-charge, samples approved before the whole lot is brought to site and it shall include all inter connections etc. panel drawings shall be got approved before actual fabrication is taken up.
15. No central / Sales Tax / Contract Tax / Excise duty etc shall be separately paid by the deptt. The tendered rate should be inclusive of GST & all taxes duties. No deduction of contract tax at source shall be made. The contractor himself shall be responsible for the same.
16. The entire installation shall be at risk and responsibility of the contractor until these are tested and handed over to the department.

For wiring, the existing conduit wherever available / required shall be used by the contractor. The recovery will be made for these items at accepted rate of other agencies.
20. Nothing extra shall be paid for inter connection with thimbles/wires/tapes/strips etc.

21. Watch and ward of the material shall be the responsibility of the contractor till they are handed over to the department for which nothing extra shall be paid.
22. The contractor shall bear all the expenses for the testing of the electrical material / switch gears etc. form the designated lab, as desired by Engineer-in-charge.
23. The contractor shall abide the specifications given in the tender where the specifications are not given CPWD specifications with as on date amendments shall be followed. Items where CPWD specifications are not covered, the decision of Engineer-in-charge shall be final and binding.
24. The contractor shall also assess the quantities of various items involved in the work and shall procure the material accordingly. If excess material is produced, it shall be the responsibility of the contractor and department will not pay for unused quantity.
25. In case any extra quantity gets procured in running bills i.e. more than to be, it shall be taken back and amount shall be adjusted.
26. The contractor/supplier shall have to produce all the relevant records to certify that the genuine material from the manufacturers has been supplied and erected. The invoice/challan of the materials shall be invariably submitted. Custom clearance paper in respect of materials imported from outside country reqd. to be submitted.
27. Both Specialized firms as well as CPWD enlisted contractors of appropriate class in composite category shall have to be submitted an undertaking from OEM as per Annexure C.
28. **The items related to Façade lighting works i/c spare parts and equipments SITC of those items are to be carried out by OEMs or their Authorized Service partners and the main contractor (lowest bidder) has to submit agreements including Annexure-C2 executed with OEMs or their Authorized Service partners, within 7 days of issue of letter of acceptance (PG Letter).**
29. **5% of tendered Value the amount retained as Performance Guarantee for Façade System etc. for two years after completion of work. This will be refunded after successfully completion of guarantee period of 2 years.**
30. **It is the responsibility of lowest bidder to get approval of each material i.e. specification, make and model from Engineer-in-charge before procurement.**
