1. Information and instructions for Contractors will form part of NIT and to be uploaded on CPWD e-Tendering website.
2. Earnest Money can be paid in the form of (i) Banker's Cheque of a Commercial Bank, (ii) Account Payee Demand Draft of a Commercial Bank (iii) Fixed Deposit Receipt (FDR) of a Commercial Bank (iv) Insurance Surety Bonds (v) Bank Guarantee (for balance amount as prescribed) from a Commercial Bank drawn in favour of **The Executive Engineer(E), Agartala Central Electrical Division (ACED), CPWD, Agartala, Phone No. 0381-2951393, e-mail: agteecaced.cpwd@gov.in**, along with bank guarantee of any scheduled bank wherever applicable.

A part of earnest money is acceptable in the form of bank guarantee also. In such case, 50% of earnest money or ₹ 20 lakhs, whichever is less, will have to be deposited in shape prescribed above and balance in shape of Bank Guarantee of any scheduled bank. 6. It is mandatory to fill details / upload scanned copies of all the documents such as **GST** registration as stipulated in the bid document. If such document is not uploaded his bid will become invalid and cost of bid document & processing fee shall not be refunded.
7. If the contractor is found ineligible after opening of bids, his bid shall become invalid and Cost of bid document and processing fee shall not be refunded.
8. If any discrepancy is noticed between the documents as uploaded at the time of submission of bid and hard copies as submitted physically by the contractor the bid shall become invalid and cost of bid document and processing fee shall not be refunded.
9. The Bid submitted shall become invalid if:-
 - i) The bidder is found ineligible.

18. **The intending bidder must have valid Class-III digital signature to submit the bid.**
19. On opening date, the contractor can login and see the bid opening process. After opening of bids, he will receive the competitor bid sheets.
20. Contractor can upload documents in the form of **JPG** format and **PDF** format.
21. In case of e-tendering, integrity Pact shall be treated in the same manner as other components of the bid document. In e-tendering, the intending bidder does not sign any documents physically and entire bid document is submitted through digital signature. Since Integrity pact is a part of bid document no separate physical submission is required with other documents to be submitted in the office of tender opening authority. In addition to other component of bid document, the integrity pact shall also be signed between Executive Engineer & successful bidder after acceptance of bid.
22. The department reserves the right to reject any prospective Applications/ bids without assigning any reason thereof and to restrict the list of qualified contractors to any number deemed suitable by it, if too many bids/applications satisfying the laid down criteria are received.
23. **The existing enlisted contractor either himself or his authorized representative shall take compulsory ERP (Enterprise Resource Planning) training through any of the CPWD Regional Training Institutes (RTIs) at Delhi, Mumbai, Chennai and Kolkata, National CPWD Academy (NCA) Ghaziabad, Training arranged by Graduates of ERP "Train the Trainers Programme" conducted by NCA, Ghaziabad or through any other special training arranged by ERP unit of CPWD before 30.06.2024. Training will be valid only when participants are registered in LMS (Learning Management System) of ERP and certificate is issued through LMS of ERP.**

From 01.07.2024, the enlisted contractor will not be allowed to participate in tendering process without uploading the certificate of above training.

In case of non-enlisted contractor being first lowest in any of the tender then either contractor himself or his authorized representative shall take compulsory ERP training through any of the CPWD Regional Training Institutes (RTIs) at Delhi, Mumbai, Chennai and Kolkata, National CPWD Academy (NCA) Ghaziabad, Training arranged by Graduates of ERP "Train the Trainers Programme" conducted by NCA, Ghaziabad or through any other special training arranged by ERP unit of CPWD within two months from the date of issue of Intent letter. The enlistment of the contractors should be valid on the last date of submission of tenders. In case the last date of submission of tender is extended, the enlistment of contractor should be valid on the original date of submission of tenders.

- 1.1 The authority competent to approve NIT for the combined cost and belonging to the major discipline will consolidate NITs for calling the bids. He will also nominate Division which will deal with all matters relating to the invitation of bids.

For composite bid, besides indicating the combined estimated cost put to bid, should clearly indicate the estimated cost of each component separately. The eligibility of bidders will correspond to the combined estimated cost of different components put to bid.

A bidder shall be deemed to have full knowledge of the site whether he inspects it or not and no extra charge consequent on any misunderstanding or otherwise shall be allowed.
