1. Contractors/ firms who fulfill the following requirements shall be eligible to apply. Joint ventures are not accepted.
 - a) Should have satisfactorily completed similar works during last seven years ending last day of month previous to the one in which tenders are invited:
 - i) Three similar works each costing not less than 40% of estimated cost.
OR
 - ii) Two similar works each costing not less than 60% of estimated cost.
OR
 - iii) One similar work costing not less than 80% of estimated cost.

Similar work shall mean works of “**Repairing & Maintenance of Kitchen Equipments**”. The value of executed works shall be brought to current costing level by enhancing the value of work at simple rate of 7% per annum; calculated from the date of completion to last date of receipt of application for bids.

Completion certificate issued by the officer not below the rank of Executive Engineer or equivalent will have to be furnished along with the application. The completion certificate must clearly indicate:-

- i) Date of completion of work and amount.
- ii) Nature of work with estimated cost.
- iii) That the work has been completed satisfactorily
- iv) Cost of work done.

The above completion certificate must be enclosed the copy of schedule of the same work.

- a) Should have had Average Annual Financial Turnover of Rs. 1.40 lacs (50% of ECPT) on construction works during the last three years ending 31st March 2026 (Scanned copy of Certificate from CA with Unique Document Identification Number (UDIN) to be uploaded).

The value of Annual Turnover figures shall be brought to current value by enhancing the actual turnover figures at simple rate of 7% per annum.

- b) Should not have incurred any loss (profit after tax should be positive) in more than two years during the last five years ending 31st March 2026. Duly audited and certified by chartered accountant.
 - c) Should have a Banker's Certificate from a commercial Bank for Rs. 1.12 lacs (40% of ECPT) or Net Worth certificate from CA with Unique Document Identification Number (UDIN) of minimum Rs. 0.29 lacs (10 % amount of ECPT) (Scanned copy of original to be uploaded).
2. The intending bidder must read the terms and conditions of CPWD-6 carefully. He should only submit his bid if he consider himself eligible and he is in possession of all the documents required.
3. This Information and Instructions for bidders posted on website shall form part of bid document.
4. The bid document consisting of plans, specifications, the Schedule of quantities of various types of items to be executed and the set of terms and conditions of the contract to be complied with and other necessary documents can be seen and downloaded from website www.etender.cpwd.gov.in or www.cpwd.gov.in or www.eprocure.gov.in free of cost.
5. But the bid can only be submitted after **deposition of original EMD either in the office of Executive Engineer inviting bids or division office of any Executive Engineer, CPWD within the period of Bid submission** and uploading the mandatory scanned documents such as Demand draft / Fixed Deposit Receipt (FDR) / Bank Guarantee (for balance amount as prescribed) of commercial Bank or Insuarnee Surety Bond towards EMD **in favour of Executive Engineer (E), PHEWD, CPWD, Parliament House, New Delhi, receipt for deposition of original EMD to division office of any Executive Engineer (including NIT issuing EE/AE), CPWD** and other documents as specified.
6. Those contractors who are not registered or have not updated there profile on the website mentioned above, are required to get registered / update there profile beforehand. The necessary training materials i/c the video with step to step process are available on download section of <https://etender.cpwd.gov.in>.
7. The intending bidder must have valid class-III digital signature certificated with encryption key (combo type) to perform any operation / transactions on the e-tendering posrtal / website & the bidders should download and install the eMsigner on their system as per instructions available on download section of <https://etender.cpwd.gov.in>.
8. On opening date, the contractor can login and see the bid opening process. After opening of bids he will receive the competitor bid sheets.
9. Contractor can upload documents in the form of JPG format and PDF format.
10. Certificate of Financial Turn Over: At the time of submission of bid contractor may upload Affidavit/Certificate from CA mentioning Financial Turnover of last 7 Years or for the period as specified in the bid document and further details if required may be asked from the contractor after opening of technical bids. There is no need tp upload entire voluminous balance sheet.
11. Contractor must ensure to quote rate of each item. The column meant for quoting rate in figures appears in pink colour and the moment rate is entered, it turns sky blue.

In addition to this, while selecting any of the cells a warning appears that if any cell is left blank the same shall be treated as "0". Therefore, if any cell is left blank and no rate is quoted by the bidder, rate of such item shall be treated as "0" (ZERO).

However, If a tenderer quotes nil rates against each item in item rate tender or does not quote any percentage above/below on the total amount of the tender or any section / sub head in percentage rate tender, the tender shall be treated as invalid and will not be considered as lowest tenderer.

12. The Eligibility Bid & Financial Bid (Price bid) shall be uploaded simultaneously before last date & time of submission of bid. The Eligibility bid shall be opened first on due date and time as mentioned

above. The time and date of opening of Financial bid (Price bid) of contractors qualifying the Eligibility bid shall be communicated to them at a later date.

13. Price bid of only those firms, whose eligibility bid is approved by competent authority, shall be opened.
14. The department reserves the right to reject any prospective application without assigning any reason and to restrict the list of qualified contractors to any number deemed suitable by it, if too many bids are received satisfying the laid down criterion.

1. The Executive Engineer receiving EMD in original form shall examine the EMD deposited by the bidder and shall issue a receipt of deposition of earnest money to the agency in a given format uploaded by tender inviting EE. The receipt may be issued by the AE (P)/AE/AAO.
2. The Executive Engineer receiving original EMD shall also intimate tender inviting Executive Engineer about deposition of EMD by the agency by email / fax / telephonically.
3. The original EMD receiving Executive Engineer shall release the EMD after verification from the e-tendering portal website (www.etender.cpwd.gov.in/CPWD or www.cpwd.gov.in) that the particular contractor is not L-1 tenderer and work is awarded.
4. The tender inviting Executive Engineer will call for original EMD of the L-1 tenderer from EMD receiving Executive Engineer immediately.

The eligibility of the contractors should be valid on the last date of submission of bids. In case the last date of submission of bid is extended, the eligibility of contractor should be valid on the original date of submission of bids.

- 1.1 The work is estimated to cost Rs. **2,80,772.00**. This estimate, however, is given merely as a rough guide.
- 1.2 Intending tenderer is eligible to submit the bid provided he has definite proof from the appropriate authority, which shall be to the satisfaction of the competent authority.
- 1.3 To become eligible for issue of bid, the bidders shall have to furnish an affidavit as under: -
- 1.4 I/We undertake and confirm that eligible similar works(s) has/have not been got executed through another contractor on back to back basis. Further that, if such a violation comes to the notice of Department, then I/we shall be debarred for bidding in CPWD in future forever. Also, if such a violation comes to the notice of Department before date of start of work, the Engineer-in-Charge shall be free to forfeit the entire amount of Earnest Money Deposit/ Performance Guarantee. (Scanned copy to be uploaded at the time of submission of bid).
2. Agreement shall be drawn with the successful tenderer on prescribed Form No. CPWD 7 which is available on website www.cpwd.gov.in . Tenderer shall quote his rates as per various terms and conditions of the said form which will form part of the agreement.
3. The time allowed for carrying out the work will be **1 Month** from the date of start as defined in schedule 'F' or from the first date of handing over of the site, whichever is later, in accordance with the phasing, if any, indicated in the bid documents.
4. The site for the work is available.
5. The bid document consisting of plans, specifications, the schedule of quantities of various types of items to be executed and the set of terms and conditions of the contract to be complied with and other necessary documents except Standard General Conditions of Contract Form can be seen from website <https://etender.cpwd.gov.in> or www.cpwd.gov.in in free of cost.
6. After submission of the bid the contractor can re-submit revised bid any number of times but before last time and date of submission of bid as notified.
7. While submitting the revised bid, contractor can revise the rate of one or more item(s) any number of times (he need not re-enter rate of all the items) but before last time and date of submission of bid as notified.
8. When tenders are invited in three stage system and if it is desired to submit revised financial bid then it shall be mandatory to submit revised financial bid. If not submitted then the tender submitted earlier shall become invalid.
9. Earnest Money in the form of Insurance Surety Bond's, Account Payee Demand Draft, Fixed Deposit Receipt, Banker's Cheque or Bank Guarantee From any of the Commercial Banks (drawn in favour of **Executive Engineer (E), PHEWD, CPWD, New Delhi.**) shall be scanned and uploaded on the e-tendering website within the period of bid submission. The original EMD should be deposited either in the office of Executive Engineer inviting bids or division office of any

Executive Engineer, CPWD within the period of bid submission. The EMD receiving Executive Engineer (including NIT issuing EE/AE) shall issue a receipt of deposition of earnest money deposit to the bidder in a prescribed format (enclosed) uploaded by tender inviting EE in the NIT.

A part of earnest money is acceptable in the form of bank guarantee also. In such case, 50% of earnest money or Rs.20 lakh, whichever is less, will have to be deposited in shape prescribed above, and balance in shape of Bank Guarantee of any schedule bank having validity for six month or more from the last date of receipt of bids which is to be scanned and uploaded by the intending bidders.

The earnest money given by all the tenderers except the lowest tenderer shall be refunded immediately after the expiry of stipulated bid validity period or immediately after acceptance of the successful bidder, whichever is earlier. However, certified copy of all the scanned and uploaded documents as specified in e- tender notice shall have to be submitted by the lowest bidder within a week physically in the office of tender opening authority. Online bid documents submitted by intending bidders shall be opened only of those bidders, whose original EMD deposited with any division of CPWD and other documents scanned and uploaded are found in order.

The bid submitted shall be opened at **15:30 hours on 17-09-2026.**

10. The bid submitted shall become invalid and e-Tender processing fee shall not be refunded if:
- (i). The bidder is found ineligible.
 - (ii). The bidder does not upload scanned copies of all the documents stipulated in the bid document.
 - (iii). If any discrepancy is noticed between the documents as uploaded at the time of submission of bid and hard copies as submitted physically by the lowest bidder in the office of bid opening authority.
 - (iv). If a tenderer quotes nil rates against each item in item rate tender or does not quote any percentage above/below on the total amount of the tender or any section / sub head in percentage rate tender, the tender shall be treated as invalid and will not be considered as lowest tenderer.
11. **Performance Guarantee: The contractor, whose bid is accepted, will be required to furnish performance guarantee of 5% (Five Percent) of the tendered value or Estimated cost put to tender(ECPT), whichever is higher within the period specified in Schedule F. where the tendered amount is less than eighty percentage (80%) of the Estimated cost put to Tender(ECPT), the Performance Guarantee in addition to the requirement above shall be increased by an amount equal to the difference between eighty percent (80%) of the ECPT and the tendered amount. This guarantee shall be in the form of Insurance Surety Bonds, Accounts Payee Demand Draft, Fixed Deposit Receipt or Bank guarantee from the any Commercial accordance with the prescribed form. In case the contractor fails to deposit the said performance guarantee within the period as indicated in Schedule F, Including the extended period if any, the Earnest Money deposited by the contractor shall be forfeited automatically without any notice to the contractor. 12. Intending Tenderers are advised to inspect and examine the site and its surroundings and satisfy themselves before submitting their tenders as to the nature of the ground and sub-soil (so far as is practicable), the form and nature of the site, the means of access to the site, the accommodation they may require and in general shall themselves obtain all necessary information as to risks, contingencies and other circumstances which may influence or affect their tender. A tenderer shall be deemed to have full knowledge of the site whether he inspects it or not and no extra charge consequent on any misunderstanding or otherwise shall be allowed. The tenderer shall be responsible for arranging and maintaining at his own cost all materials, tools & plants, water, electricity access, facilities for workers and all other services required for executing the work unless otherwise specifically provided for in the contract documents. Submission of a tender by a tenderer implies that he has read this notice and all other contract documents and has made himself aware of the scope and specifications of the work to be done and of conditions and rates at which stores, tools and plant, etc. will be issued to him by the Government and local conditions and other factors having a bearing on the execution of the work.
13. The competent authority on behalf of the President of India does not bind itself to accept the lowest or any other tender and reserves to itself the authority to reject any or all the tenders received without the assignment of any reason. All tenders in which any of the prescribed condition is not fulfilled or any condition including that of conditional rebate is put forth by the tenderer shall be summarily rejected.
14. Canvassing whether directly or indirectly, in connection with tenderers is strictly prohibited and the tenders submitted by the contractors who resort to canvassing will be liable to rejection.
15. The competent authority on behalf of President of India reserves to himself the right of accepting the whole or any part of the tender and the tenderer shall be bound to perform the same at the rate quoted.
16. The contractor shall not be permitted to tender for works in the CPWD Circle (Division in case of contractors of Horticulture/Nursery category) responsible for award and execution of contracts, in which his near relative is posted a Divisional Accountant or as an officer in any capacity between the grades of Superintending Engineer and Junior Engineer (both inclusive). He shall also intimate the names of persons who are working with him in any capacity or are subsequently employed by him and who are near relatives to any gazette officer in the Central Public Works Department or in the Ministry of Urban Development. Any breach of this condition by the contractor would render him liable to be removed from the approved list of contractors of this Department.
17. No Engineer of gazette rank or other Gazetted Officer employed in Engineering or Administrative duties in an Engineering Department of the Government of India is allowed to work as a contractor for a period of one year after his retirement from Government service, without the previous permission of the Government of India in writing. This contract is liable to be cancelled if either the contractor or any of his employees is found any time to be such a person who had not obtained the permission of the Government of India as aforesaid before submission of the tender or engagement in the contractor's service.
18. The bids for the work shall remain open for acceptance for a period of ~~30 (thirty) days~~ from the date of opening of bids in case of single bid system and **75 (seventy five) days** from the date of opening of technical bids in case bids are invited in 2 or 3 bid system. Further
