The firm should submit the attested copies of completion certificate issued by the officer not below the rank of Executive Engineer of department where firm has executed similar work. Incomplete certificate shall be summarily rejected. The completion certificate must clearly indicate the following (originals shall be produced for verification, if required).

- ii) Nature and value of the work
- iii) That the work has been completed satisfactorily
- iv) Work done amount of completion certificate.

1. The intending bidder must read the terms and conditions of CPWD-6 carefully. He should only submit his bid if he considers himself eligible and he is in possession of all the documents required.
2. Information and Instructions for bidders posted on website shall form part of bid document. The bid document consisting of plans, specifications, the schedule of quantities of various types of items to be executed and the set of terms and conditions of the contract to be complied with and other necessary documents can be seen and downloaded from website etender.cpwd.gov.in or www.cpwd.gov.in or www.eprocure.gov.in free of cost.
3. **The Contractor can deposit original EMD either in the office of Executive Engineer inviting bids or division office of any Executive Engineer, CPWD within the period of bid submission. (The EMD document shall only be issued from the place in which the office of receiving division office is situated). The contractor shall obtain the receipt of EMD from the concerned Executive Engineer in the prescribed format uploaded by NIT issuing Executive Engineer. The Bid document as uploaded can be viewed and downloaded free of cost by anyone including intending bidder. But the bid can only be submitted after uploading the mandatory scanned documents such as Insurance Surety Bonds, Account Payee Demand Draft or Bankers cheque or Fixed Deposit Receipt and Bank Guarantee (For Balance amount as prescribed) from any of the Commercial Bank against EMD or Deposit at Call Receipt or Fixed Deposit Receipt of a Scheduled Bank in favour of respective Executive Engineer, copy of receipt of original EMD and other document specified in the press notice.**
4. But the bid can only be submitted after **deposition of original EMD either in the office of Executive Engineer inviting bids or division office of any Executive Engineer, CPWD within the period of bid submission. 5. **The Contractors already registered on the e-tendering portal will have option to continue by paying tender processing fee upto one year from the date of registration, or to switch over to (new) registration without tender processing fee any time. All new registrations from 01.04.2015 will be without tender processing fee.**
6. Those contractors not registered on the website mentioned above, are required to get registered beforehand. If needed they can be imparted training on online tendering process as per details available on the website. The intending bidder must have valid class-III digital signature to submit the bid.
7. On opening date, the contractor can login and see the bid opening process. After opening of bids he will receive the competitor bid sheets.
8. Contractor can upload documents in the form of JPG format and PDF format.
9. **Earnest Money in the form of Insurance Surety Bonds, Account Payee Demand Draft or Bankers cheque or Fixed Deposit Receipt and Bank Guarantee (For Balance amount as prescribed) from any of the Commercial Bank against EMD or Deposit at Call Receipt or Fixed Deposit Receipt of a Scheduled Bank (drawn in favour of Executive Engineer(E), CPWD, Electrical Division, Bhopal) shall be scanned and uploaded to the e-Tendering website within the period of bid submission.**

A part of earnest money is acceptable in the form of bank guarantee also. 10. When tenders are invited in three stage system and if it is desired to submit revised financial bid then it shall be mandatory to submit revised financial bid. If not submitted then the tender submitted earlier shall become invalid.
11. The department reserves the right to reject any prospective application without assigning any reason and to restrict the list of qualified contractors to any number deemed suitable by it, if too many tenders are received satisfying the laid down criteria.
12. Contractor must ensure to quote rate of each item. The column meant for quoting rate in figures appears in yellow colour and the moment rate is entered, it turns sky blue. In addition to this, while selecting any of the cells a warning appears that if any cell is left blank the same shall be treated as "0". Therefore, if any cell is left blank and no rate is quoted by the bidder, rate of such item shall be treated as "0" (ZERO). However, If a tenderer quotes nil rates against each item in item rate tender or does not quote any percentage above/below on the total amount of the tender or any section / sub head in percentage rate tender, the tender shall be treated as invalid and will not be considered as lowest tenderer.
13. **Procedure for dealing with ambiguities in rates:-**
 - (i) In item rate tender, intending bidder can quote his rates in figures only, amount of each item and total is generated automatically.
 - (ii) In percentage rate tender, the tendered percentage quoted in figures shall be taken as correct.
 - (iii) In lump sum tenders the amount quoted in figures shall be taken as correct.
14. The eligibility / Pre-Qualification bids shall be opened first on due date and time as mentioned above. The time and date of opening of financial bid of contractors qualifying the technical bid shall be communicated to them at a later date.
