1. The intending bidder must read the terms and conditions of CPWD-6 carefully. He should only submit his bid if he considers himself eligible and he is in possession of all the documents required.
2. Information and Instructions for bidders posted on website shall form part of bid document.
3. The bid document consisting of plans, specifications, the schedule of quantities of various types of items to be executed and the set of terms and conditions of the contract to be complied with and other necessary documents can be seen and downloaded from website etender.cpwd.gov.in free of cost.
4. But the bid can only be submitted after deposition of original EMD either in the office of Executive Engineer inviting bids or division office of any Executive Engineer, CPWD within the period of bid submission and uploading the mandatory scanned documents such as Banker's Cheque, Demand Draft, Fixed Deposit Receipt (FDR), Insurance Surety Bond and Bank Guarantee of any Commercial Bank or through NTRP

5. Those contractors, who are not registered or have not updated their profile on the website mentioned above, are required to get registered / update their profile beforehand. 6. The intending bidder must have valid Class-III digital signature certificate with encryption key (combo type) to perform any operations / transactions on the e-tendering portal / website and the bidder should download and install the eMSigner on their system as per instructions available on download section of <https://etender.cpwd.gov.in>
7. On opening date, the contractor can login and see the bid opening process. After opening of bids he will receive the competitor bid sheets.
8. Contractor can upload documents in the form of JPG format and PDF format.
9. ~~Certificate of Financial Turn over: At the time of submission of bid contractor may upload Affidavit/Certificate from CA mentioning Financial Turnover of last 7 years or for the period as specified in the bid document and further details if required may be asked from the contractor after opening of technical bids. There is no need to upload entire voluminous balance sheet.~~
10. Contractor must ensure to quote rate in the prescribed column(s) meant for quoting rate in figures appears in yellow colour and the moment rate is entered, it turns sky blue.

In addition to this, while selecting any of the cells a warning appears that if any cell is left blank the same shall be treated as "0". Therefore, if any cell is left blank and no rate is quoted by the bidder, rate of such item shall be treated as "0" (ZERO).

1. Percentage rate bids are invited on behalf of President of India from the **approved and eligible contractors of CPWD in Composite / Building & Road Category** in Appropriate class for the following work:-

Name of Work: Operation and Maintenance of Electrical and Mechanical installation at Defence office Complex, Africa Avenue & KG Marg, New Delhi during 2026-27. (SH: SITC of EV Charger at DOC Africa Avenue and KG Marg).

The enlistment of the contractors should be valid on the last date of submission of bids. In case the last date of submission of bid is extended, the enlistment of contractor should be valid on the original date of submission of bids.

- 1.1 The work is estimated to cost **Rs. 7,46,514 /-**. This estimate, however, is given merely as a rough guide.
- 1.1.1 The authority competent to approve NIT for the combined cost and belonging to the major discipline will consolidate NITs for calling the bids. He will also nominate Division which will deal with all matters relating to the invitation of bids.
For composite bid, besides indicating the combined estimated cost put to bid, should clearly indicate the estimated cost of each component separately. The eligibility of bidders will correspond to the combined estimated cost of different components put to bid.
- 1.2 Intending bidders is eligible to submit the bid provided he has definite proof from the appropriate authority, which shall be to the satisfaction of the competent authority, of having satisfactorily completed **works as mentioned in INFORMATION AND INSTRUCTIONS FOR BIDDERS FOR e-TENDERING FORMING PART OF BID DOCUMENT**
- 1.2.1 ~~To become eligible for issue of bid, the bidders shall have to furnish an affidavit as under:-~~

~~I/We undertake and confirm that eligible similar works(s) has/have not been got executed through another contractor on back to back basis. Further that, if such a violation comes to the notice of Department, then I/we shall be debarred for bidding in CPWD in future forever. Also, if such a violation comes to the notice of Department before date of start of work, the Engineer in Charge shall be free to forfeit the entire amount of Earnest Money Deposit/Performance Guarantee. (Scanned copy to be uploaded at the time of submission of bid)~~
2. Agreement shall be drawn with the successful bidders on prescribed Form No. **CPWD 7/8** (or other Standard Form as mentioned) which is available as a Govt. of India Publication and also available on website **etender.cpwd.gov.in** Bidders shall quote his rates as per various terms and conditions of the said form which will form part of the agreement.
3. The time allowed for carrying out the work will be **02 Months** from the date of start as

defined in schedule 'F' or from the first date of handing over of the site, whichever is later, in accordance with the phasing, if any, indicated in the bid documents.

4. The site is clear for the execution of work.
5. After submission of the bid the contractor can re-submit a revised bid any number of times but before last time and date of submission of bid as notified.
6. While submitting the revised bid, the contractor can revise the rate of one or more item(s) any number of times (he need not re-enter rate of all the items) but before last time and date of submission of bid as notified.
7. ~~When bids are invited in three stage system and if it is desired to submit a revised financial bid then it shall be mandatory to submit revised financial bid. If not submitted then the bid submitted earlier shall become invalid.~~
8. Earnest Money in the form of Insurance Surety Bonds, Account Payee Demand Draft, Fixed Deposit Receipt, Banker's Cheque or Bank Guarantee including e- Bank Guarantee (for balance amount as prescribed) from any of the Commercial Banks or through NTRP (www.bharatkosh.gov.in) drawn in favour of Executive Engineer(E), ECD-II, CPWD, Sena Bhawan, New Delhi shall be scanned and uploaded on the e-Tendering website within the period of bid submission. The original EMD should be deposited either in the office of Executive Engineer inviting bids or division office of any Executive Engineer, CPWD within the period of bid submission. The EMD receiving Executive Engineer (including NIT issuing EE/AE) shall issue a receipt of deposition of earnest money deposit to the bidder in a prescribed format (enclosed) uploaded by tender inviting EE in the NIT.

A part of earnest money is acceptable in the form of bank guarantee also. In such case, minimum 50% of earnest money or Rs. 20 lac, whichever is less, shall have to be deposited in shape prescribed above, and balance may be deposited in shape of Bank Guarantee of any scheduled bank having validity for six months or more from the last date of receipt of bids which is to be scanned and uploaded by the intending bidders.

The earnest money given by all the tenderers except the lowest tenderer shall be refunded immediately after the expiry of stipulated bid validity period or immediately after acceptance of the successful bidder, whichever is earlier. However, in case of two/three bid system, earnest money deposit of bidders unsuccessful during technical bid evaluation etc. should be returned within 30 days of declaration of result of technical bid evaluation.

Copy of Enlistment Order and certificate of work experience and other documents as specified in the notice inviting e- tender shall be scanned and uploaded on the e-Tendering website within the period of bid submission. However, certified copy of all the scanned and uploaded documents as specified in e- tender notice shall have to be submitted by and uploaded documents as specified in e- tender notice shall have to be submitted by the lowest bidder within a week physically in the office of tender opening authority. Online bid documents submitted by intending bidders shall be opened only of those bidders, who has deposited EMD with any division of CPWD and other documents scanned and uploaded are found in order. 10. The bid submitted shall become invalid and e-Tender processing fee shall not be refunded if:
 - i. The bidder is found ineligible.
 - ii. The bidder does not upload scanned copies of all the documents stipulated in the bid document.
 - iii. If any discrepancy is noticed between the documents as uploaded at the time of submission of bid and hard copies as submitted physically by the lowest bidder in the office of bid opening authority.
 - iv. If a tenderer quotes nil rates against each item in item rate tender or does not quote any percentage above/below on the total amount of the tender or any section / sub head in percentage rate tender, the tender shall be treated as invalid and will not be considered as lowest tenderer.

11. The contractor whose bid is accepted will be required to furnish performance guarantee at specified percentage of the tendered amount as mentioned in schedule E and within the period specified in Schedule F. This guarantee shall be in the form of Insurance Surety Bonds, Account Payee Demand Draft, Fixed Deposit Receipt or Bank Guarantee from any of the Commercial Banks or through NTRP (www.bharatkosh.gov.in) in accordance with the prescribed form. In case the contractor fails to deposit the said performance guarantee within the period as indicated in Schedule 'F', including the extended period if any, the Earnest Money deposited by the contractor shall be forfeited automatically without any notice to the contractor. The earnest money deposited along with bid shall be returned after receiving the aforesaid performance guarantee. The contractor whose bid is accepted will also be required to furnish either copy of applicable.  Intending Bidders are advised to inspect and examine the site and its surroundings and satisfy themselves before submitting their bids as to the ~~nature of the ground and sub-soil (so far as is practicable), the form~~ and nature of the site, the means of access to the site, the accommodation they may require and in general shall themselves obtain all necessary information as to risks, contingencies and other circumstances which may influence or affect their bid. A bidders shall be deemed to have full knowledge of the site whether he inspects it or not and no extra charge consequent on any misunderstanding or otherwise shall be allowed. The bidders shall be responsible for arranging and maintaining at his own cost all materials, tools & plants, water, electricity access, facilities for workers and all other services required for executing the work unless otherwise specifically provided for in the contract documents. Submission of a bid by a bidders implies that he has read this notice and all other contract documents and has made himself aware of the scope and specifications of the work to be done and of conditions and rates at which stores, tools and plant, etc. will be issued to him by the Government and local conditions and other factors having a bearing on the execution of

13. The competent authority on behalf of the President of India does not bind itself to accept the lowest or any other bid and reserves to itself the authority to reject any or all the bids received without the assignment of any reason. All bids in which any of the prescribed condition is not fulfilled or any condition including that of conditional rebate is put forth by the bidders shall be summarily rejected.
14. Canvassing whether directly or indirectly, in connection with bidders is strictly prohibited and the bids submitted by the contractors who resort to canvassing will be liable for rejection.
15. The competent authority on behalf of President of India reserves to himself the right of accepting the whole or any part of the bid and the bidders shall be bound to perform the same at the rate quoted.
16. The contractor shall not be permitted to bid for works in the CPWD Circle (Division in case of contractors of Horticulture/Nursery category) responsible for award and execution of contracts, in which his near relative is posted as Divisional Accountant or as an officer in any capacity between the grades of Superintending Engineer and Junior Engineer (both inclusive). He shall also intimate the names of persons who are working with him in any capacity or are subsequently employed by him and who are near relatives to any gazetted officer in the Central Public Works Department or in the Ministry of Urban Development. Any breach of this condition by the contractor would render him liable to be removed from the approved list of contractors of this Department.
17. No Engineer of Gazetted Rank or other Gazetted Officer employed in Engineering or Administrative duties in an Engineering Department of the Government of India is allowed to work as a contractor for a period of one year after his retirement from Government service, without the prior permission of the Government of India in writing. This contract is liable to be cancelled if either the contractor or any of his employees is found any time to be such a person who had not obtained the permission of the Government of India as aforesaid before submission of the bid or engagement in the contractor's service.
18. The bids for the work shall remain open for acceptance for a period of 30 (thirty) days from the date of opening of bids in case of single bid system and 75 (seventy five) days from the date of opening of technical bids in case bids are invited in 2 or 3 bid system.

Further

- (i) If any tenderer withdraws his tender or makes any modification in the terms & conditions of the tender which is not acceptable to the department within 7 days after last date of submission of bids, then the Government shall without prejudice to any other right or remedy, be at liberty to forfeit 50% of the earnest money absolutely irrespective of letter of acceptance for the work is issued or not.
- (ii) If any tenderer withdraws his tender or makes any modification in the terms & conditions of the tender which is not acceptable to the department after expiry of 7 days after last date of submission of bids, then the Government shall without prejudice to any other right or remedy, be at liberty to forfeit 100% of the earnest money absolutely irrespective of letter of acceptance for the work is issued or not.

- (iii) In case of forfeiture of earnest money as prescribed in para (i) and (ii) above, the bidders shall not be allowed to participate in the rebidding process of the same work.
19. This notice inviting Bid shall form a part of the contract document. The successful bidder/contractor, on acceptance of his bid by the Accepting Authority shall within 15 days from the stipulated date of start of the work, sign the contract consisting of:-

~~The Executive Engineer in charge of the major component will call bids for the composite work. The cost of bid document and Earnest Money will be fixed with respect to the combined estimated cost put to tender for the composite bid.~~

~~The bid document will include following three components:~~

Part A:- CPWD-6, CPWD-7/8 including schedule A to F for the major component of the work, Standard General Conditions of Contract for CPWD of maintenance work 2023 as amended/ modified up to

Part B:- ~~General / specific conditions, specifications and schedule of quantities applicable to major component of the work.~~

Part C:- ~~Schedule A to F for minor component of the work (competent authority under clause 2 and clause 5 shall be same authority as mentioned in schedule A to F for major components), General/specific conditions, specifications and schedule of quantities applicable to minor component(s) of the work.~~

~~The bidders must associate himself, with agencies as per NIT conditions.~~

~~The eligible bidders shall quote rates for all items of major component as well as for all items of minor components of work.~~

~~After acceptance of the bid by competent authority, the EE in charge of major component of the work shall issue letter of award on behalf of the President of India. After the work is awarded, the main contractor will have to enter into one agreement with EE in charge of major component and has also to sign two or more copies of agreement depending upon number of EE's/DDH in charge of minor components. ~~The main contractor has to associate agencies for specialized component(s) conforming to eligibility criteria as defined in the bid document and has to submit detail of such agency(s) to Engineer in charge of relevant component(s) within prescribed time. Name of the agency(s) to be associated shall be approved by Engineer in charge of relevant component(s).~~

~~In case the main contractor intends to change any of the above agency/agencies during the operation of the contract, he shall obtain prior approval of Engineer in charge of relevant specialized component(s).~~

21. ~~Integrity Pact: The contractor shall download the Integrity Pact, which is a part of tender documents, affix his signature in the presence of a witness, and upload the same while submitting online bids for all works of estimated cost put to tender equal or more than the threshold value given in Schedule F. In the event of his failure to sign and upload the Integrity Pact along with other bid documents, his bid shall be rejected.~~
22. The intending bidders are required to update their profile in CPWD e- tender portal and to upload their bids well in advance of last date of submission of tender. 23. Price Preference to SC/ST individual contractor for item rate/percentage rate tender: Price preference in quoted item rate/percentage rate tender shall be applicable to the individual enlisted/non-enlisted SC/ST contractor as under:-

(i) For work(s) upto and equal to an estimated cost of Rs. 2.80 lakh a price preference upto 5% (with reference to the lowest valid tender) may be allowed in favor of individual SC/ST enlisted/non-enlisted contractor. No earnest money is required in such case(s).

(ii) For work(s) beyond an estimated cost of Rs. 2.80 lakh and upto and equal to estimated cost of Rs. 6.40 lakh, the price preference upto 5% (with reference to the lowest valid tender) may be allowed in favour of individual enlisted SC/ST contractor. However, earnest money at a reduced rate of ½% may be accepted in such cases.

The price preference upto 5% (with reference to the lowest valid price bid) may be allowed in favour of individual SC/ST contractor only. The above concession shall be allowed only after verification of the individual contractor's claim of belonging to SC/ST community

24. **Additional Performance Guarantee (APG)**

A bid will be treated as abnormally low if the quoted bid amount is lesser than 80% of the estimated cost put to tender.

Requirement of Additional Performance Guarantee (APG) : In case of abnormally low bids as defined above, the bidder shall be required to submit Additional Performance Guarantee (APG) in addition to the Standard Performance Guarantee (PG). The amount of Additional Performance Guarantee (APG) shall be equivalent to the difference between the 80% amount of ECPT and quoted amount. (e.g. if ECPT is 'A' and quoted amount is 0.7A then the amount of APG shall be 0.8A - 0.7A).

General Terms & Conditions

1. Introduction

These conditions are intended to amplify the General Conditions of Contract, and shall be read in conjunction with the same. For any discrepancy between the General Conditions and these Special Conditions, the more stringent shall apply.

2. Related Documents

These additional specifications are to be read in conjunction with the specification given in the tender. In case any item/ items or part thereof are not covered under these specifications, the same shall be carried out as per relevant part of the **CPWD General Specification for Electrical Works Part-I Internal-2023, Part-II External-2023, and Part IV (Sub-Station) 2013, Part V Wet Riser & Sprinkler Systems, HVAC - 2024, Part VII (DG Set)**, as amended upto dates, relevant electricity act BIS/IEC and as per direction of Engineer –in - Charge. These additional specifications are to be read in conjunction with above and in case of variations; specifications given in this additional condition shall apply. However, nothing extra shall be paid on account of these additional specifications and conditions, as the same are to be read along with schedule of quantities for the work. In case of discrepancy among the specifications/conditions as mentioned above the precedence given in general condition of contract shall be followed.

3. Site Information

The tenderer should, in his own interest, visit the site and familiarize himself with the site conditions before tendering. For any clarification, tenderer may discuss with the Engineer-in-Charge.

4. Conformity With Statutory Acts, Rules, Standards And Codes

- (i) All components shall conform to relevant Indian Standard Specifications, wherever existing, amended to date.
- (ii) All electrical works shall be carried out in accordance with the provisions of Indian Electricity Act, 2023 and Indian Electricity Rules, 1956 amended to date. They shall also conform to CPWD General Specifications for Electrical works, Part-I: Internal, 2023 and Part-II: External, 2023 as amended to date.
- (iii) All components shall conform to Energy Conservation of sustainable Building Code 2024 of India as amended or revised up to date.

5. Safety Codes And Labour Regulations

- (i) In respect of all labour employed directly or indirectly on the work for the performance of the **SITC of EV Charger** works contractor's part of work, the contractor at his own expense, will arrange for the safety provisions as per the statutory provisions, B.I.S recommendations, factory act, workman's compensation act, CPWD code and instructions issued from time to time. Failure to provide such safety requirements would make the tenderer liable for penalty as provided in the labour laws/ GCC for each violation. In addition the Engineer-in-charge shall be at liberty to make arrangements and provide facilities as aforesaid and recover the cost from the contractor.

- (ii) The contractor shall provide necessary barriers, warning signals and other safety measures while executing the works or wherever necessary so as to avoid accident. He shall also indemnify CPWD against claims for compensation arising out of negligence in this respect. Contractor shall be liable, in accordance with the Indian Law and Regulations for any accident occurring due to any cause. The department shall not be responsible for any accident occurred or damage incurred or claims arising there from during the execution of work. The contractor shall also provide all insurance including third party insurance as may be necessary to cover the risk. No extra payment would be made to the contractor due to the above provisions thereof.

6. **Works to be done by the contractor**

Unless otherwise mentioned in the tender documents, the following works shall be done by the contractor and therefore, their cost shall be deemed to be included in their tendered cost- whether specifically indicated in the schedule of work or not: -

- (i) Making good all damages caused to the structure during installation and restoring the same to their original finish.
- (ii) Minor building work necessary for installation of equipments, making opening in the wall/floors/slabs/tables or modifications in the existing openings wherever provided and restoring the same to their original condition/ finish and necessary grouting etc. as required. Opening in the slab/retaining walls/brick wall etc. shall be made by means of core cutting machines only.
- (iii) Sealing of all floor slab/wall openings provided by the Department or made by the contractor for laying cables from fire safety points of view.
- (iv) Suspenders, brackets and floor/wall supports for suspending/supporting cable tray, cables etc.
- (v) Removal & disposal of the all the malba/ debris occurs during the execution of work from the site.

7. **Rates**

The rate quoted by bidder, shall be firm and inclusive of all taxes (including GST), duties and levies and all charges for packing, forwarding insurance, loading, unloading shifting to location of work, freight and delivery, installation, testing, commissioning etc. at site including temporary constructional storage, risks, overhead charges, general liabilities/obligation etc. No escalation in quoted rates shall be permitted for any reason whatsoever.

8. **Acceptable Makes**

The acceptable makes of the various equipments/ components/ accessories have been indicated in “List of Makes” annexed with this document. The bidders shall work out the cost of the offers on this basis. Alternate make/ model is not acceptable.

9. **Machinery for Erection**

All tools and tackles required for unloading/ handling of equipments and materials at site, their assembly, erection, testing and commissioning shall be the responsibility of the contractor.

10. **Payment**

Quarterly payment will be made on completion of compliance of all terms & conditions of agreement.

11. **Completeness of the tender, submission of programme, approval of drawings and commencement of work.**

(i) **Completeness of the tender**

All sundry equipments, fittings, assemblies, accessories, hardware items, gaskets, and associated items, supports, termination lugs for electrical connections, cable glands, junction boxes and all other items which are useful and necessary for proper assembly and efficient working of the various equipments and components of the work shall be deemed to have been included in the tender, irrespective of the fact whether such items are specifically mentioned in the tender or not.

(ii) **Submission of Name of workers and supervisor etc.**

The contractor shall submit the name, IDs and credentials of all workers and staff to be deployed by them at site to the Engineer-in-Charge for approval before start of work OR 10 days prior from date of start.

12. **Extent of Work**

This includes entire labour including supervision and all material necessary to meet satisfactory operation of the system.

13. **Compliance with Regulations and Indian Standards:**

(i) All works shall be carried out in accordance with relevant regulation, both statutory and those specified by the Indian Standards related to the works covered by this specification. In particular, the equipment and installation will comply with the following:

(ii) Factories Act.

(iii) Indian Electricity Rules.

(iv) B.I.S. & other standards as applicable.

(v) Workmen's compensation Act.

(vi) Statutory norms prescribed by local bodies like CEA, Power Supply Co., etc.

14. **Indemnity:**

The successful tenderer shall at all times indemnify the department, consequent on this works contract. The successful tenderer shall be liable, in accordance with the Indian Law and Regulations for any accident occurring due to any cause and the contractor shall be responsible for any accident or damage incurred or claims arising there from during the period of erection, construction and putting into operation the equipments and ancillary equipment under the supervision of the successful tenderer in so far as the latter is responsible. The successful tenderer shall also provide all

insurance including third party insurance as may be necessary to cover the risk. No extra payment would be made to the successful tenderer on account of the above.

15. **Co-Ordination with other agencies**

The contractor shall co-ordinate with all other agencies involved in the work so that the work of other agencies is not hampered due to delay in his work. Ducting, piping, cabling or any other work, which directly affect the progress of building work, shall be given priority.

16. **Quality of materials and workmanship**

- (i) The components of the installation shall be of such design so as to satisfactorily function under all conditions of operation.
- (ii) All equipments and materials to be used in work shall be manufactured in factories of good repute having excellent track record of quality manufacturing, performance and proper after sales service.
- (iii) None of the equipment/ machines supplied shall be more than Twelve months old from date of supply at site, Copy of Excise Gate Pass/ Invoice/ Shipment /Custom Clearance certificate/ details (in case of Imported equipments) shall be submitted to prove the date of manufacture & genuineness of the equipments/ machines supplied.

17. **Care of the building**

Care shall be taken by the contractor during execution of the work to avoid damage to the building. He shall be responsible for repairing all such damages and restoring the same to the original finish at his cost. He shall also remove all unwanted and waste materials arising out of the installation from the site of work from time to time.

18. **Inspection and testing**

All the material purchased by the contractor shall not be more than three months before award of work. Proof of purchasing from such authorised source like copy of bill/ challan etc. shall be submitted to the department before claiming on account bill for payments.

19. **Final Inspection & Testing**

Final Inspection & testing will be done by the Engineer-in-Charge or his representative as per details indicated in CPWD Specifications.

20. **Safety measures**

All equipments shall incorporate suitable safety provisions to ensure safety of the operating personnel at all times. The initial and final inspection reports shall bring out explicitly the safety provisions incorporated in each equipment.

21. The firm shall have to obtain necessary Security Passes/Entry Passes by doing all necessary formalities before start of work. The department will only assist for the same.

22. Any delay at the end of agency on account of obtaining passes shall not be

entertained for extension of time for the work.

23. No claim shall be entertained by the department if any accident occurs during currency of this contract. The contractor has to arrange and provide to his workmen, all safety devices and observe all precaution to avoid any accident. The contractor shall be totally responsible for safety of their workman deployed at site.
24. The contractor shall handover inventory after completion of the contract the firm.
25. All the Nominal Tools and other T&P required for this work shall be arranged by the contractor at his own cost.
26. The department reserves the right to terminate the contract before the expiry of contract without assigning any reason and also to exclude any item of NIT while awarding the work without assigning any reason thereof.

31. No T&P shall be issued to the agency by deptt.
32. No advance payment shall be made.
33. All the materials, used by the contractor should be got approved from the Engineer-in-Charge or his authorized representative before installation. No payment will be made for any unapproved or sub-standard materials used on the work. Rejected materials should be removed from the site of work within 48 hours, by the contractor.
34. Department will not provide the store to the agency and watch and ward of

materials will be responsibility of contractor till completion/ hand over to the client department.

35. The contractor shall be solely responsible for any accident during execution of work & should take all preventive & safety measures. The department shall not be responsible in this respect for any lapse on the contractor part.
36. The contractor shall be liable and responsible for any kind of litigation in the court of law during execution of work, and any compensation there to has to be born by the contractor and the department shall not be involved in anyway.
37. The contractor has to work in restricted area and in restricted time due to security reasons. He shall be bound by the instructions of security staff and Engineer-in-Charge in this respect.

39. 45. ADDITIONAL TERMS & CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT

- 1) The work is to be carried as per the direction & satisfaction of Engineer-in-charge.
- 2) All the material brought at site shall have to be got approved from the Engineer-in-charge before use at site.
- 3) No T&P shall be issued by the department.
- 4) No claim for idle labour will be entertained by the department.
- 5) Any damage done to the existing structure shall be restored to its original shape & colour by the contractor for which nothing extra shall be paid.
- 6) The work shall be carried out in close co-ordination with other agencies like civil wing of this department / Client Department.
- 7) The work shall comprise of entire labour including supervision and all materials necessary to make a complete installation and such tests and adjustments and commissioning, as may be required by the department. The term complete installation shall not only mean major luminaires and mounting equipment covered by specifications but all incidental sundry components necessary for complete execution and satisfactory performance of installation with all layout charts whether or not those have been specifically mentioned in bill of quantity in the tender document. However, major equipment not covered in the scope of the work and required subsequently as an additional feature, not covered in the contract specifications, shall be paid extra. The decision of the engineer-in-charge in the matter shall be final and binding upon the contractor.
- 8) The rates shall be inclusive of all taxes, levies, duties, cartage etc.
- 9) The contractor shall have to adopt all the safety precautions while executing the work, therefore no claim shall be entertained by the department in case of any accident, while carrying out the work.
- 10) It shall be deemed that contractor has satisfied himself about the nature and location of the work, general and local conditions, particularly those pertaining to transport, handling and storage of materials, general ground conditions and environment / temperature. before Biding. The department shall not be responsible for lack of such knowledge and also the consequences thereof. The information and site data shown in the drawings and mentioned herein and elsewhere in the Bid document are being furnished for general information and guidance only. The Engineer-in-Charge shall in no case be responsible for the accuracy there of or any interpretations/or conclusions drawn there from by the contractor and nothing extra shall be paid even if the site conditions/information are different or otherwise incorrect at it is presumed that the contractor has satisfied himself for all possible contingencies, situations, bottlenecks and acts of coordination which may be required between different agencies.

- 11) The Engineer-in-Charge will be at liberty to take respective sample(s) of each item of Schedule of Quantity in any approved laboratory as decided by him. The sample for testing will be provided by the contractor. All expenditure required to be incurred for taking sample, packing etc. will be borne by the contractor himself. The testing charges shall be paid by the contractor and shall be re-reimbursed on passing of the sample and shall not be re-reimbursed on failure of the sample. In case any sample particular lot fails in testing, the contractor will be bound to replace the entire lot with fresh removal of prescribed specification and the rejected material will be returned to the contractor only after fresh material is supplied and it shall be tested again.
- 12) Removal of rejected materials: In case any materials/Substandard work are rejected by the Engineer in-Charge, the same shall be removed from the site within 48 hours, failing which the same may be got removed by the Engineer-in-charge at the risk and cost of the contractor. The decision of the Engineer-in-charge shall be final and binding in this regard.
- 13) In case of any dispute regarding rejection of quality of materials, the decision of the Engineer-in Charge will be final and binding upon the contractor.
- 14) All taxes applicable at prevalent rates shall have to be paid by the contractor himself and the rates quoted by him shall include these taxes and nothing extra on this account shall be payable.
- 15) The rates for different items of work shall apply for all heights and depths, leads and lifts including all labour & materials and other aspects involved in the execution of work unless otherwise specified in the agreement or specifications applicable to the agreement.
- 16) Any damage done by the contractor to any existing work during the course of execution of the work shall be made good by him at his own cost.
- 17) Articles manufactured by the reputed firms and approved by Engineer-in-Charge shall only be used. Only articles classified, as 'first quality' by the manufacturer shall be used unless otherwise specified. In case articles bearing ISI certification are not available in the market, quality of samples brought by the contractor shall be judged by standards laid down in the relevant CPWD specifications. For the items not covered by CPWD specifications relevant BIS standards shall apply. The sample of materials to be brought to site for use in work shall be got approved from the Engineer-in-Charge before actual execution of work.
- 18) The quantities of any item shall not be exceeded beyond the agreement quantities without prior permission of Engineer-in-Charge.
- 19) Statutory applicable recoveries such as on account of GST, Income tax, Surcharge, Construction Worker's Welfare Cess etc. as applicable from time to time shall be made from the gross amount of Running A/c Bill and Final Bill of the contractor.
- 20) The contractor shall make his own arrangement for getting the permission for entry of trucks carrying materials for the site from the traffic police / Client.

- 21) Any reference made to any Indian Standard Specifications in these documents, shall imply to the latest version of that standard, including such revisions / amendments as issued by the Bureau of Indian Standards up to last date of receipt of tenders. The contractor shall keep at his own cost all such publications of relevant Indian Standards applicable to the work at site.
- 22) The contractor will not have any claim in case of any delay by the Engineer-in-Charge in removal of trees or shifting, removing of telegraph, telephone or electric lines (overhead or underground), water and sewer lines and other structure etc., if any which may come in the way of the work. However, suitable extension of time can be granted to cover such delay.
- 23) The contractor shall clean the site thoroughly of scaffolding materials, rubbish, equipment's left out of his work and dress the site around the building to the complete satisfaction of the Engineer-in charge before the work is treated as completed.
- 24) The contractor shall comply with proper and legal orders and directions of the local or public authority or municipality and abide by their rules and regulations and pay all fee and charges which may be liable. The contractor shall give due notices to municipality police and /or other authorities that may be required under the law/rules in force the area and obtain all requisites licenses for temporary obstructions/enclosures and pay all charges which may leviable on account of his execution of the work under the Agreement. Nothing shall be payable on this account.
- 25) No residential accommodation shall be provided to any of the staff engaged by the contractor. The contractor shall also not be allowed to erect any permanent / temporary set up for his staff in the campus.
- 26) Contractor has to provide drinking water facility at site for the workers deputed by him.
- 27) The Contractor shall give due notices to Municipality, Police and/ or other authorities that may be required under the law/ rules under force and obtain all requisite licenses for temporary obstructions/ enclosures and pay all charges which may be leviable on account of his execution of the work under the agreement. Nothing extra shall be payable on this account.
- 28) The work shall be carried out in a manner complying in all respects with the requirements of relevant bye laws of the local bodies, labour laws, minimum wages act, workmen compensation act and other statutory laws enacted by Central Govt. as well as State Govt.
- 29) Any other inventory added during the contract period to any of the installations of these areas shall also be maintained within the scope of work without any extra cost.

- 30) The contractor shall provide necessary barriers, warning signals and other safety measures while executing the work or wherever necessary so as to avoid accidents. He shall also indemnify CPWD against claims for compensation arising out of negligence in this respect. Contractor shall be liable, in accordance with the Indian law and Regulations for any accidents occurring due to any cause. The contractor shall also provide all insurance including third party insurance as may be necessary to cover the risk. No extra payment would be made to the contractor due to the above provisions thereof.
- 31) Before start of work, the Contractor keeping in view that the space available is limited, shall inspect the site for material yard, other storage, steel fabrication yard, site laboratory and seek formal approval of the Engineer-in-charge. No space will be available at site of work for the fabrication of steel / aluminum work grating, railing, etc. The Contractor should make his own arrangement for the same in his workshop. Nothing shall be paid for the carriage of such manufactured items from workshop to site of work. The Contractor shall not stack building material / malba on local municipality land or road or on the land owned by any other authority and in case of failure to do so, he shall face penal action as per the rules, regulation and bye-laws of the said body or authority. The Engineer-in-Charge shall be at liberty to recover the amount due but not paid to the concerned authorities on account of the above from any amount due to the Contractor including amount of the security deposit or retention money in respect of this Contractor or any other Contract.
- 32) In order to adhere to the Committed Program and requirement of client department, the work shall be carried out in more than one shift and Contractor will deploy the resources accordingly. No extra claim on this account shall be entertained. Contractor should give advance notice in writing to Engineer-in-charge for doing any work in odd hours and arrange permission accordingly
- 33) The contractor shall take all necessary precautions to prevent any nuisance or inconvenience to the owners, tenants of adjacent properties and to the public in general and to prevent any damage to such properties and any pollution of smoke, streams and waterways. He shall make good at his cost and to the satisfaction of the Engineer-in-Charge, any damage to roads, paths, cross drainage works or public or private property whatsoever caused by the execution of the work or by traffic brought thereon by the contractor. Utmost care shall be taken to keep the noise level to the barest minimum so that no disturbance as far as possible is caused to the occupants/users of adjoining buildings.
- 34) All necessary test as per the NIT/CPWD specifications/ relevant BIS codes shall be carried out on all other materials whether ISI marked or otherwise, from CPWD lab or from approved lab as directed by Engineer-in-charge. Wherever NIT/CPWD specifications/ relevant BIS codes do not specify the frequency of tests the same shall be carried out as per the direction of the Engineer- incharge. Payment shall be borne by the contractor.

- 35) The contractor shall be responsible for the watch and ward of the building, safety of all fittings and fixtures including sanitary and water supply fittings and fixtures provided by him against pilferage and breakage during the period of installation and thereafter till the building is physical completed and handed over. No Extra Payment Shall Be Made In This Account.
- 36) The contractor shall at his risk and cost, make all arrangements and provide all facilities as per Engineer-in-Charge may require for collecting and preparing the require number of samples for such test at such time and to such place or places as may be directed by the Engineer in charge and bear all charge.
- 37) No claims of the labourers shall be entertained by the Department including that of providing employment, regularization of services etc. & the contractor shall be responsible for any court case by his workers.

Failure to provide such safety requirement would make the firm liable for penalty as decided by Engineer-in-charge. The agency will be solely responsible for any damages, mishap or injury/death of their staff deployed at the site.

- 39) The Contractor shall submit Technical Data Sheet & Drawings, Layout Drawings & Single Line Diagram for approval of the Department before supply of material at site.
