1. Eligible Criteria**(A) For CPWD registered contractor**

- (a) The CPWD registered contractor should have valid registration upto the last date of receipt of tender in appropriate class

(B) For Non- CPWD registered contractor

Eligibility of agencies shall be evaluated on the basis of their past performance. The agencies are requested to give correct information as contained in these documents and give documentary evidence in support of the information as under:

- (a) Details of experience of similar works during last 7 years ending previous day of last date of submission of tenders along with completion certificate of client department indicating their satisfactory completion.
- (b) **Joint Ventures are not accepted.**
- (a) Should have experience of satisfactorily completed similar works **during last seven years** ending previous day of last date of submission of tenders(**Form-A**) as below: -
 - 1. *Three similar completed works each costing not less than 40 % of value of the estimated cost put to Tender.*
 - Or**
 - 2. *Two similar completed works, each costing not less than 60 % of value of the estimated cost put to Tender*
 - Or**
 - 3. *One similar completed work of costing not less than 80 % of value of the estimated cost put to Tender*

The value of executed work shall be brought to current costing level by enhancing the actual value of work at simple rate of 7% per annum, calculated from the actual date of completion to previous day of last date of receipt of Technical & Financial bids through e- procurement.

- Note-1:- Components of work executed other than those included in definition of similar work shall be deducted while calculating cost of similar work. Bidder shall submit abstract of cost of work in support of this.
- Note-2:- For the purpose, “Cost of work” shall mean gross value of the completed work including the cost of materials supplied by the Government/Client, but excluding those supplied free of cost. This should be certified by an officer not below the rank of Executive Engineer / Project Manager or equivalent.
- Note-3:- The value of executed work shall be brought to current costing level by enhancing the actual value of work at simple rate of 7% per annum; calculated from the date of completion to last date of submission of bids.
- Note-4:- If any discrepancy is noticed in the work experience certificates and other documents then details/ clarifications may be asked from the contractor after opening of bids.

The Similar work mean “Providing services of commercial Inspection vehicle”.

2. Conditions for CPWD and Other Contractor:

- a) Earnest Money in the form of Treasury Challan or Demand Draft or Pay order or Banker's Cheque or Deposit at Call Receipt or Fixed Deposit Receipt, Insurance Surety Bond, Bank Guarantee of any commercial Bank (drawn in favour of **Executive Engineer, BFD V, CPWD, 68th BN BSF Campus, Mundra Road, Bhuj- Kutch**) shall be scanned and uploaded to the e-Tendering website within the period of bid submission. **The original EMD should be deposited either in the office of executive engineer inviting bids or division office of any executive engineer, CPWD within the period of bid submission. The EMD receiving Executive Engineer shall issue a receipt of deposition of earnest money deposit to the bidder in a prescribed format (enclosed) uploaded by tender inviting EE in the NIT. The receipt shall also be uploaded in the e-tendering website by the intending bidder upto the specified and submission date and time.**

A part of earnest money is acceptable in the form of bank guarantee also. In such case, minimum 50% of earnest money or Rs. 20 lac, whichever is less, shall have to be deposited in shape prescribed above, and balance may be deposited in shape of Bank Guarantee of any scheduled bank having validity for six months or more from the last date of receipt of bids which is to be scanned and uploaded by the intending bidders.

4. Agreement shall be drawn with the successful bidders on prescribed Form No. **CPWD 7** (or other Standard Form as mentioned) which is available as a Govt. of India Publication and also available on website <https://etendercpwd.com> Bidders shall quote his rates as per various terms and conditions of the said form which will form part of the agreement.
5. The time allowed for carrying out the work will be **12 Months**. From the date of start as defined in schedule 'F' or from the first date of handing over of the site, whichever is later.
6. The site for the work is available.
7. The bid document consisting of plans, specifications, the schedule of quantities of various types of items to be executed and the set of terms and conditions of the contract to be complied with and other necessary documents except Standard General Conditions of Contract Form can be seen on website <https://etendercpwd.com> **free of cost**.
8. After submission of the bid the contractor can re-submit revised bid any number of times but before last time and date of submission of bid as notified.
9. While submitting the revised bid, contractor can revise the rate, but before last time and date of submission of bid as notified.
10. The bid submitted shall become invalid if:
 - (i) The bidder is found ineligible.
 - (ii) The bidder does not deposit original EMD with division office of any Superintending Engineer/ Project Manager/Dy. Director (Hort.) / Executive Engineer, CPWD.
 - (iii) The bidder does not upload all the documents (including copy of Pan Card, Copy of registration in appropriate class & category) as stipulated in the bid documents including the copy of receipt for deposition of original EMD.
 - (iv) If any discrepancy is noticed between the documents as uploaded at the time of submission of bid and hard copies as submitted physically by the lowest tenderer in the office of tender opening authority.
 - (v) GST registration Certificate of the State in which the work is to be taken up, if already obtained by the bidder. If the bidder has not obtained GST registration in the State in which the work is to be taken up or as required by GST authorities then in such a case the bidder shall scan and upload following under taking along with other bid documents. "If work is awarded to me, I/we shall obtain GST registration Certificate of the State, in which work is to be taken up, within one month from the date of receipt of award letter or before release of any payment by CPWD, whichever is earlier, failing which I/We shall be responsible for any delay in payments which will be due towards me/us on a/c of the work executed and/or for any action taken by CPWD or GST department in this regard.

11. The contractor whose bid is accepted will be required to furnish performance guarantee “(a) 5% of tendered value or Estimated Cost Put to Tender (ECPT) (whichever is higher) and (b) Where the tendered amount is less than eighty percent (80%) of the Estimated Cost Put to Tender (ECPT), the Performance Guarantee, in addition to the requirement under (a) above, shall be increased by an amount equal to the difference between eighty percent (80%) of the ECPT and the tendered amount .” as mentioned in schedule F and within the period specified in Schedule F. This guarantee shall be in the form of Insurance Surety Bonds, Account Payee Demand Draft, Fixed Deposit Receipt or Bank Guarantee from any of the Commercial Banks in accordance with the prescribed form. In case the contractor fails to deposit the said performance guarantee within the period as indicated in Schedule 'F', including the extended period if any, the Earnest Money deposited by the contractor shall be forfeited automatically without any notice to the contractor. The earnest money deposited along with bid shall be returned after receiving the aforesaid performance guarantee.
12. The competent authority on behalf of the President of India does not bind itself to accept the lowest or any other bid and reserves to itself the authority to reject any or all the bids received without the assignment of any reason. All bids in which any of the prescribed condition is not fulfilled or any condition including that of conditional rebate is put forth by the bidders shall be summarily rejected.
13. Canvassing whether directly or indirectly, in connection with bidders is strictly prohibited and the bids submitted by the contractors who resort to canvassing will be liable for rejection.
14. The competent authority on behalf of President of India reserves to himself the right of accepting the whole or any part of the bid and the bidders shall be bound to perform the same at the rate quoted.
15. The contractor shall not be permitted to bid for works in the CPWD Circle responsible for award and execution of contracts, in which his near relative is posted a Divisional Accountant or as an officer in any capacity between the grades of Superintending Engineer and Junior Engineer (both inclusive). He shall also intimate the names of persons who are working with him in any capacity or are subsequently employed by him and who are near relatives to any gazetted officer in the Public Works Department or in the Ministry of Urban Development. Any breach of this condition by the contractor would render him liable to be removed from the approved list of contractors of this Department.
16. No Engineer of Gazetted Rank or other Gazetted Officer employed in Engineering or Administrative duties in an Engineering Department of the Government of India is allowed to work as a contractor for a period of one year after his retirement from Government service, without the prior permission of the Government of India in writing. This contract is liable to be cancelled if either the contractor or any of his employees is found any time to be such a person who had not obtained the permission of the Government of India as aforesaid before submission of the bid or engagement in the contractor's service.

The bid for the works shall remain open for acceptance for a period of Thirty (30) days from the date of opening of financial bid. If any bidders withdraws his bid before the said period or issue of letter of acceptance, whichever is earlier, or makes any modifications in the

terms and conditions of the bid which are not acceptable to the department, then the Government shall, without prejudice to any other right or remedy, be at liberty to forfeit 50% of the said earnest money as aforesaid. Further the bidders shall not be allowed to participate in the rebidding process of the work.

17. This notice inviting Bid shall form a part of the contract document. The successful bidder/contractor, on acceptance of his bid by the Accepting Authority shall within 15 days from the stipulated date of start of the work, sign the contract consisting of:-

18. In case any discrepancy is noticed between the documents as uploaded at the time of submission of the bid online and hard copies as submitted physically in the office of Executive Engineer, BFD V, CPWD, 68th BN BSF Campus, Mundra Road, Bhuj- Kutch 370001 then the bid submitted shall become invalid and the Government shall, without prejudice to any other right or remedy, be at liberty to forfeit 50% of the said earnest money as aforesaid. Further the firm/ agency shall not be allowed to participate in the retendering process of the work.
19. The technical bid sheet duly filled shall be submitted online by the due date which shall be opened first on due date and time only for those firms who are found eligible as per prequalification criteria. The time and date of opening of financial bid of the eligible contractors whose technical bid is accepted shall be communicated to them at a later date.
20. The bidder has to sign the integrity pact as given in the bid documents.

Preamble

WHEREAS the Principal/ Owner has floated the Tender (**NIT No. 04/EE/BFD V/Bhuj/2026-27 (2nd Re call)**) (hereinafter referred to as "Bid") and intends to award, under laid down organizational **procedure contract for "Replacement of existing 104.00 km damaged fencing with improved smart fencing from BP 1051 to BP 1135 (Phase-3) along Indo-Pak Border in Gujarat Sector Bhuj(SH: Providing Services for Hiring of Taxi/ inspection vehicle for AE -II & III, BFD-V,CPWD, Bhuj.** AND WHEREAS the Principal/Owner values full compliance with all relevant laws of the land, rules, regulations, economic use of resources and of fairness/transparency in its relation with its Bidder(s) and Contractor(s).

AND WHEREAS to meet the purpose aforesaid both the parties have agreed to enter into this Integrity Agreement (hereinafter referred to as **"Integrity Pact" or "Pact"**), the terms and conditions of which shall also be read as integral part and parcel of the Tender/Bid documents and Contract between the parties.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of mutual covenants contained in this Pact, the parties hereby agree as follows and this Pact witnesses as under:

Article 1: Commitment of the Principal/Owner

- 1) The Principal/Owner commits itself to take all measures necessary to prevent corruption and to observe the following principles:
 - (a) No employee of the Principal/Owner, personally or through any of his/her family members, will in connection with the Tender, or the execution of the Contract, demand, take a promise for or accept, for self or third person, any material or immaterial benefit which the person is not legally entitled to.
 - (b) The Principal/Owner will, during the Tender process, treat all Bidder(s) with equity and reason. The Principal/Owner will, in particular, before and during the Tender process, provide to all Bidder(s) the same information and will not provide to any Bidder(s) confidential / additional information through which the Bidder(s) could obtain an advantage in relation to the Tender process or the Contract execution.
- II) The Principal/Owner shall endeavor to exclude from the Tender process any person, whose conduct in the past has been of biased nature.
 - (i) If the Principal/Owner obtains information on the conduct of any of its employees which is a criminal offence under the Indian Penal code (IPC)/Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988 (PC Act) or is in violation of the principles herein mentioned or if there be a substantive suspicion in this regard, the Principal/Owner will inform the Chief Vigilance Officer and in addition can also initiate disciplinary actions as per its internal laid down policies and procedures.

Article 2: Commitment of the Bidder(s)/Contractor(s)

- (i) It is required that each Bidder/Contractor (including their respective officers, employees and agents) adhere to the highest ethical standards, and report to the Government / Department all suspected acts of fraud or corruption or Coercion or Collusion of which it has knowledge or becomes aware, during the tendering process and throughout the negotiation or award of a contract.
- (ii) The Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) commits himself to take all measures necessary to prevent corruption. He commits himself to observe the following principles during his participation in the Tender process and during the Contract execution:
 - a) The Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) will not, directly or through any other person or firm, offer, promise or give to any of the Principal/Owner's employees involved in the Tender process or execution of the Contract or to any third person any material or other benefit which he/she is not legally entitled to, in order to obtain in exchange any advantage of any kind whatsoever during the Tender process or during the execution of the Contract.

- (iii) The Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) will not enter with other Bidder(s) into any undisclosed agreement or understanding, whether formal or informal. This applies in particular to prices, specifications, certifications, subsidiary contracts, submission or non-submission of bids or any other actions to restrict competitive or to cartelize in the bidding process.
 - a) The Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) will not commit any offence under the relevant IPC/PC Act. Further the Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) will not use improperly, (for the purpose of competition or personal gain), or pass on to others, any information or documents provided by the Principal/Owner as part of the business relationship, regarding plans, technical proposals and business details, including information contained or transmitted electronically.
 - (iv) The Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) of foreign origin shall disclose the names and addresses of agents/representatives in India, if any. Similarly Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) of Indian Nationality shall disclose names and addresses of foreign agents/representatives, if any. Either the Indian agent on behalf of the foreign principal or the foreign principal directly could bid in a tender but not both. Further, in cases where an agent participate in a tender on behalf of one manufacturer, he shall not be allowed to quote on behalf of another manufacturer along with the first manufacturer in a subsequent/parallel tender for the same item.
 - (v) The Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) will, when presenting his bid, disclose any and all payments he has made, is committed to or intends to make to agents, brokers or any other intermediaries in connection with the award of the Contract.
- 3) The Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) will not instigate third persons to commit offences outlined above or be an accessory to such offences.
 - 4) The Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) will not, directly or through any other person or firm indulge in fraudulent practice **means a willful misrepresentation or omission of facts or submission of fake/forged documents in order to induce public official to act in reliance thereof, with the purpose of obtaining unjust advantage by or causing damage to justified interest of others and/or to influence the procurement process to the detriment of the Government interests.**
 - 5) The Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) will not, directly or through any other person or firm use Coercive Practices (means the act of obtaining something, compelling an action or influencing a decision through intimidation, threat or the use of force directly or indirectly, where potential or actual injury may befall upon a person, his/ her reputation or property to influence their participation in the tendering process).

Article 3: Consequences of Breach

Without prejudice to any rights that may be available to the Principal/Owner under law or the Contract or its established policies and laid down procedures, the Principal/Owner shall have the following rights in case of breach of this Integrity Pact by the Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) and the Bidder/ Contractor accepts and undertakes to respect and uphold the Principal/Owner's absolute right:

- 1) If the Bidder(s)/Contractor(s), either before award or during execution of Contract has committed a transgression through a violation of Article 2 above or in any other form, such as to put his reliability or credibility in question, the Principal/Owner after giving 14 day's notice to the contractor shall have powers to disqualify the Bidder(s) /Contractor(s) from the Tender process or terminate/determine the Contract, if already executed or exclude the Bidder/Contractor from future contract award processes. The imposition and duration of the exclusion will be determined by the severity of transgression and determined by the Principal/Owner. **Such exclusion may be forever or for a limited period as decided by the Principal/Owner.**
- 2) **Forfeiture of EMD/Performance Guarantee/Security Deposit:** If the Principal/Owner has disqualified the Bidder(s) from the Tender process prior to the award of the Contract or terminated/determined the Contract or has accrued the right to terminate/determine the Contract according to Article 3(1), the Principal/Owner apart from exercising any legal rights that may have accrued to the Principal/Owner, may in its considered opinion forfeit the entire amount of Earnest Money Deposit, Performance Guarantee and Security Deposit of the Bidder/Contractor.
- 3) **Criminal Liability:** If the Principal/Owner obtains knowledge of conduct of a Bidder or Contractor, or of an employee or a representative or an associate of a Bidder or Contractor which constitutes corruption within the meaning of IPC Act, or if the Principal/Owner has Substantive suspicion in this regard, the Principal/Owner will inform the same to law enforcing agencies for further investigation.

Article 4: Previous Transgression

- (i) The Bidder declares that no previous transgressions occurred in the last 5 years with any other Company in any country confirming to the anticorruption approach or with Central Government or State Government or any other Central/State Public Sector Enterprises in India that could justify his exclusion from the Tender process.
- (ii) If the Bidder makes incorrect statement on this subject, he can be disqualified from the Tender process or action can be taken for banning of business dealings/ holiday listing of the Bidder/Contractor as deemed fit by the Principal/ Owner.

If the Bidder/Contractor can prove that he has resorted / recouped the damage caused by him and has installed a suitable corruption prevention system, the Principal/Owner may, at its own discretion, revoke the exclusion prematurely.

Article 5: Equal Treatment of all Bidders/Contractors/Subcontractors

- 1) The Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) undertake(s) to demand from all sub-contractors a commitment in conformity with this Integrity Pact. The Bidder/Contractor shall be responsible for any violation(s) of the principles laid down in this agreement/Pact by any of its Subcontractors/sub-vendors.
- 2) The Principal/Owner will enter into Pacts on identical terms as this one with all Bidders and Contractors.
 - (i) The Principal/Owner will disqualify Bidders, who do not submit, the dulySigned Pact between the Principal/Owner and the bidder, along with the Tender or violate its provisions at any stage of the Tender process, from the Tender process.

Article 6- Duration of the Pact

- 1) This Pact begins when both the parties have legally signed it. It expires for the Contractor/Vendor 9 months after the completion of work under the contract or till the continuation of defect liability period, whichever is more and for all other bidders, till the Contract has been awarded.
- 2) If any claim is made/lodged during the time, the same shall be binding and continue to be valid despite the lapse of this Pacts as specified above, unless it is discharged/determined by the Competent Authority, PWD.

Article 7- Other Provisions

- (i) This Pact is subject to Indian Law, place of performance and Jurisdiction is the **Headquarters of the Division** of the Principal/Owner, who has floated the Tender.
- (ii) Changes and supplements need to be made in writing. Side agreements have not been made.
- (iii) If the Contractor is a partnership or a consortium, this Pact must be signed by all the partners or by one or more partner holding power of attorney signed by all partners and consortium members. In case of a Company, the Pact must be signed by a representative duly authorized by board resolution.
- (iv) Should one or several provisions of this Pact turn out to be invalid; the remainder of this Pact remains valid. In this case, the parties will strive to come to an agreement to their original intentions.

- (v) It is agreed term and condition that any dispute or difference arising between the parties with regard to the terms of this Integrity Agreement/ Pact, any action taken by the Owner/Principal in accordance with this **Integrity Agreement/ Pact or interpretation thereof shall not be subject to arbitration.**

Article 8- LEGAL AND PRIOR RIGHTS

All rights and remedies of the parties hereto shall be in addition to all the other legal rights and remedies belonging to such parties under the Contract and/or law and the same shall be deemed to be cumulative and not alternative to such legal rights and remedies aforesaid. Special Terms and conditions

1. The vehicle provided shall be maintained in good running condition, interior decorated, well maintained and good looking.
2. Deduction of taxes shall be as per prevailing govt. rate.
3. The contractor should not change driver or vehicle frequently without the approval of Engineer-in-charge. However, the Engineer-in-charge reserves the right to ask for the replacement of driver and vehicle at any time without giving any notice.
4. The driver should be neatly dressed and well behaved with a pleasing personality having the knowledge of traffic rules & office building location Driver shall be fluent in Hindi language. Mobile telephone must be provided by the contractor to the driver.
5. Taxi services mainly deployed for inspection of border works along Indo- Pak border. Therefore agency must submit undertaking as per Form 'C' that no information from office of SE- BFC-II CPWD & other CPWD offices as well as from border area will be leaked by them. And if it is found that any information regarding border works or in any other issue leaked/ share by them, then action will be initiate as per Indian laws/ Acts or others. Also driver must aware of border area along Indo- Pak IB as well as local BSF offices located in Kutch Distt.
6. All maintenance and operation cost i.e fuel, driver salary, repair and servicing etc. shall be borne by the agency.
7. Rates are net and inclusive of all taxes.
8. Nothing extra shall be paid on account of daily allowance, transportation/ conveyance allowance, boarding / lodging, if any, payable by agency to the driver deployed for the work.
9. The agency show take insurance policy for the taxi and driver employed under this work. No claim shall be entertained what so ever in case of any accident and injury/damage occur to the driver vehicle deployed for this work.
