3. Information and Instructions for tenderer posted on website shall form part of tender document.
4. The tender document consisting of plans, specifications, the schedule of quantities of various types of items to be executed and the set of terms and conditions of the contract to be complied with and other necessary documents can be seen and downloaded from website **<https://etender.cpwd.gov.in>** or **www.cpwd.gov.in** or www.eprocure.gov.in free of cost.
5. But the tender can only be submitted after deposition of original EMD either in the office of Executive Engineer inviting tenders or division office of any Executive Engineer, CPWD within the period of tender submission and uploading the mandatory scanned documents such as Demand draft or Fixed Deposit Receipts and Bank Guarantee of any scheduled Bank towards EMD in favour of Executive Engineer as mentioned in NIT, receipt for deposition of original EMD to division office of any Executive Engineer (including NIT issuing EE/ AE), CPWD and other documents as specified.
6. Those contractors not registered on the website mentioned above, are required to get registered beforehand. If needed they can be imparted training on online tendering process as per details available on the website.
7. The intending tenderer must have valid class-III digital signature to submit the tender.
8. On opening date, the contractor can login and see the tender opening process. After opening of tenders, he will receive the competitor tender sheets.
9. Contractor can upload documents in the form of JPG format and PDF format.
10. Contractor must ensure to quote rate in the prescribed column (5) meant for quoting rate in figures appears in pink colour and the moment rate is entered, it turns sky blue.

In addition to this, while selecting any of the cells a warning appears that if any cell is left blank the same shall be treated as "0". Therefore, if any cell is left blank and no rate is quoted by the tenderer, rate of such item shall be treated as "0" (ZERO).

However, If a tenderer quotes nil rates against each item in item rate tender or does not quote any percentage above/below on the total amount of the tender or any section / sub head in percentage rate tender, the tender shall be treated as invalid and will not be considered as lowest tenderer.

11. SC/ST contractors enlisted under class V category are exempted from processing fee payable to ITI.
12. Integrity pact of the tender document shall be signed between Engineer-in-Charge and the successful bidder after acceptance of the tender.
13. **All composite category contractors are renamed as building category contractors with no change in their class as per new rules for enlistment of contractors in CPWD, 2020.**
 - 13.1 The responsibility of execution of Specialized E&M works under scope of NIT shall lie with Main composite Contractor only. He is required to furnish the documents/certificates in support of his experience to execute the mentioned specialized E&M works given in Table-1 below after award of work. If the main agency

does not have required experience, they must associate Specialized Agency/Agencies to execute the mentioned E&M components of the work having requisite experience as per table-1, However, the composite category contractor shall also be eligible to carry out himself any or all of these works without associating any specialized agency provided (a)He fulfills the prescribed eligibility criteria respectively for these work(s),or,(b)He directly procures the equipment of approved make from manufacturer and get it installed from authorized agency/service provider of the manufacturer or specialized agency as per criteria mentioned in NIT. In this connection, it is mentioned that the composite contractor and the associated specialized agencies shall give required affidavit to confirm their association to the Engineer-in-charge. Tender accepting authority may approve change of sub-agency in case it is required during the currency of the contract.

- 13.2 In case composite category contractor does not fulfill the prescribed eligibility criteria respectively for these work(s), or, He does not directly procure the equipment of approved make from manufacturer and get it installed from authorized agency/service provider of the manufacturer or specialized agency as per criteria mentioned in NIT, they must associate Specialized Agency/Agencies to undertake the specialized component/components of the work having requisite experience for individual works as mentioned below:

2. 3. The time allowed for carrying out the work will be **12 (Twelve) Months** from the date of start as defined in schedule 'F' or from the first date of handing over of the site, whichever is later, in accordance with the phasing, if any, indicated in the tender documents.

6. After submission of the bid the contractor can re-submit revised tender any number of times but before last time and date of submission of tender as notified.
7. While submitting the revised bid, contractor can revise the rate of one or more item(s) any number of times (he need not re-enter rate of all the items) but before last time and date of submission of tender as notified.
8. Earnest Money in the form of Demand Draft or Bank Guarantee and Fixed Deposit Receipt (drawn in favour of **Executive Engineer, Siliguri Central Division (EZ), CPWD, Nirman Sadan, Hakimpura, Sliguri-734001** shall be scanned & uploaded to the e-tendering website within the period of tender submission. 9. The tender submitted shall become invalid and e-Tender processing fee shall not be refunded if:
 - (i) The tenderer is found ineligible.
 - (ii) The tenderer does not upload scanned copies of all the documents stipulated in the tender document.**
 - (iii) If any discrepancy is noticed between the documents as uploaded at the time of submission of tender and hard copies as submitted **physically by the lowest tenderer** in the office of tender opening authority.
 - (iv) If a tenderer quotes nil rates against each item in item rate tender or does not quote any percentage above/below on the total amount of the tender or any section/sub head in percentage rate tender, the tender shall be treated as invalid and will not be considered as lowest tenderer.**
10. **The contractor whose tender is accepted will be required to furnish Performance Guarantee (PG) as mentioned in schedule 'E' and within the period specified in Schedule F. PG shall be 5% of the Estimated cost put to tender (ECPT) or contract amount whichever is higher, or as prescribed from time to time. If the quoted bid amount is less than 80% of the estimated cost put to tender, the bidder shall be required to submit Additional Performance Guarantee (if applicable) in addition to the Standard Performance Guarantee (PG). The amount of Additional Performance Guarantee (if applicable) shall be equivalent to the difference between the 80% amount of ECPT and quoted amount. (e.g. if ECPT is a and Quoted amount is 0.7A then the amount of APG shall be 0.8A – 0.7A).**

The Additional Performance Guarantee (if applicable) shall be in the prescribed format of Performance Guarantee and has to be submitted within the time frame prescribed for submission of performance Guarantee. These guarantees shall be in the form in Insurance Surety Bonds or Account Payee Demand Draft, Fixed Deposit Receipt or Bank Guarantee from any of the Commercial Banks in accordance with the

prescribed form. Intending Tenderers are advised to inspect and examine the site and its surroundings and satisfy themselves before submitting their tenders as to the nature of the ground and sub-soil (so far as is practicable), the form and nature of the site, the means of access to the site, the accommodation they may require and in general shall themselves obtain all necessary information as to risks, contingencies and other circumstances which may influence or affect their tender. A tenderers shall be deemed to have full knowledge of the site whether he inspects it or not and no extra charge consequent on any misunderstanding or otherwise shall be allowed. The tenderers shall be responsible for arranging and maintaining at his own cost all materials, tools & plants, water, electricity access, facilities for workers and all other services required for executing the work unless otherwise specifically provided for in the contract documents. Submission of a tender by a tenderers implies that he has read this notice and all other contract documents and has made himself aware of the scope and specifications of the work to be done and of conditions and rates at which stores, tools and plant, etc. will be issued to him by the Government and local conditions and other factors having a bearing on the execution of the work.

12. The competent authority on behalf of the President of India does not bind itself to accept the lowest or any other tender and reserves to itself the authority to reject any or all the tenders received without the assignment of any reason. All tenders in which any of the prescribed condition is not fulfilled or any condition including that of conditional rebate is put forth by the tenderers shall be summarily rejected.
13. Canvassing whether directly or indirectly, in connection with tenderers is strictly prohibited and the tenders submitted by the contractors who resort to canvassing will be liable for rejection.
14. The competent authority on behalf of President of India reserves to himself the right of accepting the whole or any part of the tender and the tenderers shall be bound to perform the same at the rate quoted.
15. The contractor shall not be permitted to tender for works in the CPWD Circle (Division in case of contractors of Horticulture/Nursery category) responsible for award and execution of contracts, in which his near relative is posted a Divisional Accountant or as an officer in any capacity between the grades of Superintending Engineer and Junior Engineer (both inclusive). He shall also intimate the names of persons who are working with him in any capacity or are subsequently employed by him and who are near relatives to any gazetted officer in the Central Public Works Department or in

the Ministry of Urban Development. Any breach of this condition by the contractor would render him liable to be removed from the approved list of contractors of this Department.

16. No Engineer of Gazetted Rank or other Gazetted Officer employed in Engineering or Administrative duties in an Engineering Department of the Government of India is allowed to work as a contractor for a period of one year after his retirement from Government service, without the prior permission of the Government of India in writing. This contract is liable to be cancelled if either the contractor or any of his employees is found any time to be such a person who had not obtained the permission of the Government of India as aforesaid before submission of the tender or engagement in the contractor's service.
17. The tender for the works shall remain open for acceptance for a period of **Thirty (30) days** from the date of opening of tenders. If any tenderer withdraws his tender before the said period or issue of letter of acceptance, whichever is earlier, or makes any modifications in the terms and conditions of the tender which are not acceptable to the department, then the Government shall, without prejudice to any other right or remedy, **suspend the tenderer for one year and he shall not be eligible to bid for CPWD tenders from date of issue of suspension order.**
18. This Notice Inviting Tender shall form a part of the contract document. The successful tenderers/contractor, on acceptance of his tender by the Accepting Authority shall within 15 days from the stipulated date of start of the work, sign the contract consisting of:-
 - a) The Notice Inviting Tender, all the documents including additional conditions, specifications and drawings, if any, forming part of the tender as uploaded at the time of invitation of tender and the rates quoted online at the time of submission of tender and acceptance thereof together with any correspondence leading thereto.

This form will state the work to be carried out, as well as the date for submitting and opening tenders and the time allowed for carrying out the work, also the amount of earnest money to be deposited with the tender, and the amount of the security deposit and Performance guarantee to be deposited by the successful tenderer and the percentage, if any, to be deducted from bills. Copies of the specifications, designs and drawings and any other documents required in connection with the work signed for the purpose of identification by the officer inviting tender shall also be open for inspection by the contractor at the office of officer inviting tender during office hours.

2. In the event of the tender being submitted by a firm, it must be signed separately by each partner thereof or in the event of the absence of any partner, it must be signed on his behalf by a person holding a power holding a power-of attorney authorizing him to do so, such power of attorney to be produced with the tender, and it must disclose that the firm is duly registered under the **Indian Partnership Act, 1952**.
3. Receipts for payment made on account of work, when executed by a firm, must also be signed by all the partners, except where contractors are described in their tender as a firm, in which case the receipts must be signed in the name of the firm by one of the partners, or by some other person having due authority to give effectual receipts for the firm.

In case of any such lowest contractor in his revised offer quotes rate of any item more than their respective original rate quoted already at the time of submission of tender, then such revised offer shall be treated invalid. Such case of revised offer of the lowest contractor or case of refusal to submit revised offer by the lowest contractor shall be treated as withdrawal of his tender before acceptance and 50% of his earnest money shall be forfeited. In case all the lowest contractors those have same tendered amount (as a result of their quoted rate of individual items), refuse to submit revised offers, then tenders are to be recalled after forfeiting 50% of EMD of each lowest contractors.

Contractor, whose earnest money is forfeited because of non-submission of revised offer, or quoting higher revised rate(s) of any item(s) than their respective original rate quoted already at the time of submission of his bid shall not be allowed to participate in the retendering process of the work.

4A. Applicable for Percentage Rate Tender only (CPWD-7) In case of Percentage Rate Tenders, contractor shall fill up the usual printed form, stating at what percentage below/above (in figures as well as in words) the total estimated cost given in Schedule of Quantities at Schedule-A, he will be willing to execute the work. The tender submitted shall be treated as invalid if :-

- I. The contractor does not quote percentage above/below on the total amount of tender or any section/sub head of the tender.

higher than the percentage quoted at the time of submission of tender. The lowest tender shall be decided on the basis of revised offers.

In case any of such contractor refuses to submit revised offer, then it shall be treated as withdrawal of his tender before acceptance and 50% of earnest money shall be forfeited.

If the revised tendered amount of two more contractors received in revised offer is again found to be equal, the lowest tender, among such contractors, shall be decided by draw of lots in the presence of SE of the Circle EE(s) in-charge of major & minor component(s) (also DDH in case Horticulture work is also included in the tender), & the lowest contractors those have quoted equal amount of their tenders.

In case all the lowest contractors those have quoted same tendered amount, refuse to submit revised offers, then tenders are to be recalled after forfeiting 50% of EMD of each contractor.

5. The officer inviting tender or his duly authorized assistant will open tenders in the presence of any intending contractors who may be present at the time.
6. The officer inviting tenders shall have the right of rejecting all or any of the tenders and will not be bound to accept the lowest or any other tender.
7. The receipt of an accountant or clerk for any money paid by the contractor will not be considered as any acknowledgment or payment to the officer inviting tender and the contractor shall be responsible for seeing that he procures a receipt signed by the officer inviting tender or a duly authorized Cashier.

8. In the case of Item Rate Tenders, only rates quoted shall be considered. Any tender containing percentage below/above the rates quoted is liable to be rejected. However, if a discrepancy is found, the rates which correspond with the amount worked out by the contractor shall unless otherwise proved be taken as correct. - 1 The order of preference in case of any discrepancy as indicated in condition No. 8.1 under "Conditions of Contract" give in standard CPWD contract form may be read as the following:
 - i) Nomenclature of items as per schedule of quantities.
 - ii) Particular specification and special condition, if any.
 - iii) CPWD specifications.
 - iv) Architectural Drawings
 - v) Indian standard specifications of B.I.S.
 - vi) Sound Engineering Practice

A reference made to any Indian Standard specification in these documents, shall imply to the latest version of that standard. Including such revision/amendments as issued by the bureau of Indian standard upto last date of receipt of tenders. The contractor shall keep at his own cost all such publications of relevant Indian standard applicable to the work at site.

If there are varying or conflicting provisions made in any document forming part of the contract, the Accepting Authority shall be the deciding authority with regard to the intention/interpretation of the tender and his decision shall be final and binding on the contractor.
- 2 Except for the items, for which particular specifications are given or where it is specifically mentioned otherwise in the description of items in the schedule of quantities the work shall generally be carried out in accordance with the "CPWD specifications (with upto date corrections slips). (Hereinafter to be referred to as CPWD specifications) and instructions of Engineer-in-Charge. Wherever CPWD specifications are silent the latest IS codes/specification shall be followed.
- 3 Unless otherwise provided in the Schedule of Quantities/Specifications, the rates tendered by the contractor shall be all inclusive and shall apply to all heights, lifts, leads and depths of the work and nothing extra shall be payable to him on account of the same. Extra payment for centering/shuttering, if required to be done for heights greater than 3.5 m shall however be admissible at the rates arrived at in accordance with clause 12 of the agreement, if not already specified.
- 4
 - a) The contractor (s) shall inspect the site of work before tendering and acquaint himself with the site conditions and no claim on this account shall be entertained by the department.
 - b) The contractor (s) shall get himself acquainted with nature and extent of the work and satisfy himself about the availability of materials from kiln or approved quarries for collection and conveyance of materials required for construction.
- 5 The tenderer shall see the approaches to the site. In case any approach from main road is required by the contractor, the same shall be made good, improved and maintained by the contractor at his own cost. No payment shall be made on this account.
- 6 The contractor (s) shall give to the Municipality, Police and other authorities all necessary notices etc. that may be required by law and obtain all requisite Licenses for temporary obstructions, enclosures etc. and pay all fee, taxes and charges which

- may be leviable on account of these operations in executing the contract. He shall make good any damage to the adjoining property whether public or private and shall supply and maintain light and other illumination on for cautioning the public at night.
- 7 The contractor shall take all precautions to avoid accidents by exhibiting necessary caution boards day and night speed limit boards red flags, red lights and providing barriers. He shall be responsible for all dangers and incidents caused to existing / new work due to negligence on his part. No hindrances shall be caused to traffic during the execution of the work.
 - 8 Contractor shall provide permanent bench marks and other reference points for the proper execution of work and these shall be preserved till the end of work. All such reference points shall be in relation to the levels and locations, given in the Architectural and plumbing drawings
 - 9 The contractor shall make his own arrangement for obtaining electric connection(s) if required and make necessary payments directly to the department concerned.
 - 10 Other agencies doing works related with this project may also simultaneously execute their works and the contractor shall afford necessary facilities for the same. The contractor shall leave such necessary holes, openings etc. for laying/burying in the work, pipes cables, conduits, clamps, boxes and hooks for fan clamps etc. as may be required for the other agencies. Nothing extra over the Agreement rates shall be paid for doing these.
 - 11 Some restrictions may be imposed by the security staff etc. on the working and for movement of labour, materials etc. The contractor shall be bound to follow all such restrictions/instructions and nothing extra shall be payable on account of the same.
 - 12 The contractor shall fully comply with all legal orders and directions of the Public or local authorities or municipality and adhere by their rules and regulations and pay all fees and charges for which he may be liable in this regard. Nothing extra shall be paid/reimbursed for the same.
 - 13 The building work shall be carried out in the manner complying in all respects with the requirements of the relevant bylaws and regulations of the local body under the jurisdiction of which the work is to be executed or as directed by the Engineer-in-charge and nothing extra shall be paid on this account.
 - 14 The contractor shall give a performance test of the entire installation(s) as per standing specifications before the work is finally accepted by making his own arrangements for water supply, electricity etc. and nothing extra whatsoever shall be payable for the same.
 - 15 If as per local Municipal regulations, huts for labour are not to be erected at the site of work, the contractor shall be required to provide such accommodation at a place as is acceptable to the local body and nothing extra shall be paid on this account.
 - 16 In case of items for which abbreviated nomenclature is not available in the aforesaid publication and also in case of extra and substituted items for which abbreviated nomenclature are not provided for in the agreement, full nomenclature of item shall be reproduced in the measurement books and bill forms for running account bills.
 - 17 For the purpose of recording measurements and preparing running account bills, the abbreviated nomenclature indicated in the publications Abbreviated Nomenclature of Items of DSR 2018 shall be accepted. The abbreviated nomenclature shall be taken to cover all the materials and operations as per the complete nomenclature of the relevant items in the agreement and relevant specifications.

- 18 For the final bill, however, full nomenclature of all the items shall be adopted in preparing abstract in the measurement books and in the bill forms.
- 19 It shall be ensured by the contractor that no electric live wire is left exposed or unattended to avoid any accidents in this regard.
- 20 The contractor shall maintain in perfect condition, all portions executed till completion of the entire work allotted to him. Where however phased delivery of work is contemplated these provisions shall apply separately to each phase.
- 21 The entire royalty at the prevalent rates shall have to be paid by the contractor on all the boulders, metals, shingle sand etc. collected by him for execution of the work, directly to the Revenue authority or authorized agents of the State Government concerned or the Central Government, as the case may be.

22 PROGRAMME CHART

- i) The contractor shall prepare an integrated programme chart for the execution of work, showing clearly all activities from the start of work to completion, with details of manpower, equipment and machinery required for the fulfillment of the programme within the stipulated period or earlier as indicated in the mile stones under clause 5 of the contract and submit the

- 23 If it appears to the Engineer-in-Charge that the actual progress of work does not conform to the approved programme referred above the contractor shall produce a revised programme showing the modifications to the approved programme to ensure completion of the work within the stipulated time for completion.
- 24 The submission for approval by the Engineer-in-Charge of such programme or the furnishing of such particulars shall not relieve the contractor of any of his duties or responsibilities under the contract. This is without prejudice to the right of Engineer-in-Charge to take action against the contractor as per terms and conditions of the agreement.
- 25 If the work is carried out in more than one shift or during night no claim on this account shall be entertained.
- 26 Existing drains, pipes, cables, over-head wires, sewer lines, water lines and similar services encountered in the course of the execution of work shall be protected against the damage by the contractor at his own expense. The contractor shall not

store materials or otherwise occupy any part of the site in a manner likely to hinder the operation of such services.

- 27 The contractor shall be responsible for the watch and ward/guard of the buildings, safety of all fittings and fixtures including sanitary and water supply fittings and fixtures provided by him against pilferage and breakage during the period of installations and thereafter till the building is physically handed over to the department. No extra payment shall be made on this account.
- 28 The contractor shall bear all incidental charges for cartage, storage and safe custody of materials issued by department.
- 29 Any cement slurry added over base surface for continuation of concreting for better bond is deemed to have been built in the items and nothing extra shall be payable for extra cement considered in consumption on this account.
- 30 The contractor shall take instructions from the Engineer-in-charge for stacking of materials. No excavated earth or building materials etc. shall be stacked/collected in areas where other buildings, roads, services, compound walls etc. are to be constructed.

Any trenching and digging for laying sewer lines/water lines/cables etc. shall be commenced by the contractor only when all men, machinery's and materials have been arranged and closing of the trench(s) thereafter shall be ensured within the least possible time.

- 34 The materials shall be issued to the contractor at the place of delivery as mentioned in the Schedule-B during the working hours as per the rules of CPWD stores in force from time to time. If these are delivered at any other place, adjustments on accounts of the difference in cost of cartage shall be affected as per the terms of clause 12 of the contract agreement. The contractor shall however have to cart the materials to the site of work at his cost as soon as these are issued.
- 35 Materials like reinforcing bars, flats, tees, angles, sheets, CI and SCI pipes etc., if contemplated to be issued shall be issued in available sizes and lengths and the contractors shall bear the cost of cutting and shaping them according to the requirements of work. No claim for the wastage on this account shall be entertained.
- 36 The contractor shall bear all incidental charges for cartage, storage and safe custody of materials issued by the departments and shall construct suitable godowns, yards at the site of work for storing all materials as to be safe against damage by sun, rain, dampness, fire, theft etc. at his own cost and also employ necessary watch and ward establishment for the purpose, at his own cost. Materials to be charged directly to work and stipulated for issue free of cost shall also be issued to the contractor as soon as those are received at site or at the stipulated place of issue. The provision of this para shall apply equally and fully to those as well.
- 37 All materials obtained from the Govt. stores or otherwise on receipt shall be got checked by the Engineer-in-charge of the work or his representations before use.
- 38 The contractor shall bear all incidental charges for cartage, storage and safe custody of materials issued by department.
- i) The contractor shall submit for the approval of Engineer-in-Charge names of specialized agencies of repute along with their technical capacity proposed to be

engaged by him, who must have executed satisfactorily works of value as specified in mandatory conditions.

- ii) The works shall be carried out in accordance with the Architectural drawings and structural drawings, to be issued from time to time by the Engineer-in-Charge. Before commencement of any item of work, the contractor shall correlate all the relevant architectural and structural drawings issued for the work and satisfy himself that the information available there of is complete and unambiguous. The discrepancy, if any shall be brought to the notice of the Engineer-in-Charge before execution of the work. The contractor alone shall be responsible for any loss or damage executing by the commencement of work on the basis of any erroneous and or incomplete information.
 - iii) The contractor shall take all precautions to avoid accidents by, exhibiting caution boards day and night, speed limit boards, red flags, red light and providing necessary barriers and other measures required from time to time. The contractor shall be responsible for all damages and accidents due to negligence on his part.
 - iv) Other agencies will also simultaneously execute and install the works of electrification, air conditioning, lifts, fire-fighting etc. for this work and the contractor shall provide necessary facilities for the same. The contractor shall leave such recesses, holes openings etc. as may be required for the electric, air-conditioning and other related works (for which inserts, sleeves, brackets, conduits base pinion, clamps etc. shall be supplied free of cost by the department unless otherwise specifically mentioned) and the contractor shall fix the same at time of casting of concrete, stone work & brick work, if required and nothing extra shall be payable on this account.
 - v) All materials obtained from Govt. stores or otherwise shall be got checked by the Engineer-in-Charge or his any authorized supervisor staff on receipt of the same at site before use.
 - vi) The contractor shall conduct work so as not to interfere with or hinder the progress or completion of the work being performed by other contractor(s) or by the Engineer-in-Charge and shall as far as possible arrange his work and shall place and dispose off the materials being used or removed so as not to interfere with the operations of other contractor or he shall arrange his work with that of the others in an acceptable and coordinated manner and shall perform it in proper sequence to the complete satisfaction of others.
- 39 Samples of all materials and fittings to be used in the work in respect of brand manufacturer and quality shall be got approved from the Engineer-in-Charge, well in advance of actual execution and shall be preserved till the completion of the work. Articles bearing BIS certifications mark shall only be used unless no manufacturer has got BIS mark for the particular material. Any material/fitting whose sample has not been approved in advance and any other unapproved material brought by the contractor shall be immediately removed as soon as directed.

The rates for all items of work shall unless clearly specialised otherwise include cost of all labour, material tools and plants and other inputs involved in the execution of the item.

The contractor (s) shall quote all inclusive rates against the items in the schedule of quantities and nothing extra shall be payable for any of the conditions and

specifications mentioned. In the tender documents unless specifically specified otherwise.

Unless otherwise specified in the schedule of quantities the rates for all items shall be considered as inclusive of pumping/baling out water, if necessary, for which no extra payment shall be made. Those conditions shall be considered to include water from any source such as inflow of flood, surface and sub-soil water etc. and shall apply to the execution in any season.

The rates for all items in which the use of cement is involved is inclusive of charges for curing.

The foundation trenches shall be kept free from water while works below ground level are in progress.

- 40 The contractor shall provide at his own cost suitable weighing, surveying, leveling and measuring equipment's as may be necessary at site for checking. All such equipment's shall be got calibrated in advance from the reputed laboratory suggested by the Engineer-in-Charge. Nothing extra shall be payable on this account.
- 41 On completion of work, the contractor shall submit at his own cost four prints of "as built" drawings to the Engineer-in-Charge within 30 days of completion of work. These drawings shall have the following information:
 - a) Route of all piping and their diameters including soil waste pipes & vertical stacks.
 - b) Ground and invert levels of all drainage pipes together with locations of all manholes and connections upto outfall.
 - c) Route of all water supply lines with diameters, location of control valves, access panels etc.

42 **Maintenance of Register of Tests**

- i) All the registers of tests to be carried out at construction site or in outside laboratories shall be maintained by the contractor which shall be issued to the contractor by Engineer-in-Charge in the same manner as being issued to CPWD field staff.
- ii) The test registers to be issued to the contractor are:
 - a) Material at site account register
 - b) Inspection register
 - c) Drawing register
- (iii) All samples of materials including cement concrete cubes shall be taken jointly with contractor by JE and out of this, at least 50% sample shall be taken in presence of AE in charge. If there is no JE, all samples of materials including cement concrete cubes shall be taken by AE jointly with contractor. All the necessary assistance shall be provided by the contractor. Cost of samples materials is to be borne by the contractor and he shall be responsible for safe custody of samples to be tested at site.
- (iv) All the tests in field lab setup at construction site shall be carried out by the Engineering staff deployed by the contractor which shall be 100% witnessed by JE

and 50% of tests shall be witnessed by AE-in-Charges. At least 10% of the tests are to be witnessed by the Executive Engineer.

(v) All the entries in the registers will be made by the designated Engineering staff of the contractor and same should be regularly reviewed by JE/AE/EE.

(vi) Contractor shall be responsible for safe custody of all the test registers.

43 Submission of copy of all test registers, Materials at site register along with each alternate Running Account Bill and Final Bill shall be mandatory. These registers should be duly checked by AE(P) in Division office and receipts of register should also be acknowledged by Account Officer by signing the copies and register to confirm receipt in Division office.

If all the test registers and hindrance register is not submitted along with each alternate R/A bill & Final Bill, it will be responsibility of EE & AAO that no payment is released to the contractor.

44 Maintenance of Material at Site (MAS) Register-

(i) All the MAS registers including cement and steel registers shall be maintained by Contractor which shall be issued to the contractor by Engineer-in-Charge in the same manner as being issued to CPWD field staff.

(ii) Each of the entry of receipt of material at site shall be 100% test checked by JE or by AE if there is no JE.

Such secured advance shall be recovered in full from the next payment made to the contractor.

SCOPE OF WORK:

1. It is proposed to carry out the maintenance of all electrical installations at **Accountant General Office Complex, Gangtok**. The services are required on Working day in a month.
2. The contractor shall engage adequate number of workers for the above said work but not less than as follows:

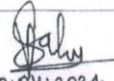
