1. The intending bidder must read the terms and conditions of CPWD-6 carefully. He should only submit his bid if he considers himself eligible and he is in possession of all the documents required.
2. Information and Instructions for bidders posted on website shall form of bid document.
3. The bid document consisting of plans, specifications, the schedule of quantities of various types of items to be executed and the set of terms and conditions of the contract to be complied with and other necessary documents can be seen and downloaded from website <https://etender.cpwd.gov.in> free of cost. But the bid can only be submitted after deposition of original EMD either in the office of the Executive Engineer (E), inviting the bids or divisions office of any Executive Engineer, CPWD within the period of submission. (The EMD document shall only be issued from the place in which the office of receiving division office is situated) and uploading mandatory scanned documents such as demand draft or pay order of banker's cheque or deposit at call receipt or fixed deposit, deposit receipts and bank guarantee of any scheduled bank towards EMD in favor of Executive Engineer as mentioned in the NIT, receipt for deposition of original EMD to division office of any Executive Engineer, CPWD and other documents as specified.
4. Those contractors not registered on the website mentioned above, are required to get registered beforehand. If needed they can be imparted training on online tendering process as per details available on the website.
5. The intending bidder must have valid class-III digital signature to submit the bid.
6. On opening date, the contractor can login and see the bid opening process. After opening of bids, he will receive the competitor bid sheets.
7. Contractor can upload documents in the form of JPG format and PDF format.

8. Contractor must ensure to quote rate of each item. The column mean for quoting rate in figures appears in pink color and the moment rate is entered, it turns sky blue.

In addition to this, while selecting any of the cells a warning appears that if any cell is left blank the same shall be treated as "0".

Therefore, if any cell is left blank and no rate is quoted by the bidder, rate of such item shall be treated as "0" (ZERO). However, if a tenderer does not quote any percentage above / below on the total amount of the tender or any section / sub head in percentage rate tender, the tender shall be treated as invalid and will not be considered as lowest tenderer.

9. When bids are invited in three stage system and if it is desired to submit revised financial bid then it shall be mandatory to submit revised financial bid. If not submitted, then the bid submitted earlier shall become invalid.
10. The department reserves the right to reject any prospective application without assigning any reason and to restrict the list of qualified contractors to any number deemed suitable by it, if too many tenders are received satisfying the laid down criterion.

Further that, if such a violation comes to the notice of Department, then I/we shall be debarred for bidding in CPWD in future forever. Also, if such a violation comes to the notice of Department before date of start of work, the Engineer-in- Charge shall be free to forfeit the entire amount of Earnest Money Deposit/Performance Guarantee. (Scanned copy to be uploaded at the time of submission of bid)

- 1.2.3 ~~When bids are invited from non-CPWD contractors and CPWD class-II contractors as per provisions of clause 1.2.1 above, it will be mandatory for non-CPWD contractors and CPWD class-II contractors to upload the work experience certificate(s) and the affidavit as per the provisions of clause 1.2.2.~~

2. Agreement shall be drawn with the successful bidders on prescribed Form No. CPWD 7 which is available as a Govt. of India Publication and also available on website www.cpwd.gov.in. Bidders shall quote his rates as per various terms and conditions of the said form which will form part of the agreement.
3. The time allowed for carrying out the work will be **12 (Twelve)** Months from the date of start as defined in schedule 'F' or from the first date of handing over of the site, whichever is later, in accordance with the phasing, if any, indicated in the bid documents.
4. The site for the work is available.
5. The bid document consisting of plans, specifications, the schedule of quantities of various types of items to be executed and the set of terms and conditions of the contract to be complied with and other necessary documents except Standard General Conditions of Contract Form can be seen on website <https://etender.cpwd.gov.in>.
6. After submission of the bid the contractor can re-submit revised bid any number of times but before last time and date of submission of bid as notified.
7. While submitting the revised bid, contractor can revise the rate of one or more item(s) any number of times (he need not re-enter rate of all the items) but before last time and date of submission of bid as notified.
8. When bids are invited in three stage system and if it is desired to submit revised financial bid then it shall be mandatory to submit revised financial bid. If not submitted then the bid submitted earlier shall become invalid.
9. Earnest Money in the form of Treasury Challan or Demand Draft or Pay order or Banker's Cheque or Deposit at Call Receipt or Fixed Deposit receipt (drawn in favour of **Executive Engineer , RCD, CPWD, Rajkot** shall be scanned and uploaded to the e- tendering website within the period of bid submission.

The original EMD should be deposited either in the office of the Executive Engineer (E), inviting the bids or divisions office of any Executive Engineer, CPWD within the period of submission. The EMD receiving Executive Engineer (including NIT issuing EE/AE) shall issue a receipt of deposition of earnest money deposit to the bidder in a prescribed format uploaded by the tender inviting Executive Engineer in the NIT.

This receipt shall also be uploaded to the e-tendering website by the intending bidder upto the specified bid submission date and time.

A part of earnest money is acceptable in the form of bank guarantee also. In such case, 50% of earnest money or Rs. 20 lakh, whichever is less, shall have to be deposited in shape prescribed above, and balance may be deposited in shape of Bank Guarantee of any scheduled bank having validity for six months or more from the last date of receipt of bids which is to be scanned and uploaded by the intending bidders.

Copy of Enlistment Order and certificate of work experience and other documents as specified in the press notice shall be scanned and uploaded to the e- Tendering website within the period of bid submission. ~~However, certified copy of all the scanned and uploaded documents as specified in press notice shall have to be submitted by the lowest bidder only within a week physically in the office of tender opening authority.~~

Online bid documents submitted by intending bidders shall be opened only of those bidders, **whose EMD deposited with any division office of CPWD** and other documents scanned and uploaded are found in order.

10. The bid submitted shall become invalid ~~and e-Tender processing fee shall not be refunded if:~~
- (i) The bidder is found ineligible.
 - (ii) The bidder does not deposit original EMD with division office of any Executive Engineer, CPWD (The EMD document shall only be issued from the place in which the office of receiving division office situated.)
 - (iii) The bidder does not upload all the documents (including **GST** registration) as stipulated in the bid document including the copy of receipt for depositing of original EMD.
 - (iv) If any discrepancy is noticed between the documents as uploaded at the time of submission of bid and hard copies as submitted physically by the lowest bidder in the office of bid opening authority.

11. The contractor whose bid is accepted will be required to furnish **performance guarantee of 5% (Five Percent)** of the bid amount within the period specified in Schedule F. This guarantee shall be in the form of cash (in case guarantee amount is less than Rs. 10000/-) or Deposit at Call receipt of any scheduled bank/Banker's cheque of any scheduled bank/Demand Draft of any scheduled bank/Pay order of any Scheduled Bank of any scheduled bank (in case guarantee amount is less than Rs. 1,00,000/-) or Government Securities or Fixed Deposit Receipts or Guarantee Bonds of any Scheduled Bank or the State Bank of India in accordance with the prescribed form. In case the contractor fails to deposit the said performance guarantee within the period as indicated in Schedule 'F', including the extended period if any, the Earnest Money deposited by the contractor shall be forfeited automatically without any notice to the contractor. Intending Bidders are advised to inspect and examine the site and its surroundings and satisfy themselves before submitting their bids as to the nature of the ground and sub-soil (so far as is practicable), the form and nature of the site, the means of access to the site, the accommodation they may require and in general shall themselves obtain all necessary information as to risks, contingencies and other circumstances which may influence or affect their bid. A bidders shall be deemed to have full knowledge of the site whether he inspects it or not and no extra charge consequent on any misunderstanding or otherwise shall be allowed. The bidders shall be responsible for arranging and maintaining at his own cost all materials, tools & plants, water, electricity access, facilities for workers and all other services required for executing the work unless otherwise specifically provided for in the contract documents. Submission of a bid by a bidders implies that he has read this notice and all other contract documents and has made himself aware of the scope and specifications of the work to be done and of conditions and rates at which stores, tools and plant, etc. will be issued to him by the Government and local conditions and other factors having a bearing on the execution of the work.

13. The competent authority on behalf of the President of India does not bind itself to accept the lowest or any other bid and reserves to itself the authority to reject any or all the bids received without the assignment of any reason. All bids in which any of the prescribed condition is not fulfilled or any condition including that of conditional rebate is put forth by the bidders shall be summarily rejected.

14. Canvassing whether directly or indirectly, in connection with bidders is strictly prohibited and the bids submitted by the contractors who resort to canvassing will be liable for rejection.

15. The competent authority on behalf of President of India reserves to himself the right of accepting the whole or any part of the bid and the bidders shall be bound to perform the same at the rate quoted.

16. The contractor shall not be permitted to bid for works in the CPWD Circle (Division in case of contractors of Horticulture/Nursery category) responsible for award and execution of contracts, in which his near relative is posted a Divisional Accountant or as an officer in any capacity between the grades of Superintending Engineer and Junior Engineer (both inclusive). He shall also intimate the names of persons who are working with him in any capacity or are subsequently employed by him and who are near relatives to any gazette officer in the Central Public Works Department or in the Ministry of Urban Development. Any breach of this condition by the contractor would

render him liable to be removed from the approved list of contractors of this Department.

17. No Engineer of Gazetted Rank or other Gazetted Officer employed in Engineering or Administrative duties in an Engineering Department of the Government of India is allowed to work as a contractor for a period of one year after his retirement from Government service, without the prior permission of the Government of India in writing. This contract is liable to be cancelled if either the contractor or any of his employees is found any time to be such a person who had not obtained the permission of the Government of India as aforesaid before submission of the bid or engagement in the contractor's service.
18. The bid for the works shall remain open for acceptance for a period of 15 days from the date of opening of bid. If any bidders withdraws his bid before the said period or issue of letter of acceptance, whichever is earlier, or makes any modifications in the terms and conditions of the bid which are not acceptable to the department, then the Government shall, without prejudice to any other right or remedy, be at liberty to forfeit 50% of the said earnest money as aforesaid. Further the bidders shall not be allowed to participate in the rebidding process of the work.
19. This notice inviting Bid shall form a part of the contract document. The successful bidders/contractor, on acceptance of his bid by the Accepting Authority shall within 15 days from the stipulated date of start of the work, sign the contract consisting of:-

~~20.1.1 The Executive Engineer in charge of the major component will call bids for the composite work. The cost of bid document and Earnest Money will be fixed with respect to the combined estimated cost put to tender for the composite bid.~~

~~20.1.2 The bid document will include following three components:~~

~~Part A:- CPWD-6, CPWD-7/8 including schedule A to F for the major component of the work, Standard General Conditions of Contract for CPWD 2014 as amended / modified up to date.~~

~~Part B:- General/specific conditions, specifications and schedule of quantities applicable to major component of the work.~~

~~Part C:- Schedule A to F for minor component of the work. (SE/EE in charge of major component shall also be competent authority under clause 2 and clause 5 as mentioned in schedule A to F for major components), General/ specific conditions, specifications and schedule of quantities applicable to minor component(s) of the work.~~

~~20.1.3 The bidders must associate himself, with agencies of the appropriate class eligible to bid for each of the minor component individually.~~

- ~~20.1.4 The eligible bidders shall quote rates for all items of major component as well as for all items of minor components of work.~~
- ~~20.1.5 After acceptance of the bid by competent authority, the EE in charge of major component of the work shall issue letter of award on behalf of the President of India. After the work is awarded, the main contractor will have to enter into one agreement with EE in charge of major component and has also to sign two or more copies of agreement depending upon number of EE's/DDH in charge of minor components. - ~~20.1.7 Security Deposit will be worked out separately for each component corresponding to the estimated cost of the respective component of works. The Earnest Money will become part of the security deposit of the major components of work.~~
- ~~20.1.8 The main contractor has to associate agency(s) for minor component(s) conforming to eligibility criteria as defined in the bid document and has to submit detail of such agency(s) to Engineer in charge of minor component(s) within prescribed time. Name of the agency(s) to be associated shall be approved by Engineer in charge of minor component(s).~~
- ~~20.1.9 In case the main contractor intends to change any of the above agency / agencies during the operation of the contract, he shall obtain prior approval of Engineer in charge of minor component. The new agency/agencies shall also have to satisfy the laid down eligibility criteria. In case Engineer in charge is not satisfied with the performance of any agency, he can direct the contractor to change the agency executing such items of work and this shall be binding on the contractor.~~

Copy of such agreement shall be submitted to EE/DDH in charge of each minor component as well as to EE in charge of major component. In case of change of associate contractor, the main contractor has to enter into agreement with the new contractor associated by him.~~
- ~~20.1.11 Running payment for the major component shall be made by EE of major discipline to the main contractor. Running payment for minor components shall be made by the Engineer in charge of the discipline of minor component directly to the main contractor.~~
- ~~20.1.12(A) The composite work shall be treated as complete when all the components of the work are complete. The completion certificate of the composite work shall be recorded by Engineer in charge of major component after record of completion certificate of all other components.~~
- ~~(B) Final bill of whole work shall be finalized and paid by the EE of major component. Engineer(s) in charge of minor component(s) will prepare and pass the final bill for their component of work and pass on the same to the EE of major component for including in the final bill for composite contract.~~

 - (b) fails or refuses to furnish the Performance Guarantee, in accordance with the provisions of tender document and Instructions to contractor, OR
 - (c) fails or refuses to start the work, in accordance with the provisions of the contract and Instructions to contractor, OR
 - (d) fails or refuses to submit fresh Bank Guarantee of an equal amount of this Bank Guarantee, against Security Deposit after award of contract.

Preamble

WHEREAS the Principal / Owner has floated the Tender (NIT No)
(hereinafter referred to as "Tender/Bid") and intends to award, under laid down organizational procedure, contract forhereinafter referred to as the "Contract".

AND WHEREAS the Principal/Owner values full compliance with all relevant laws of the land, rules, regulations, economic use of resources and of fairness/transparency in its relation with its Bidder(s) and Contractor(s).

AND WHEREAS to meet the purpose aforesaid both the parties have agreed to enter into this Integrity Agreement (hereinafter referred to as "Integrity Pact" or "Pact"), the terms and conditions of which shall also be read as integral part and parcel of the Tender/Bid documents and Contract between the parties.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of mutual covenants contained in this Pact, the parties hereby agree as follows and this Pact witnesses as under:

Article 1: Commitment of the Principal/Owner

1) The Principal/Owner commits itself to take all measures necessary to prevent corruption and to observe the following principles:

(a) No employee of the Principal/Owner, personally or through any of his/her family members, will in connection with the Tender, or the execution of the Contract, demand, take a promise for or accept, for self or third person, any material or immaterial benefit which the person is not legally entitled to.

(b) The Principal/Owner will, during the Tender process, treat all Bidder(s) with equity and reason. The Principal/Owner will, in particular, before and during the Tender process, provide to all Bidder(s) the same information and will not provide to any Bidder(s) confidential / additional information through which the Bidder(s) could obtain an advantage in relation to the Tender process or the Contract execution.

(c) The Principal/Owner shall endeavour to exclude from the Tender process any person, whose conduct in the past has been of biased nature.

2) If the Principal/Owner obtains information on the conduct of any of its employees which is a criminal offence under the Indian Penal code (IPC)/Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988 (PC Act) or is in violation of the principles herein mentioned or if there be a substantive suspicion in this regard, the Principal/Owner will inform the Chief Vigilance Officer and in addition can also initiate disciplinary actions as per its internal laid down policies and procedures.

Article 2: Commitment of the Bidder(s)/Contractor(s)

1) It is required that each Bidder/Contractor (including their respective officers, employees and agents) adhere to the highest ethical standards, and report to the Government / Department all suspected acts of fraud or corruption or Coercion or Collusion of which it has knowledge or becomes aware, during the tendering process and throughout the negotiation or award of a contract.

2) The Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) commits himself to take all measures necessary to prevent corruption. He commits himself to observe the following principles during his participation in the Tender process and during the Contract execution:

a) The Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) will not, directly or through any other person or firm, offer, promise or give to any of the Principal/Owner's employees involved in the Tender process or execution of the Contract or to any third person any material or other benefit which he/she is not legally entitled to, in order to obtain in exchange any advantage of any kind whatsoever during the Tender process or during the execution of the Contract.

b) The Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) will not enter with other Bidder(s) into any undisclosed agreement or understanding, whether formal or informal. This applies in particular to prices, specifications, certifications, subsidiary contracts, submission or non-submission of bids or any other actions to restrict competitiveness or to cartelize in the bidding process.

c) The Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) will not commit any offence under the relevant IPC/PC Act. Further the Bidder(s)/Contract(s) will not use improperly, (for the purpose of competition or personal gain), or pass on to others, any information or documents provided by the Principal/Owner as part of the business relationship, regarding plans, technical proposals and business details, including information contained or transmitted electronically.

d) The Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) of foreign origin shall disclose the names and addresses of agents/representatives in India, if any. Similarly Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) of Indian Nationality shall disclose names and addresses of foreign agents/representatives, if any. Either the Indian agent on behalf of the foreign principal or the foreign principal directly could bid in a tender but not both. Further, in cases where an agent participate in a tender on behalf of one manufacturer, he shall not be allowed to quote on behalf of another manufacturer along with the first manufacturer in a subsequent/parallel tender for the same item.

2) Forfeiture of EMD/Performance Guarantee/Security Deposit: If the Principal/Owner has disqualified the Bidder(s) from the Tender process prior to the award of the Contract or terminated/determined the Contract or has accrued the right to terminate/determine the Contract according to Article 3(1), the Principal/Owner apart from exercising any legal rights that may have accrued to the Principal/Owner, may in its considered opinion forfeit the entire amount of Earnest Money Deposit, Performance Guarantee and Security Deposit of the Bidder/Contractor.

3) Criminal Liability: If the Principal/Owner obtains knowledge of conduct of a Bidder or Contractor, or of an employee or a representative or an associate of a Bidder or Contractor which constitutes corruption within the meaning of IPC Act, or if the Principal/Owner has substantive suspicion in this regard, the Principal/Owner will inform the same to law enforcing agencies for further investigation.

Article 4: Previous Transgression

1) The Bidder declares that no previous transgressions occurred in the last 5 years with any other Company in any country confirming to the anticorruption approach or with Central Government or State Government or any other Central/State Public Sector Enterprises in India that could justify his exclusion from the Tender process.

2) If the Bidder makes incorrect statement on this subject, he can be disqualified from the Tender process or action can be taken for banning of business dealings/ holiday listing of the Bidder/Contractor as deemed fit by the Principal/ Owner.

3) If the Bidder/Contractor can prove that he has resorted / recouped the damage caused by him and has installed a suitable corruption prevention system, the Principal/Owner may, at its own discretion, revoke the exclusion prematurely.

Article 5: Equal Treatment of all Bidders/Contractors/Subcontractors 1) The Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) undertake(s) to demand from all subcontractors a commitment in conformity with this Integrity Pact. The Bidder/Contractor shall be responsible for any violation(s) of the principles laid down in this agreement/Pact by any of its Subcontractors/ sub-vendors.

2) The Principal/Owner will enter into Pacts on identical terms as this one with all Bidders and Contractors.

3) The Principal/Owner will disqualify Bidders, who do not submit, the duly signed Pact between the Principal/Owner and the bidder, along with the Tender or violate its provisions at any stage of the Tender process, from the Tender process.

Article 6- Duration of the Pact

This Pact begins when both the parties have legally signed it. It expires for the Contractor/Vendor 12 months after the completion of work under the contract or till the continuation of defect liability period, whichever is more and for all other bidders, till the Contract has been awarded.

If any claim is made/lodged during the time, the same shall be binding and continue to be valid despite the lapse of this Pacts as specified above, unless it is discharged/determined by the Competent Authority, CPWD.

Article 7- Other Provisions

1) This Pact is subject to Indian Law, place of performance and jurisdiction is the Head quarters of the Division of the Principal/Owner, who has floated the Tender.

2) Changes and supplements need to be made in writing. Side agreements have not been made.

3) If the Contractor is a partnership or a consortium, this Pact must be signed by all the partners or by one or more partner holding power of attorney signed by all partners and consortium members. In case of a Company, the Pact must be signed by a representative duly authorized by board resolution.

4) Should one or several provisions of this Pact turn out to be invalid; the remainder of this Pact remains valid. In this case, the parties will strive to come to an agreement to their original intentions.

5) It is agreed term and condition that any dispute or difference arising between the parties with regard to the terms of this Integrity Agreement / Pact, any action taken by the Owner/Principal in accordance with this Integrity Agreement/ Pact or interpretation thereof shall not be subject to arbitration.

Article 8- LEGAL AND PRIOR RIGHTS

All rights and remedies of the parties hereto shall be in addition to all the other legal rights and remedies belonging to such parties under the Contract and/or law and the same shall be deemed to be cumulative and not alternative to such legal rights and remedies aforesaid. For the sake of brevity, both the Parties agree that this Integrity Pact will have precedence over the Tender/Contact documents with regard any of the provisions covered under this Integrity Pact.

Sub: Strict implementation of labour welfare measures in CPWD.

1. Labour welfare measures: All Engineers-in-Charge are directed to ensure that all labour welfare measures prescribed in Clause 19 of the General Conditions of Contract are duly observed at site of work.

2. Motivation: The labour needs to be motivated. Field officers should have frequent interactions with the work force to encourage them and to make them aware that they are participating in nation development.

3. Digital Payment: Sl. No. 5(vii) of CPWD Contractors' Labour Regulation mandates digital payment of wages through bank or ECS or online transfer. It has to followed scrupulously and field officers shall ensure due compliance. Also, the labour force should be trained to make digital payment and transfer of money through UPI etc.

4. Record of manpower generation: The contractor is required to maintain a record of all workmen employed by him for the work vide GCC annexure IV "Register of Workmen employed by Contractor". It should invariably be checked by field officers and it should cover all workmen including supervisory, highly skilled, skilled, semi-skilled and unskilled so that details of manpower generation is available with the Department.

5. Health and Safety Measures: "Model Rules for the Protection of Health and Sanitary Arrangements for Workers Employed by Central PWD or its Contractors" have been prescribed in GCC. All field officers should ensure implementation of model rules.

6. COVID-19 appropriate behaviour: It must be ensured that social distancing, hand washing and masking are being followed to prevent spread of infection. Arrangements may be also be made for testing and vaccination of the workforce.

7. Equal treatment: Engineers-in-Charge shall ensure that there is no discrimination of the labour on the basis of religion, caste, community and region.

ADDITIONAL TERMS & CONDITION

1. The Vehicles provided must not be older than 02 years and must be in very good condition. LPG/CNG cylinders must not be used as fuel for running the vehicle in any case. Further the vehicles must not be fitted with any LPG/CNG kit. The model of vehicle should be provided are Maruti Suzuki Ertiga / TATA Nexon / Toyota Urban Cruiser / Hyundai Creta.
2. Vehicle should have Commercial RTO registration and have valid permit issued by Road Transport Authority for State of Gujarat.
3. The Hiring of the vehicles shall be for One year from the date mentioned in the Agreement and may be extended, if services provided are found satisfactory. However, service provider shall have no right for continuity of his services after completion of 12 months from the date of hiring of vehicles. The hiring shall be extended at the sole discretion of The Executive Engineer (E), CPWD, Jamnagar on the same terms and conditions subject to mutual consent of this office and the service provider.
4. The normal working hours will be from 9:30 AM to 7:30 PM. However, occasionally the vehicles may have to report earlier or may be relieved after 7:30 PM.
5. It will be the sole discretion of the department to use the deployed vehicles for any purpose including on Sunday and Holidays, irrespective of numbers of hours.
6. The vehicles deployed must be available to the department for operations every day by 9:30 AM or before, as directed. In case, hired vehicles does not report on time or does not report at all, the Department would have right to hire another vehicle from the market and the cost incurred by the Department and an additional penalty of Rs.1000/- for each such incident, shall be recovered from the service provider by the way of deduction from the monthly payment
7. In case of the failure of any vehicle deployed during the journey, the Service Provider must arrange for the alternate vehicle immediately. If the Service provider is unable to do so, then the proportionate amount of deduction will be done from the monthly payment.
8. The Service provider shall be responsible for the payment of all Government/Local Taxes/Tolls in respect of the hired vehicles.
9. The vehicles provided under the contract must be properly and comprehensively insured and should carry necessary RC (Reg. Certificate), permits/clearances, including pollution clearance certificate (PUC)
10. Vehicle proposed by the bidder should be of his own or their associated companies/persons having proper authority/affidavit showing the ownership and authorization for utilization of the vehicle.

11. The Service provider should ensure that all the provisions relating to Motor Vehicle Act, Insurance provisions, Minimum Wages Act regarding the payment to the drivers and also the provisions of Gratuity to the drivers are strictly followed by the service provider while providing the vehicles, as all these statutory liabilities will be on account of the service provider/contractor/vehicle provider.
12. The bidders may give details of vehicle proposed to be put up as new vehicle with quotation, then he will provide vehicle within 15 days. In the meantime the contractor will arrange for vehicles, not older than two years, under intimation to this office.
13. In case of any mishap/accident, all the claims arising out from shall be paid by the vehicle provider only.
14. The service provider shall ensure compliance with all labour laws in force.
15. Driver must not smoke, chew tobacco products or drink (liquor or any type of intoxication), while on duty. In case of misbehavior of the driver or failure to meet any of the agreed/accepted terms and conditions, a penalty of Rs. 1000/- per instance shall be charged from the contracted agency/service provider.
16. Records of the journey/logbook undertaken by the vehicle shall be maintained on daily basis indicating the time and mileage and to be signed by the concerned officers using the vehicle.
17. All costs towards, fuel, repairs, maintenance and other taxes etc, if any, shall be borne by the service provider.
18. No payment shall be made in advance. The service provider shall submit the bill at each stage/in the first week of following month (2 Months Cycle) on completion of each stage of work for sanction of the amount of bill and passing the bill for payment. The Department shall be at liberty to withhold any of the payments in full or in part subject to recovery of penalties mentioned in preceding paras.
19. Driver provided with the vehicle must have minimum driving experience of 2 years and must possess a valid Driving license to drive the vehicle.
20. The service provider shall ensure that the speedometer and odometer (for measuring distance covered) of car supplied is properly sealed, so that no tampering is done with a view to inflate distance travelled. The authorized officer of the CPWD would carry out surprise checks of speedometer and odometer of the vehicles. If found defective, would be got fitted from authorized workshop and cost for the same will be recovered from the Service provider by the mode of deduction.
21. The service provider will be liable to pay the wages and allowances to the Driver and the Driver will be on the establishment of the service provider for all practical and legal purposes. This Department would not be responsible at all to see whether the minimum

wages, as per the prevailing Acts and Rules, are being paid to the Drivers or not, and this would be a matter between the service provider and the Driver(s) and for any legal consequences department shall not be a party at all.

22. The following items should be maintained during contract period, which will be checked periodically by the vehicle officer in charge and also by the Executive Engineer (E), CPWD, Jamnagar:
 - There should be at least two sets of white covers.
 - There should be at least two sets of towels and napkins in the car to be provided by the service provider and should be changed every week.
 - The air spray & First Aid Medical Kit are to be provided by the contractor
23. The liability of this Executive Engineer (E), CPWD, Jamnagar shall be limited to hiring charges only. The service provider and/or driver(s) shall not be treated as Government Servant on any ground including that vehicle being used for the Government office duties.
24. The drivers provided along with the vehicles must be neatly dressed and well-mannered and should also be in possession of Mobile phone and his mobile number along with the service provider's mobile number shall be made available to this office for contacting them regularly. Drivers should be well experienced and well conversant with city and its suburbs and should not have any police case pending or complaint against them.
25. The Executive Engineer (E), CPWD, Jamnagar shall have the right/discretion to terminate the agreement at any time without giving any notice, if unsatisfactory performance is found during the Contract period.
26. In case, the Service provider wants to withdraw the vehicle, he has to give two (2) months advance/prior notice failing which two months charges shall be recovered/forfeited (proceeding from the date of stoppage of service by the service provider).
27. In case of any dispute of any kind and in any respect whatsoever, the decision of the Executive Engineer (E), CPWD, Jamnagar, shall be final and binding.
28. Necessary GST & It will be deducted as applicable.
29. Driver shall have valid four wheeler license.
30. The logbook has to be signed by the officials using the vehicle on daily basis so that monitoring can be done.
