2. The intending tenderer must read the terms and conditions of CPWD-6 carefully. He should only submit his tender if he considers himself eligible and he is in possession of all the documents required.
3. Information and Instructions for tenderer posted on website shall form part of tender document.
4. The tender document consisting of plans, specifications, the schedule of quantities of various types of items to be executed and the set of terms and conditions of the contract to be complied with and other necessary documents can be seen and downloaded from website <https://etender.cpwd.gov.in> free of cost.
5. But the bid can only be submitted after deposition of original EMD either in the office of Executive Engineer inviting bids or division office of any Executive Engineer, CPWD within the period of bid submission and uploading the mandatory scanned

documents such as Demand draft or Pay order or Bankers Cheque or Deposit at call Receipt or Fixed Deposit Receipts and Bank Guarantee of any scheduled Bank towards EMD in favour of **Executive Engineer, Srinagar, CPWD, Srinagar** as mentioned in NIT, receipt for deposition of original EMD to division office of any Executive Engineer (including NIT issuing EE/AE), CPWD and other documents as specified.

6. Those contractors not registered on the website mentioned above, are required to get registered beforehand. The necessary training materials including the videos are available on downloaded section of <https://etender.cpwd.gov.in>.
7. The intending tenderer must have valid class-III digital signature to submit the tender.
8. The intending bidder must have valid class-III digital signature certificate with encryption key (combo type) to perform any operation / transaction on the e-tendering portal / website and the bidder should download and install the e M singer on their system as per instructions available in download section of <https://etender.cpwd.gov.in>
9. On opening date, the contractor can login and see the tender opening process. After opening of tenders, he will receive the competitor tender sheets.
10. Contractor can upload documents in the form of JPG format and PDF format.
11. Contractor must ensure to quote rate in the prescribed column meant for quoting rate in figures appears in yellow colour and the moment rate is entered, it turns sky blue.
In addition to this, while selecting any of the cells a warning appears that if any cell is left blank the same shall be treated as "0". Therefore, if any cell is left blank and no rate is quoted by the tenderer, rate of such item shall be treated as "0" (ZERO).

1. The work is estimated to cost **Rs. 4,42,275/-**-This estimate, however, is given merely as a rough guide.

1.1.1 The authority competent to approve NIT for the combined cost and belonging to the major discipline will consolidate NITs for calling the bids. He will also nominate Division which will deal with all matters relating to the invitation of bids.

For composite bid, besides indicating the combined estimated cost put to bid, should clearly indicate the estimated cost of each component separately. The eligibility of bidders will correspond to the combined estimated cost of different components put to bid.

1.1.2 Intending bidders is eligible to submit the bid provided he has definite proof from the appropriate authority, which shall be to the satisfaction of the competent authority, of having satisfactorily completed similar works of magnitude specified below: -

3. The time allowed for carrying out the work will be **45 Days** from the date of start as defined in schedule 'F' or from the first date of handing over of the site, whichever is later, in accordance with the phasing, if any, indicated in the bid documents.
4. (i). The site for the work is available.
5. The bid document consisting of plans, specifications, the schedule of quantities of various types of items to be executed and the set of terms and conditions of the contract to be complied with and other necessary documents except Standard General Conditions of Contract Form can be seen from website **www.etender.cpwd.gov.in** or **www.cpwd.gov.in** free of cost.
6. After submission of the bid the contractor can re-submit revised bid any number of times but before last time and date of submission of bid as notified.
7. While submitting the revised bid, contractor can revise the rate of one or more item(s) any number of times (he need not re-enter rate of all the items) but before last time and date of submission of bid as notified.
8. Earnest Money in the form of Treasury challan or Demand Draft or Pay order or Banker's Cheque or Deposit at Call Receipt or Fixed Deposit Receipt (drawn in favour of **Executive Engineer, Srinagar, CPWD, Srinagar (J&K)** shall be scanned and uploaded to the e-tendering web site within the period of bid submission. The original EMD should be deposited either in the office of Executive Engineer inviting bids or Division office of any Executive Engineer CPWD within the period of bid submission. The EMD receiving Executive Engineer (including NIT issuing EE) shall issue a receipt of deposition of earnest money deposited to the bidder in a prescribed format (enclosed) uploaded by tender inviting EE in the NIT. 9. The bid submitted shall become invalid and cost of bid & e-Tender processing fee shall not be refunded if:
 - (i) The bidder is found ineligible.
 - (ii) The bidder does not upload all the documents (including service tax registration/GST registration/Sales Tax registration) as stipulated in the bid document including the proforma for Earnest money declaration
 - (iii) If any discrepancy is noticed between the documents as uploaded at the time of submission of bid and hard copies as submitted physically by the lowest tenderer in the office of tender opening authority.
 - (iv) If a tenderer quotes nil rates against each item in item rate tender or does not quote any percentage above/below on the total amount of the tender or any section/sub head in

percentage rate tender, the tender shall be treated as invalid and will not be considered as lowest tenderer.

10. The contractor whose bid is accepted will be required to furnish **performance guarantee of 5% (Five Percent)** of the bid amount within the period specified in Schedule F. This guarantee shall be in the form of Insurance Surety Bonds, Account Payee Demand Draft, Fixed Deposit Receipt or Bank Guarantee from any of the Commercial Banks in accordance with the prescribed form. A bidders shall be deemed to have full knowledge of the site whether he inspects it or not and no extra charge consequent on any misunderstanding or otherwise shall be allowed. The bidders shall be responsible for arranging and maintaining at his own cost all materials, tools & plants, water, electricity access, facilities for workers and all other services required for executing the work unless otherwise specifically provided for in the contract documents. Submission of a bid by a bidder implies that he has read this notice and all other contract documents and has made himself aware of the scope and specifications of the work to be done and of conditions and rates at which stores, tools and plant, etc. will be issued to him by the Government and local conditions and other factors having a bearing on the execution of the work

12. The competent authority on behalf of the President of India does not bind itself to accept the lowest or any other bid and reserves to itself the authority to reject any or all the bids received without the assignment of any reason. All bids in which any of the prescribed condition is not fulfilled or any condition including that of conditional rebate is put forth by the bidders shall be summarily rejected.
13. Canvassing whether directly or indirectly, in connection with tenderers is strictly prohibited and the tenders submitted by the contractors who resort to canvassing will be liable to rejection.
14. The competent authority on behalf of President of India reserves to himself the right of accepting the whole or any part of the bid and the bidders shall be bound to perform the same at the rate quoted.
15. The contractor shall not be permitted to tender for works in the CPWD Circle (Division in case of contractors of Horticulture/Nursery category) responsible for award and execution of contracts, in which his near relative is posted a Divisional Accountant or as an officer in any capacity between the grades of Superintending Engineer and Junior Engineer (both inclusive). He shall also intimate the names of persons who are working with him in any capacity or are subsequently employed by him and who are near relatives to any gazetted officer in the Central Public Works Department or

in the Ministry of Urban Development. Any breach of this condition by the contractor would render him liable to be removed from the approved list of contractors of this Department.

16. No Engineer of gazetted rank or other Gazetted Officer employed in Engineering or Administrative duties in an Engineering Department of the Government of India is allowed to work as a contractor for a period of one year after his retirement from Government service, without the previous permission of the Government of India in writing. This contract is liable to be cancelled if either the contractor or any of his employees is found any time to be such a person who had not obtained the permission of the Government of India as aforesaid before submission of the tender or engagement in the contractor's service.
17. The bids for the work shall remain open for acceptance for a period of **30 (thirty) days from the date of opening of bids in case of single bid system** and 75 (seventy five) days from the date of opening of technical bids in case bids are invited in 2 or 3 bid system. Further
 - i) If any tenderer withdraws his tender or makes any modification in the terms & conditions of the tender which is not acceptable to the department within 7 days after last date of submission of bids, then the Government shall without prejudice to any other right or remedy, be at liberty to forfeit 50% of the earnest money absolutely irrespective of letter of acceptance for the work is issued or not.
