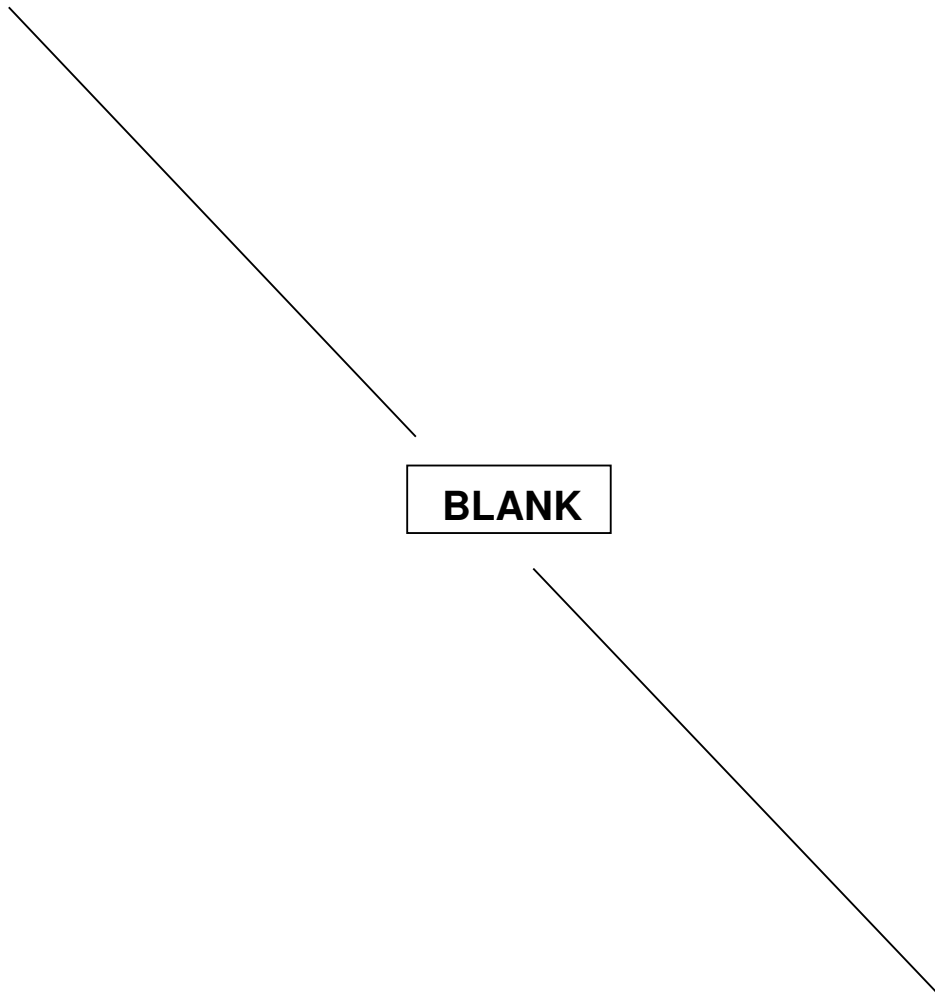

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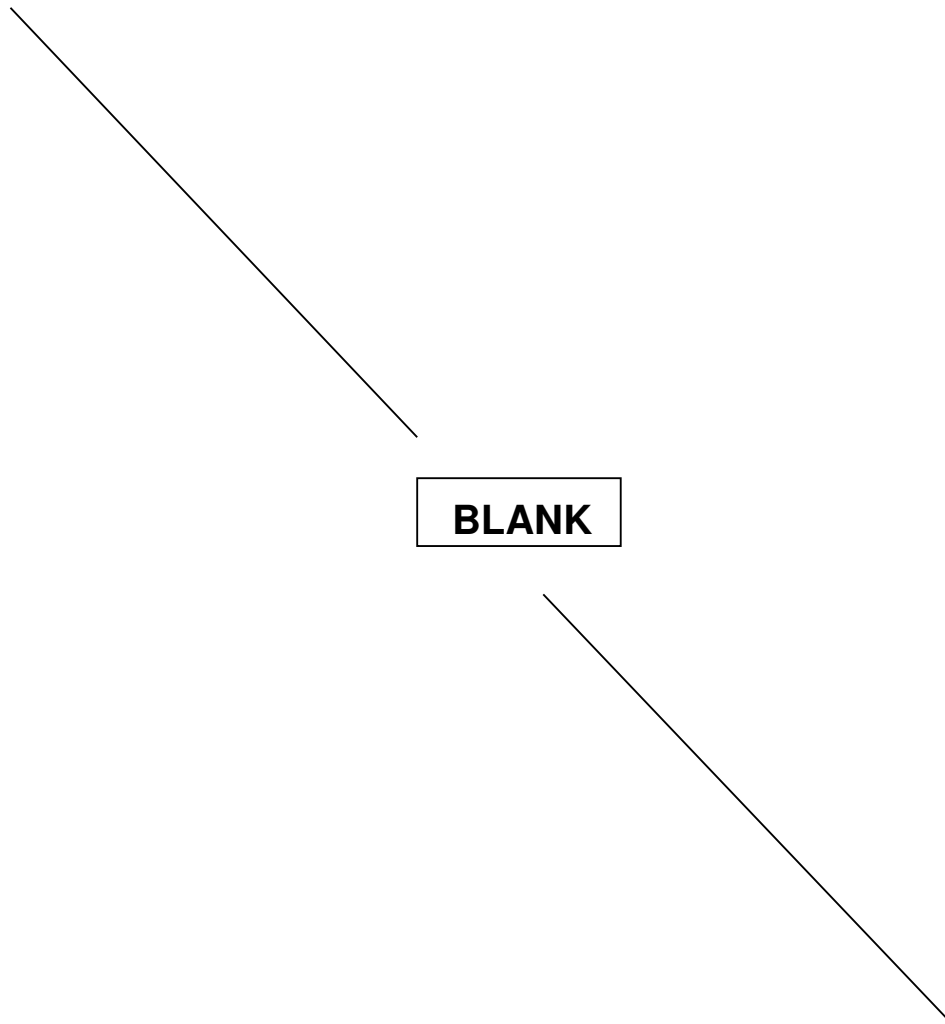

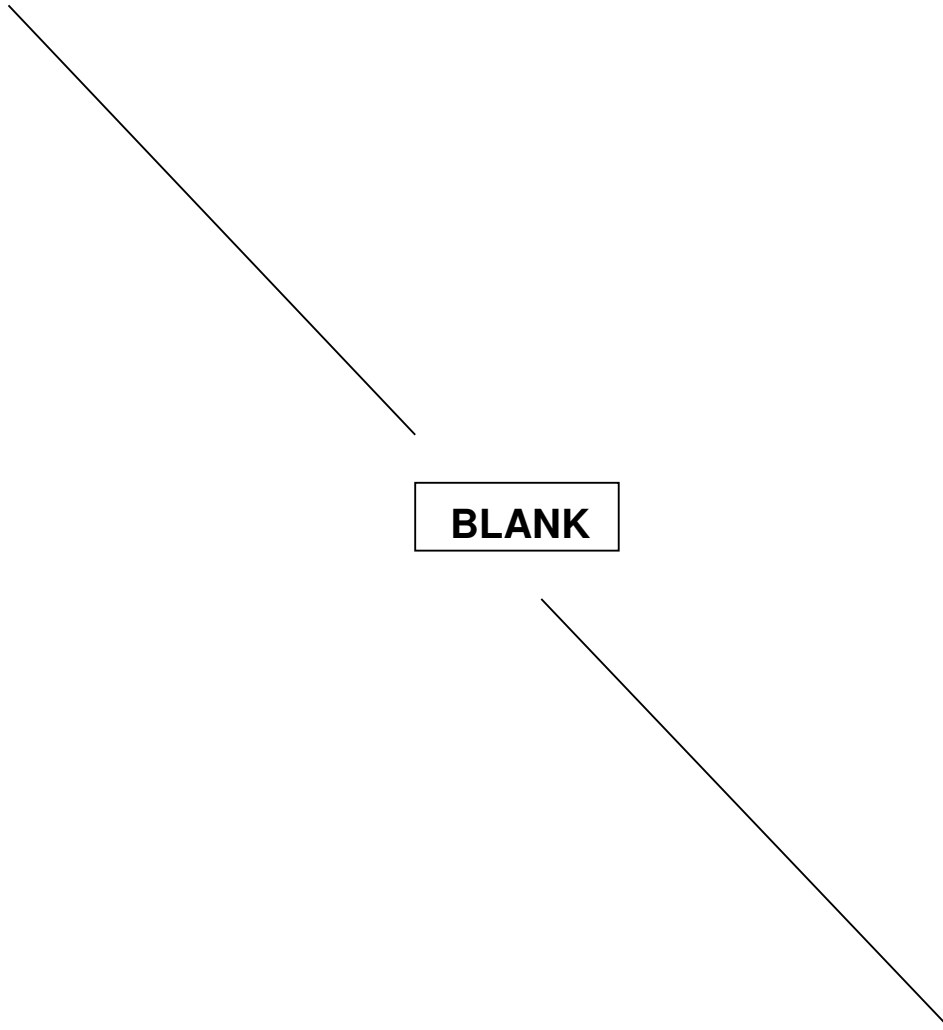

Intending Bidders are advised to inspect and examine the site and its surroundings and satisfy themselves before submitting their bids as to the nature of the ground and sub-soil (so far as is practicable), the form and nature of the site, the means of access to the site, the accommodation they may require and in general shall themselves obtain all necessary information as to risks, contingencies and other circumstances which may influence or affect their bid. A bidder shall be deemed to have full knowledge of the site whether he inspects it or not and no extra charge consequent on any misunderstanding or otherwise shall be allowed. The bidder shall be responsible for arranging and maintaining at his own cost all materials, tools & plants, water, electricity access, facilities for workers and all other services required for executing the work unless otherwise specifically provided for in the contract documents. - 8.3 The chasing, cutting and making holes in the masonry and / or cement concrete and / or RCC works shall be done carefully without causing any damage to the structure. As far as possible, mechanical cutters & core cutting machines shall be used in a workman like manner, for concealing the pipelines and fittings. The chases / holes, so made, shall be made good with the cement mortar of mix 1: 3 (1cement: 3 fine sand) after testing of the pipe lines for leakage. The cost of cutting cores in RCC, cutting holes in masonry & making good the same shall be inclusive in the respective item of drainage/water supply lines.

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9.0 Co-operation & Co-ordination with other agencies:

- 9.1 The contractor for this work shall plan his work in such a manner so that the work (S) of other contractor (S) is /are not affected in any way. The work should be planned in a systematic manner so as to ensure proper co-ordination of various disciplines viz. sanitary & water supply, drainage, rain water harvesting, electrical, fire fighting, information technology, communication & electronics and any other services.
- 9.2 Conduits for electrical wiring/cables will be laid in such a way that they leave enough space for Concreting and do not adversely affect the structural members. Nothing extra over the agreement rate shall be paid for the same.
- 9.3 The successful tenderer shall co-ordinate with other contractors and agencies engaged in the construction of building, if any, and exchange freely all technical information so as to make the execution of this works contract smooth. No remuneration should be claimed from the department for such technical cooperation. If any unreasonable hindrance is caused to other agencies and any completed portion of the work has to be dismantled and re-done for want of cooperation and coordination by the successful tenderer during the course of work, such expenditure incurred will be recovered from the successful tenderer if the restoration work to the original condition or specification of the dismantled portion of the work was not undertaken by the successful tenderer himself.
- 9.4 Other agencies will also be executing simultaneously the works like other buildings, electrical cable laying, street lighting and horticulture works etc. for the same project along with this particular work. The contractor shall extend necessary facilities for the same and cooperate with such contractors. No claim in the matter shall be entertained.
- 9.5 The Contractor shall take all necessary precautions to prevent any nuisance or inconvenience to the owners, tenants or occupants of the adjacent properties and to the public in general. The Contractor shall take all care, as not to damage any other adjacent property or other services running adjacent to the plot. If any damage is done, the same shall be made good by the Contractor at his own cost and to the entire satisfaction of the Engineer-in-Charge. The Contractor shall use such methodology and equipments for execution of the work, so as to cause minimum environmental pollution of any kind during construction. Further, the Contractor shall take all precautions to abide by the environmental related restrictions imposed by Maharashtra Pollution Control Board, Govt. of Maharashtra.
- 9.6 Utmost care shall be taken to keep the noise level to the barest minimum so that no disturbance as far as possible is caused to the occupants / users of adjoining buildings. No claim what so ever on account of site constraints mentioned above or any other site constraints, inadequate availability of skilled, semi-skilled or unskilled

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workers in the near vicinity, non-availability of construction machinery spare parts and any other constraints not specifically stated here, shall be entertained from the Contractor.

- 9.7 The contractor shall conduct his work, so as not to interfere with or hinder the progress or completion of the work being performed by other contractor(s) or by the Engineer-in-Charge and shall as far as possible arrange his work and shall place and dispose off the materials being used or removed so as not to interfere with the operations of other contractors or he shall arrange his work with that of the others in an acceptable and in a proper co-ordinated manner and shall perform it in proper sequence to the complete satisfaction of others.

10.0 Safety Measures :-

- 10.1 The contractor shall also provide necessary barricade, informatory boards, lights and flagmen at either end of the execution area and at such intermediate points as required as per local body norms and at no extra cost.
- 10.2 The contractor shall maintain in good condition all work executed till the completion of the entire work entrusted to the contractor under this contract & nothing extra shall be paid on this account.
- 10.3 For form work use of solid timber and products involving solid timber shall not be permitted.
- 10.4 Any damage to work resulting from rains or from any other cause until the work is taken over by Department after completion of work shall be made good by the contractor at his own cost.
- 10.5 Any damage made by men, machinery, vehicles (LMVs or HMTVs), or any way to the public/private property such as services of electricity, water, telephone, LAN, road and path during execution of the work shall be repaired/redone by the Agency/Contractor. If contractor fails to repair/redone damage, the work shall be done on his risk as per the direction of the Engineer in charge. No any cost claim shall be entertained on this account.
- 10.6 All safety equipment such as Safety Helmets, Safety shoes, gloves, Safety belt etc. shall be made available to site Engineers, Supervisors, labourers, masons fitters etc.

11.0 Handling of Material/Waste :-

- 11.1 Unserviceable materials shall have to be removed and disposed off to places as decided by the Engineer-in-charge. Scarified rubbish of brick aggregates of WBM etc. shall be spread on the shoulders / on the slope of embankments and suitably compacted for which nothing extra shall be paid.
- 11.2 The contractor shall take instructions from the Engineer-in-charge for stacking of materials in any place. No excavated earth or building material shall be stacked on areas where other buildings, roads services of compound walls are to be constructed.

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- 11.3 The contractor & his work people shall observe all relevant rules regarding security promulgated in which work is to be carried out by the controlling authority of the area.
- 11.4 For water supply, in case the contractor is required to make his own arrangement then including boring of tube well, if necessary, and nothing extra shall be paid by the Department for arrangement of water or on its treatment as per requirements laid down in IS: 456 / 2000 Para 5.4 or CPWD Specification 2009 Volume-I to II with upto date correction slips.
- 11.5 In case of any calamity or injury to any labour/ workmen etc. or loss / wastage of materials due to nature or insurgency, contractor shall have to bear the cost of compensation and no claim to this effect shall be entertained by the department.
- 11.6 The contractor shall keep himself ready for execution of any item / items of work / part of the item of work on emergent notice given by the Engineer-in-charge on day to day basis during rainy season. Payment of items executed shall be as per terms of contract stipulated elsewhere in this document.
- 11.7 The contractor shall provide at his own cost suitable weighing and measuring equipments /instruments as may be necessary at site for checking purposes. All such equipments /instruments shall be got tested for calibration in advance from laboratory approved by the Engineer-in- Charge.
- 11.8 The work on item of internal finishing must be started as soon as the structure is completed.
- 11.9 The fittings used for items of water supply & sanitary works shall be of same make for all items from amongst the makes mentioned in the items.
- 11.10 The contractor shall be responsible for the protection of sanitary and water supply fittings and fixtures against pilferage and breakage during the period of installation and thereafter until the building is handed over.
- 11.11 The contractor may have to give a performance test of the entire installation (S) as per standing specifications before the work is finally accepted.
- 11.12 Some restrictions may be imposed by the security staff etc. on the working and for movement of labour, materials etc. The contractor shall be bound to follow all such restriction / instructions including issue of identity cards to all persons authorized by him to do work / visit the work site and nothing shall be payable on this account.
- 11.13 No claim for idle establishment & labour, machinery & equipments, tools & plants and the like, for any reason whatsoever, shall be admissible during the execution of work as well as after its completion.

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12.0 CLEANLINESS OF SITE

- 12.1 The Contractor shall not stack building material /malba /muck/ rubbish on the land or road of the local development authority or on the land owned by the others, as the case may be. So the muck, rubbish etc. shall be removed periodically as directed by the Engineer-in-Charge, from the site of work to the approved dumping grounds as per the local byelaws and regulations of the concerned authorities and all necessary permissions in this regard from the local bodies shall be obtained by the Contractor.
- 12.2 Nothing extra shall be payable on this account. In case, the Contractor is found stacking the building material / malba as stated above, the Contractor shall be liable to pay the stacking charges / penalty as may be levied by the local body or any other authority and also to face penal action as per the rules, regulations and bye-laws of such body or authority. The Engineer –in-Charge shall be at liberty to recover, such sums due but not paid to the concerned authorities on the above counts, from any sums due to the Contractor including amount of the Security Deposit and performance guarantee in respect of this contract agreement.

13.0 LABOUR AND SECURITY

- 13.1 In the event of the contractor(s) committing a default or breach of any of the provisions of the Central Public Works Department, Contractor's Labour Regulations and Model Rules for the protection of health and sanitary arrangements for the workers as amended from time to time or furnishing any information or submitting or filing any statement under the provisions of the above Regulations and Rules which is materially incorrect, he/they shall, without prejudice to any other liability, pay to the Government a sum not exceeding Rs. 200/- for every default, breach or furnishing, making, submitting, filing such materially incorrect statements and in the event of the contractor(s) defaulting continuously in this respect, the penalty may be enhanced to Rs. 200/- per day for each day of default subject to a maximum of 5 percent of the estimated cost of the work put to tender. The decision of the Engineer-in-Charge shall be final and binding on the parties.
- 13.2 The Contractor shall display all permissions, licenses, registration certificates, bar charts, other statements etc under various labour laws and other regulations applicable to the works, at his site office.
- 13.3 Contractor should make own arrangement for labour huts away from the site .The contractor will not be provided space for labour huts etc. inside the campus. No payment shall be made for construction of labour housing.
- 13.4 The huts for labour are not to be erected at the site of work by the contractors, the contractors are required to provide such accommodation as is acceptable to local bodies and nothing extra shall be paid on this account.

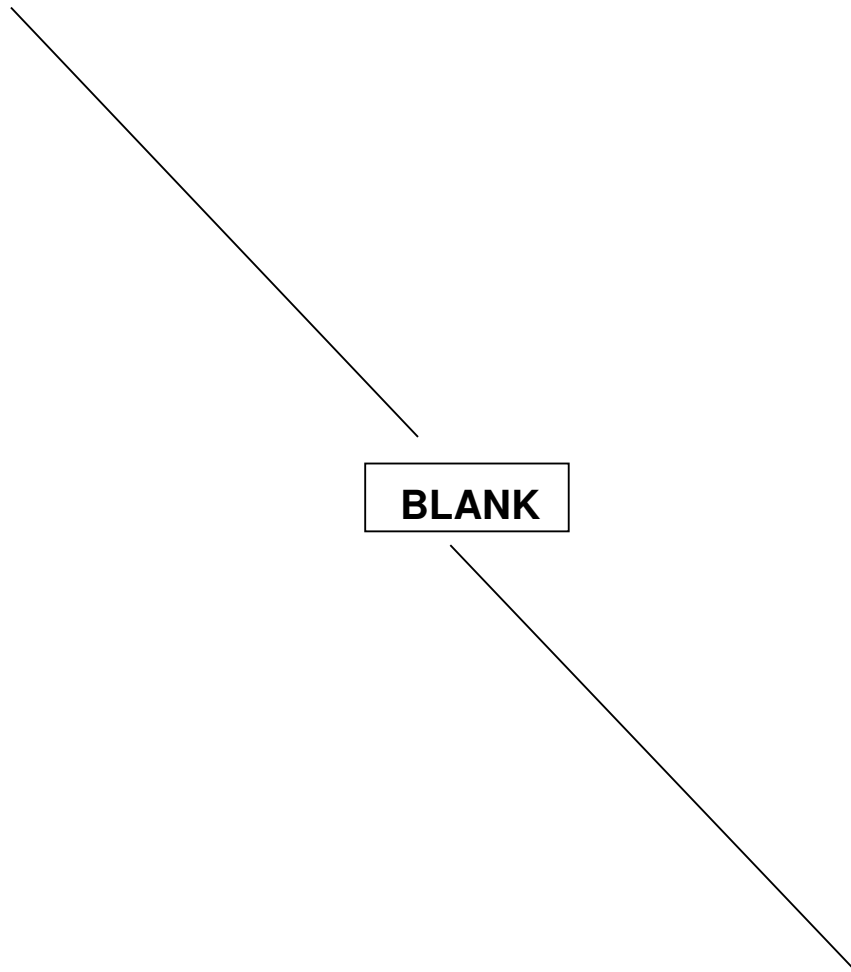

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- 13.5 Contractor has to follow the security requirement of the campus and obtain necessary entry passes for the labour and vehicles and follow security checks at entry/exit gates, restriction on movement of vehicle, restricted timings of working etc. The Department however shall assist the contractor in obtaining such passes for movement of vehicles and labour. No claim whatsoever shall be entertained on account of delay in entry of vehicles and labour including restrictions in working hours, if there is any.
- 13.6 The contractor shall employ only Indian Nationals after verifying their antecedents and loyalty. The contractor shall, on demand submit list of his agents, employees and work people concerned & shall satisfy as to the bonafides of such people.
- 13.7 The contractor & his work people shall observe all relevant rules regarding security promulgated in which work is to be carries out by the Controlling Administrative Authority of the campus/area (hereinafter referred to as "Administrator").
- 13.8 The contractor, his representative, workman shall be allowed to enter through specified gates & timing as laid down by the controlling authority. They shall be issued an identity card or an individual pass in accordance with the standing rules & regulations & they should possess the same while working. The Contractor shall be responsible for the conduct & actions of his workmen, agents/representatives.
- 13.9 Normally contractor shall be allowed to carry out work between 7 AM to 6 PM. However, he may also be allowed to carry out the work beyond 6 PM & up to 7AM if the site conditions/circumstances so demand with prior written permission from the "Administrator". However, if the work is carried out in more than one shift or at night, no claim on this account shall be entertained.
- 13.10 Normally contractor's material /vehicles etc. shall be allowed to move in /go-out between 7 AM to 7 PM only & no movement of material /vehicles out of site of work shall be allowed during night hours unless specific permission is obtained from the "Administrator".
- 13.11 In case if a separate entry has been allowed, the contractor has to make all arrangement for making a separate entry gate and barricading of the working area to segregate/separate the same from other area. All these have to be done by the contractor at his own cost including safeguarding any untoward incident in the restricted are due to separate entry gate and barricading arranged by the contractor. No extra amount on this account shall be payable by the department.
- 13.12 In the event of any restrictions being imposed by the Security agency, CPWD, Traffic or any other authority having jurisdiction in the area on the working or movement of labour / material, the contractor shall strictly follow such restrictions and nothing extra shall be payable to the contractor on such accounts. The loss of time on these accounts, if any, shall have to be made up by augmenting additional resources whatever required. Nothing extra shall be payable on this account.

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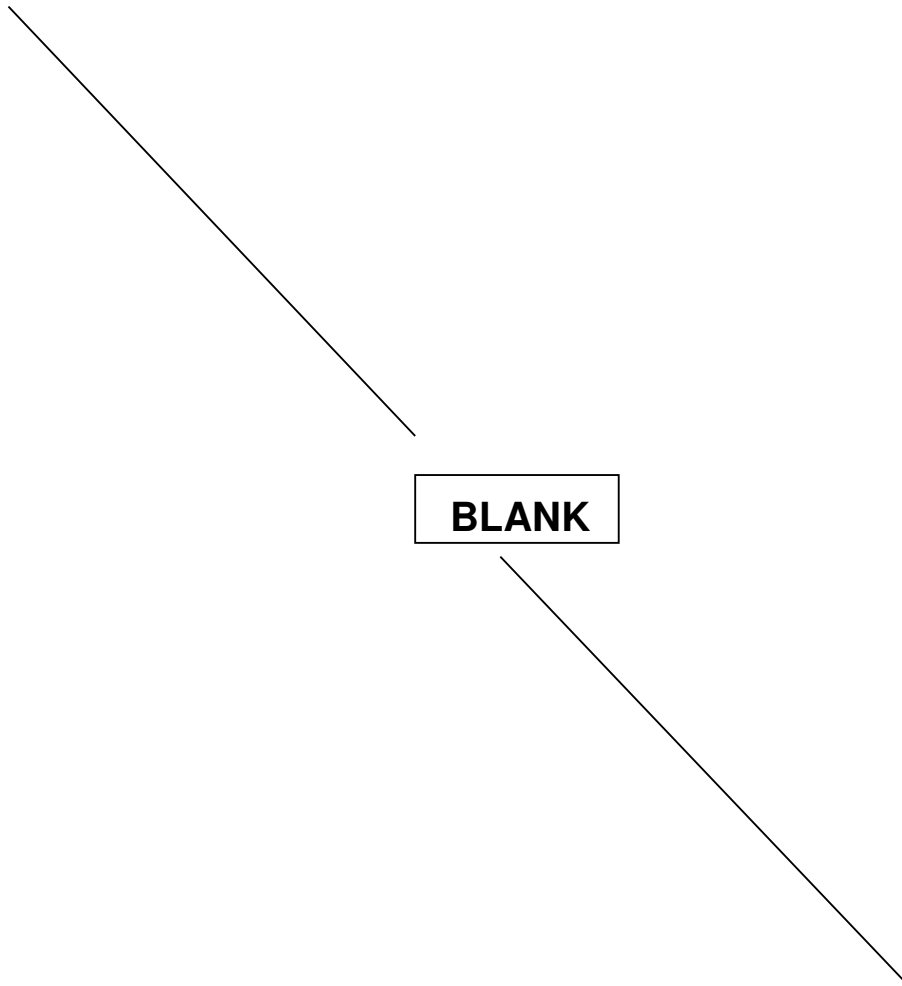

CONDITIONS FOR ARRANGING CEMENT / STEEL BY CONTRACTOR

1.0 CONDITIONS FOR CEMENT

- 1.1 The contractor shall procure **Ordinary Portland Cement conforming to IS:8112 as required in the work.** Cement shall be from reputed manufacturers of cement, such as A.C.C., Ultra tech, Vikram, Shree Cement, Ambuja, Jaypee Cement, Century Cement and J.K. Cement or from any other reputed cement Manufacturer having a production capacity not less than one million tonnes per annum as approved by ADG for that sub region.

The tenderer may also submit a list of names of cement manufacturers which they propose to use in the work. The tender accepting authority reserves right to accept or reject name (S) of cement manufacturers (S) which the tenderer proposes to use in the work. No change in the tendered rates will be accepted if the tender accepting authority does not accept the list of cement manufacturers, given by the tenderer, fully or partially.

The supply of cement shall be taken in 50 kg bags bearing manufacturer's name and ISI marking. Samples of cement arranged by the contractor shall be taken by the Engineer-in-Charge and got tested in accordance with provisions of relevant BIS codes. In case test results indicate that the cement arranged by the contractor does not conform to the relevant BIS codes, the same shall stand rejected and it shall be removed from the site by the Contractor at his own cost within a week's time of written order from the Engineer-in-charge to do so.

- 1.2 The cement shall be brought at site in supply as per requirements of work.

The cement godown of the capacity to store a minimum of 200 bags of cement shall be constructed by the contractor at site of work for which no extra payment shall be made.

- 1.3 Double lock provision shall be made to the door of the cement go-down. The keys of one lock shall remain with the Engineer-in-Charge or his authorized representative and the keys of the other lock shall remain with the contractor. The Contractor shall be responsible for the watch and ward and safety of the cement go-down. The Contractor shall facilitate the inspection of the cement go-down by the Engineer-in-Charge at any time.

- 1.4 The cement shall be got tested by the Engineer-in-charge and shall be used on the work only after satisfactory test results have been received. The contractor shall supply free of charge the cement required for testing including its transportation cost to testing laboratories. The cost of tests shall be borne by the Contractor:

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- 1.5 The actual issue and consumption of cement on work shall be regulated and proper accounts maintained as provided in clause 10 of contract. The theoretical consumption of cement shall be worked out as per procedure prescribed in clause 42 of the contract and shall be governed by conditions laid therein. In case the cement consumption is less than theoretical consumption including permissible variation, recovery at the rate so prescribed shall be made. In case of excess consumption no adjustment need to made.
- 1.6 Cement brought to site and cement remaining unused after completion of work shall not be removed from site without written permission of the Engineer-in-Charge.
- 1.7 The damaged cement shall be removed from the site immediately by the contractor on receipt of a notice in writing from the Engineer-in-charge. If he does not do so within 10 days of receipt of such notice, the Engineer-in-charge shall get it removed at the cost of the contractor.

2.0 SPECIAL CONDITIONS FOR STEEL

27.2 Special conditions for steel reinforcement bars

The CPWD/Contractor shall procure IS marked TMT bars of various grades from

1) The steel manufacturers such as SAIL, TATA steel Ltd., RINI, Jindal Steel & Power Ltd, and JSW steel or their authorized dealers having valid BIS license for IS:1786-2008(Amendment -1 November 2012)

(2) (a) The steel manufacturers or their authorized dealers (as per following selection criteria) having valid BIS license for IS:1786-2008(Amendment -1 November 2012).

The procured steel should have following qualities.-

- i. Excellent ductility, bend ability and elongation of finished product due to possible refining technology.
- ii. Consumption of steel should be accurate as per design.
- iii. Steel should have no brittleness problem in finished product.
- iv. Steel should carry the quality of corrosion and earthquake resistance.
- v. Quality steel with achievement of proper level of sulphur and phosphorus as per IS:1786-2008.

3.0 MATERIALS OBTAINED FROM DISMANTLEMENT

- 3.1 The contractors in course of their work, should understand that all materials (e.g. stone and other materials) obtained in the work of dismantling, excavation etc. will be considered Government's property and may be issued to the contractor if required for use in this work or be credited to the contractor at agreement rates or at rates approved by the S.E. incase rate is not mentioned in agreement BOQ.

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4.0 MATERIAL BROUGHT BY THE CONTRACTOR

4.1 The contractors shall have to deposit, the approved paints of required colour and shade as per actual requirement of the work to be done, with the Engineer-in-Charge at his departmental stores at the site of work.

4.1.1 The paint will be issued to the contractor from time to time according to his requirements for the work in the same manner as the issue of materials stipulated to be issued departmentally.

Similar procedure shall be followed for water proofing compound.

4.2 The day-to-day receipt and issue quantity account of water proofing compound, paints etc. shall be maintained by the Junior Engineer and signed daily by the contractor or his authorised agent.

5.0 TESTING OF MATERIALS

5.1 With a view to avoid controversy about quality of cement concrete as revealed in the test results of 7 days cubes falling short of the prescribed standards by over 10% to 20% and pending testing of balance 3 cubes for 28 days as final confirmatory acceptance test, crushed samples of cement concrete from the failed 7 days cubes should be preserved in a sealed bag.

5.1.1 In case of concrete and reinforced concrete work, the contractor shall be required to make arrangement for carrying out compressive strength tests at his own cost. He shall render all assistance for the preparation of cubes, safe custody of the same, proper curing and carriage up to the laboratory where the test is to be performed, the cube tests can be performed at any laboratory approved by the Engineer-in-Charge.

6.0 Any cement slurry added over base surface (or for continuation of concreting) for bond, if added, its cost shall be deemed to have been included in the respective items, unless otherwise, specifically stated, and nothing extra shall be payable nor extra cement considered in the cement consumption on this account.

- 2.0 For concrete mix design, laboratory tests will be carried out by the contractor through approved laboratories/institutions approved by the Engineer-in-charge. For this purpose the various ingredients for mix design shall be sent to the lab/test houses or Institutions and the samples of such ingredients sent shall be preserved at site. The trial mix shall be prepared with approved aggregates, cement and water. The concrete batching plant to be employed in the work shall be used for preparing the trial mix to simulate actual field conditions.
- 3.0 In respect of projected balconies, projected slabs at roof level and projected verandah, the payment for the R.C.C. work shall be made under the item of R.C.C. slabs. The payment for centering and shuttering of such items shall similarly be paid under the item of centering and shuttering of R.C.C. slab. Nothing extra shall be paid for the side shuttering at the edges of these projected balconies and projected verandahs. All the exposed edge shall, however, be finished as per specifications and nothing extra shall be paid for this.
- 4.0 The rate quoted by the agency shall be net and nothing extra shall be payable on account of change of quantities of concrete ingredients like coarse sand aggregates and admixtures etc. as per the approved mix design.
- 5.0 The Contractor shall engage RMC producing plants as per the list given in the agreement and the contractor shall draw M.O.U. with approved R.M.C. Plant owner and submit to Engineer-in-charge within a week of such approval. The contractor will not be allowed to purchase ready mix concrete without completion of above stated formalities for use in this project.

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PARTICULAR SPECIFICATIONS

1.0 Material

- 1.1 All stone aggregate and stone ballast shall be of hard stone variety to be obtained from approved quarries at Usgaon, dodamarg, panchwadi or any other source to be got approved by the Engineer-in-charge.
- 1.2 Sand should be obtained from Goa govt. approved mines or any other source to be got approved by the Engineer-in-charge and screened as required. The same shall be clean and sharp angular grit type. If the sand brought to site is dirty it must be washed in clean water. In case, river sand is banned or not available locally, use of alternative to river sand i.e. M-Sand as per CPWD specifications shall be permitted by Engineer-in-charge.
- 1.3 Cast iron pipe and fittings without ear shall be used. However, pipes and fitting with ears may be accepted without any extra payment. In such cases, clamps are not required for and no extra payment will be made for fixing the pipes.

2.0 EMBEDDING OF PIPES, CONDUITS ETC.

- 2.1 The brick work for the portions of the external wall of W.C. through which pipes are taken, will be done after the pipes are fixed as far as practicable.
- 2.2. All crossings, embedments etc. in walls and floors for water supply, drainage and sanitary pipes, fittings etc. shall be provided as per previously prepared detailed drawings for individual walls and floors so as to avoid cuttings of brick work and floors. All such areas shall be made good during finishing and nothing extra shall be paid for this.

3 EARTH WORK:-

- 3.1 The work shall be done in accordance with CPWD Specifications - 2019- Vol.I & Vol. II and National Building Code 2016 with upto date correction slips.
- 3.2 Excavation shall be undertaken to the width of the Basement / Retaining wall footing including necessary margins for construction operation as per drawing or directed otherwise. Where the nature of soil or the depth of the trench and season of the year, do not permit vertical sides, the contractor at his own expense shall put up the necessary shoring, strutting and planking or cut slopes with or without steps, to a safer angle or both with due regard to the safety of personnel and works and to the satisfaction of the Engineer – in - charge, Measurement of plan area of excavation for payment shall be

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permitted only. Nothing extra shall be paid for making steps and slopes etc. as required.

- 3.3 The contractor shall make at his own cost all necessary arrangements for maintaining water level, in the area where works are under execution low enough so as not to cause any harm to the works or problems in carrying out with the execution.

4.0 SPECIFICATIONS FOR MOORUM

- 4.1 The contractor has to bring moorum required for filling in the road work, from sources, approved by the Engineer-in-Charge. The filling material shall be moorum obtained from pits of weather disintegrated rocks free from organic matters and should preferably contain siliceous material and natural mixture of clay of calcareous origin. The size of moorum shall not be more than 20mm.
- 4.2 The moorum brought to site shall be directly used for filling and no claim for double handling shall be entertained. Filling shall be done in regular horizontal layers, each not exceeding 20cm, in depth. The moorum shall be free from all roots, grass and rubbish and all lumps and clods, if any, shall be broken. Each layer shall be consolidated by breaking clods, watering and ramming with steel rammers. The top surface of finally finished area shall be dressed.
- 4.3 Before filling is started the contractor shall remove rank vegetation, grass, brushwood, shrubs and building rubbish etc. from the area and nothing extra shall be paid for on this account.

5. CONCRETE WORK:-

The work shall be done in accordance with CPWD Specifications - 2019- Vol.I & Vol. II with upto date correction slips.

6.0 SHUTTERING / Form Work:-

- 6.1 The work shall be done in accordance with CPWD Specifications - 2019- Vol.I & Vol. II with up to date correction slips.
- 6.2 Film coated marine plywood shuttering/ Steel shuttering as approved by the Engineer-in-Charge shall be used by the contractor. Minimum size of shuttering plates shall be 600mm x 900mm except for the case when closing pieces required to complete the shuttering panels. Dented, broken, cracked, twisted or rusted shuttering plates shall not be allowed to be used on the work. And nothing extra should be paid for using superior shuttering/ Form Work.
- 6.3 The shuttering plates shall be cleaned properly with electrically driven sanders to remove any cement slurry or cement mortar or rust. Proper shuttering oil or deboning compound shall be applied on the surface of the shutter plates in the requisite quantity before assembly of steel reinforcement.

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- 6.4 The joint filler shall be resilient closed cell expanded polyethene and non- tainting as manufactured by Supreme Industries Ltd.
- 6.5 Providing joint filler of required thickness in position to substrate using either double sided foam adhesive tape or neoprene synthetic rubber adhesive.

7.0 BRICK WORK:-

Unless otherwise specified bricks of Fly Ash cement/ Fly ash lime & Gypsum of class designation 75 kg/sqcm and AAC blocks of class designation 35 kg/sqcm as per relevant IS codes shall be used in all items of brick work. The work shall also include for leaving chases / notches for dowels / cramps for all kinds of cladding to come over brick work.

8.0 STONE / MARBLE WORK:-

- 8.1 The execution of stones work shall be in general as per CPWD Specifications - 2019– Vol.I & Vol. II with upto date correction slips.
- 8.2 All holes, rebates, recesses etc. for providing fixing and inserts shall be predrilled and precut and worked using precision machine tools.
- 8.3 Samples of each item of stone work either individually or in combination shall be prepared for approval of Engineer-in-Charge before commencement of work.
- 8.4 Sequence of execution for cladding work shall be suggested by the contractor for approval of Engineer-in-Charge.

9.0 SCAFFOLDING:-

- 9.1 The wood work in general shall be carried out as per CPWD Specifications – 2019 Vol.I & II with upto date correction slips.
- 9.2 All fittings and fixtures shall be got approved from the Engineer-in Charge before procurement well in advance and the approved samples shall be kept at site till completion of the work for which nothing extra shall be paid.
- 9.3 The shape and size of beading shall be as per drawings. The joints of beading shall be mitered.

10.0 FLOORING

- 10.1 All work in general shall be carried out as per CPWD Specifications- 2019 - Vol.I & Vol. II with upto date correction slips.

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- 10.2 Whenever flooring is to be done in patterns tiles/ stone, the contractor shall get samples of each pattern laid and approved by the Engineer-in-Charge before final laying of such flooring for which nothing extra shall be paid.
- 10.3 Different stones/ tiles used in pattern flooring as per the approved architectural drawings and nothing extra for laying pattern flooring shall be paid. No additional wastage if any shall be accounted for any extra payment.
- 10.4 The proper gradient shall be given to flooring for toilets, varrandah, kitchen, court yard, etc. as per the directions of Engineer-in-Charge For this there may be extra thickness of mortar below the tiles/stone slabs. These gradients should be insured in the shuttering itself.

11.0 Ceramic Tiles / Vitrified Tiles Work/ Granite stone flooring

- 11.1 Work shall be carried out as per CPWD Specifications- 2019 Vol I & II with up to date correction slips and as per manufactures specifications.
- 11.2 Rates shall be inclusive of all operations including labour, material, wastage, T&P, scaffolding etc. complete. Nothing extra shall be payable on these account.
- 11.3 One piece Granite stone for treads / risers in staircase shall be used including rounding of nose.
- 11.4 POP protection layer shall be laid on all finished floors for protection from damage during execution of other items of work in that area which shall be removed and cleaned just before handing over of the premises for which nothing extra shall be paid.
- 11.5 The testing of tiles shall be carried out at prescribed frequency and methodology as per IS 13630.

12.0 STAINLESS STEEL RAILING/HANDRAILS:

12.1 GENERAL

The contractor shall apply all materials, labour, tools, ladders, scaffolding and other equipments necessary for the completion and protection of all stainless steel work.

12.2 MATERIAL

All stainless steel pipes and plates shall conform to AISI 304 in 18/8 composition. 18 will be chromium and 8 will be Nickel and carbon content will be 0.03 maximum and the relevant clauses associated with this grade of steel to be followed.

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12.3 SURFACE FINISH

Surface finish of all the stainless steel materials will be in 240 grit satin finish / matt finish.

13.0 FINISHING

- 13.1 The work shall be carried out as per CPWD Specifications- 2019 Vol.-I & Vol. II with upto date correction slips.
- 13.2 All painting material shall brought to the site of work in the original sealed containers. The material brought to the site of work shall be sufficient for at least 30 days of work. The material shall be kept under the joint custody of contractor and representative of the Engineer-in-Charge. The empty containers shall not be removed from the site till the completion of the work without permission of the Engineer-in-Charge.
- 13.3 Paint register shall be maintained as per CPWD proforma for periodical verification by CPWD

14.0 FIXING OF SCI/CI PIPE

- 14.1 The SCI/CI pipes and G.I. pipes, wherever necessary, shall be fixed to RCC columns, beams etc. with rawl plugs, or appropriate fasteners as approved by Engineer-in-Charge, and nothing extra shall be payable on this account. GI pipes shall be, wherever made to pass through wall / concrete, then it shall be done using protective sleeves around the pipes to protect it from damage, nothing extra shall be payable on this account.
- 14.2 Water tanks, taps, sanitary, water supply and drainage pipes, fittings and accessories should confirm to bye-laws and specifications of the Municipal Body/Corporation where CPWD Specifications are not available. The work of water supply, internal sanitary installation and drainage etc. shall be carried out as per local Municipal Corporation or such local body bye-laws. The contractor shall get the materials (fixtures/fittings) tested by the Municipal body/Corporation authorities wherever required at his own cost and after completion of work shall produce necessary completion certificates from such authorities.

15. RATES

- 15.1 The rates quoted by the Contractor are deemed to be inclusive of site clearance, setting out work, profile, setting lay out on ground, establishment of reference bench mark(s), installing various signage, taking spot levels, survey with total station, construction of all safety and protection devices, compulsory use of helmet and safety shoes, and other appropriate safety gadgets by workers, imparting continuous

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training for all the workers, barriers, preparatory works, construction of clean, hygienic and well ventilated workers housings in sufficient numbers as per drawing supplied by Engineer in charge, working during monsoon or odd season, working beyond normal hours, working at all depths, height, lead, lift, levels and location, etc. and any other unforeseen but essential incidental works required to complete this work. Nothing extra shall be payable on this account and no extension of time for completion of work shall be granted on these accounts.

- 15.2 All ancillary and incidental facilities required for execution of work like labour camp, stores, fabrication yard, offices for Contractor, watch and ward, temporary ramp required to be made for working at the basement level, temporary structure for plants and machineries, water storage tanks, installation and consumption charges of temporary electricity, telephone, water etc. required for execution of the work. Protection works, testing facilities / laboratory at site of work, facilities for all field tests and for taking samples etc. during execution or any other activity which is necessary (for execution of work and as directed by Engineer-in-Charge), shall be deemed to be included in rates quoted by the Contractor, for various items in the schedule of quantities. Nothing extra shall be payable on these accounts.
- 15.3 For completing the work in time, the Contractor might be required to work in two or more shifts (including night shifts). No claim whatsoever shall be entertained on this account, not with-standing the fact that the Contractor may have to pay extra amounts for any reason, to the labourers and other staff engaged directly or indirectly on the work according to the provisions of the labour and other statutory bodies regulations and the agreement entered upon by the Contractor with them.
- 15.4 All material shall only be brought at site as per program finalized with the Engineer-in-Charge. Any pre-delivery of the material not required for immediate consumption shall not be accepted and thus not paid for.

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GUARANTEE TO BE EXECUTED BY CONTRACTOR
FOR REMOVAL OF DEFECTS
AFTER COMPLETION IN RESPECT OF WATER PROOFING WORKS.

This agreement made this _____ day of _____ Two Thousand _____ between _____ son of _____ (hereinafter called the guaranter on one part) and President of India (hereinafter called Government of the other part).

WHEREAS THIS agreement is supplementary to a contract (hereinafter called the contract) dated _____ and made between the GUARANTER OF THE ONE part and the GOVERNMENT of the other part, where by the contractor, interalia, undertook to render to buildings and structures in the said contract recited completely water and leak proof.

AND WHEREAS THE GUARANTER agreed to give a guarantee to the effect that the said structures will remain water and leak - proof for five years from the date of giving the water proofing treatment.

NOW THE GUARANTER hereby guarantees that water proofing treatment given by him will render the structures completely leak - proof and the minimum life of such water proofing treatment shall be five years to be reckoned from the date after the maintenance period prescribed in the contract.

Provided that the guaranter will not be responsible for leakage caused by earthquakes or structural defects or misuse of roof or alterations and for such purpose :

- a) misuse of roof shall mean any operation which will damage proofing treatment, like chopping of firewood and things of the same nature which might cause damage to the roof,
- b) alteration shall mean construction of an additional storey or a part or construction adjoining to existing roof, where by water-proofing treatment is removed in parts :
- c) the decision of the Engineer-in-Charge with regard to cause of leakage shall be final.

During this period of guarantee the guaranter shall make good all defects and in case of any defects being found, render the building water proof to the satisfaction of Engineer-in-Charge at his cost and shall commence the work for such rectification within seven days from the date of issue of the notice from the Engineer-in-Charge calling upon him to rectify the defects, failing which the work shall be got done by the Department by some other contractor at the GUARANTER'S cost and risk. The decision of the Engineer-in-Charge as to the cost, payable by the Guaranter shall be final and binding.

That if Guarantee fails to execute the water proofing or commits breach thereunder, then the Guarantor will indemnify the principal and his successors against all

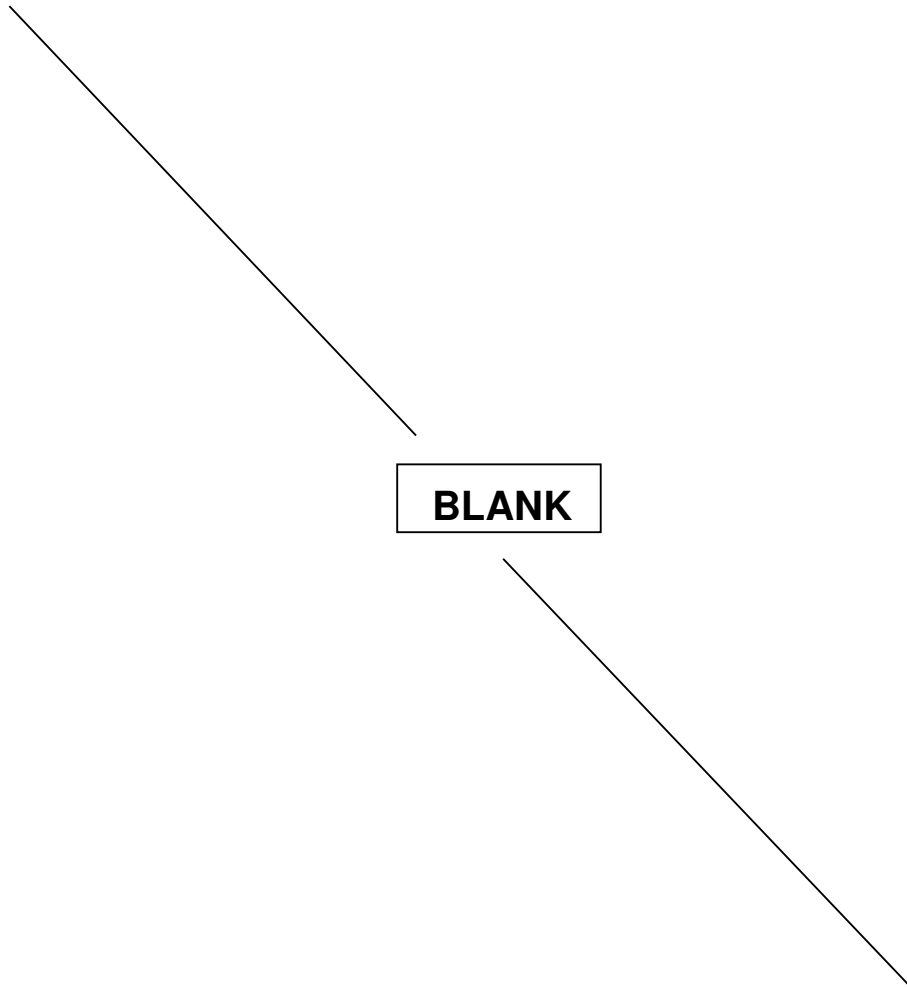

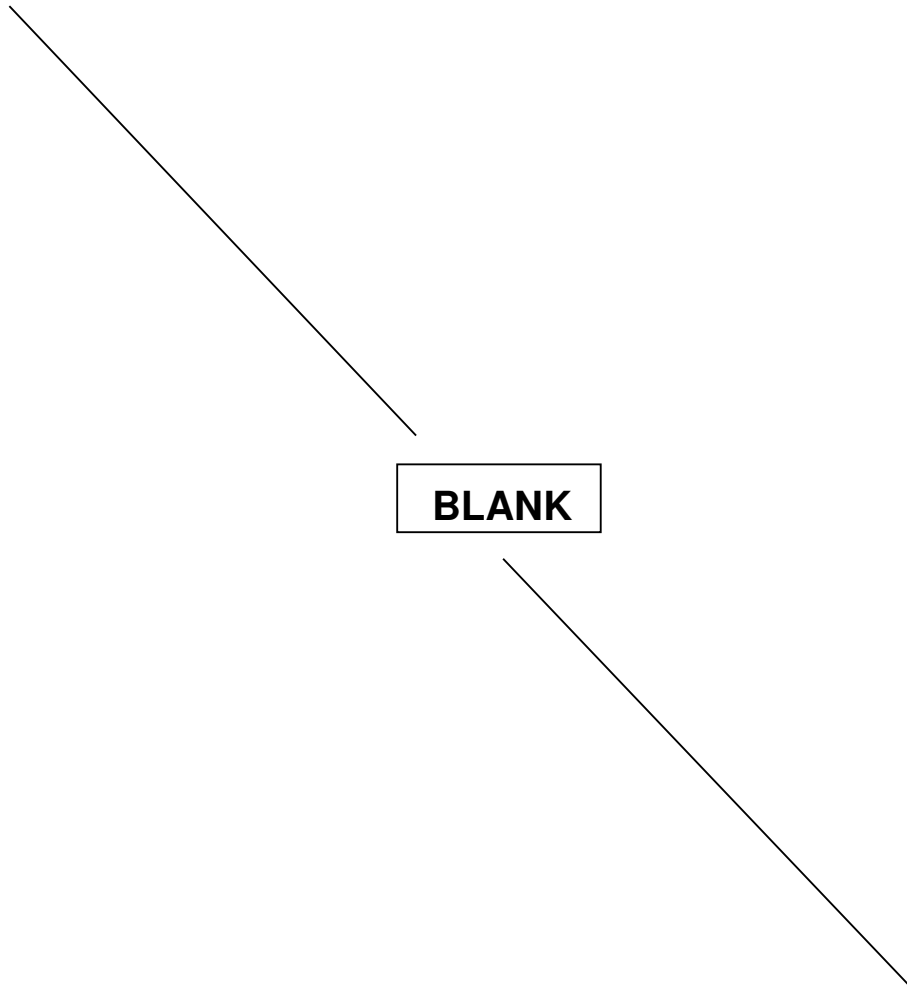

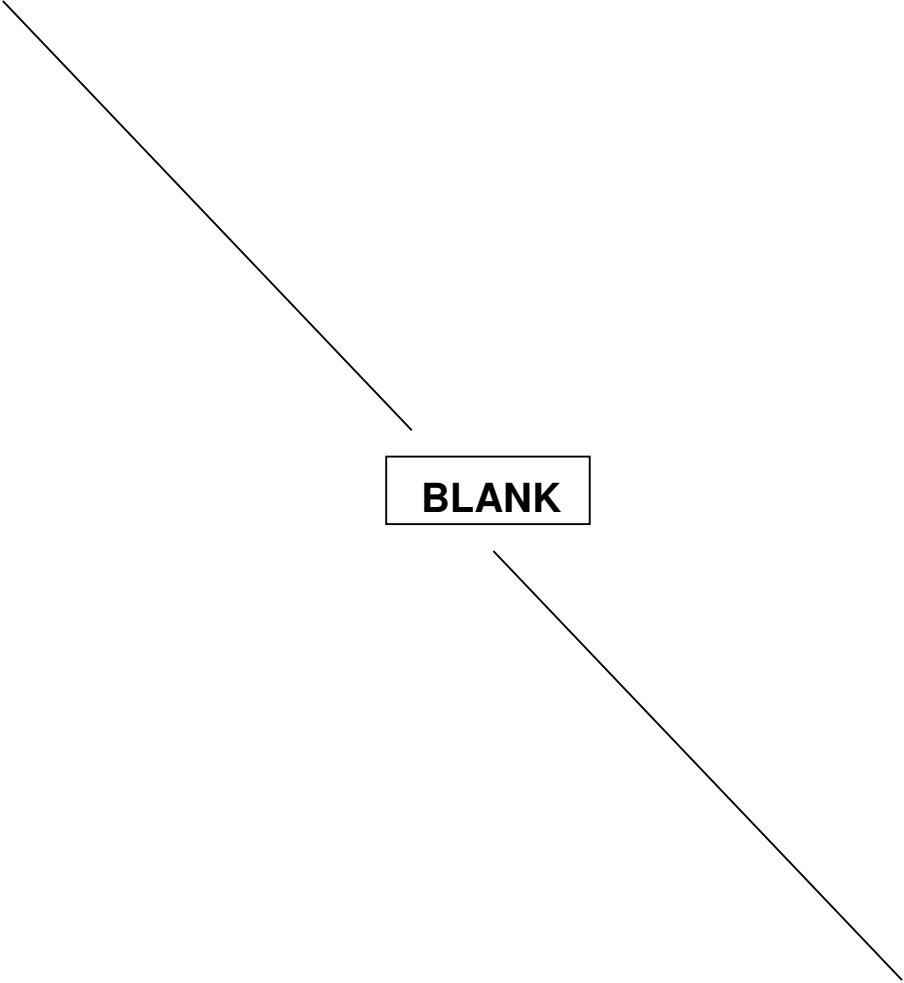
